Provider Description

Information provided by the provider describing their agency:

HART United, Inc. is a private, non-profit agency founded in 1979. The agency provides support services in a variety of settings to nearly 150 individuals with developmental disabilities throughout CT. The agency encourages individuals and their families to have more choices and opportunities in the community.

The HART administrative office is located in North Haven. The licensed group homes are located in New Haven, Hamden, Wallingford, Milford and Waterbury. HART also supports individuals in apartment programs and provides in-home supports to families requiring respite.

Since 1990, HART, in collaboration with DDS, provides nursing and assistance with licensure to 40 Community Companion Homes supporting 65 individuals throughout CT. Families licensed by DDS share their homes with, and provide support for, individuals with developmental disabilities. Community Companion Homes provide a more family-oriented living environment than a Community Living Arrangement (CLA) and offer a viable residential option. The supports encourage integration and participation in all aspects of community life.

Some additional support services HART provides are social skills, self-advocacy, behavioral intervention, daily living skills, psychiatric services, vocational counseling, nursing, Special Olympics participation, nutritional counseling, occupational therapy, physical therapy, speech therapy, and money management.

HART will continue to maintain a commitment to persons with developmental disabilities, effecting changes that will empower individuals and their families to have more choices and opportunities in the future. The philosophy of our founders will continue...respect and dignity to all individuals.
