Homeless Systems Hubs

Initiated in 2021 by DOH, Hubs provides access to homeless system services beyond the 211-call system and seeks to increase efficiency in housing placements for those facing homelessness by offering walk-in, on-site housing support services. Social services referrals can also include employment and training resources, mental health support, reentry services, disability resources, substance abuse and recovery, and referrals to youth services to prevent homelessness.

Some Hubs may also provide basic needs services such as hot meals, showers, laundry, mail services, respite services, day/warming shelter access, and health clinic services, as well as access to flexible funds to cover transportation costs, car repairs, and alternative or temporary housing.
