The Connecticut Department of Transportation (CTDOT) is seeking to retain one (1) professional consulting firm to provide Program Management services for projects, planning studies and other services associated with managing the Greater Hartford Mobility Program (GHMP). Responsibilities will include, but are not limited to, program management and oversight of tasks to deliver the various multi-modal initiatives of the GHMP. Additional duties may include:

- *Provide coordination, oversight and administration of planning and design consultants, Department staff, and contractors assigned to the program/projects.*
- *Research, maintain, and update information and documents which have been developed as part of the program. This includes reviewing past information as well as any newly developed material as the program moves forward.*
- *Develop, implement, and maintain program level reporting to the CTDOT (scope, schedule, cost, quality, safety, etc.).*
- *Provide support to evaluate, research and determine funding and revenue streams, including various grants or other funding sources.*
- *Develop and maintain planning and program-level schedules.*
- *Develop and maintain program-level budgets, including quantity and cost estimates.*
- *Develop planning and feasibility studies.*
- *Develop, manage and facilitate the risk management process, including the development of the initial risk register and risk management plan.*
- *Provide oversight, support services and coordination for public outreach/involvement and stakeholder engagement.*
- *Maintain the GHMP website, including coordination with other project websites associated with the GHMP.*
- *Provide marketing, branding, and advertising support for associated programs/projects.*
- *Prepare and maintain the Project Management Plans (PMP) and other required documents for federal oversight agencies.*
- *Prepare and maintain Traffic Management Plans.*
- *Provide planning and engineering services, discrete design services, environmental and construction phase support.*

The CTDOT is seeking to engage one (1) firm to perform the Construction Engineering and Inspection services for the following project:

Project No. 0166-0104 – The Project consists of the construction of a new maintenance facility to be located on Rt. 69 in Wolcott. The new 5,850 square foot building is a facility composed of 3,525 sf of bay area and a 2,325 sf office core area. The building is steel frame construction with exterior steel siding. The work includes concrete, steel framing, steel joists, metal roof, waterproofing, insulation, metal wall panels and accessories, fireproofing, joint sealants, expansion control, doors and frames, overhead coiling doors, aluminum and steel windows, hardware, glazing, louvers, metal framing and gypsum board, interior finishes, interior specialties, equipment, furnishings, tank monitoring system, plumbing systems, heating-ventilating-air conditioning systems, electrical systems, communications systems, and electronic safety systems. Site work associated with this facility consists of excavation and grading, removal and disposal of existing pavement, re-use of a fuel-oil aboveground storage tank and wastewater holding underground storage tank, new 1000 gallon diesel tank and motor fuel island, new domestic water well, potable water underground storage tank and booster pump, septic system, generator, new utilities, new pavement, fencing, pavement markings, limited turf establishment, and exterior site lighting.
