Re: **Final Product Testing**

Effective September 15, 2024, all products presented to a cannabis testing laboratory for final certificate of analysis must be in their final packaging in accordance with section 21a-421j-29(e) of the Department's Policies and Procedures. Please keep in mind that the entire batch needs to be packaged and presented in its entirety for random sampling by the cannabis testing laboratory.

If you would like to conduct preliminary testing for any contaminants prior to packaging, you may do so pursuant to 21a-421j-29(d).

As a reminder, the batch size restriction does not take effect until January 1, 2025.

No action needs to be taken for previously registered products.

All COA's received prior to September 15, 2024 may still be used for product registration provided they were received within the 30 days prior, pursuant to 21a-421j-30(d)(1) of the Department's Policies and Procedures.
