RE: DCP announces public comment period for proposed regulations of Adult-Use Cannabis and Medical Marijuana

The public comment period will close January 10, 2025.

HARTFORD — The Department of Consumer Protection has opened a public comment period to receive input on the proposed regulations for the Adult-Use Cannabis and Medical Marijuana programs.

The Adult-Use Cannabis program has been governed by formal Policies and Procedures since the inception of the program. The new regulations will mirror the Policies and Procedures for the Regulation of Adult-Use Cannabis, and combine existing regulations for the Medical Marijuana Program to create a cohesive set of regulations. The language remaining in the Palliative Use of Marijuana regulations is specific to medical regulation that does not overlap with the Adult-Use industry.

These proposed regulations will create clarity, stability and consistency in the regulation of the legal cannabis market. Information about the regulation process can be found on the [Connecticut General Assembly's website](#).
