RE: Sale of Manufacturer Hemp Products

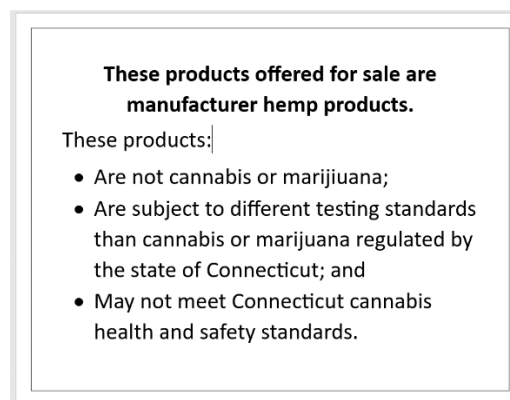
[Public Act 23-166](#) allows for the sale of manufacturer hemp products by licensed dispensary facilities, hybrid retailers and retailers. Please note that each manufacturer hemp product sold within these establishments must be:

- Stored separately from marijuana, cannabis or cannabis products.
- Conspicuously separated from cannabis or cannabis products in any display area.
- Clearly labeled to distinguish each individual manufacturer hemp product as (1) A manufacturer hemp product; (2) Subject to different testing standards than cannabis or marijuana; and (3) Not marijuana, cannabis or a cannabis product. This labeling requirement for each product may be satisfied by means of a sticker.
- Displayed with signage approved by the department (see details and example below).

Display Signage pertaining to manufacturer hemp products must be approved by the Department prior to being posted. The sign should be conspicuous and not part of any product advertisement or name. It should clearly and conspicuously state the following:

- The product offered for sale is a manufacturer hemp product and not cannabis or marijuana;
- The product is subject to different testing standards than cannabis and marijuana regulated by the state of Connecticut; and,
- The product may not meet Connecticut cannabis health and safety standards.
