ACCESSORY STRUCTURE. A structure that is accessory to and incidental to that of the dwelling(s) or townhouse(s) and that is located on the same lot.	ACCESSORY STRUCTURE. A structure [that] <u>whose use</u> is accessory to and incidental to that of the dwelling(s) or townhouse(s) and that is located on the same lot.	As written by the ICC, the definition is grammatically incorrect. The second "that" ("incidental to that of") is indefinite -- it doesn't have any precedent so it's unclear what "that" refers to.
