Hello,

Please be reminded that, per the Regulation of Adult Use Policies and Procedures Section 21a-421j-3 (a), all cannabis must be disposed of “in the presence of an authorized representative of the commissioner in such a manner as to render the cannabis non-recoverable,” unless the Department of Consumer Protection has approved an alternative process in the form of a Standard Operating Procedure (SOP). All requests for alternative process approval will be reviewed on an individual basis. The Department does not offer blanket approval to specific processes as each licensee poses unique circumstances.

If you are planning to dispose of cannabis and do not have an alternative SOP approved by the Agency, we will assign an agent to be present for the disposal. Please notify us via email at dcp.cannabislicensing@ct.gov no less than 72 business hours in advance and include the products to be disposed of and planned manner of disposal.
