



Pre-filled Dual-Chamber Vaporizer Delivery Device Guidance

This guidance document addresses cannabis products that comprise a single vape device containing two pre-filled chambers within the same vaporizer delivery device, where each chamber is pre-filled with cannabis oil from different batches.

The manufacturing cannabis establishment shall:

1. Ensure the cannabis oil in each chamber receives its own universal identification number (UID) from the Cannabis Analytic Tracking System (CATS) and passing certificate of analysis (COA) testing prior to product registration;
2. Comply with all labeling requirements for each cannabis oil product within the dual-chamber vape device;
3. Include specific instructions that only one chamber of the dual-chamber vaporizer delivery device should be consumed at one time, such that both chambers shall not be consumed simultaneously;
4. Register each side of the dual-chamber device separately with the Department. Each side's brand application should be submitted with its respective batch information. Each separately registered side may use the same product name if it also includes a differentiator. Ex: Product 1 (Side A) and Product 1 (Side B), Product 2 (Side 1) and Product 2 (Side 2), etc.; and,
5. Only register a pre-filled dual-chamber vaporizer delivery device with either:
 - a. A button, toggle or other similar mechanism that only allows access to the cannabis oil from one chamber at a time; or
 - b. Physically separate areas where only one chamber can be accessed at a time for consumption.

The device may:

1. Use the same heating element for each cannabis oil chamber; and
2. Contain cannabis oils that constitute different cannabis oil products in each chamber.

Note: It is permissible for a cannabis establishment to register and sell pre-filled cartridges to be used in vaporizer delivery devices, that are sold separately, that have the ability to accept multiple cartridges. Devices or paraphernalia not containing cannabis are not subject to registration with the Department.
