

SPECIAL SERVICES:

DIRECT CREMATION

3,380 – 3,650

Our charge for a Direct Cremation (without ceremony) includes Initial transfer of the deceased from the local place of death; washing and disinfecting; transfer to crematory; cremation; medical examiner's fee; basic services of staff; refrigeration; pouch to enclose unembalmed remains.

If you want to arrange a Direct Cremation, you can use an alternative container. Alternative containers encase the body and can be made of materials like fiberboard or composition materials (with or without an outside covering). The containers we provide are constructed of heavy cardboard and are not included in the Direct Cremation Price.

IMMEDIATE BURIAL

Our charge for an Immediate Burial (without ceremony) includes Initial transfer of the deceased from the local place of death; transfer of the deceased to the cemetery; basic services of staff; sheltering of remains; and washing & disinfection of remains (required by law).

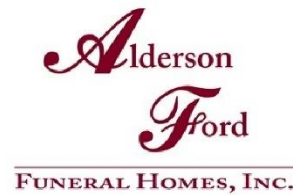

CONNECTICUT SALES TAX: 6.35% Sales Tax is incurred on funeral merchandise over a **\$2,500** exemption less the retail price of the casket selected for burial. Sales tax will also be charged on Cash Advances where applicable.

PROFESSIONAL SERVICES:

A.) BASIC SERVICES OF FUNERAL DIRECTOR, STAFF AND OVERHEAD **3,850**

Our fee for basic services includes, but is not limited to staff to respond to the initial request for service; arrangement conference with family or responsible party; arrangement of the funeral; preparation and filing of necessary authorizations and permits; recording vital statistics; preparation and placement of obituary notices; staff assistance prior to and following the funeral, including coordination with those providing other portions of the funeral such as cemetery, crematory, ministers and others. Also included in these charges are overhead expenses relative to our facility such as insurance, property taxes, telephone and utility, maintenance, custodial service, parking lot and grounds, as well as various religious and fraternal paraphernalia, business equipment, and supervision of these basic minimum services. This fee for our basic services and overhead will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. (This fee is already included in our charges for direct cremation, immediate burials, and forwarding or receiving remains).

B.) EMBALMING **1250**

Except in certain special cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation or immediate burial.
