- a) **C-22-02** Complaint regarding Town of Chester, Richard Leighton, Building Inspector & Fire Marshal. This is in reference to the building permits issued for buildings located RE: [189-191 Middlesex Avenue, Chester, CT] received 5/3/22 from Mr. Thomas A. Gribbin A.I.A Noyes Vogt Architects. Referred to OSBI for investigation; report submitted to Committee. Compliance Panel assigned: Donald Harwood, Lou Free, Henry Miga. Notarized complaint form received 10/12/23. Compliance conference held 4/11/24. Recommendation sent to full Committee. Matter to proceed with formal hearing.
