RE: Delivery of Cannabis and Cannabis Products to Consumers, Patients and Caregivers

As of July 1, 2024, all delivery to consumers, patients and caregivers must be performed through a licensed delivery service. Licensed retailers, hybrid retailers, micro-cultivators and dispensary facilities must stop using their own employees to deliver cannabis and cannabis products no later than June 30, 2024. [For more information, please review Section 7 of Public Act 24-76.](#)

Licensed cannabis establishments may continue to use their own employees or a licensed transporter to transport their cannabis to other licensed cannabis establishments, research programs, or laboratories as authorized in [Chapter 420h](#) of the general statutes.
