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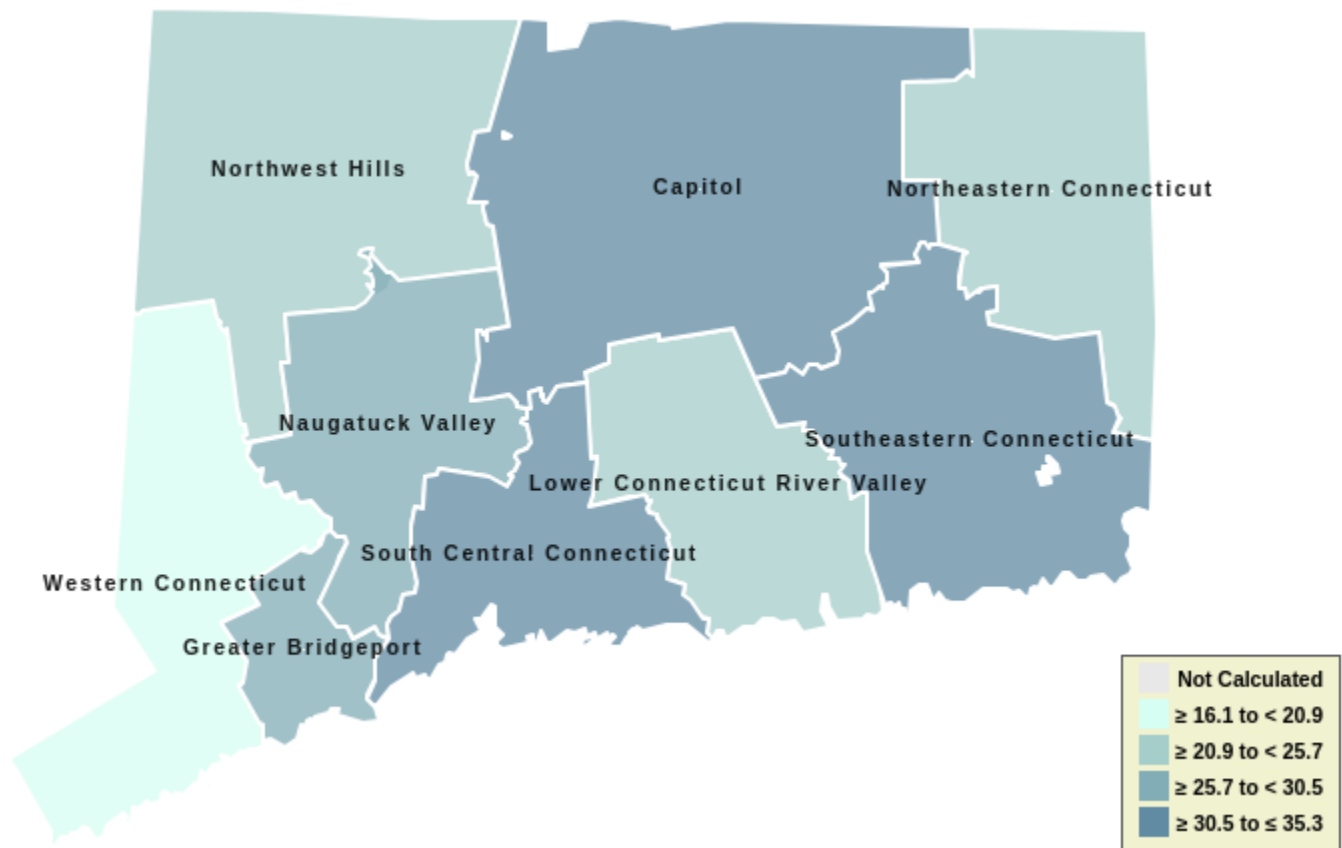
Limitations

Data presented in this report is from Connecticut's syndromic surveillance system, EpiCenter, which collects real-time data from Emergency Departments (ED) in Connecticut. Limitations that should be considered when interpreting this data include:

- Local health departments and districts with zero cases are not included in this report.
- Healthcare data is associated with ZIP codes, which are not defined with respect to town, county, or any other administrative region boundaries. Where ZIP codes cross boundaries, they were assigned to both towns/counties/regions so that local health department personnel are not missing data from their jurisdiction. As a result, reported totals for individual towns, counties or other administrative regions may sum to a value greater than the reported total for the state or other containing regions.

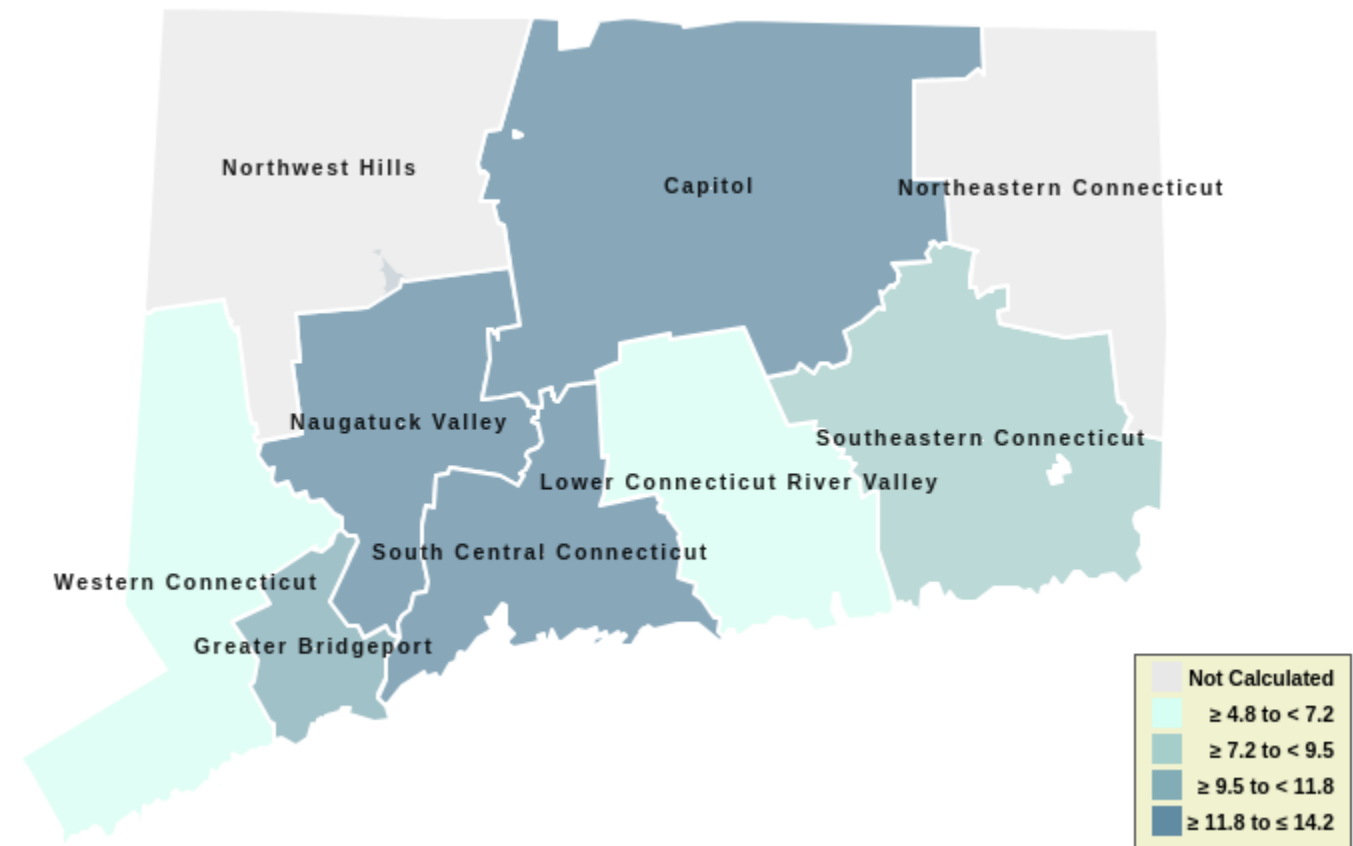

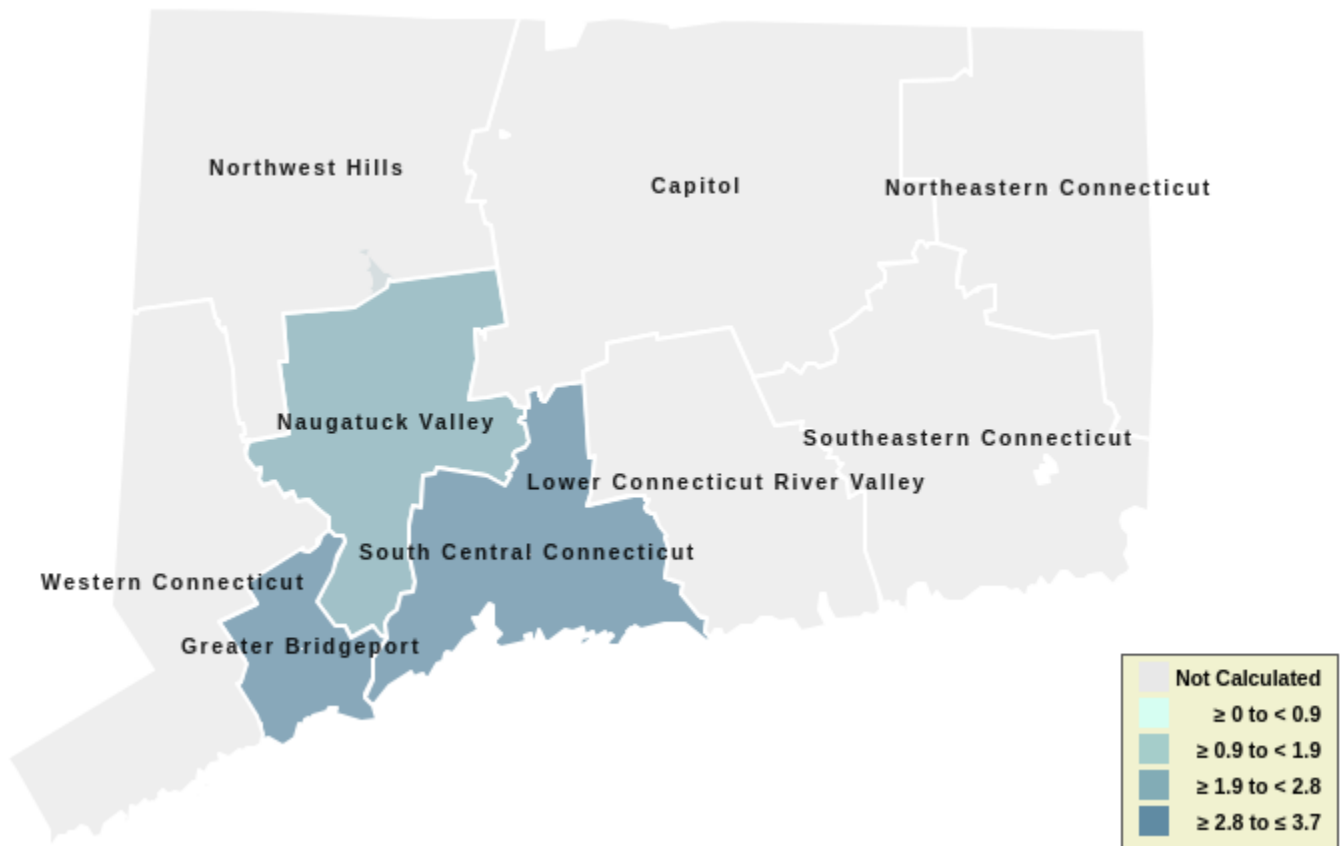

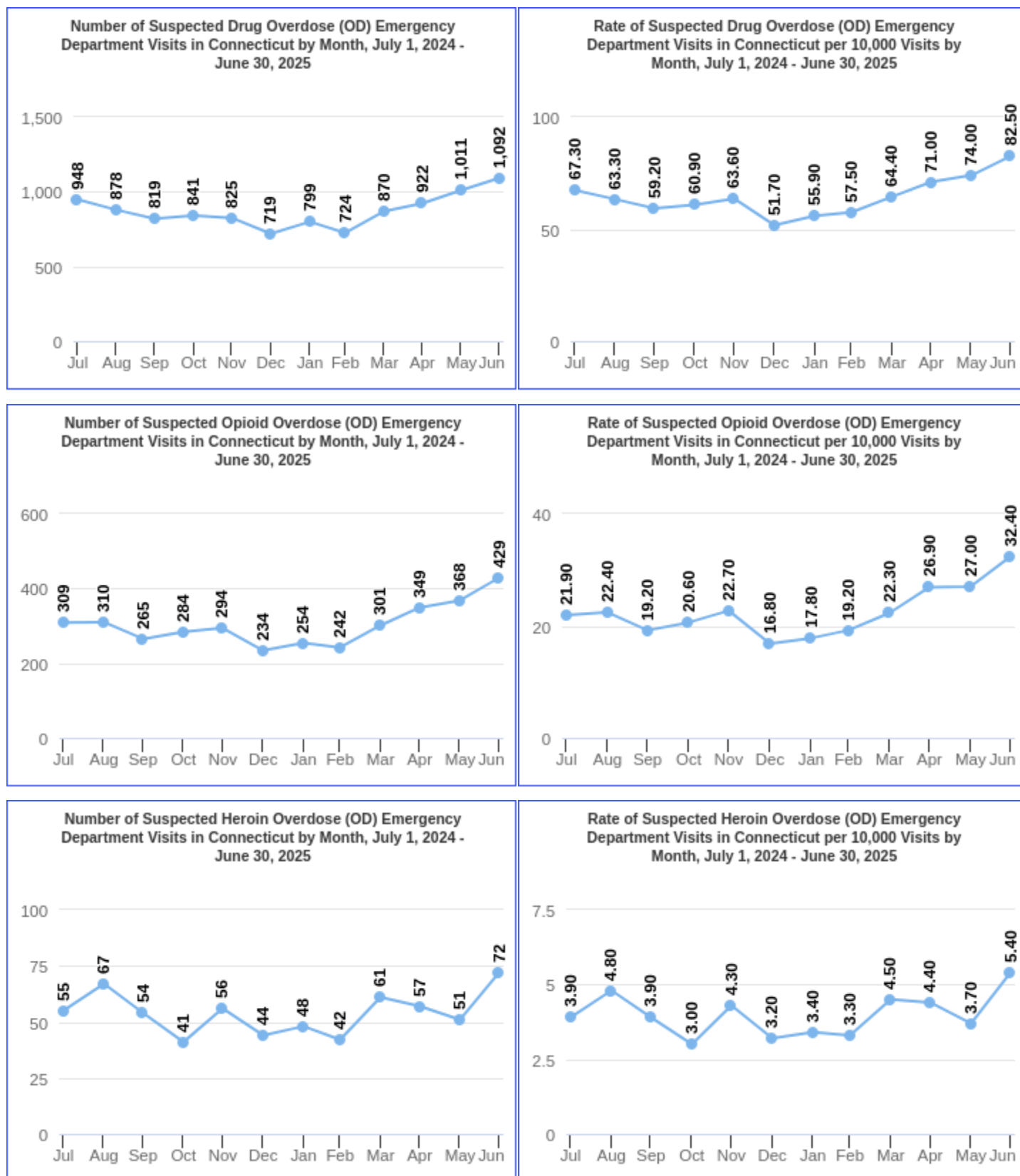

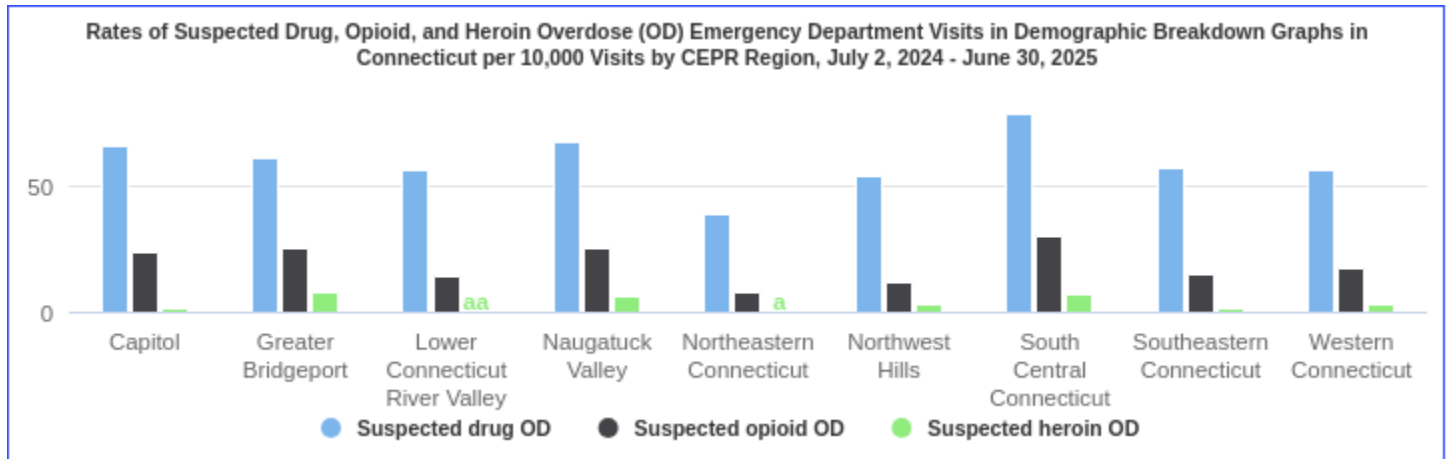

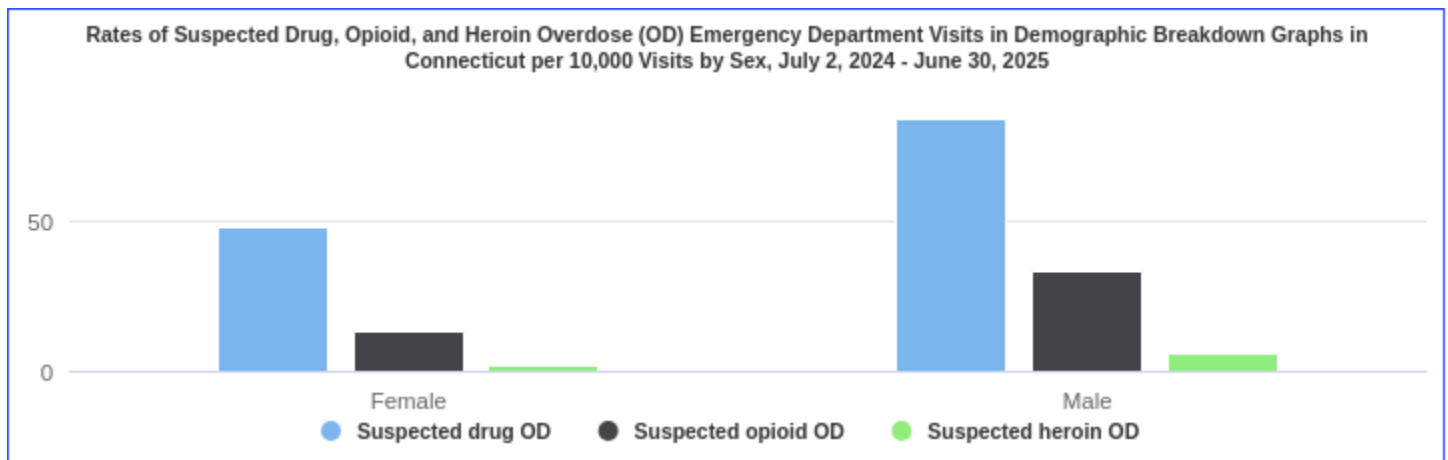

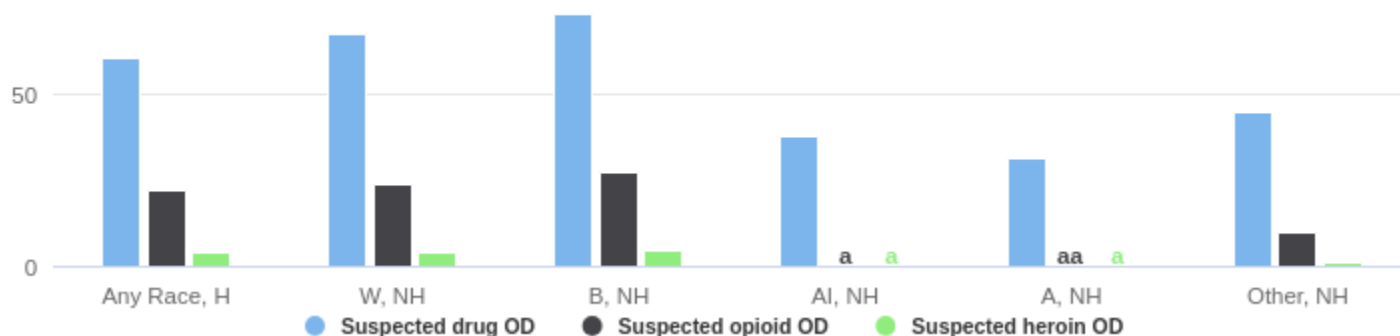

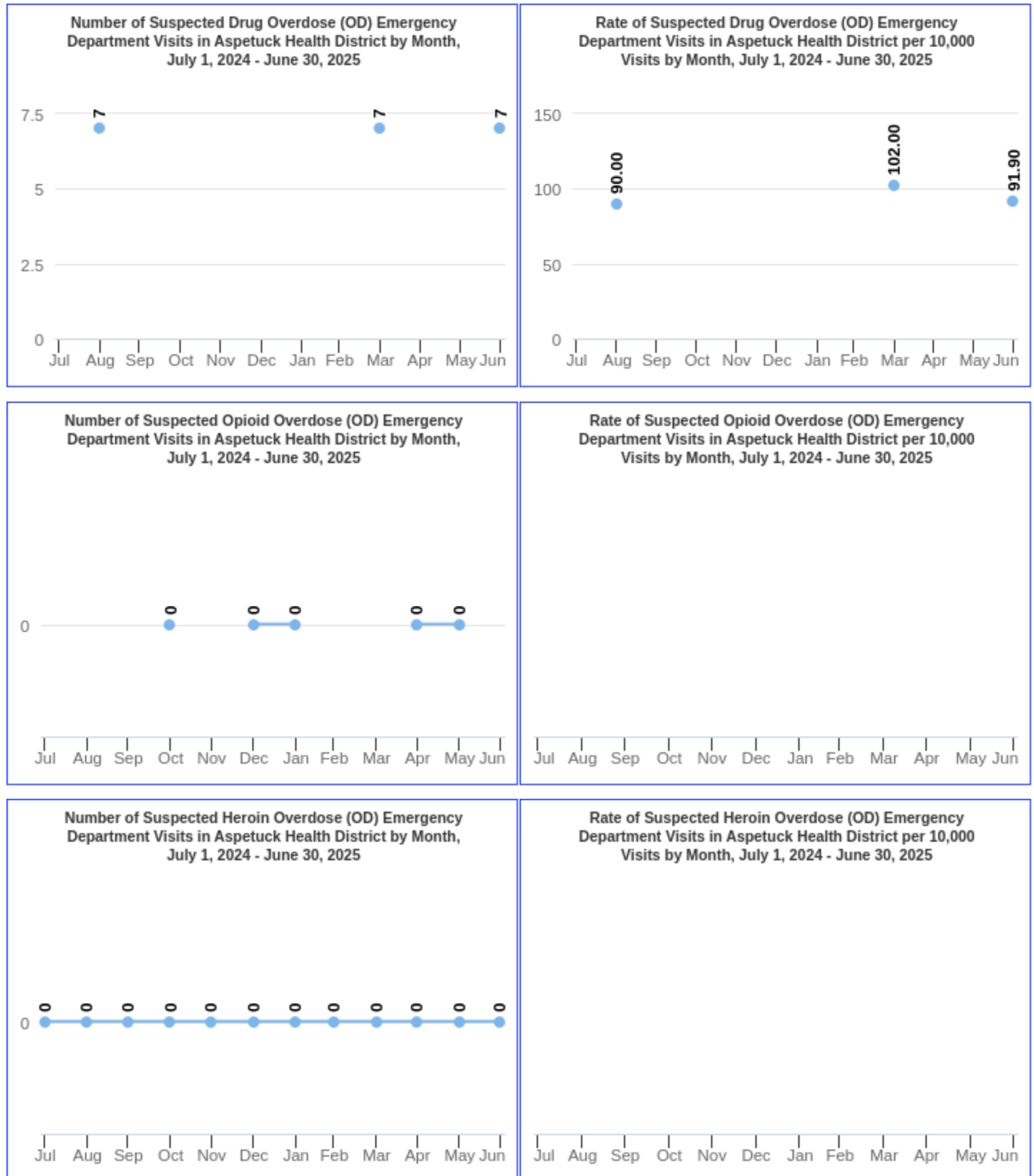

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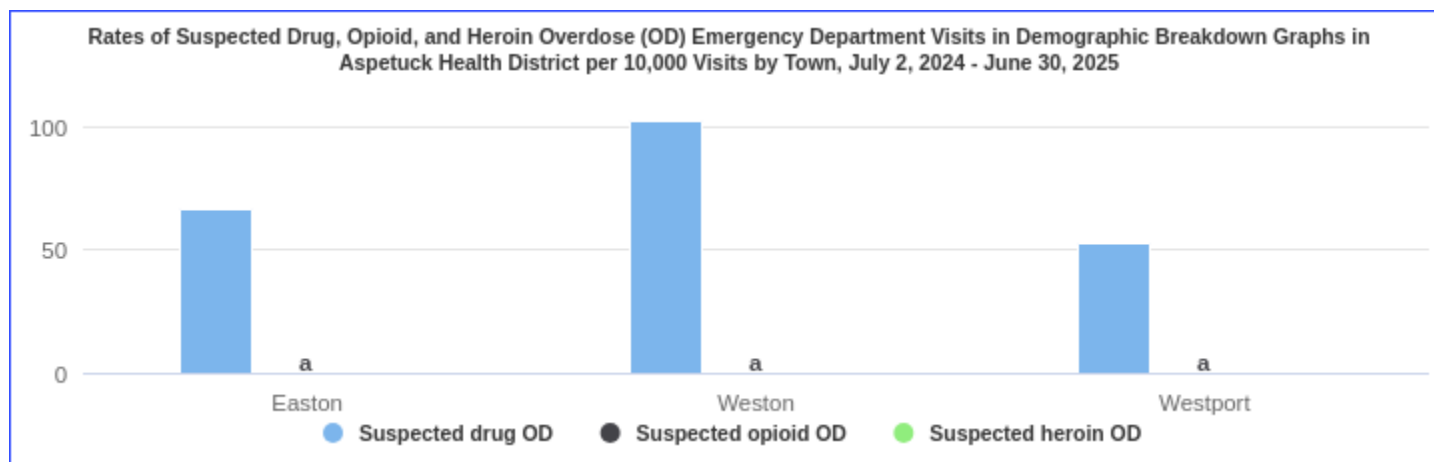

Suspected Drug Overdose in Aspetuck Health District



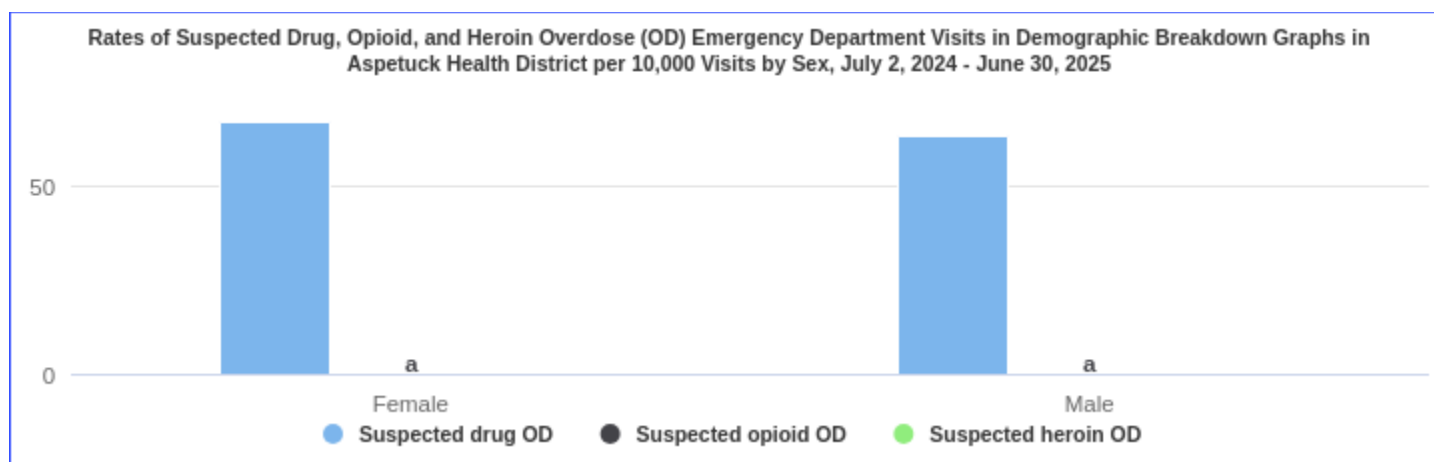

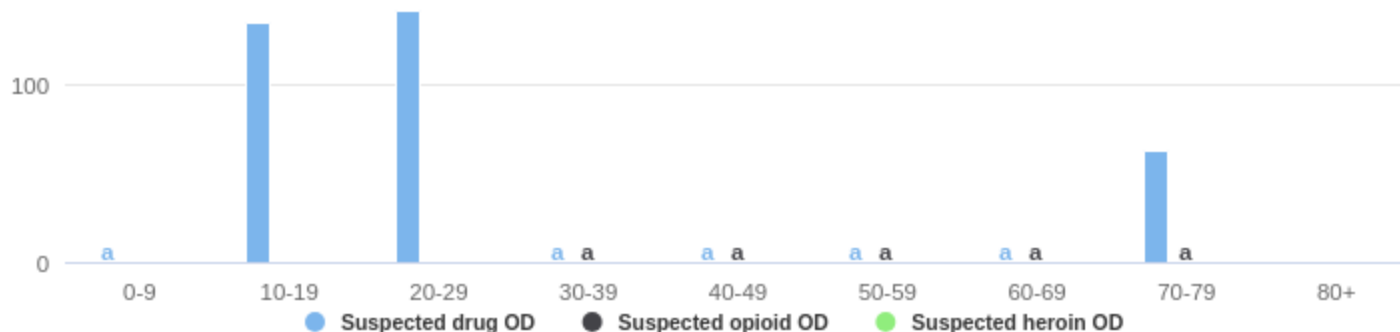

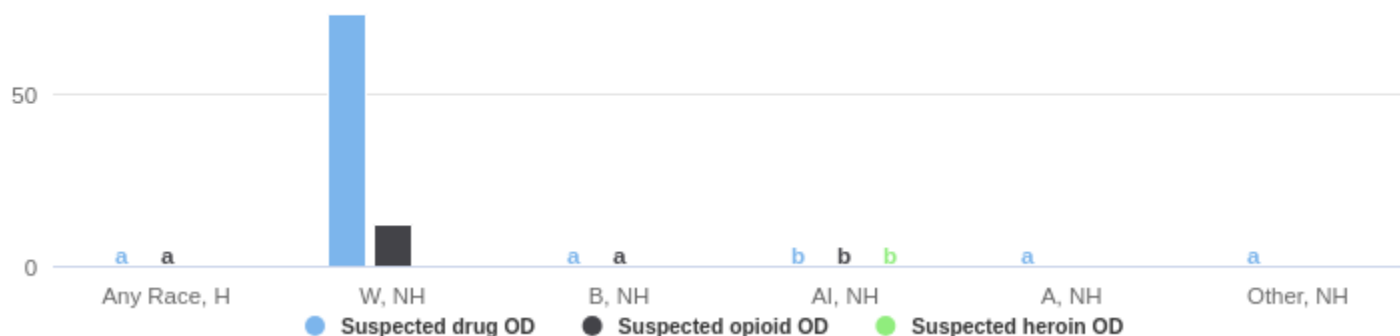

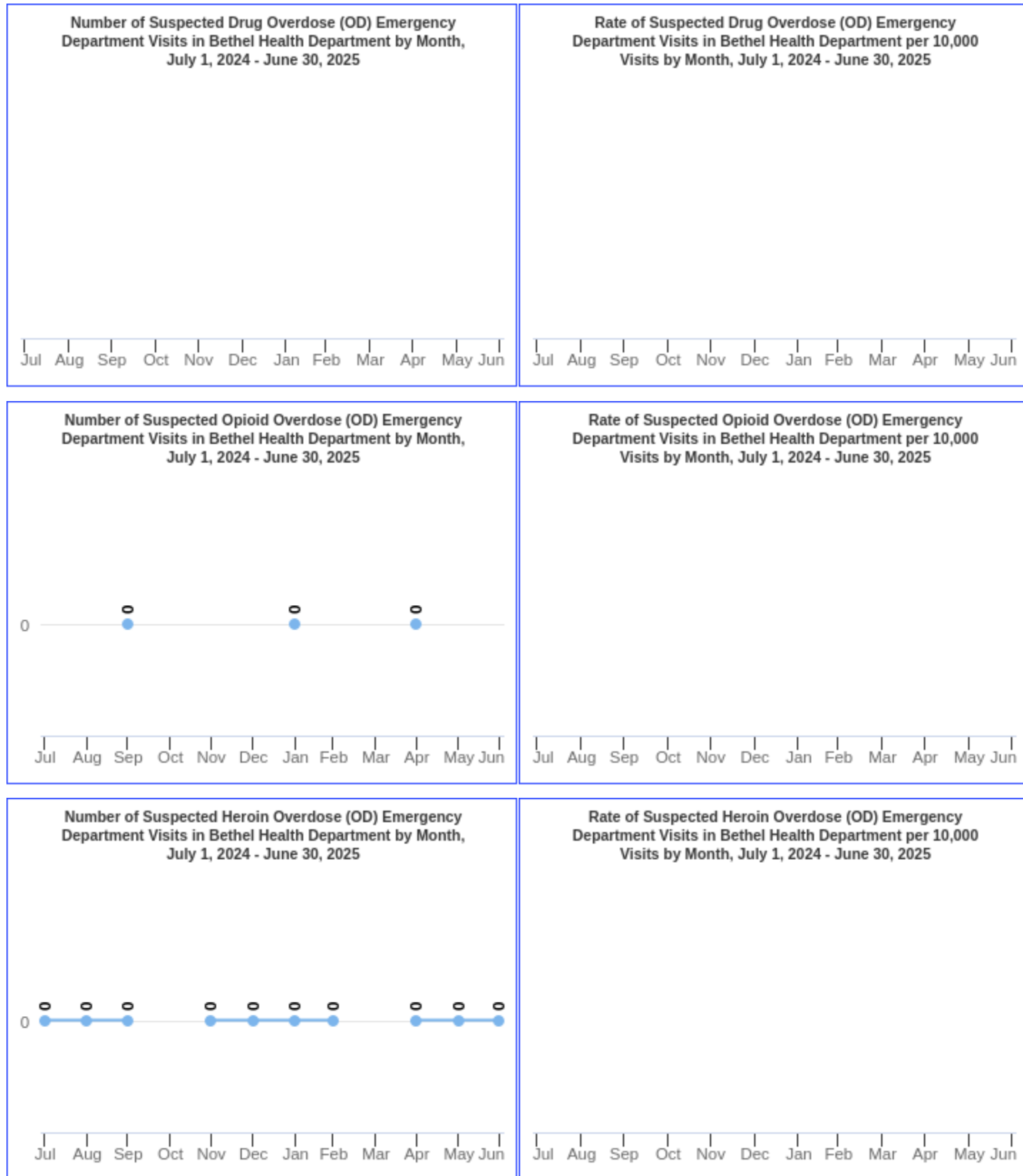

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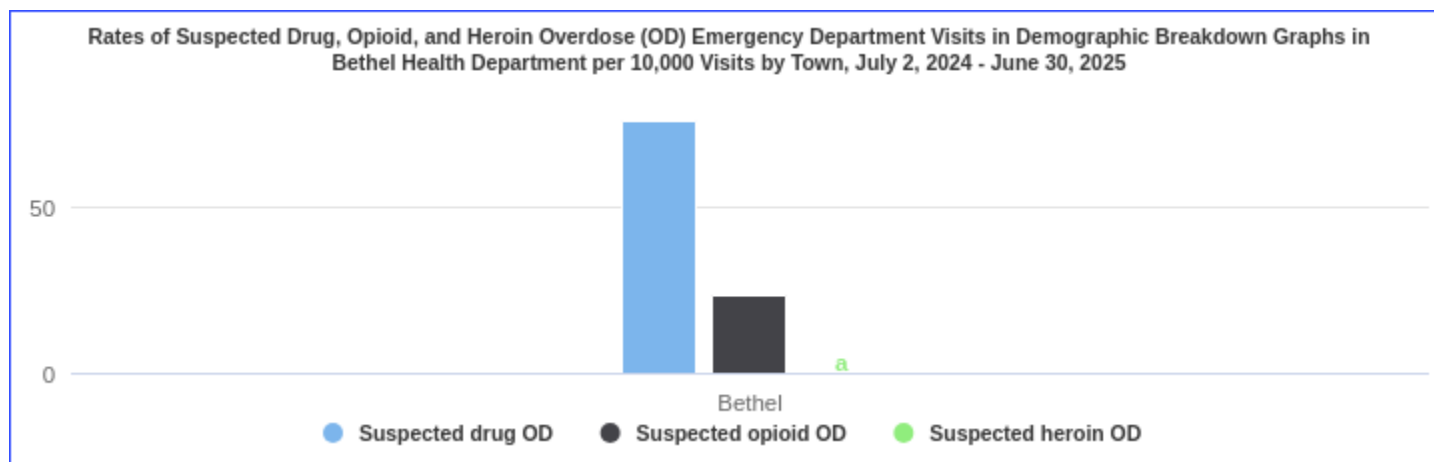

Suspected Drug Overdose in Bethel Health Department



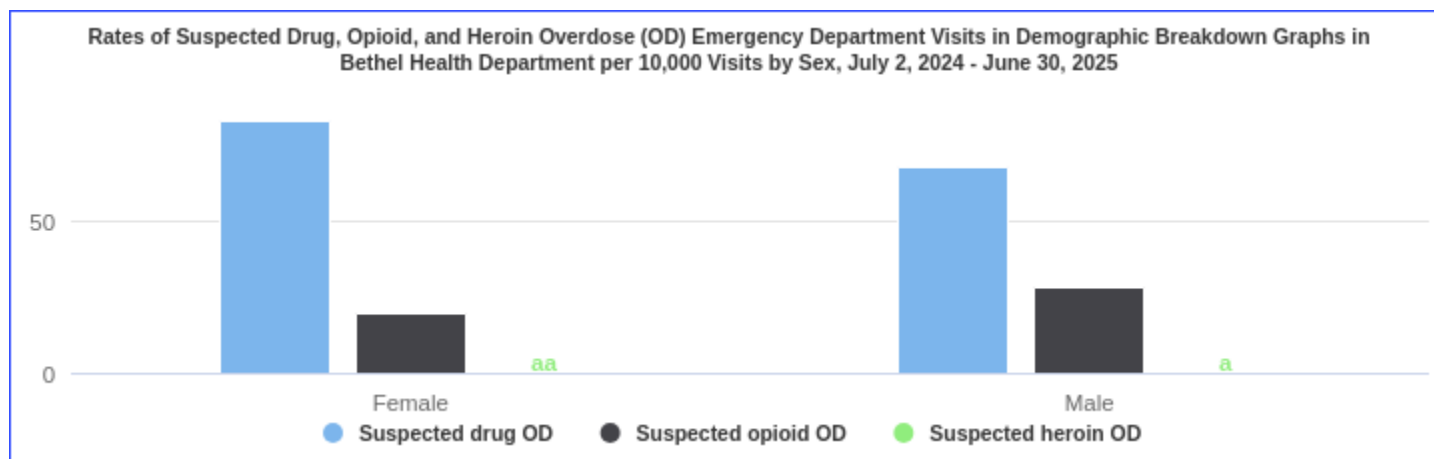

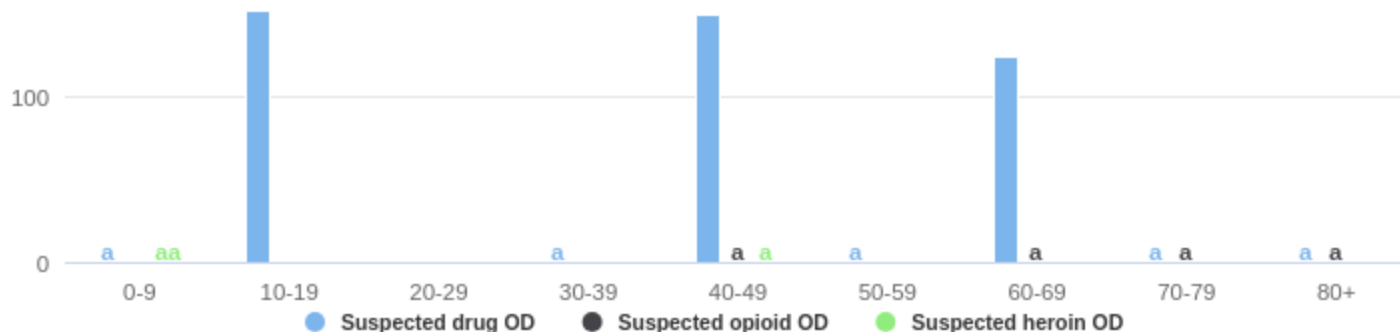

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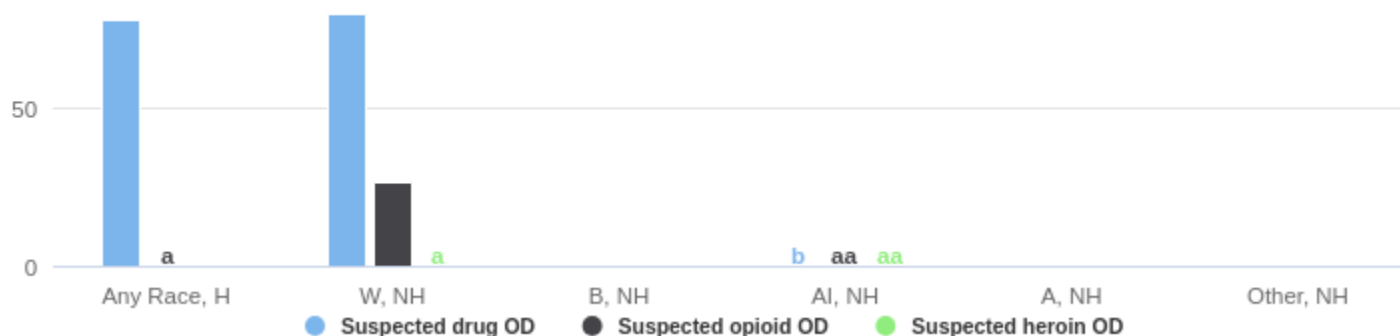

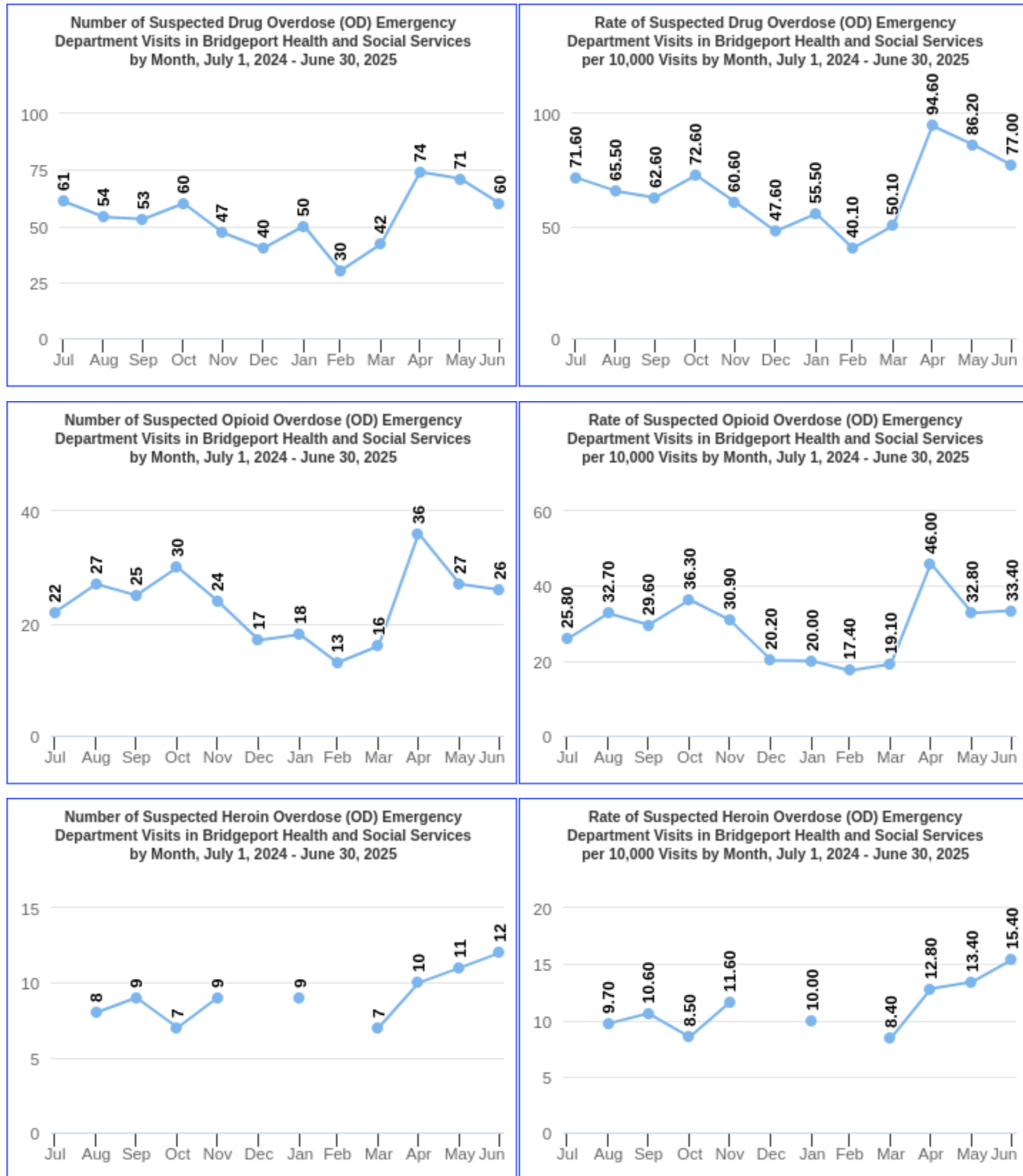

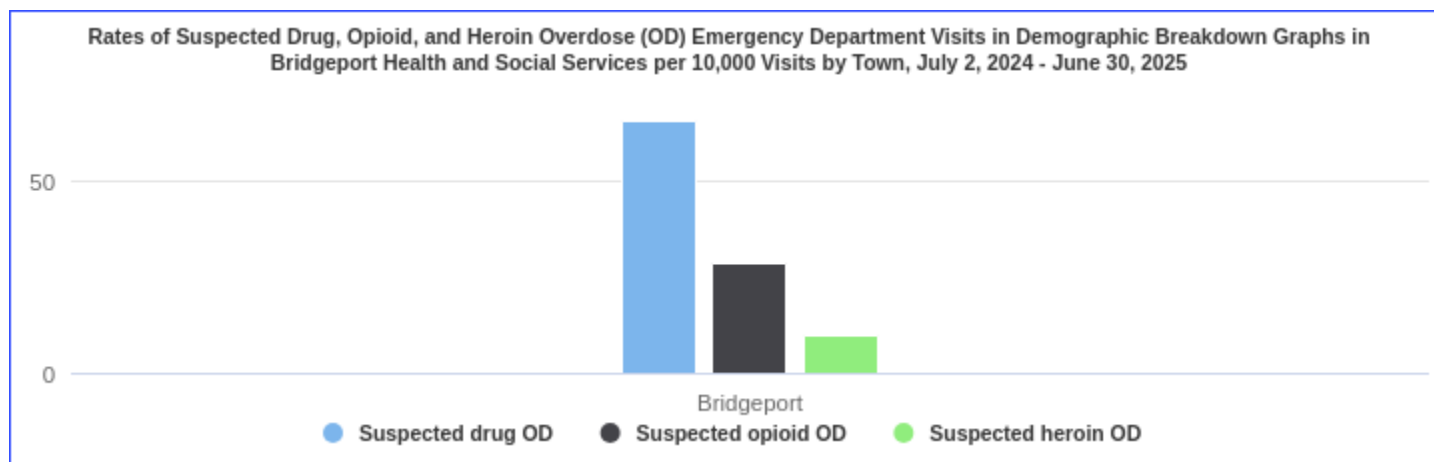

Suspected Drug Overdose in Bridgeport Health and Social Services



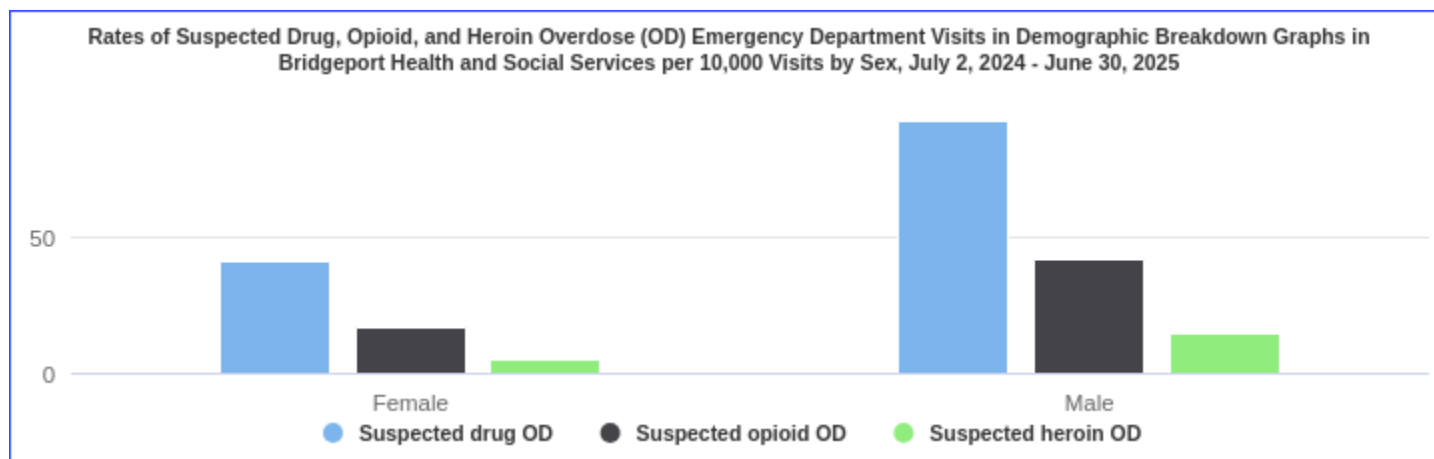

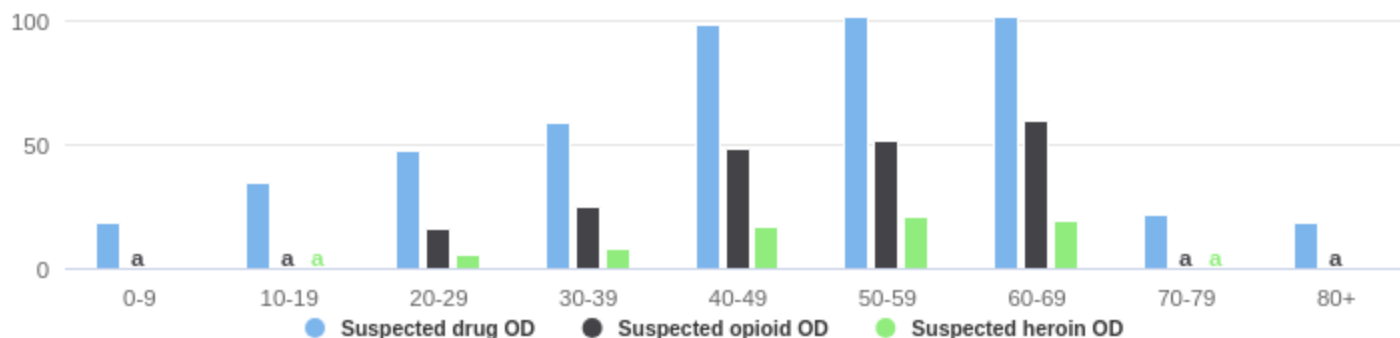

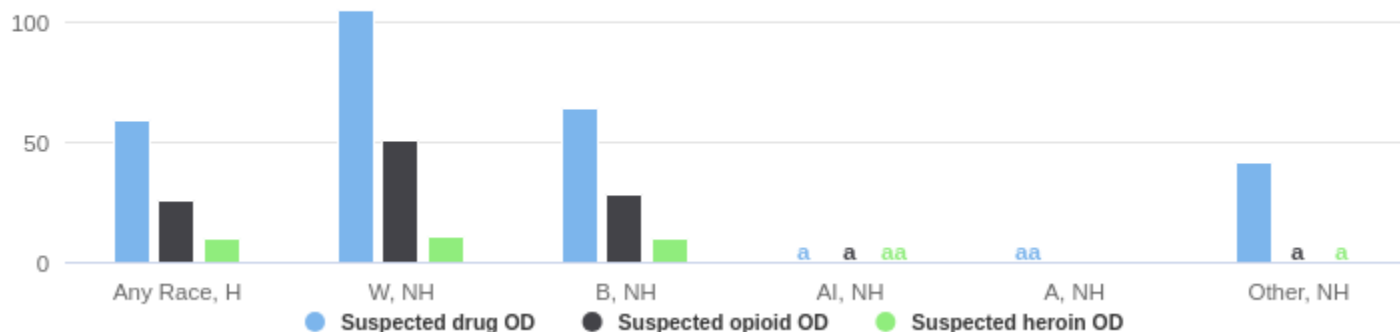

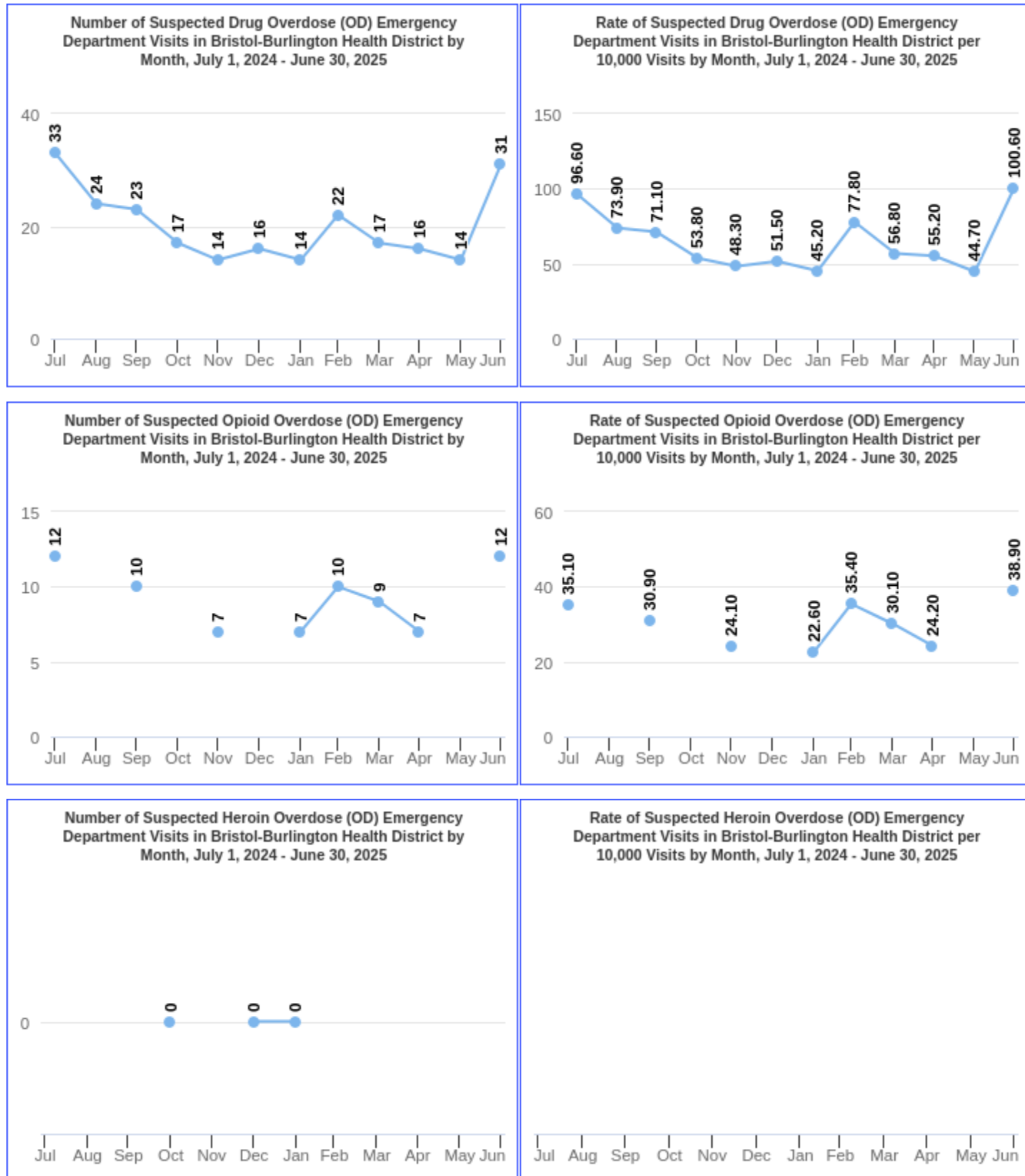

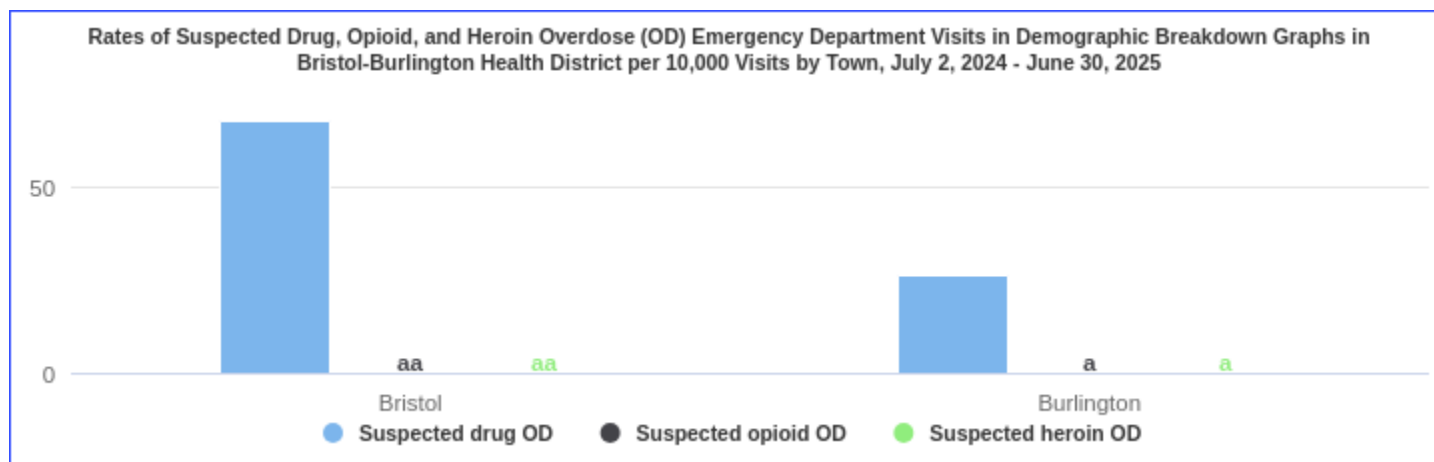

Suspected Drug Overdose in Bristol-Burlington Health District



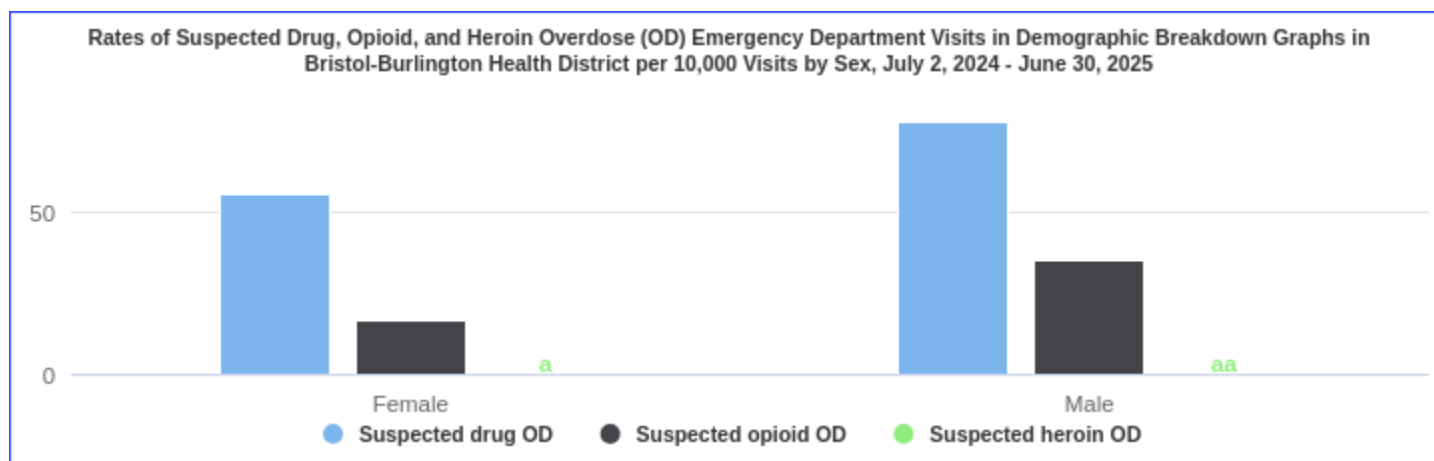

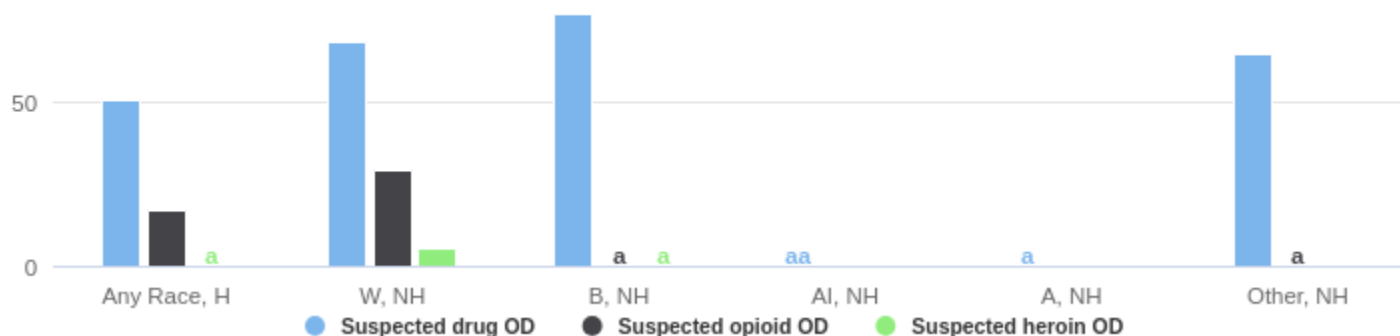

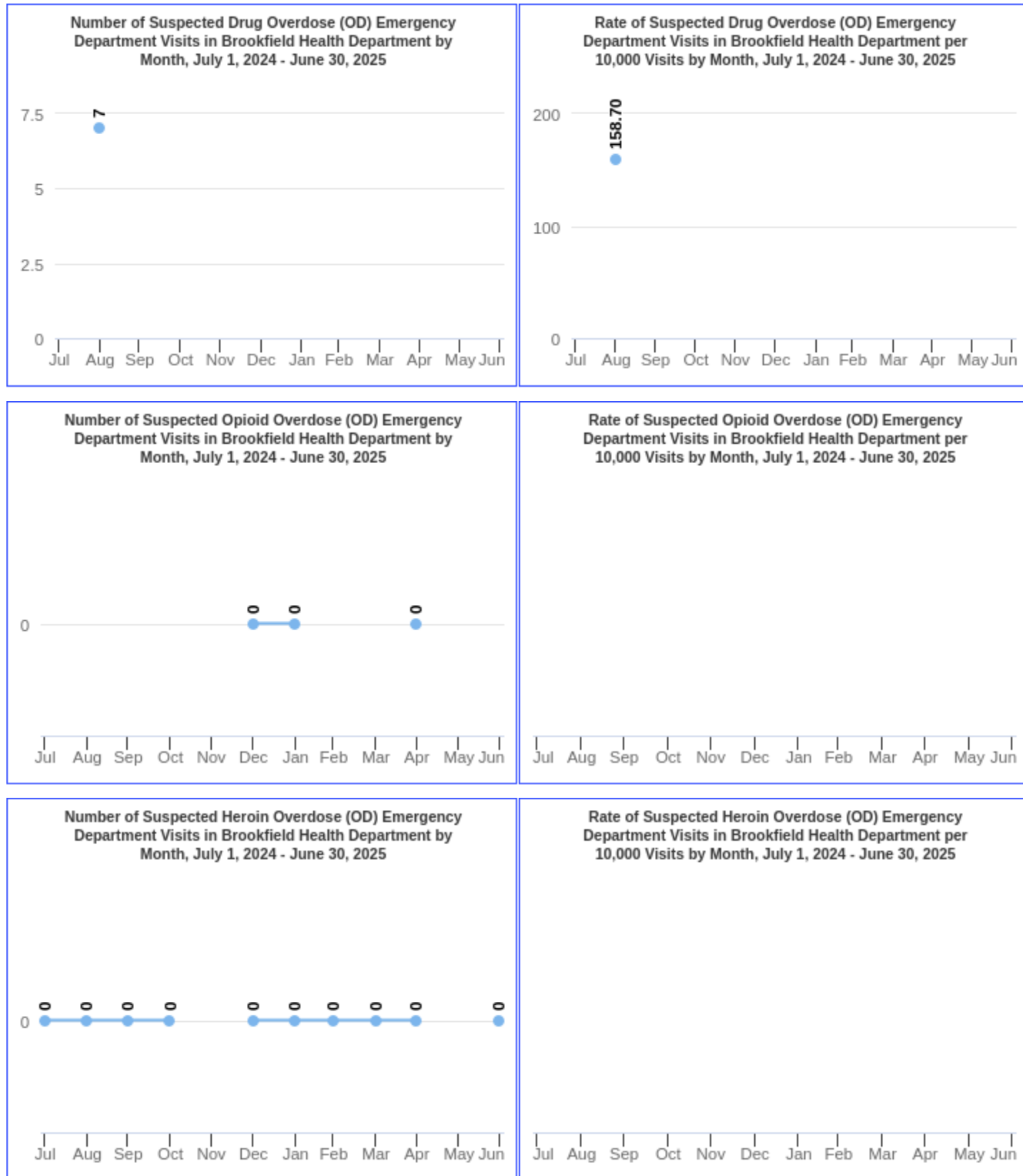

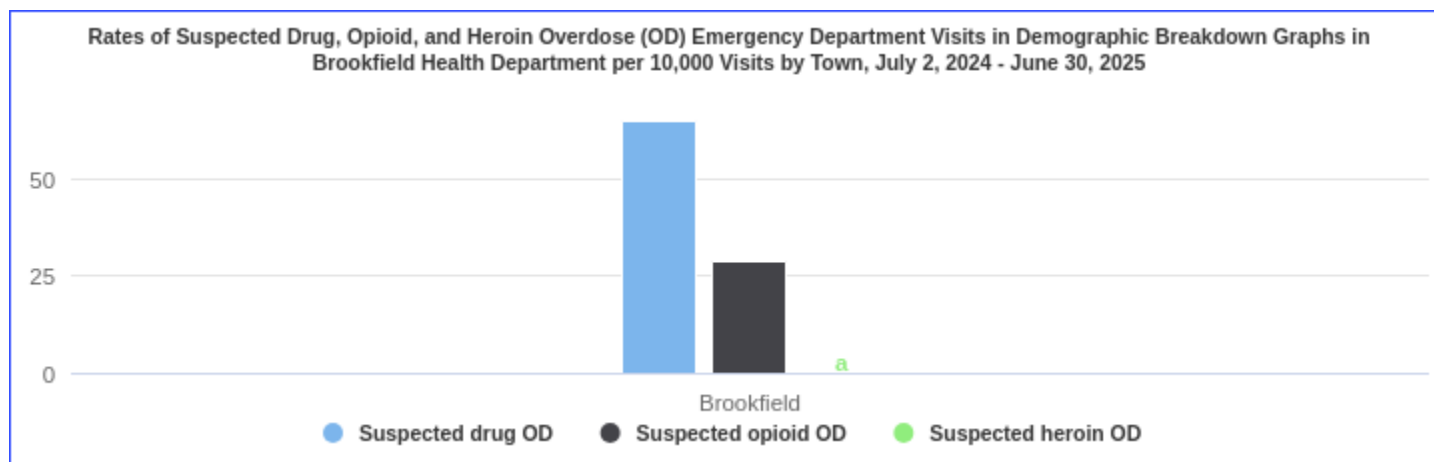

Suspected Drug Overdose in Brookfield Health Department



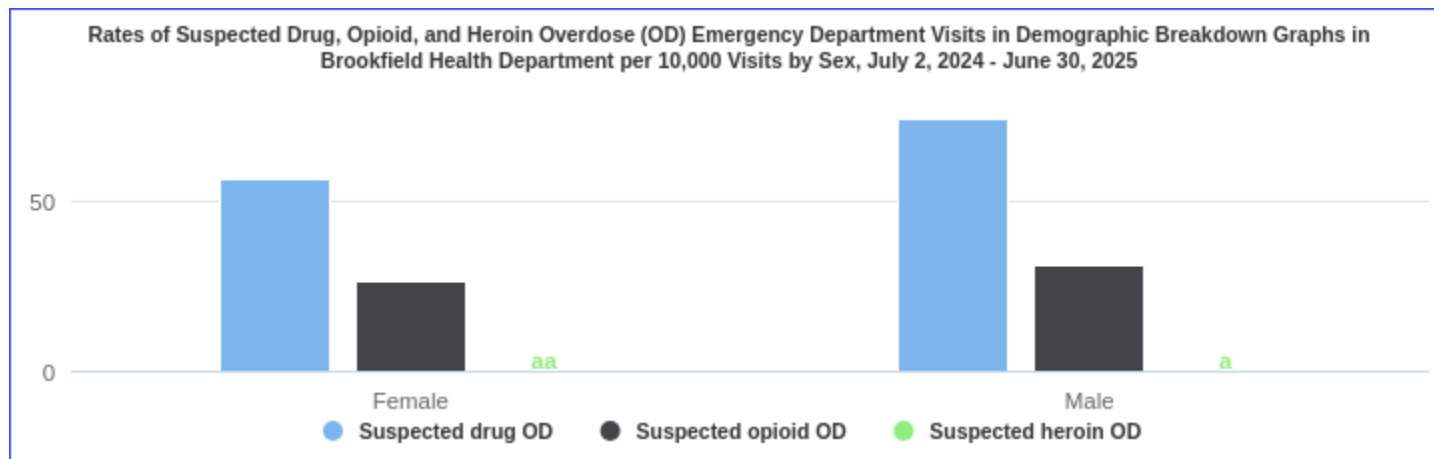

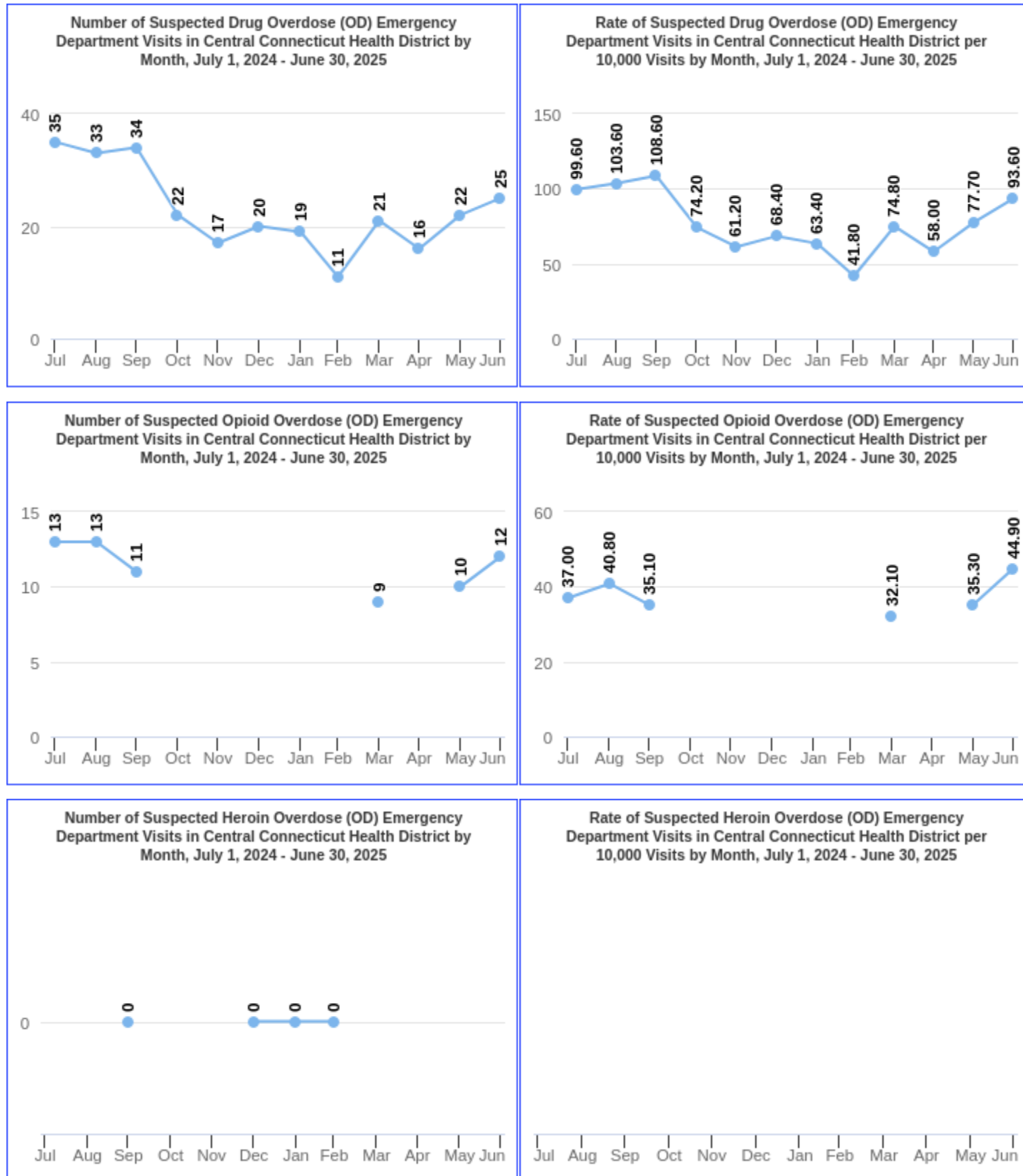

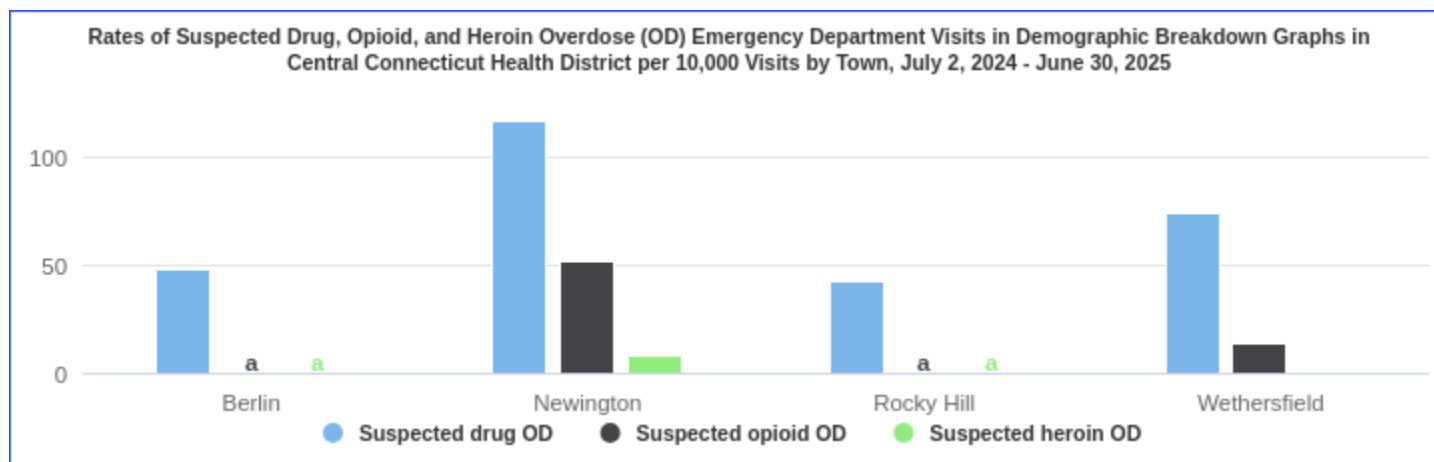

Suspected Drug Overdose in Central Connecticut Health District



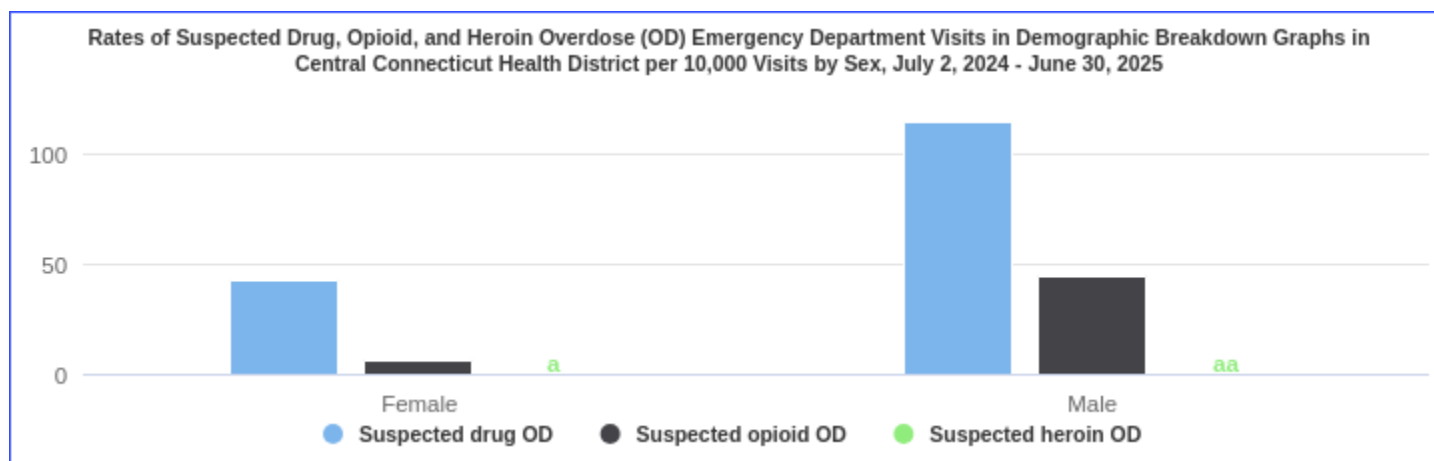

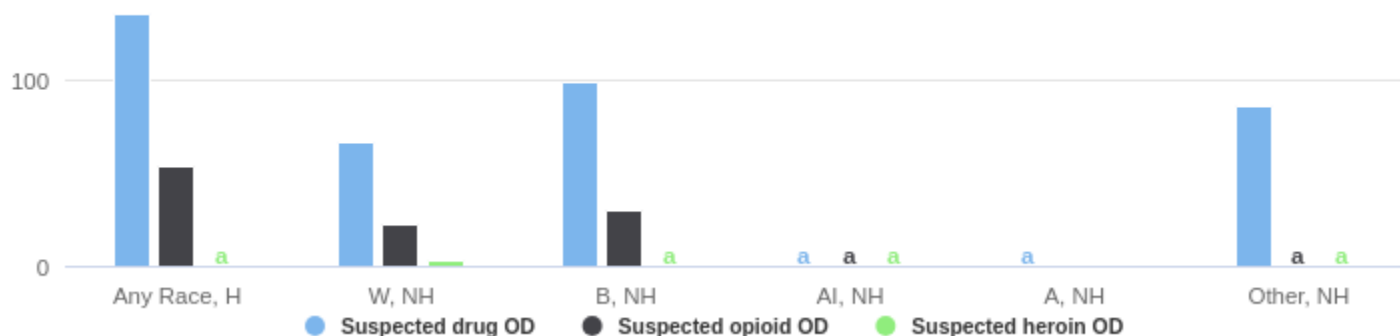

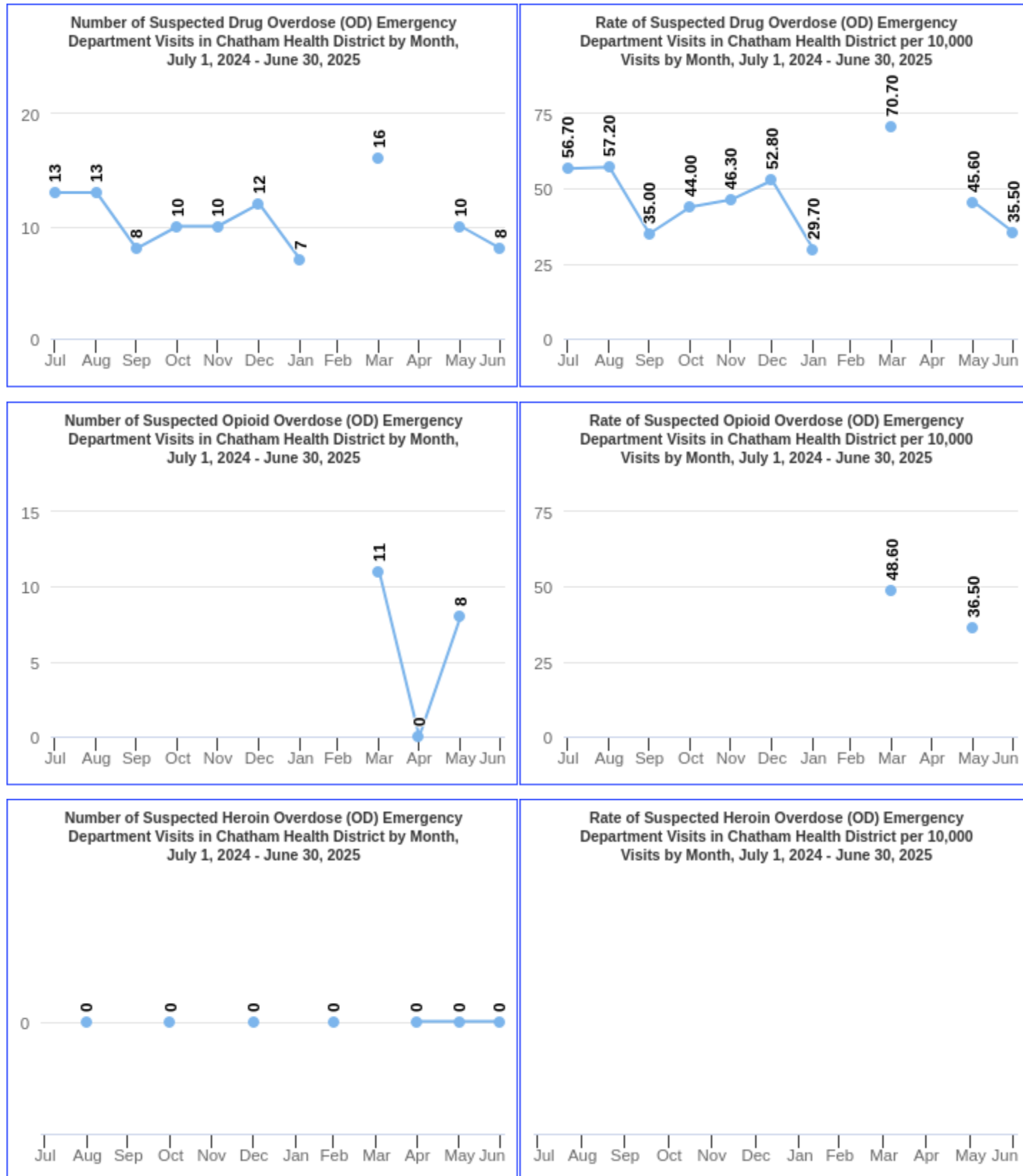

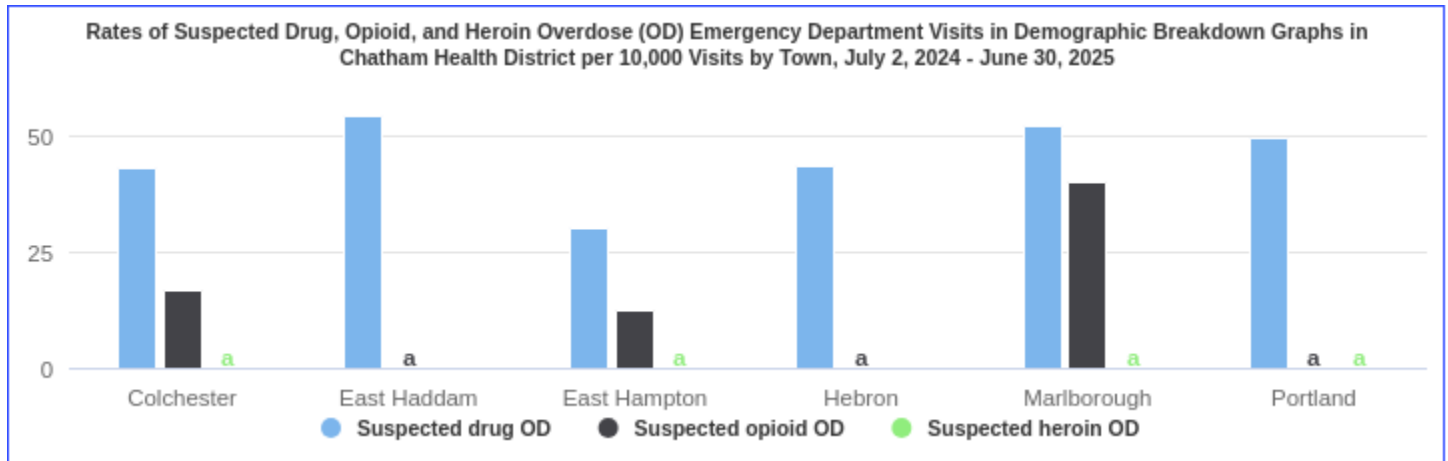

Suspected Drug Overdose in Chatham Health District



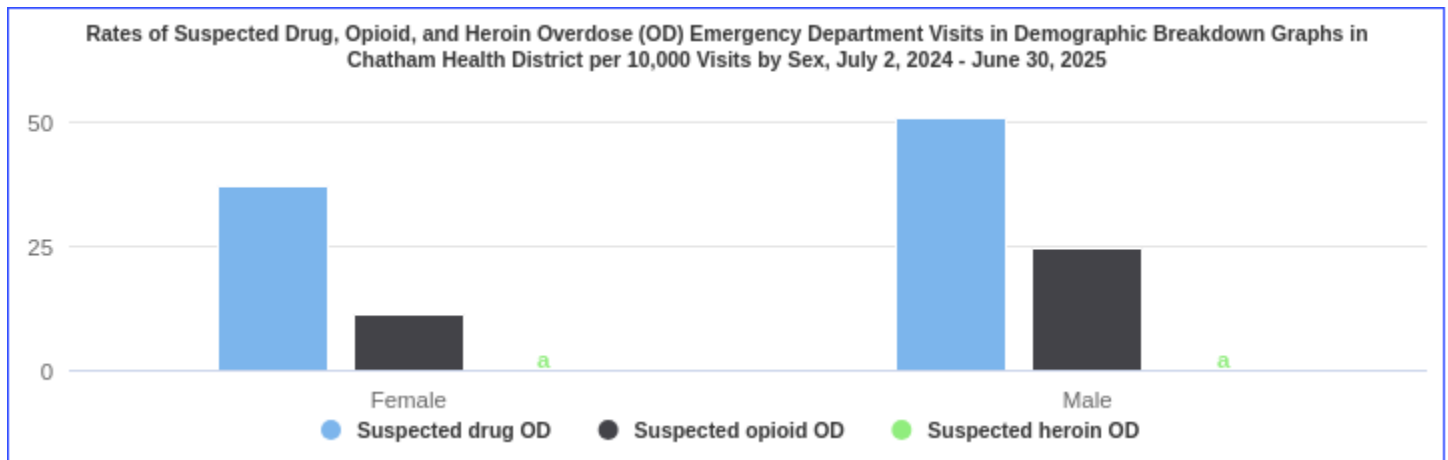

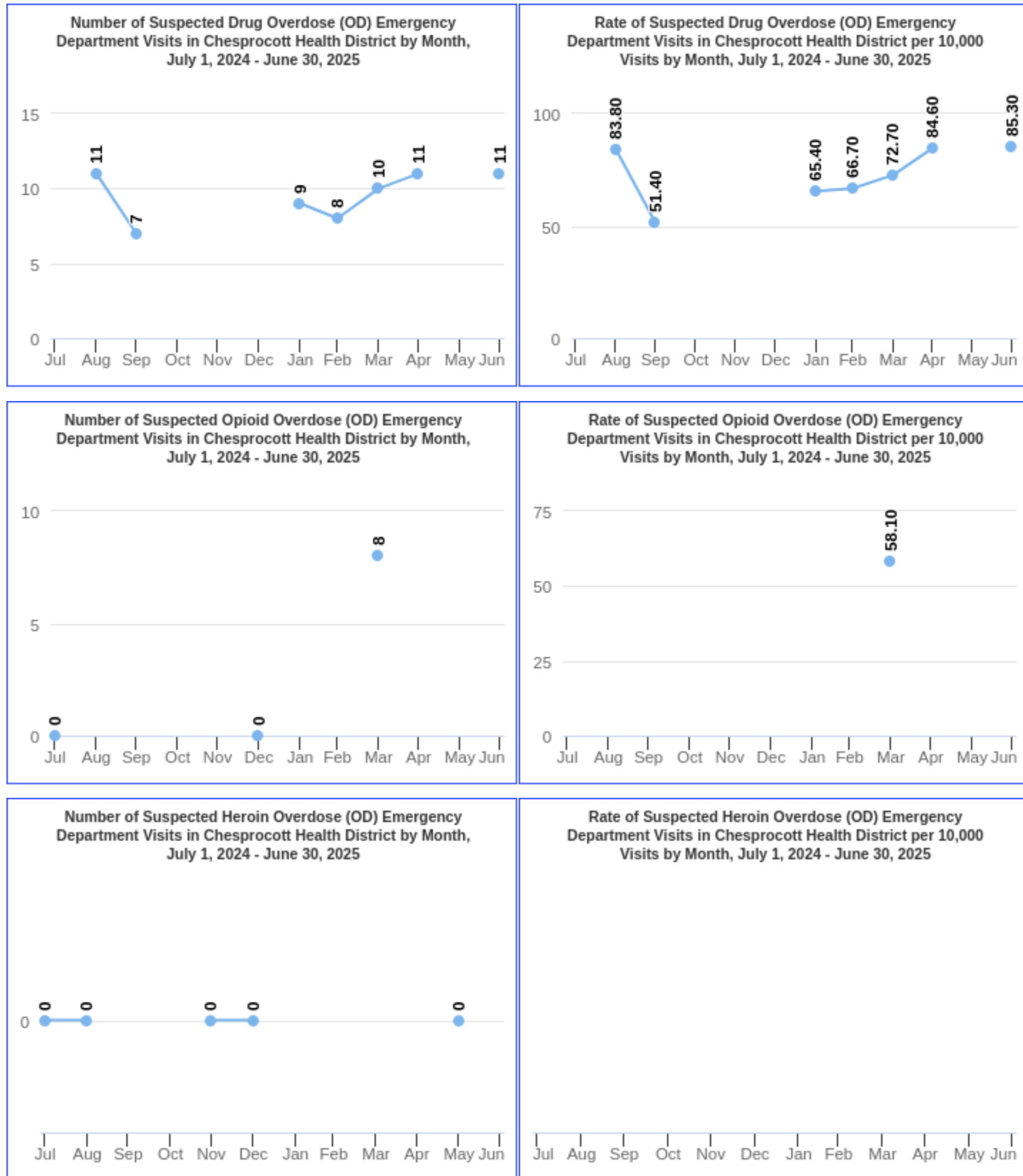

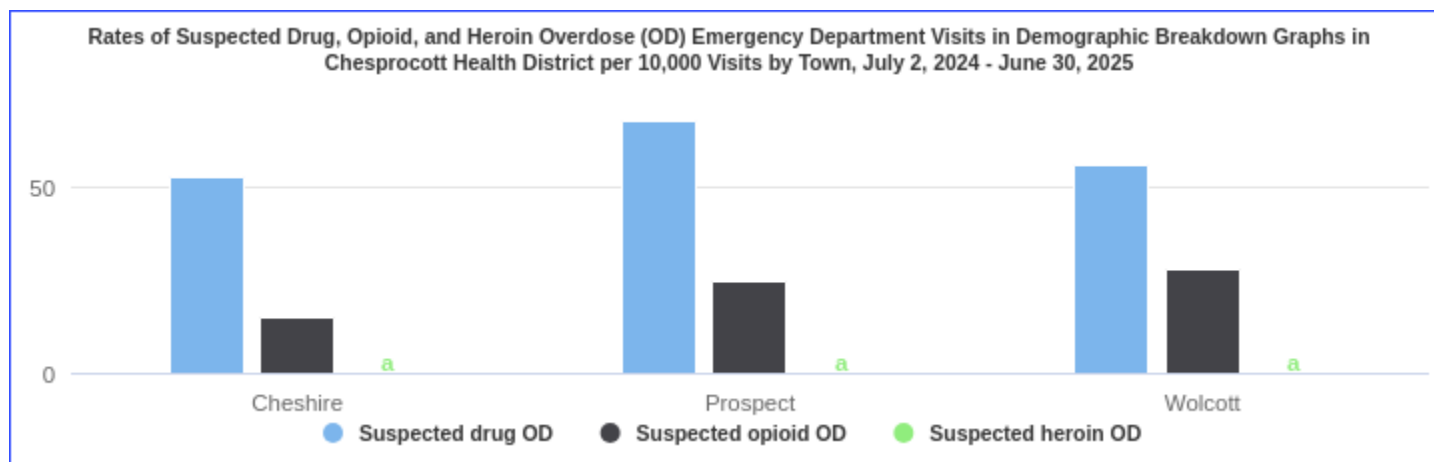

Suspected Drug Overdose in Chesprocott Health District



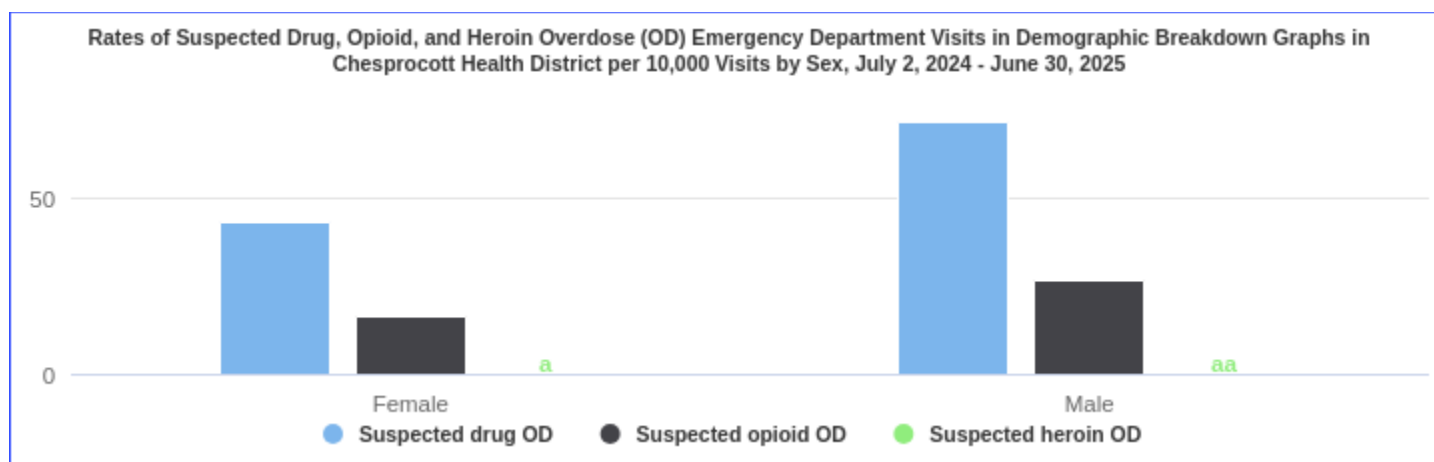

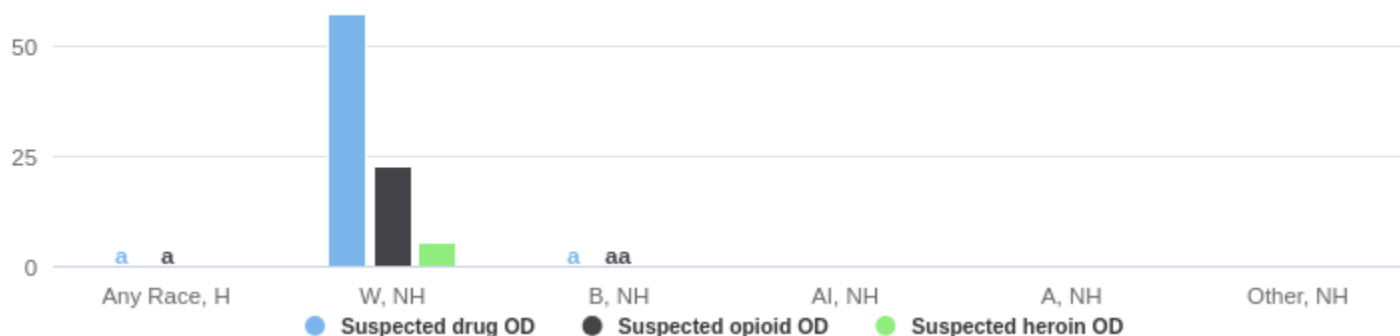

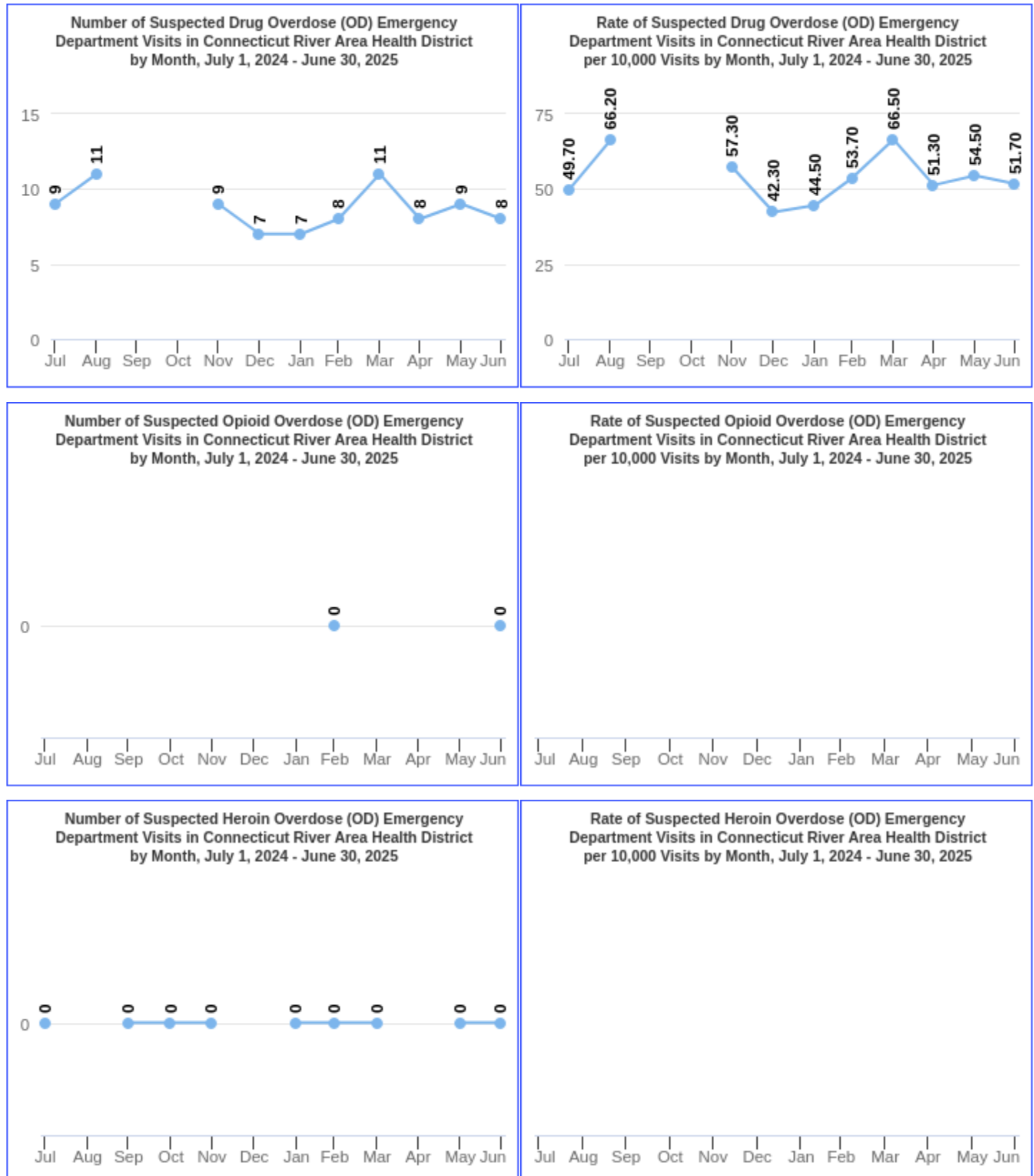

Suspected Drug Overdose in Connecticut River Area Health District



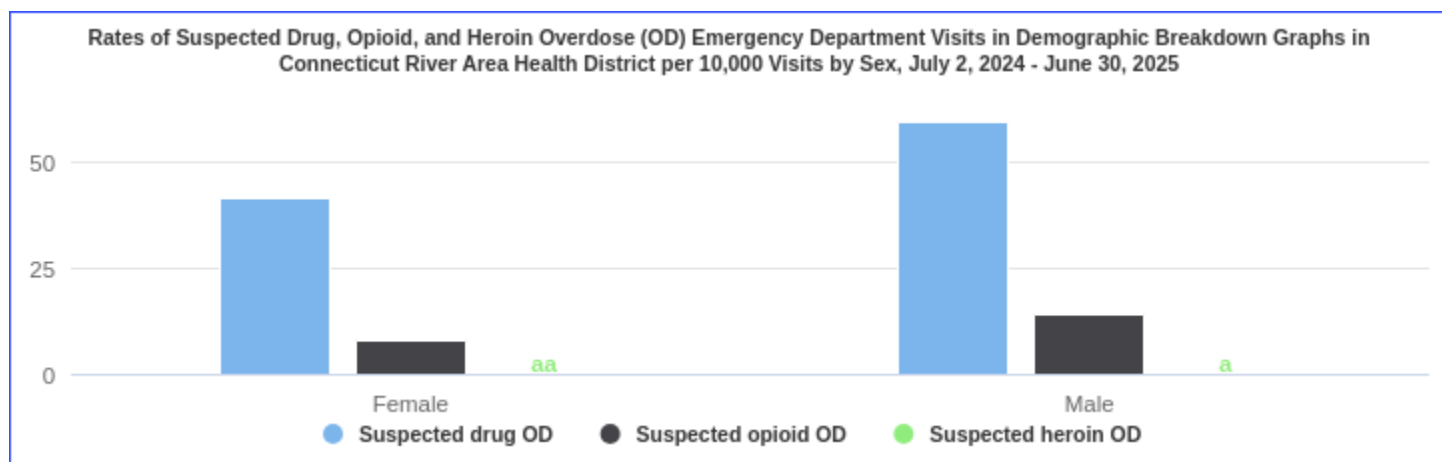

Suspected Drug Overdose in Cromwell Health Department



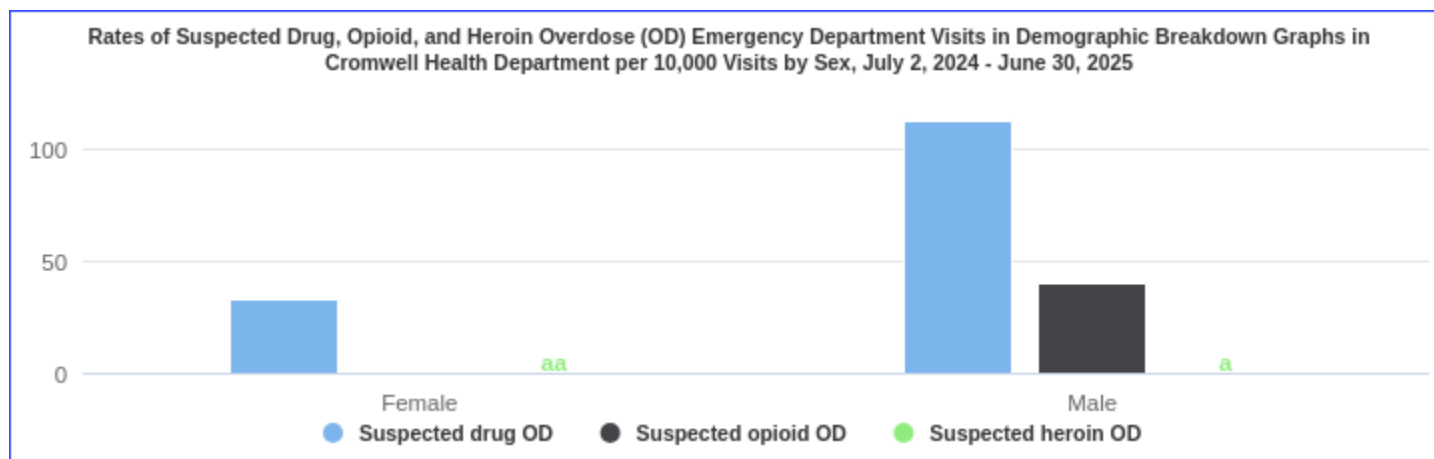

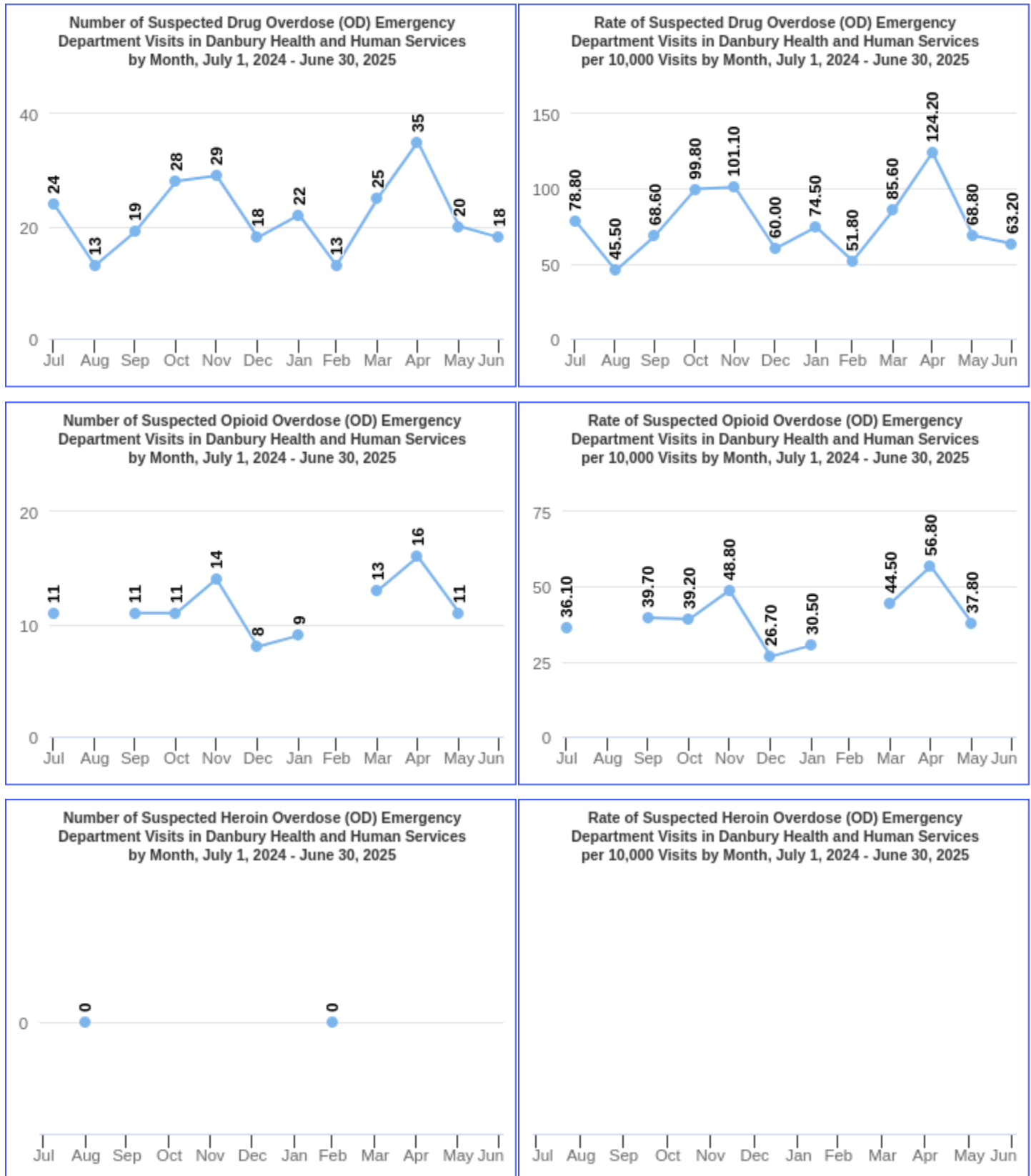

Suspected Drug Overdose in Danbury Health and Human Services



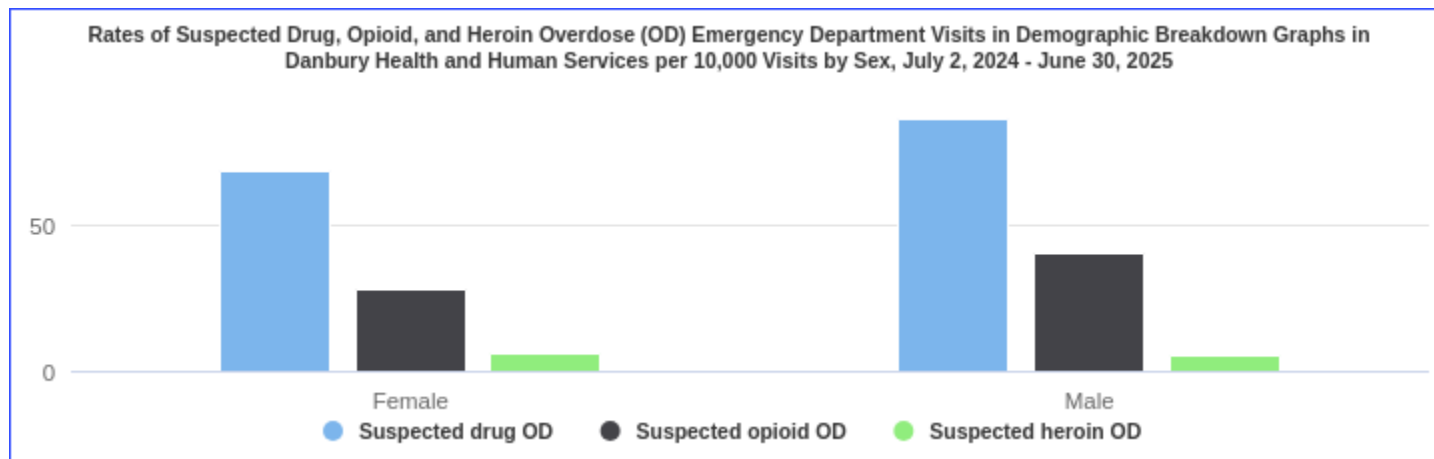

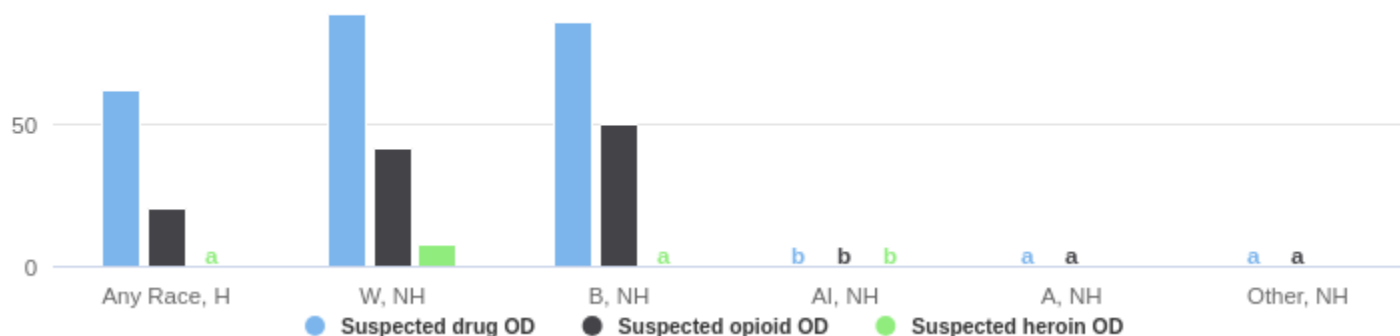

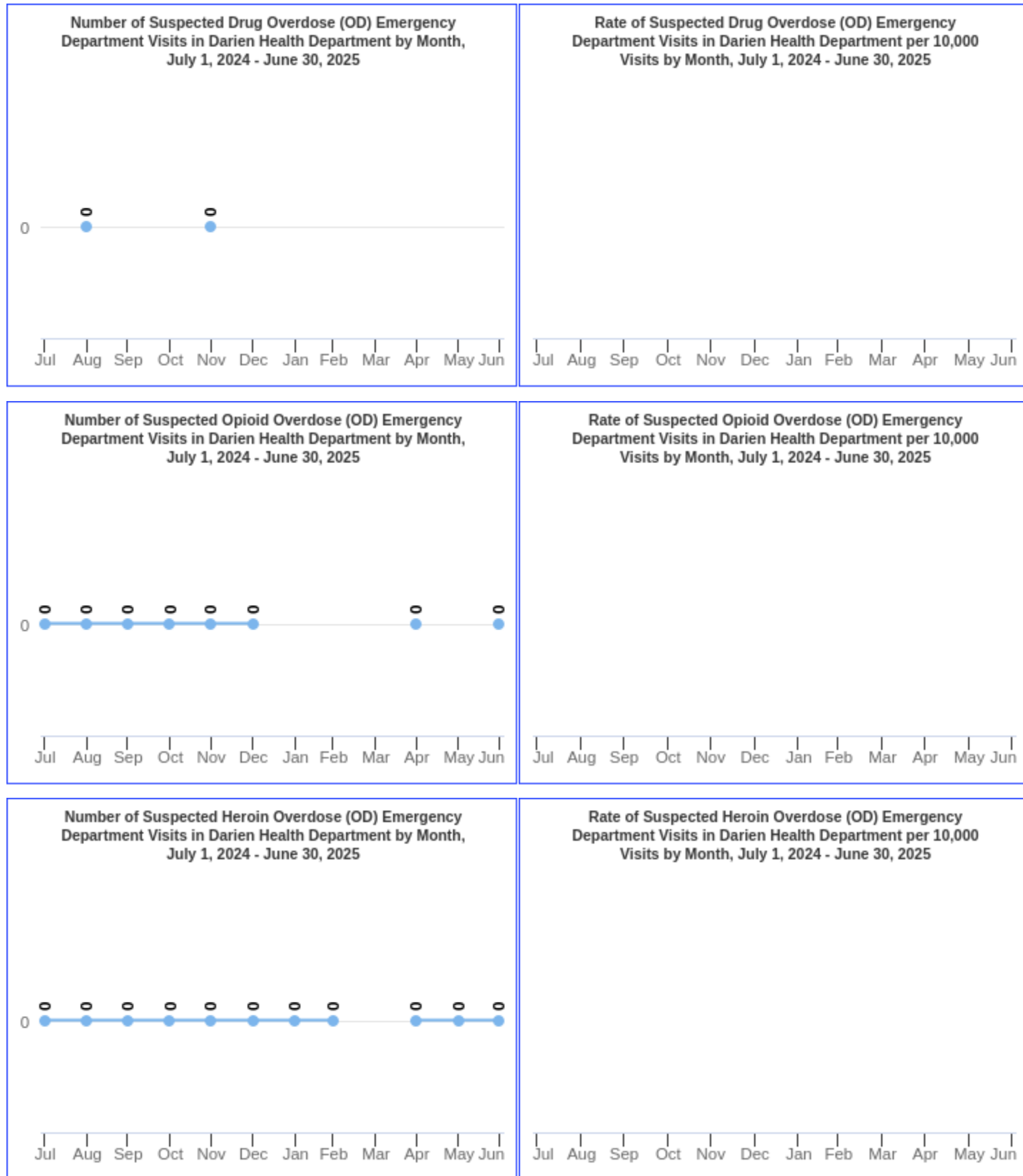

Suspected Drug Overdose in Darien Health Department



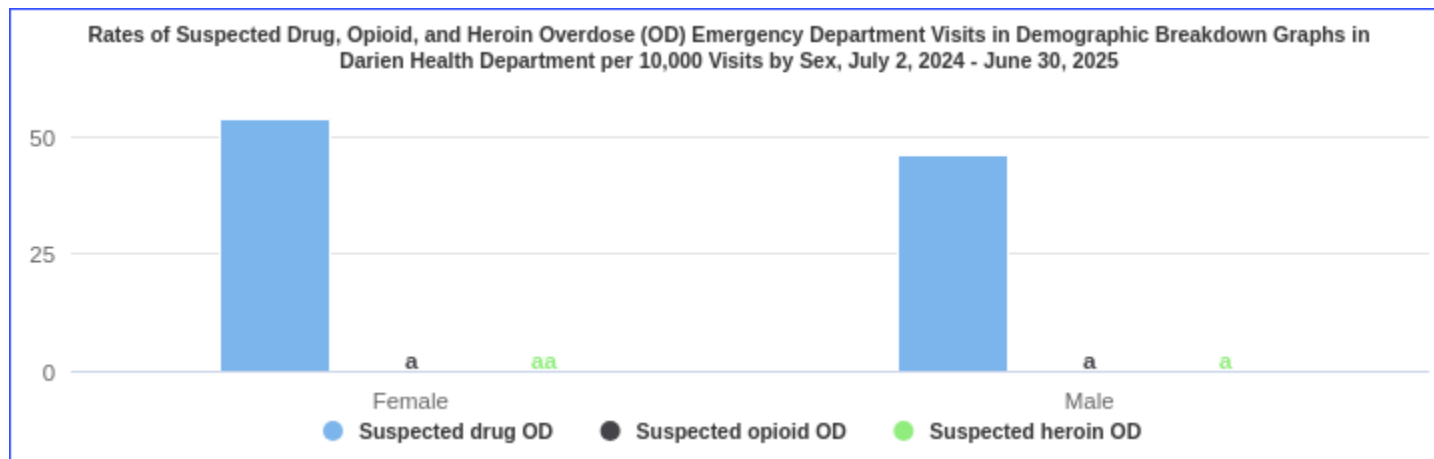

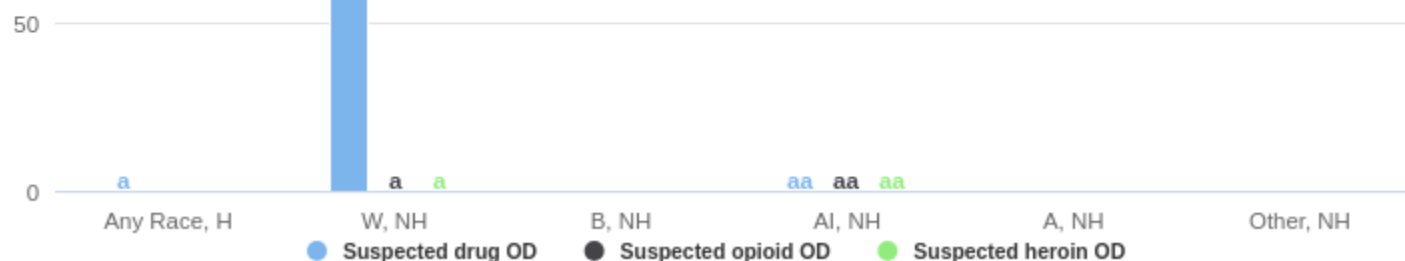

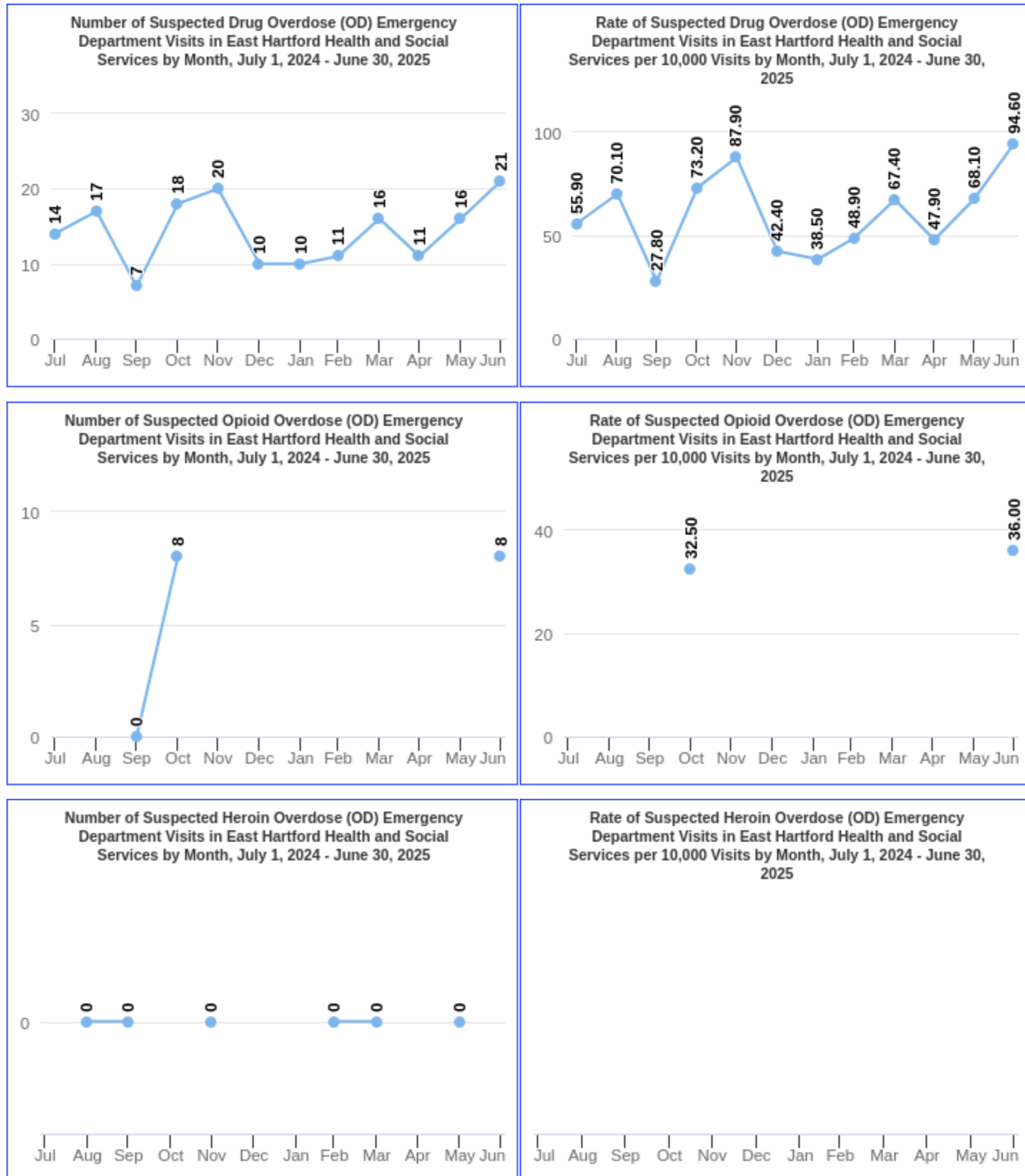

Suspected Drug Overdose in East Hartford Health and Social Services



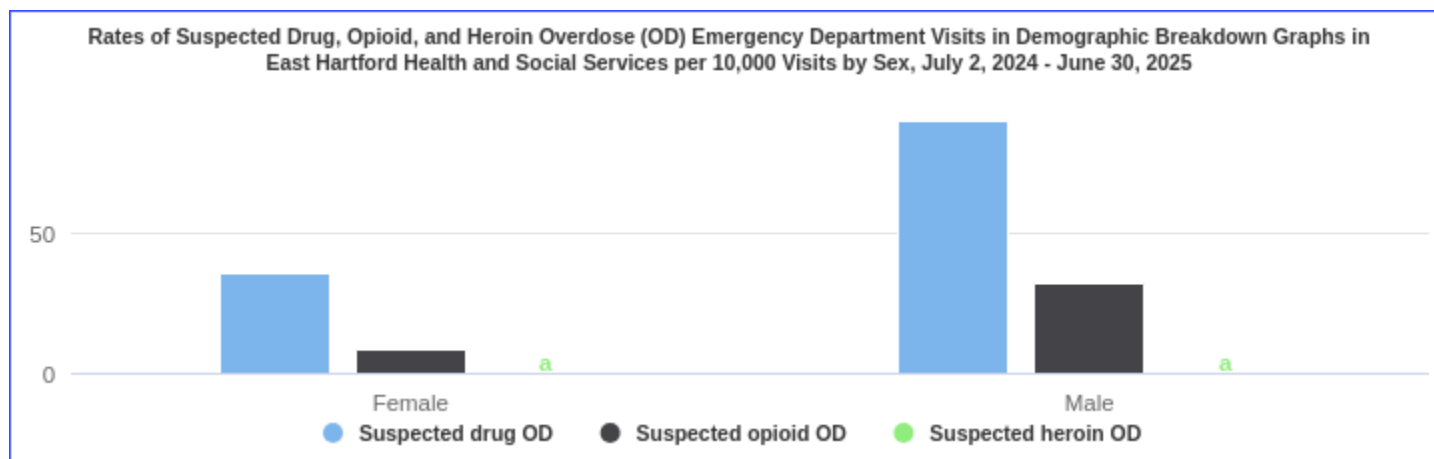

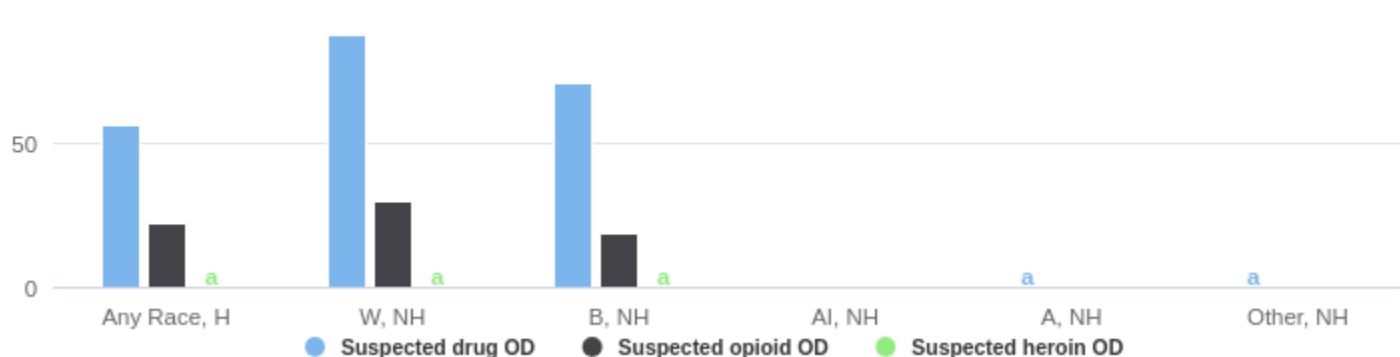

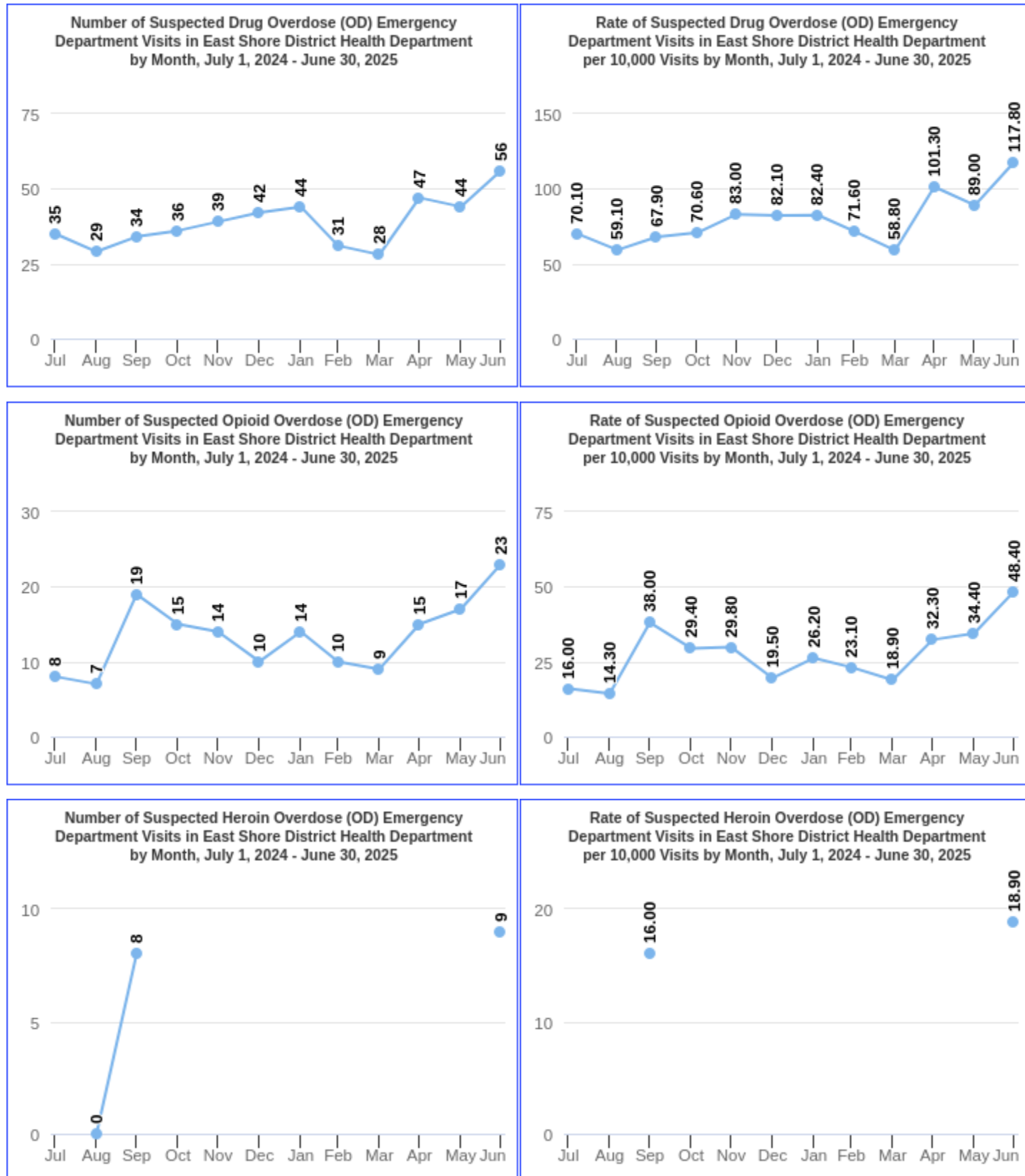

Suspected Drug Overdose in East Shore District Health Department



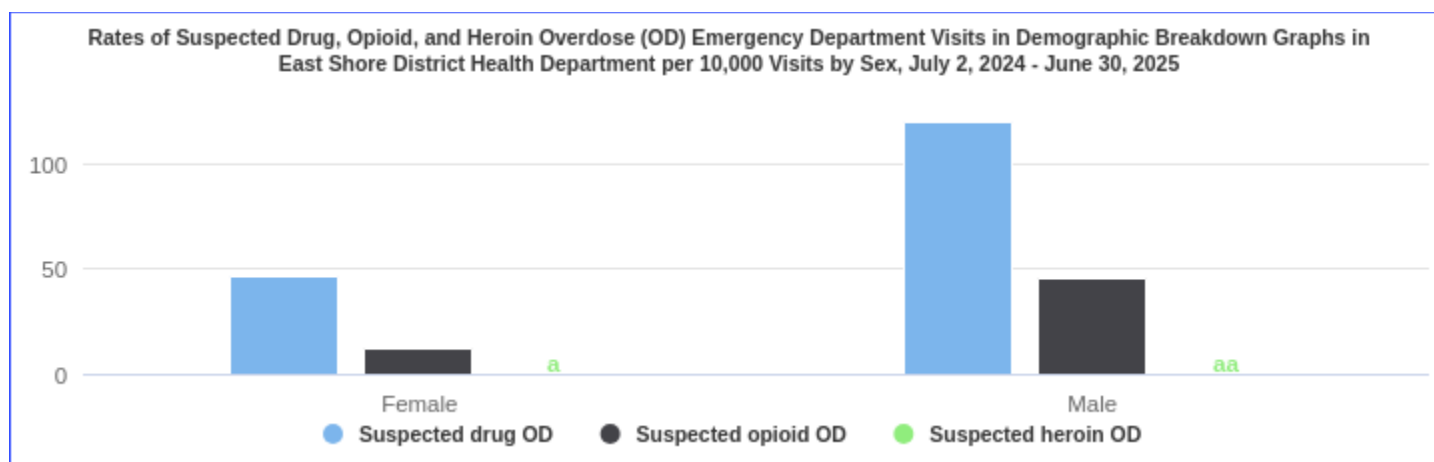

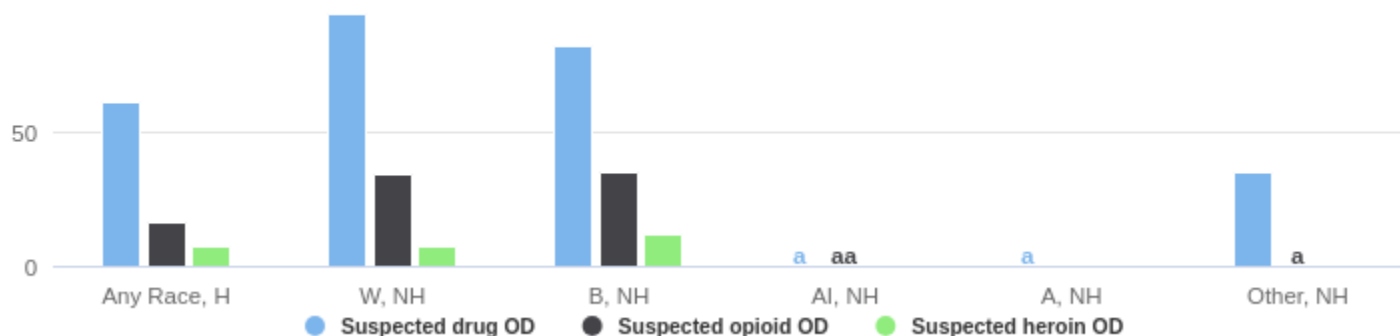

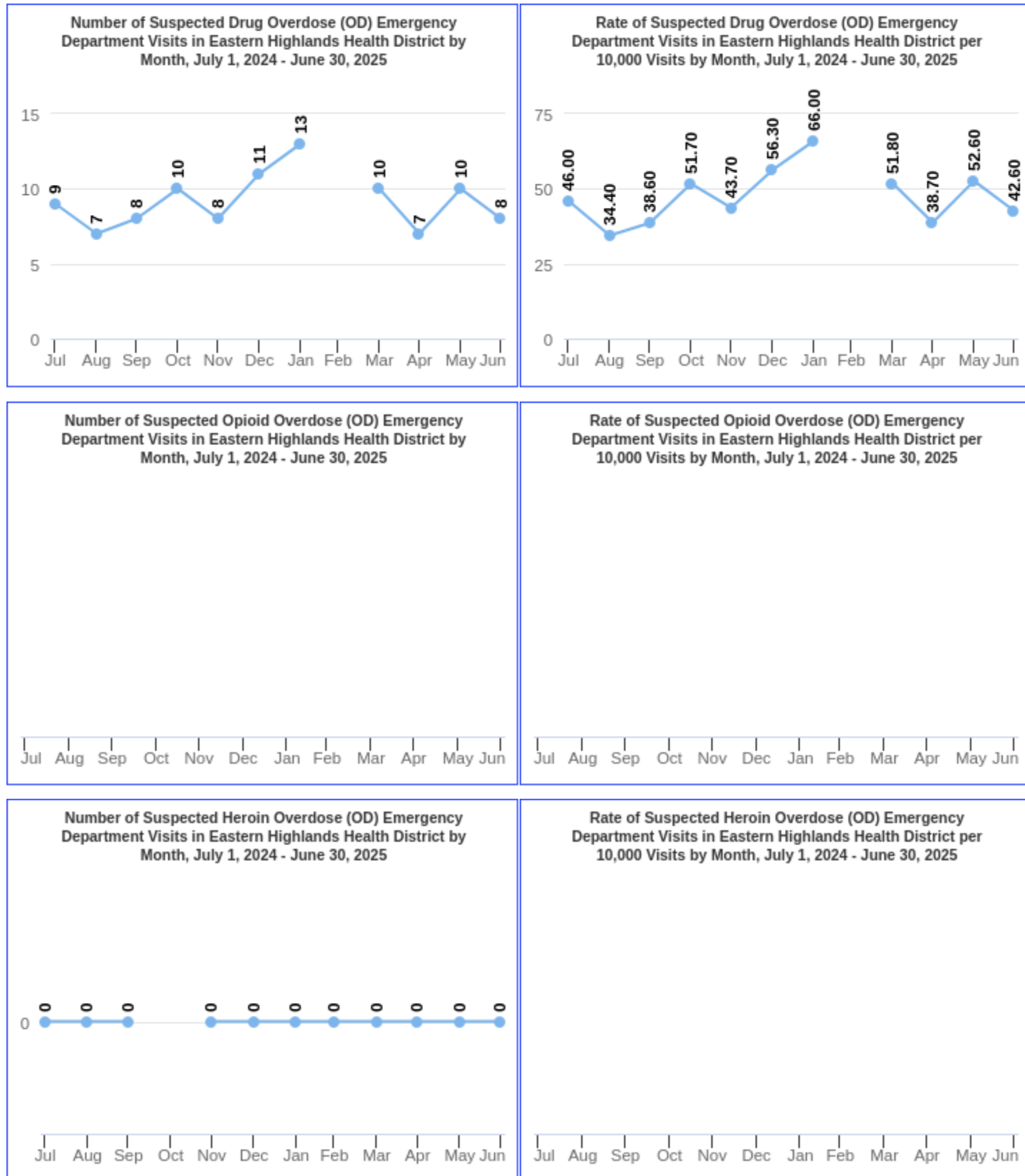

Suspected Drug Overdose in Eastern Highlands Health District



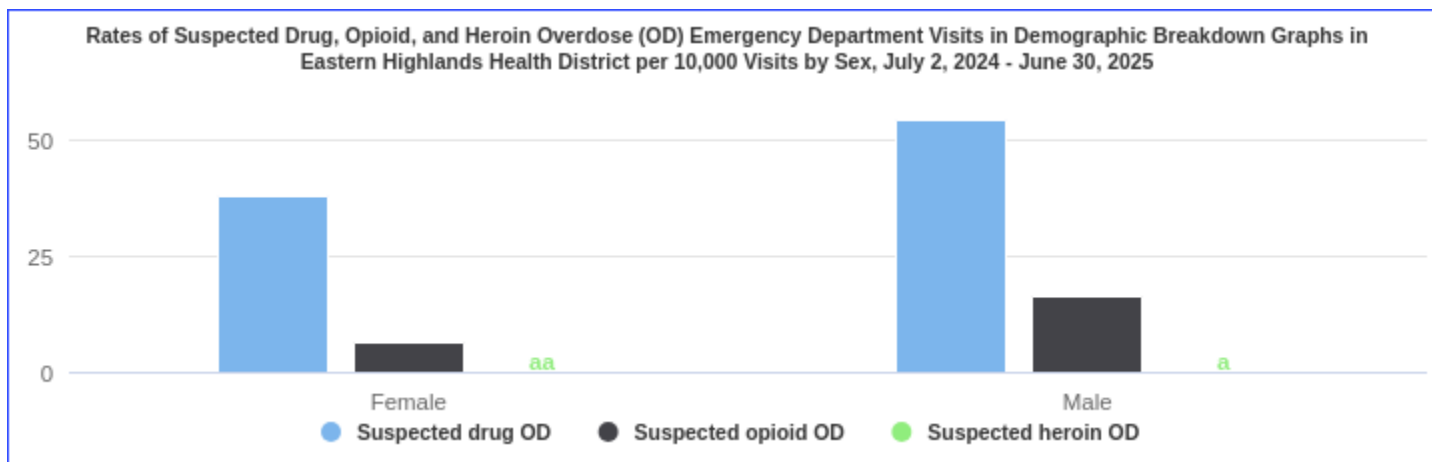

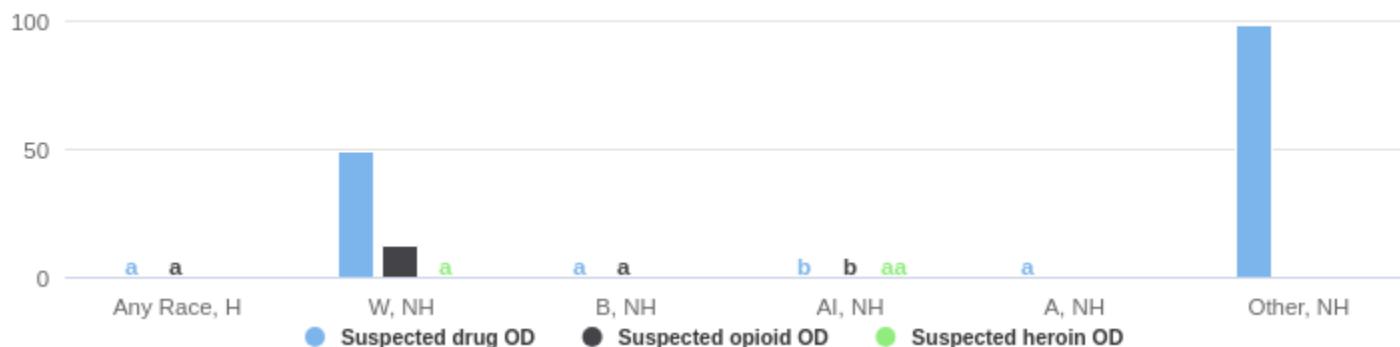

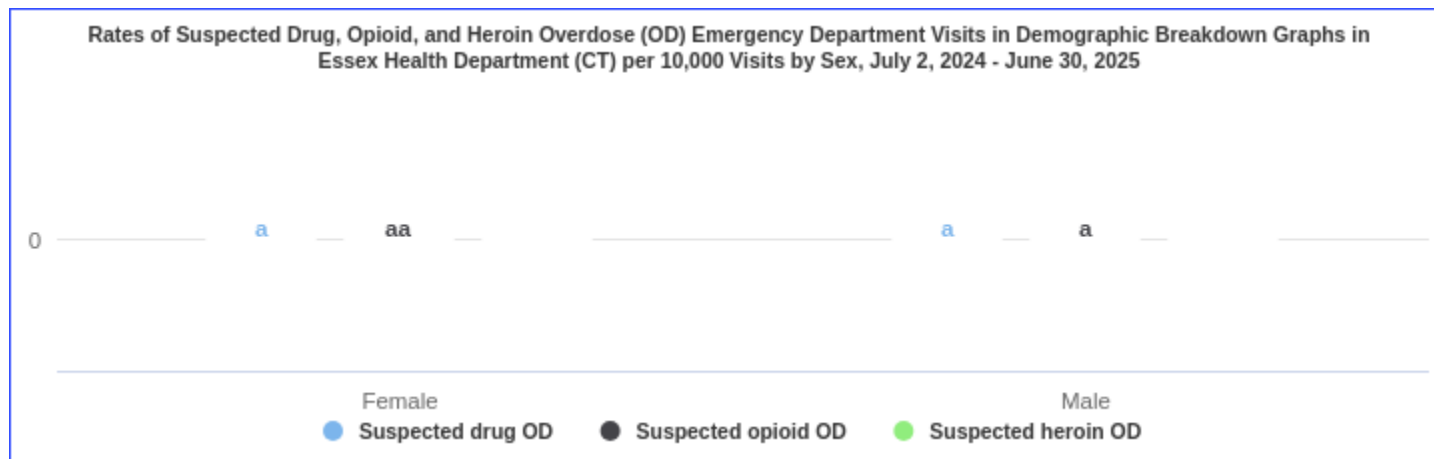

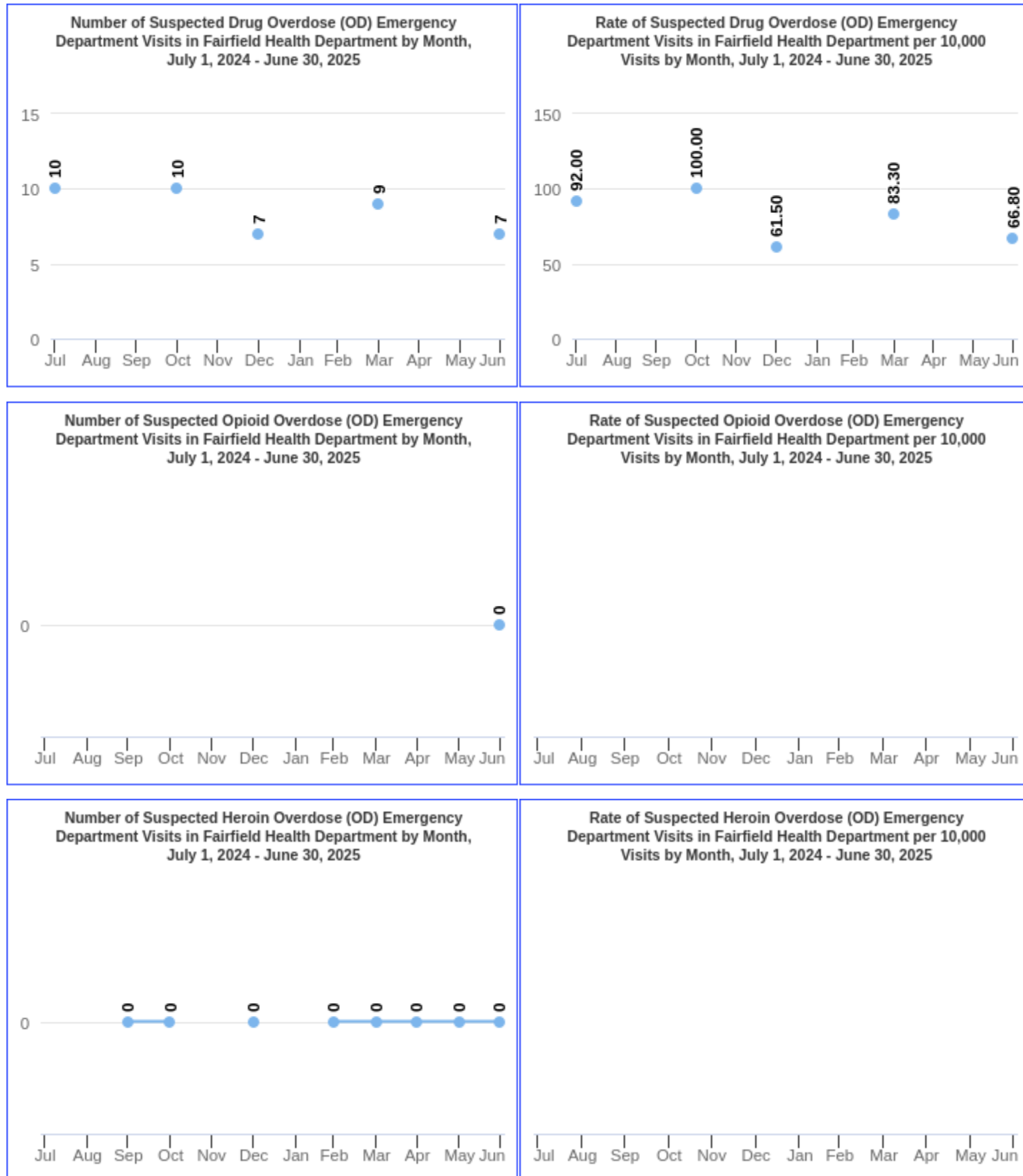

Suspected Drug Overdose in Fairfield Health Department



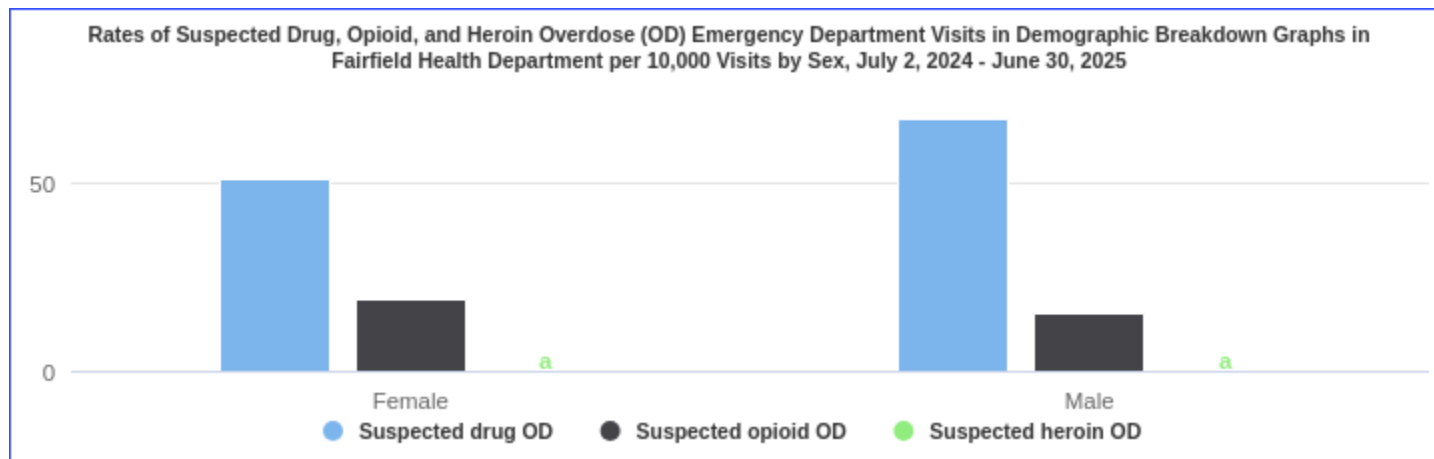

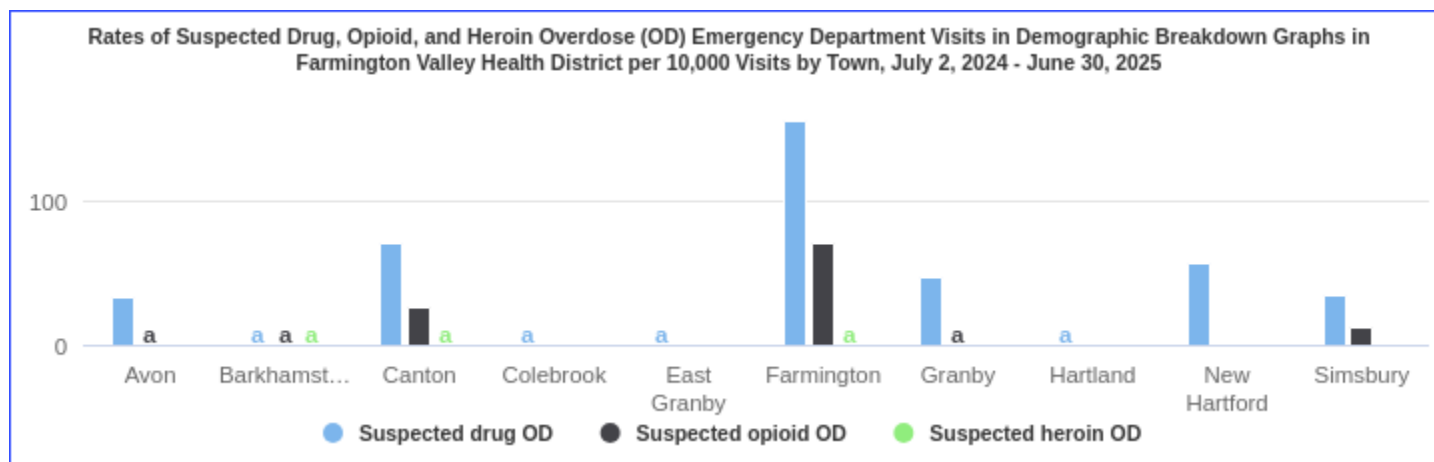

Suspected Drug Overdose in Farmington Valley Health District



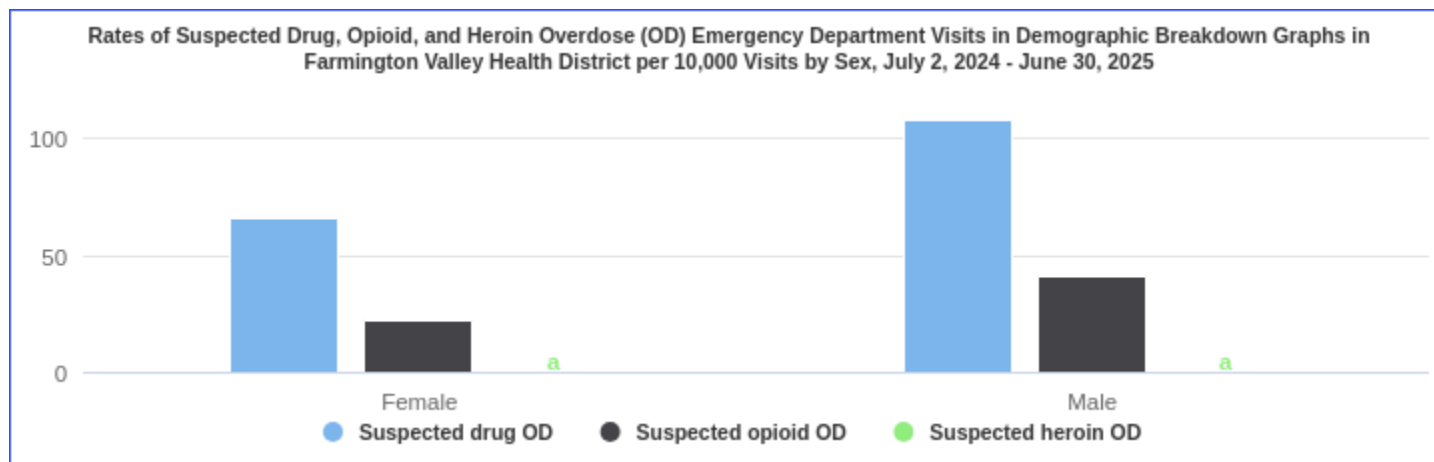

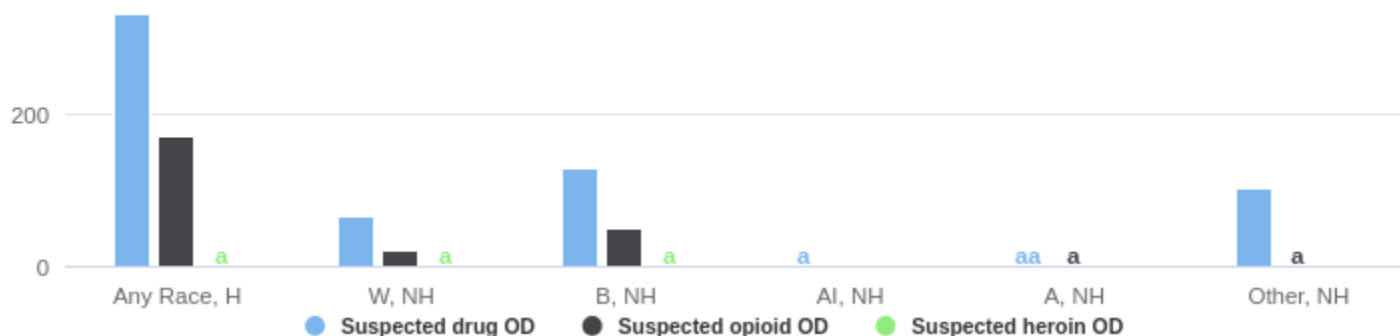

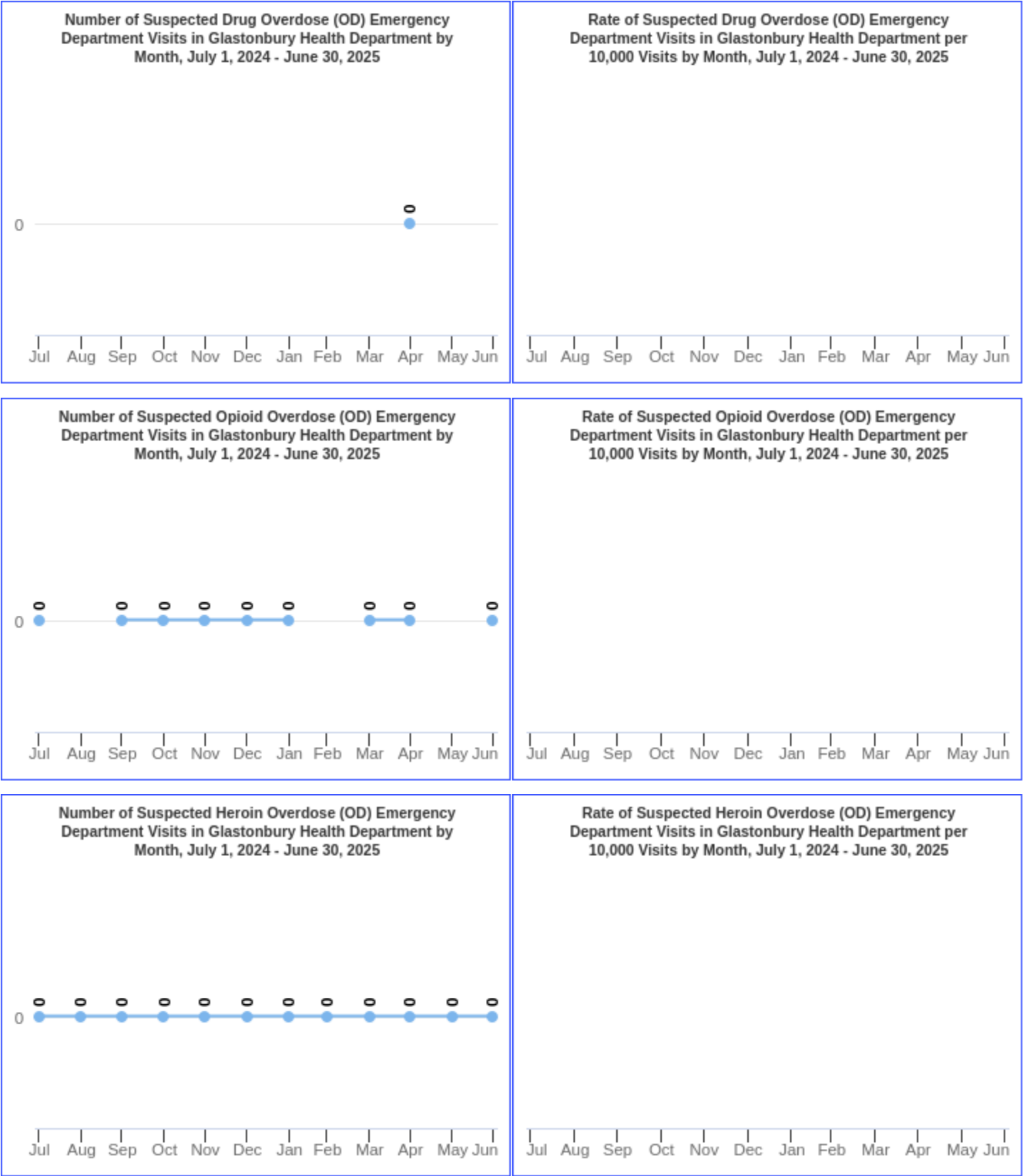

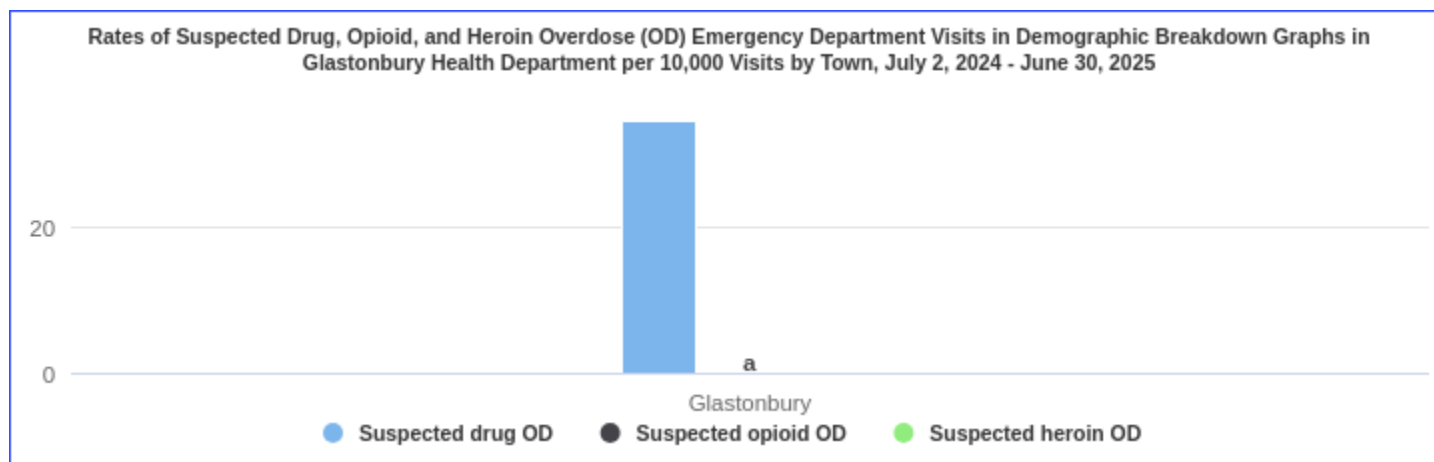

Suspected Drug Overdose in Glastonbury Health Department



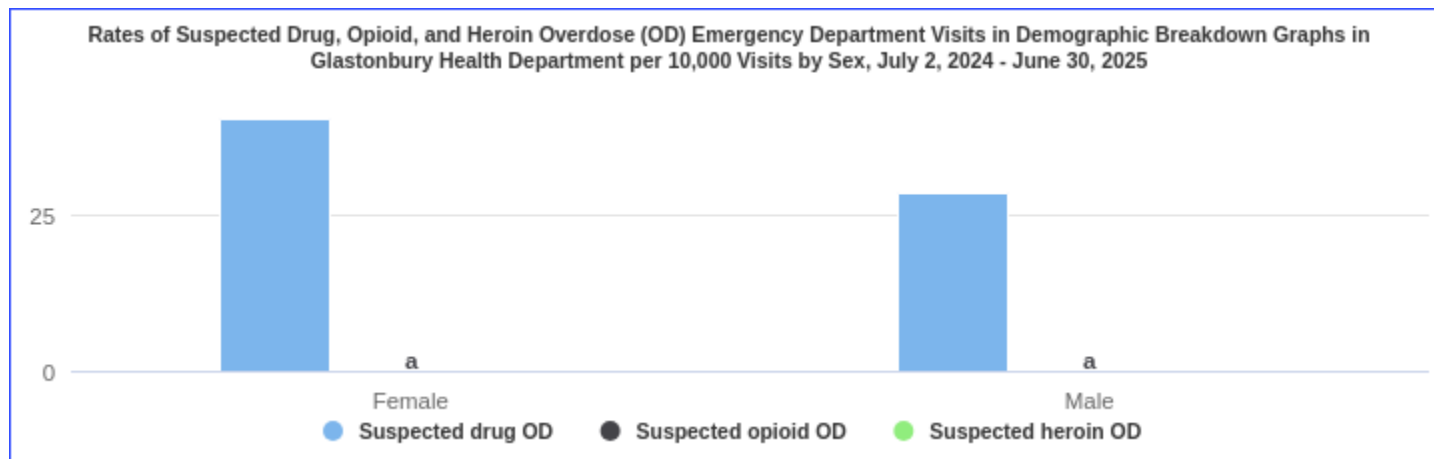

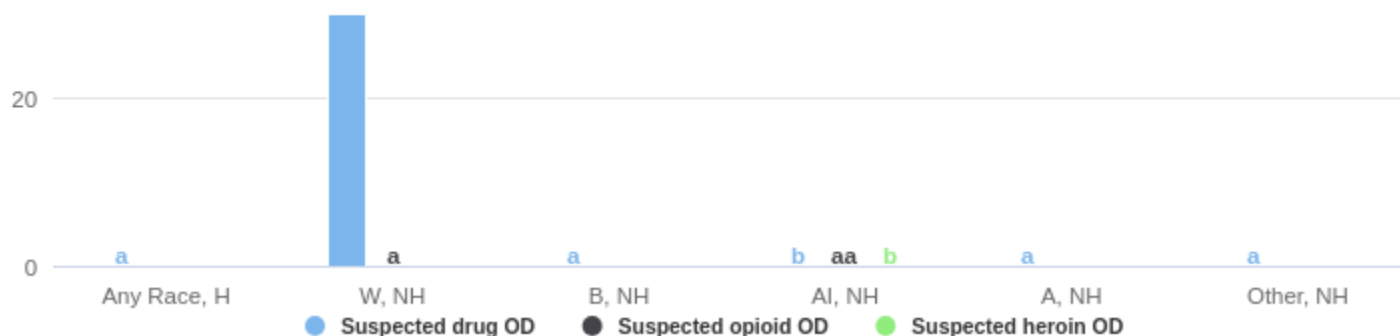

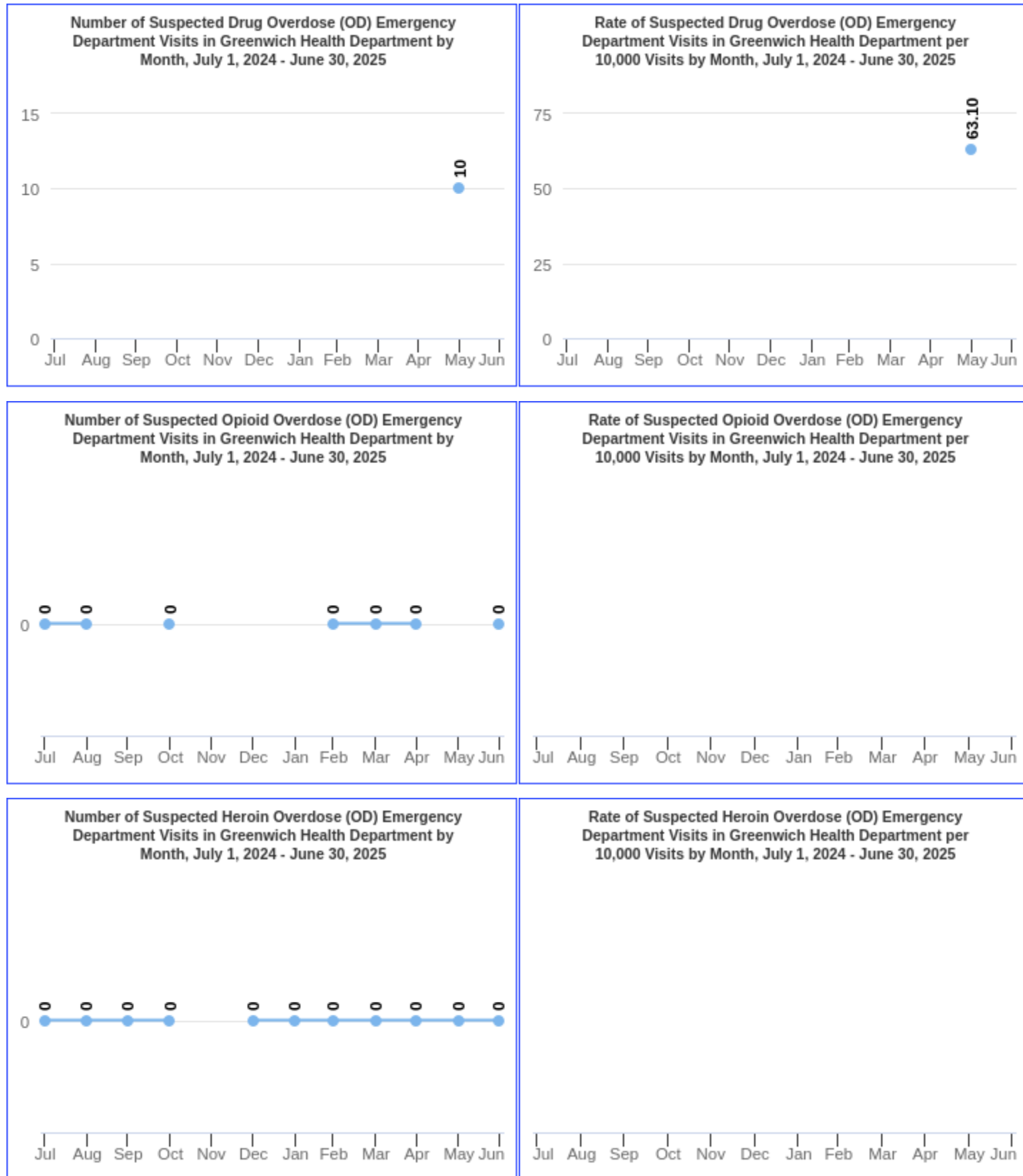

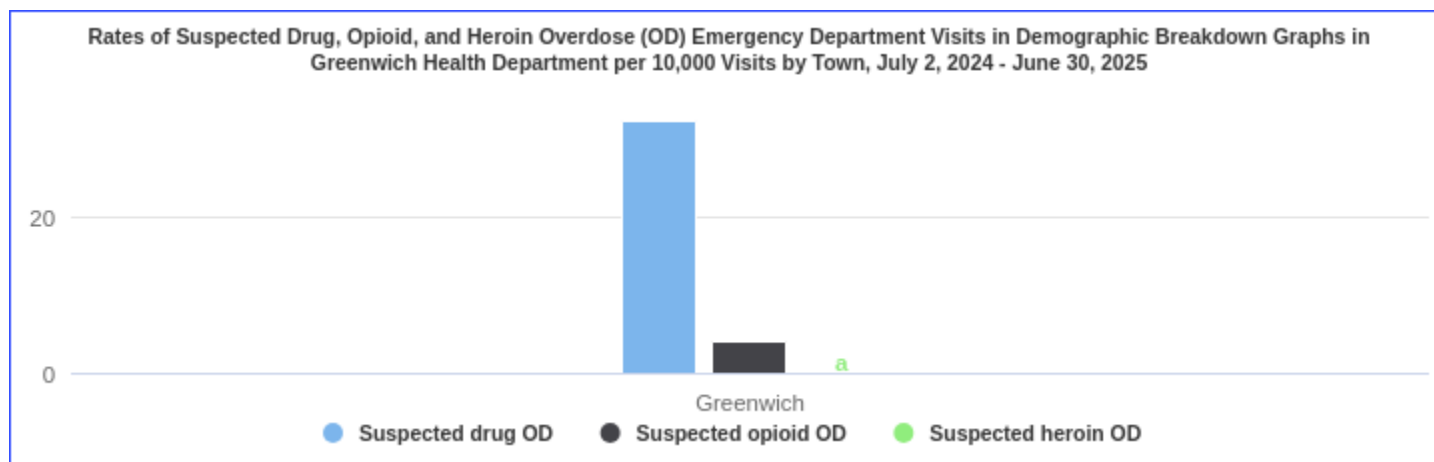

Suspected Drug Overdose in Greenwich Health Department



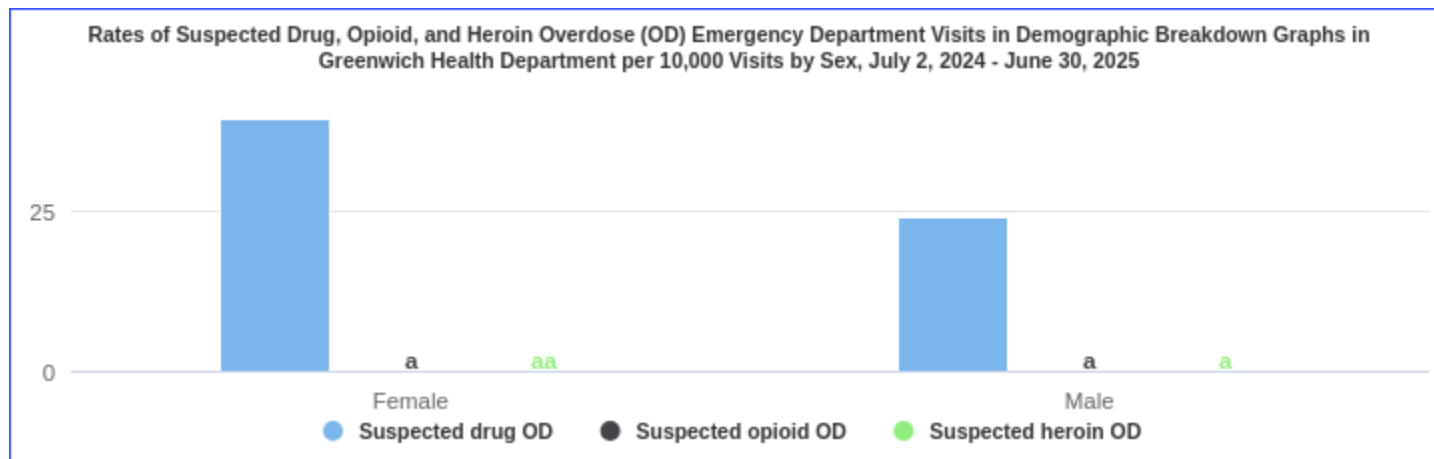

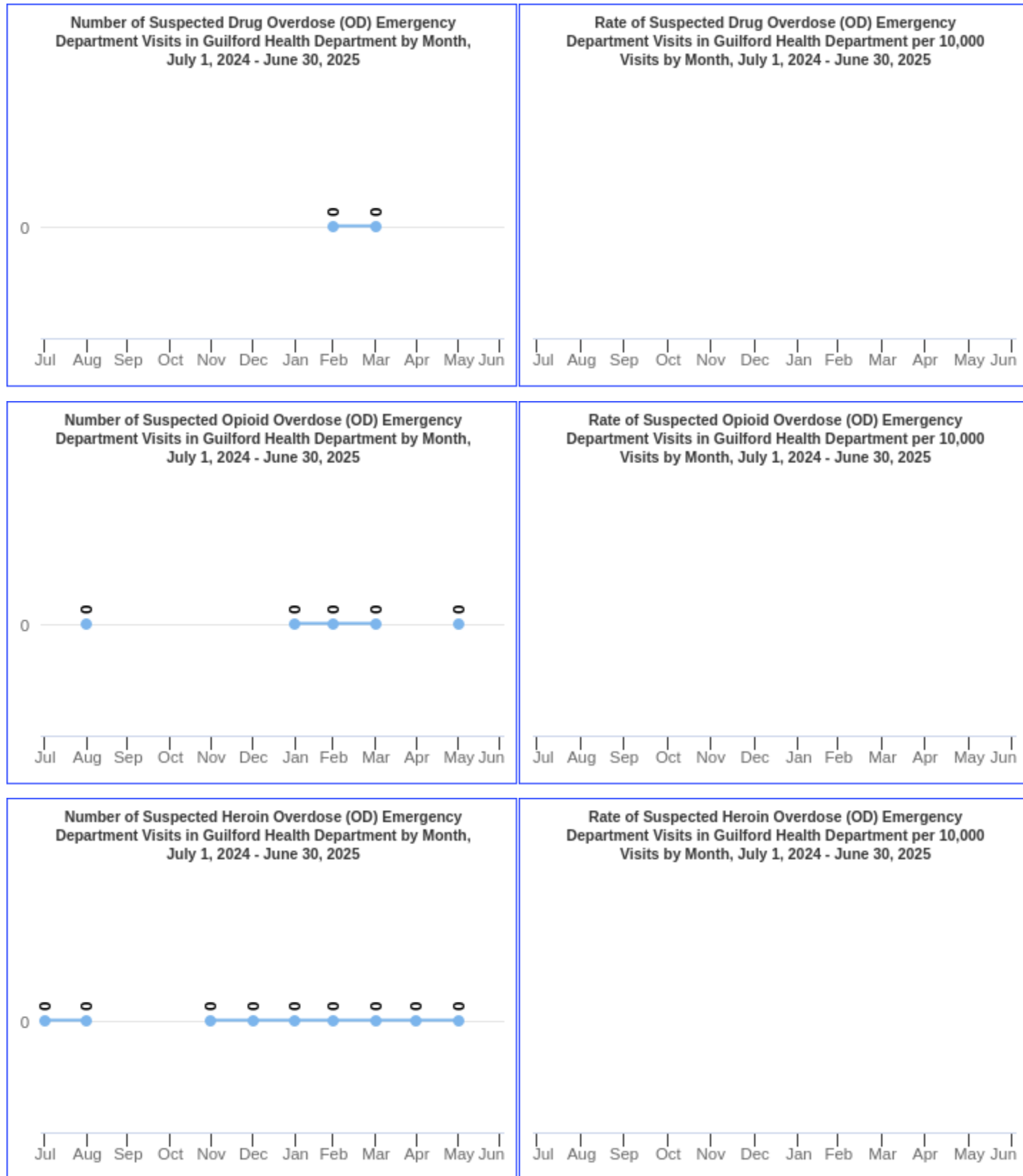

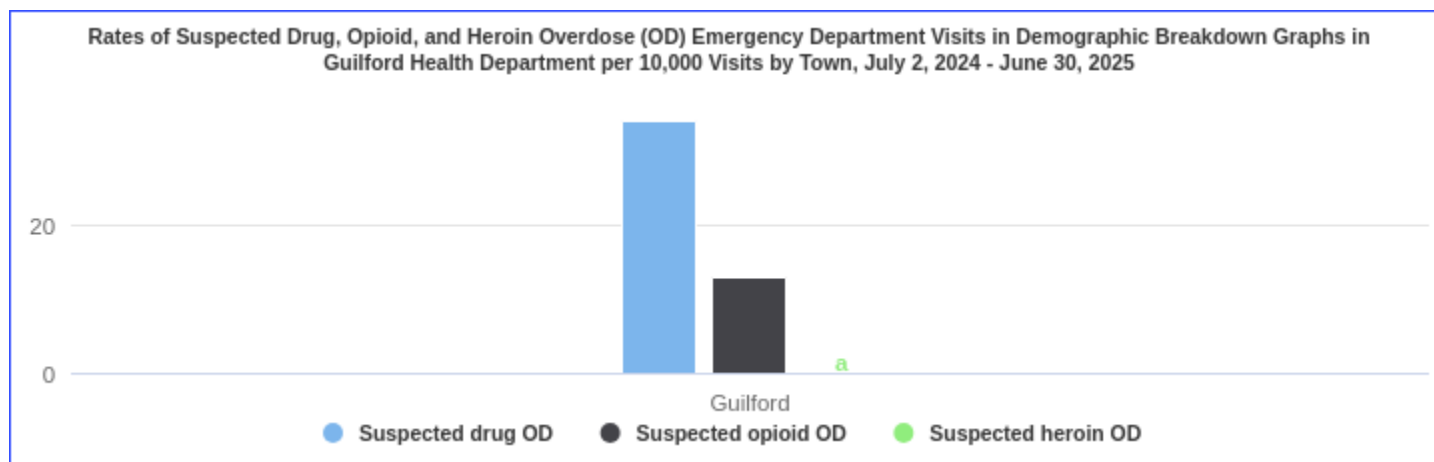

Suspected Drug Overdose in Guilford Health Department



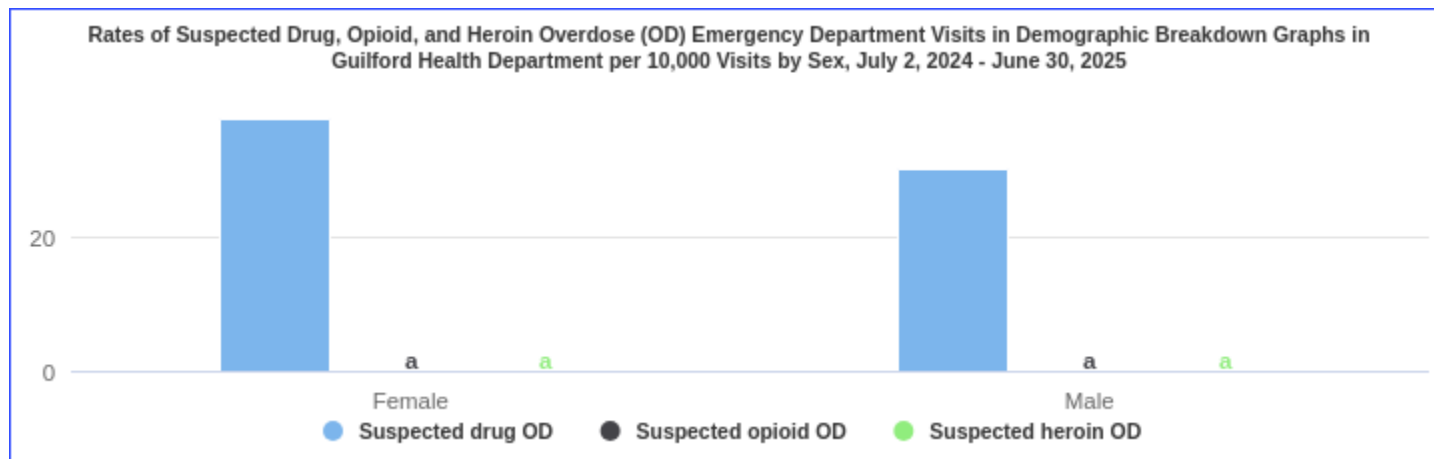

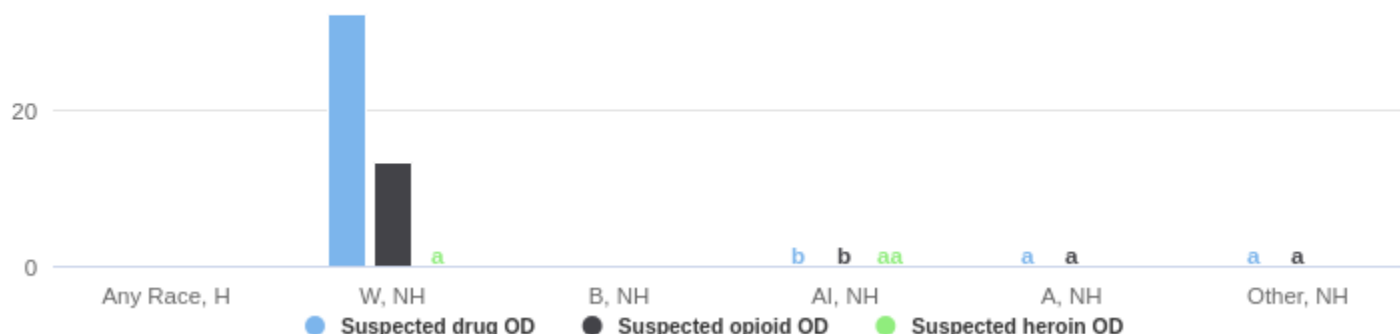

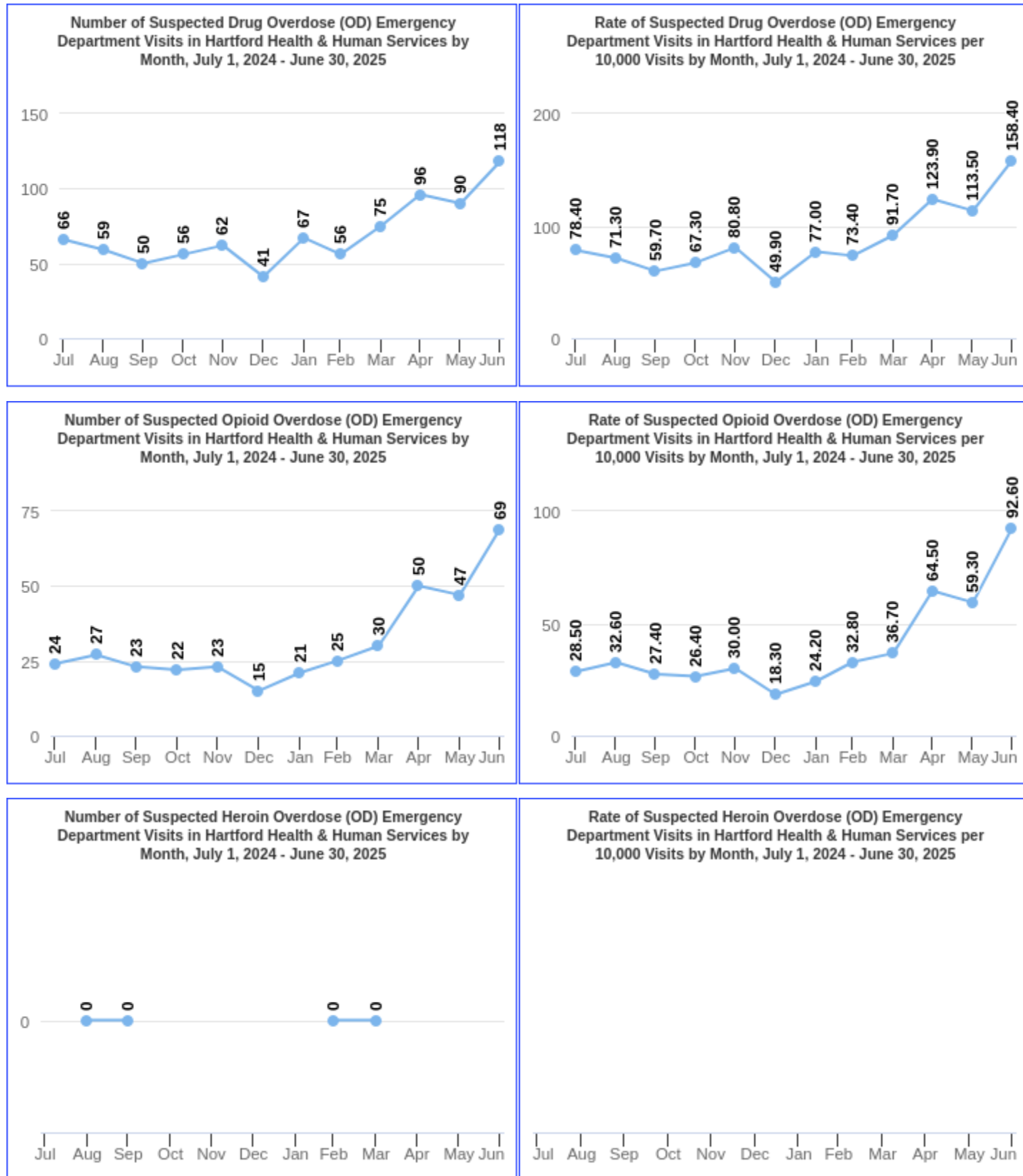

Suspected Drug Overdose in Hartford Health & Human Services



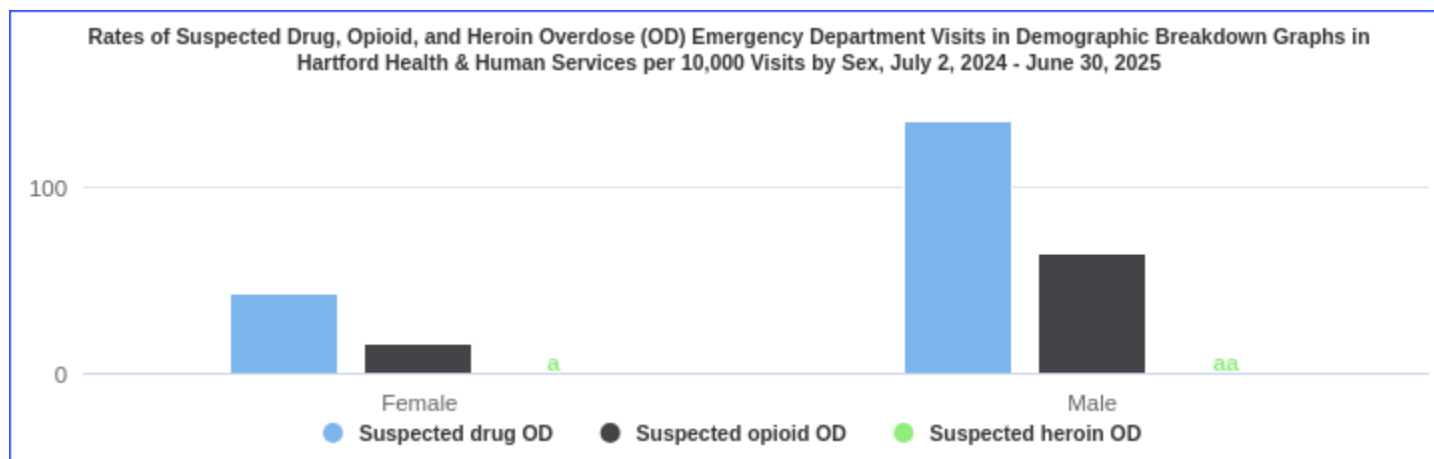

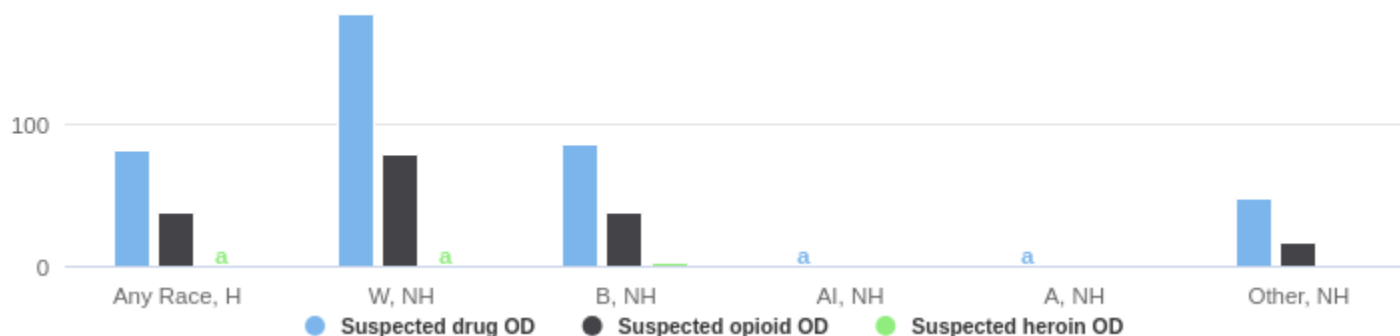

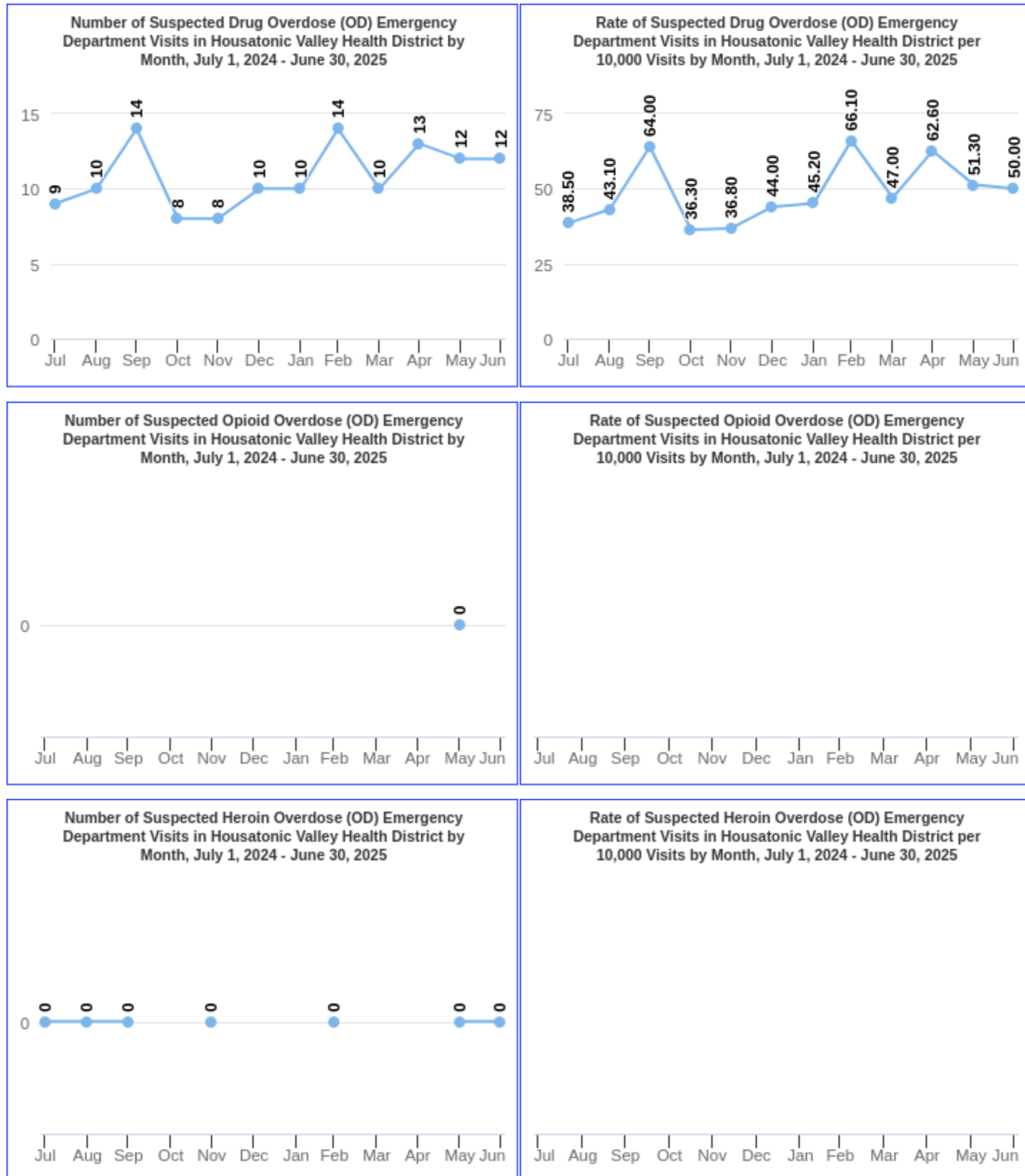

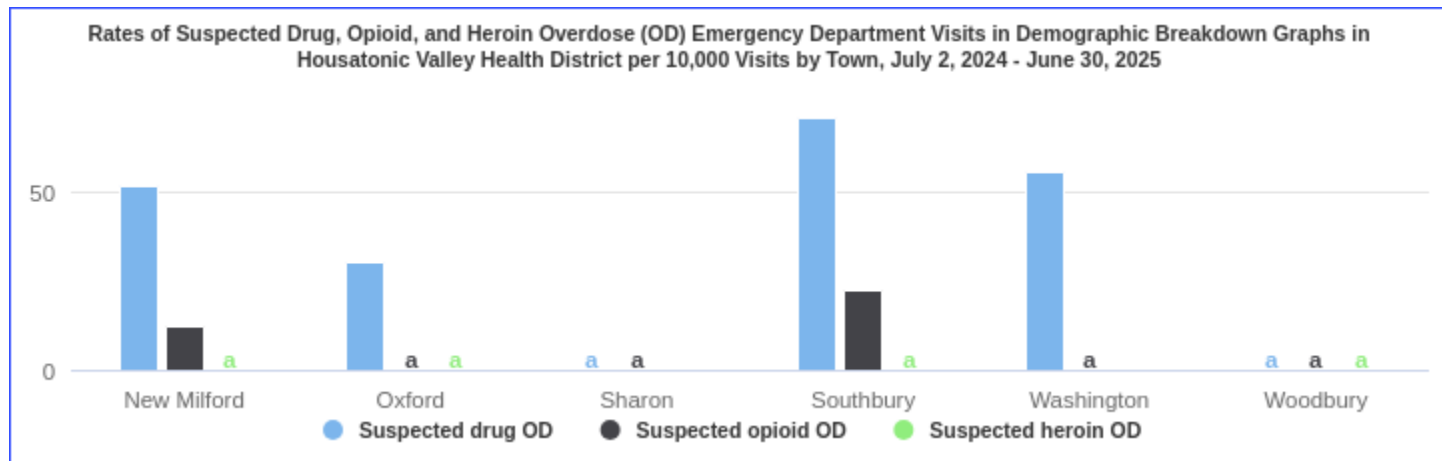

Suspected Drug Overdose in Housatonic Valley Health District



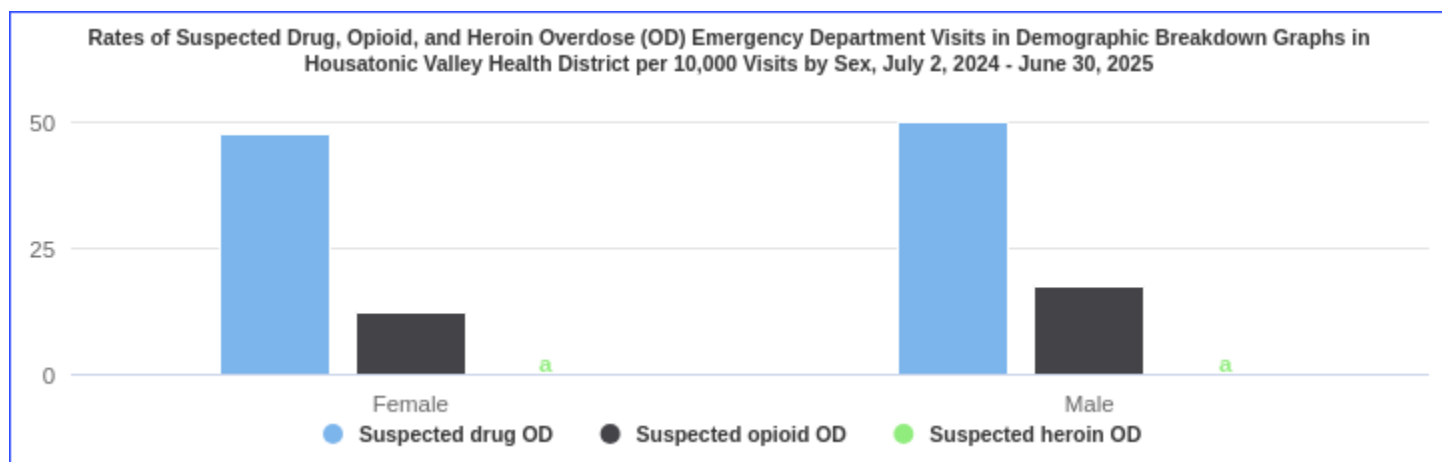

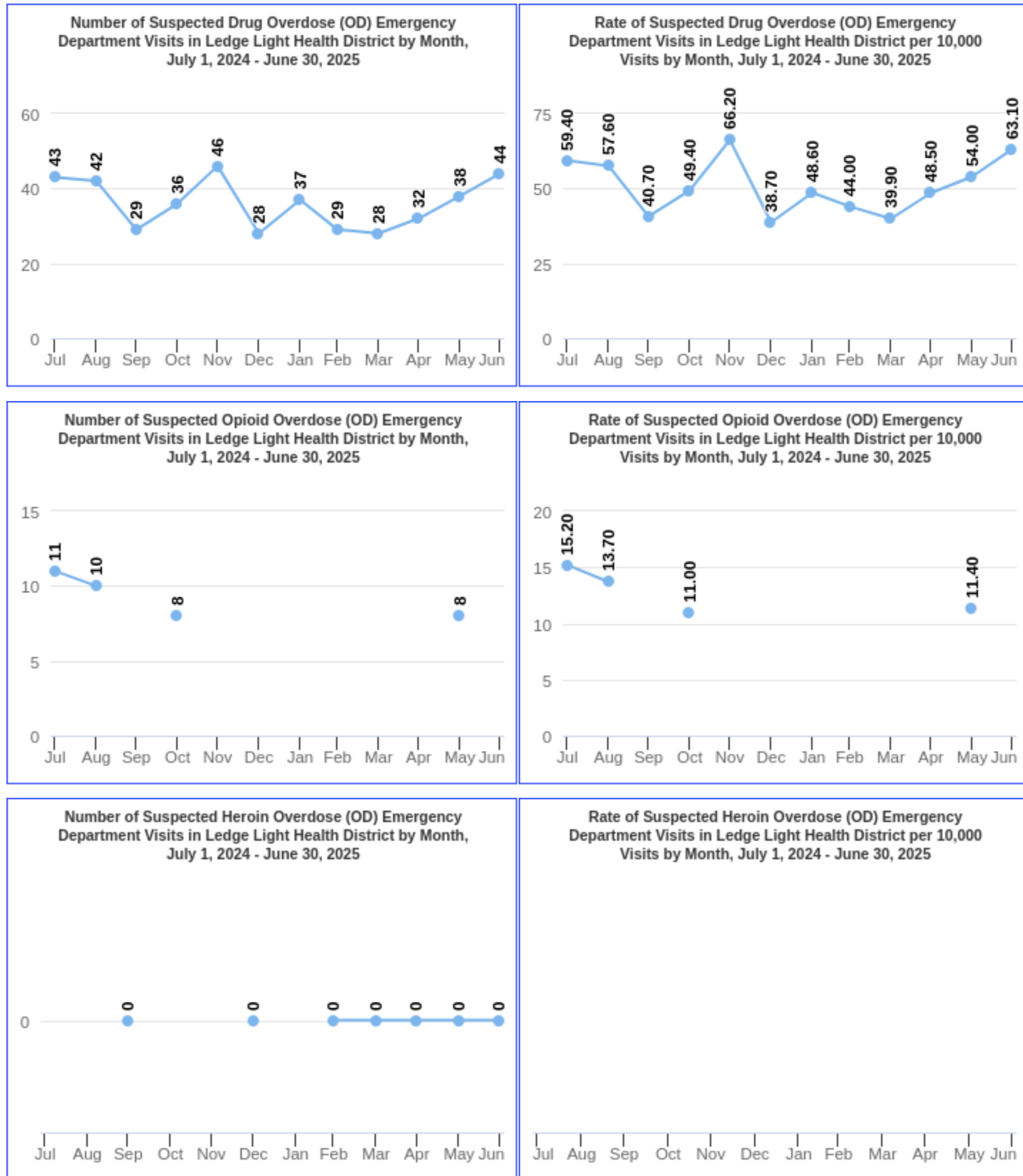

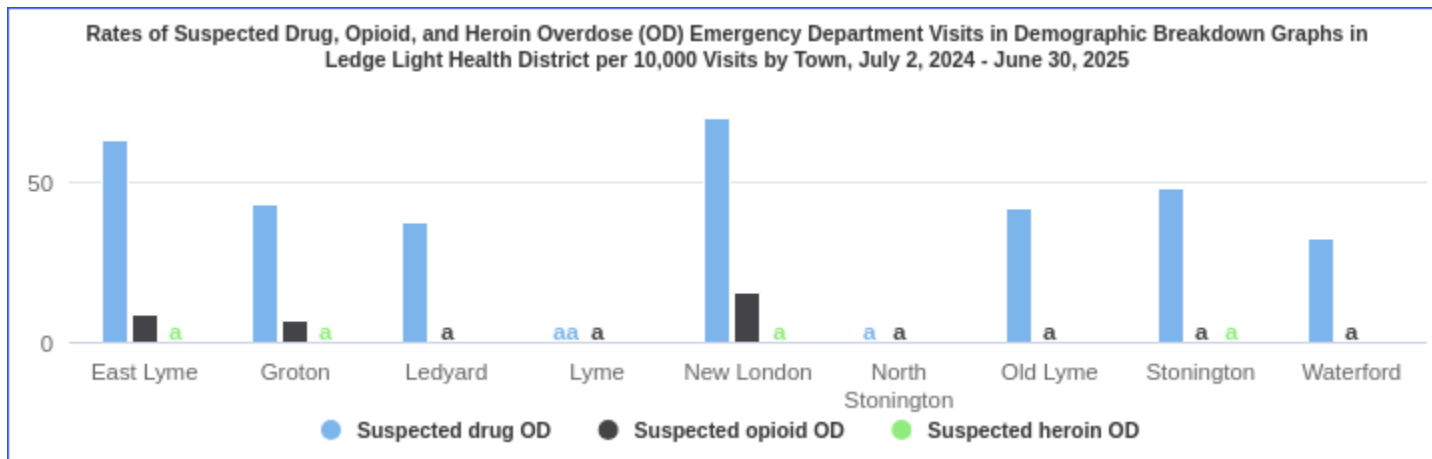

Suspected Drug Overdose in Ledge Light Health District



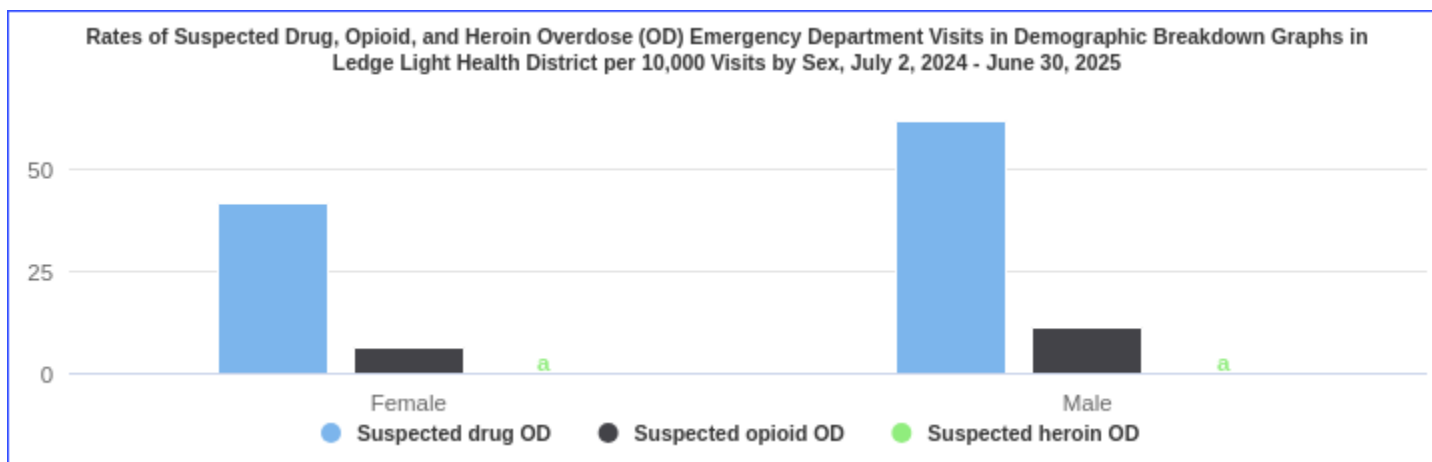

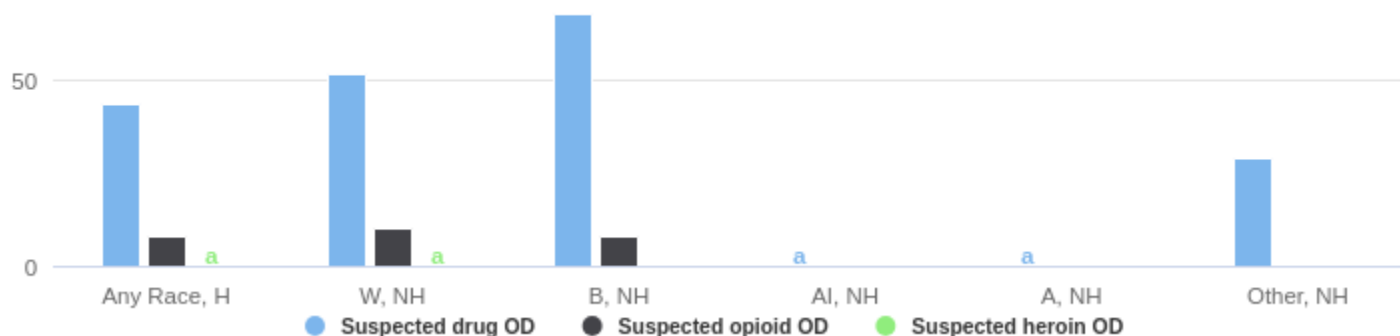

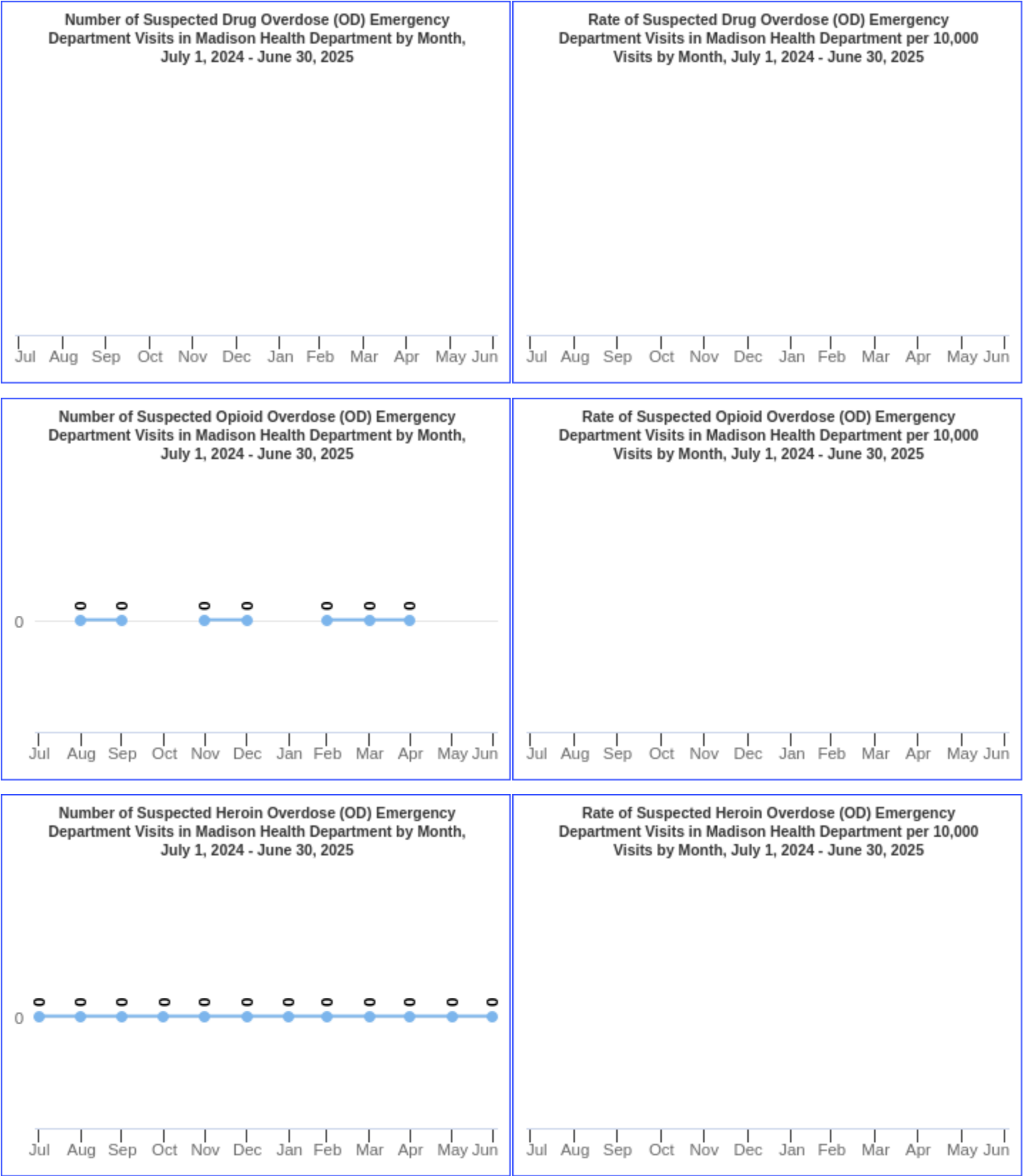

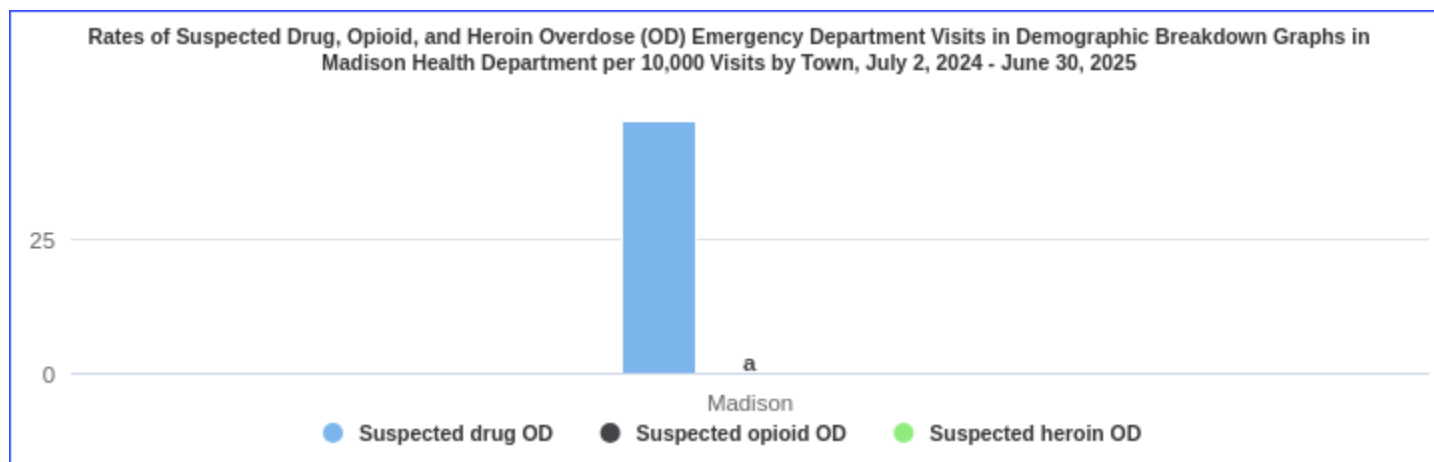

Suspected Drug Overdose in Madison Health Department



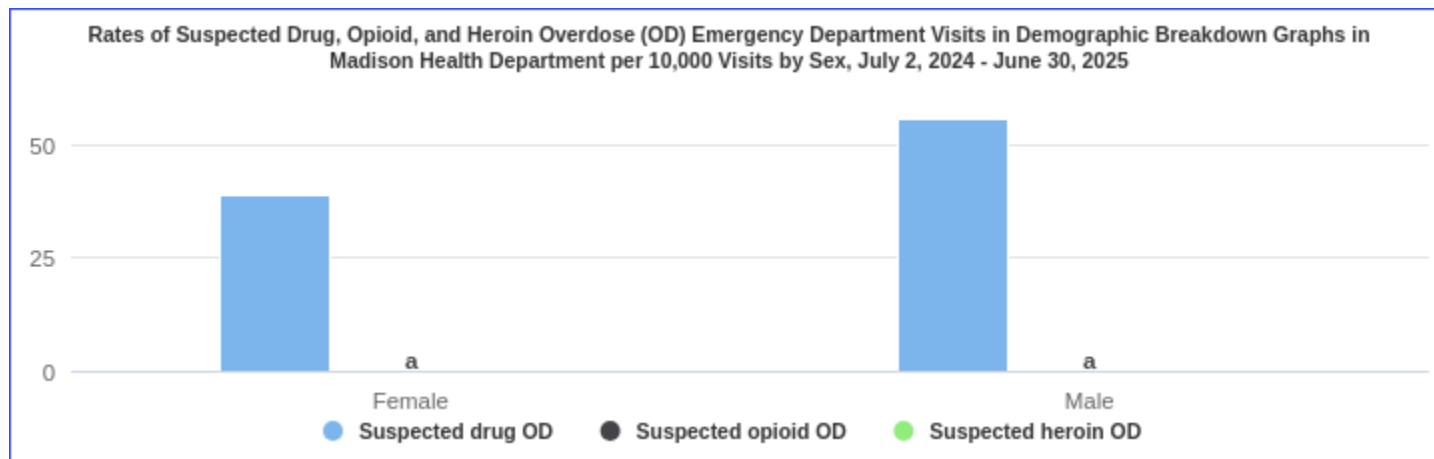

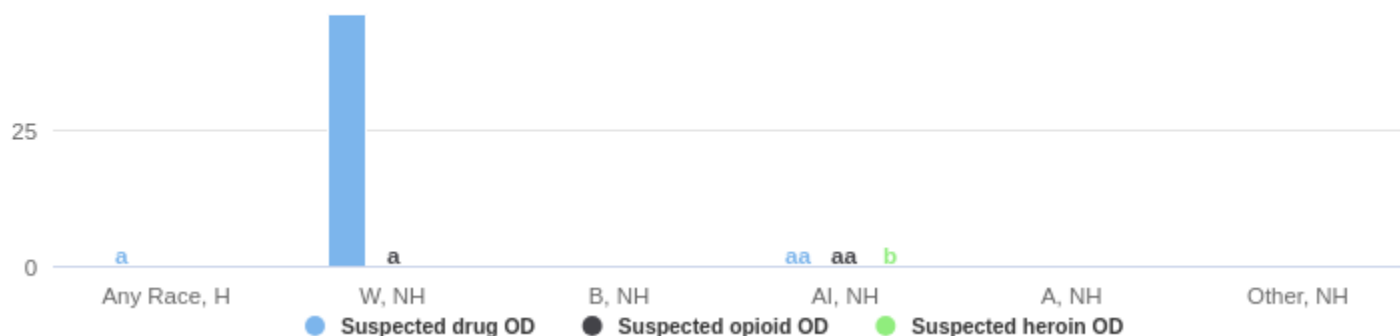

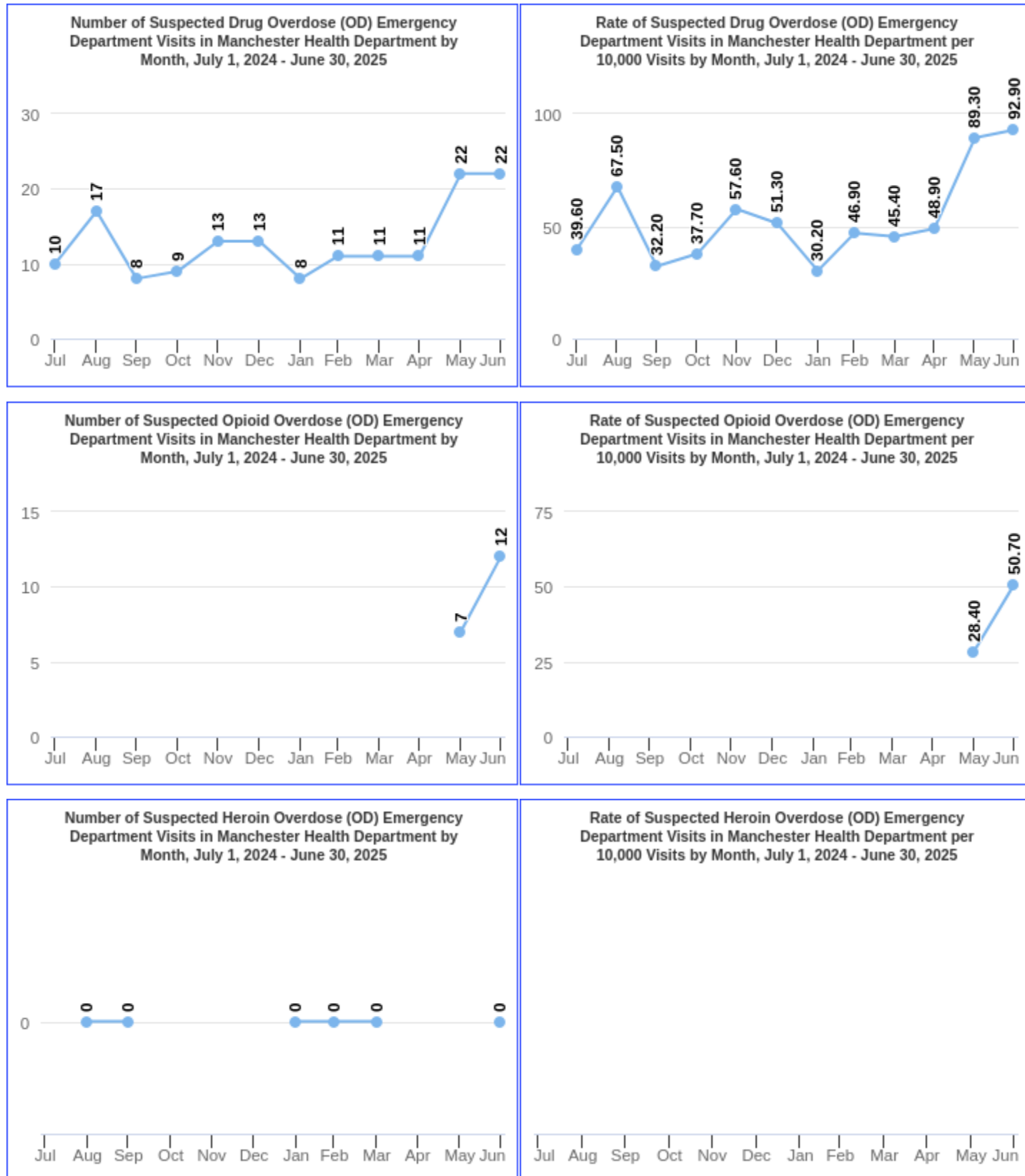

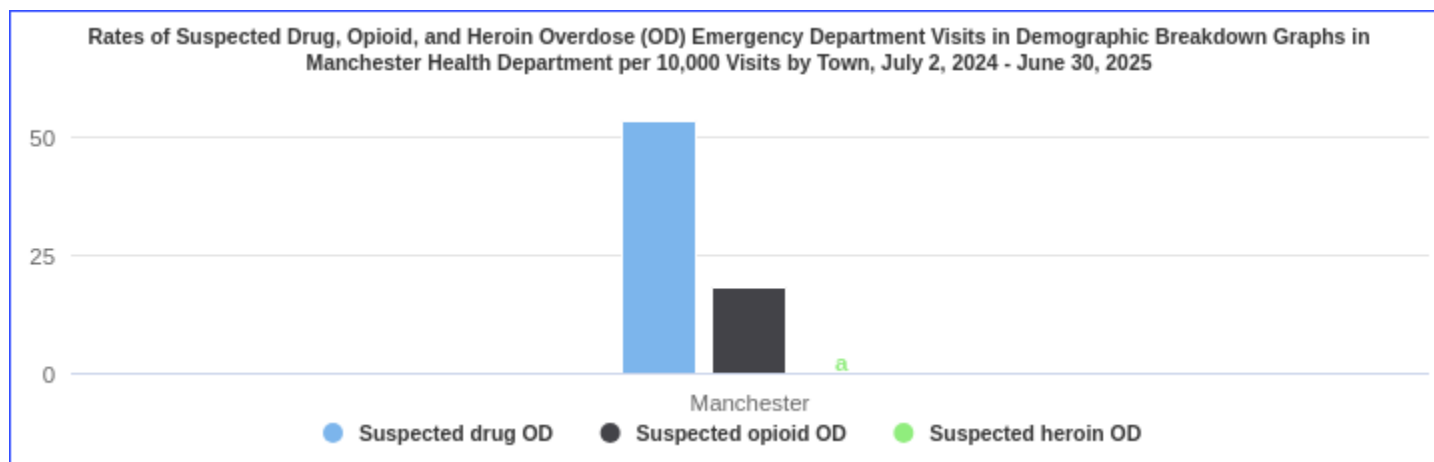

Suspected Drug Overdose in Manchester Health Department



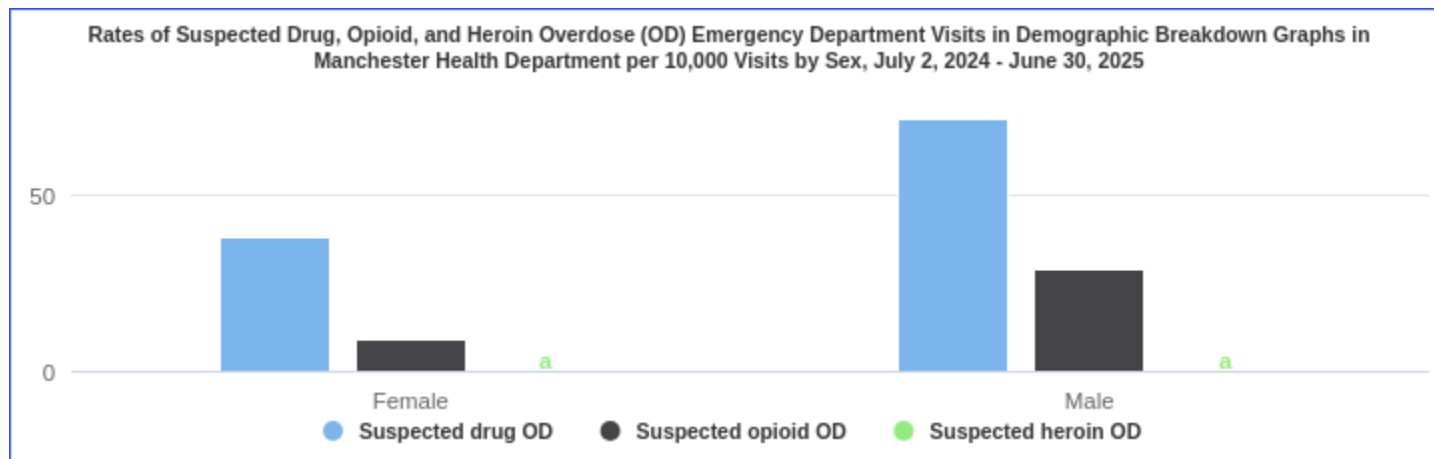

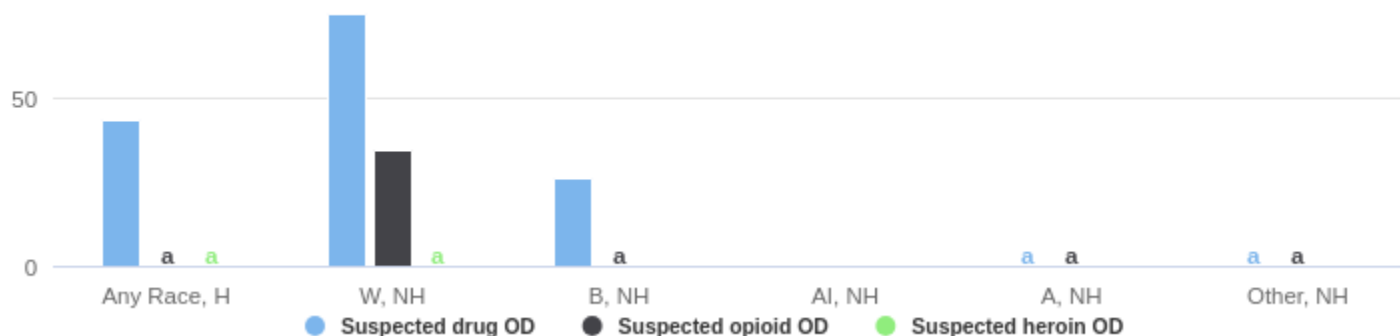

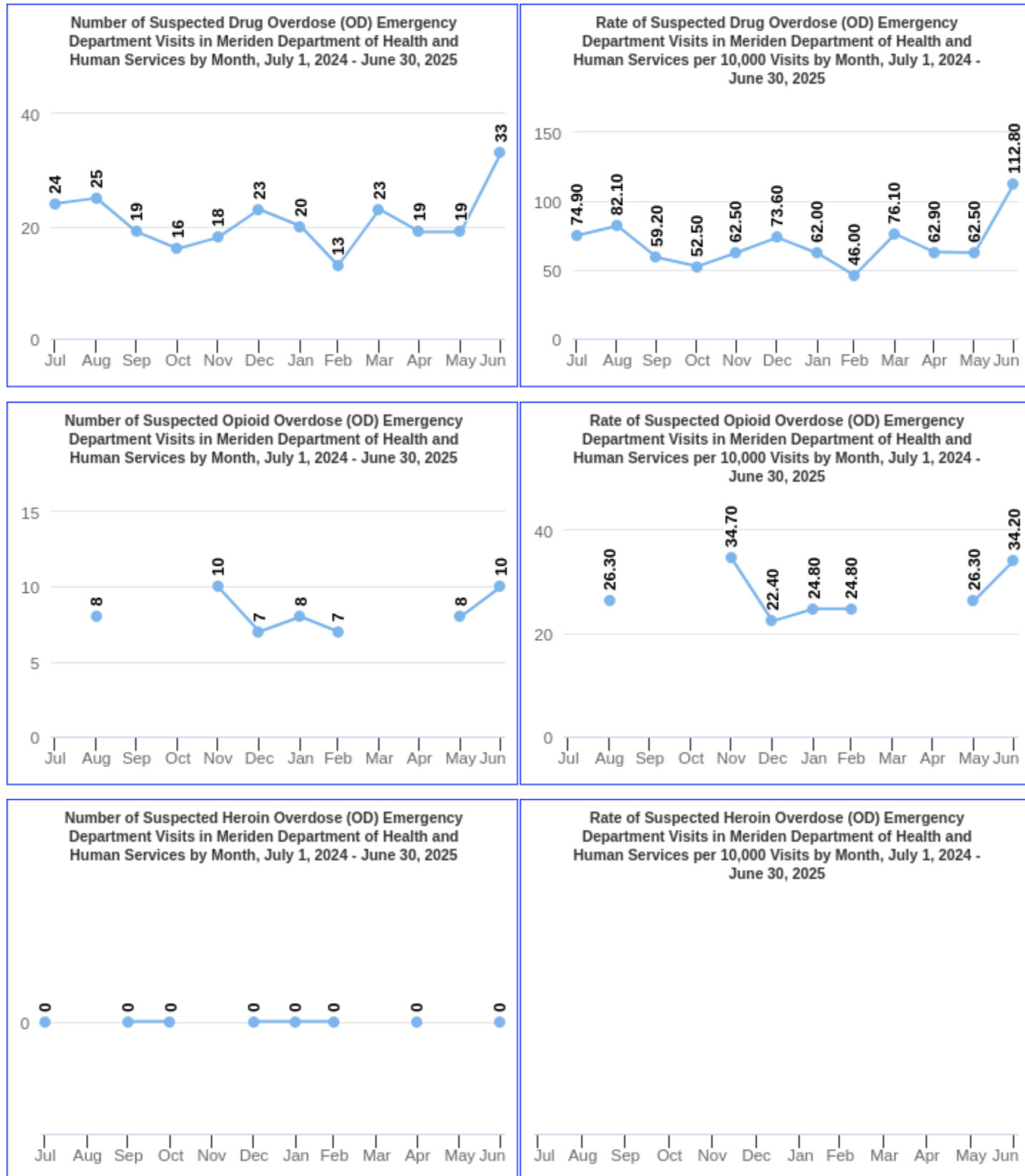

Suspected Drug Overdose in Meriden Department of Health and Human Services



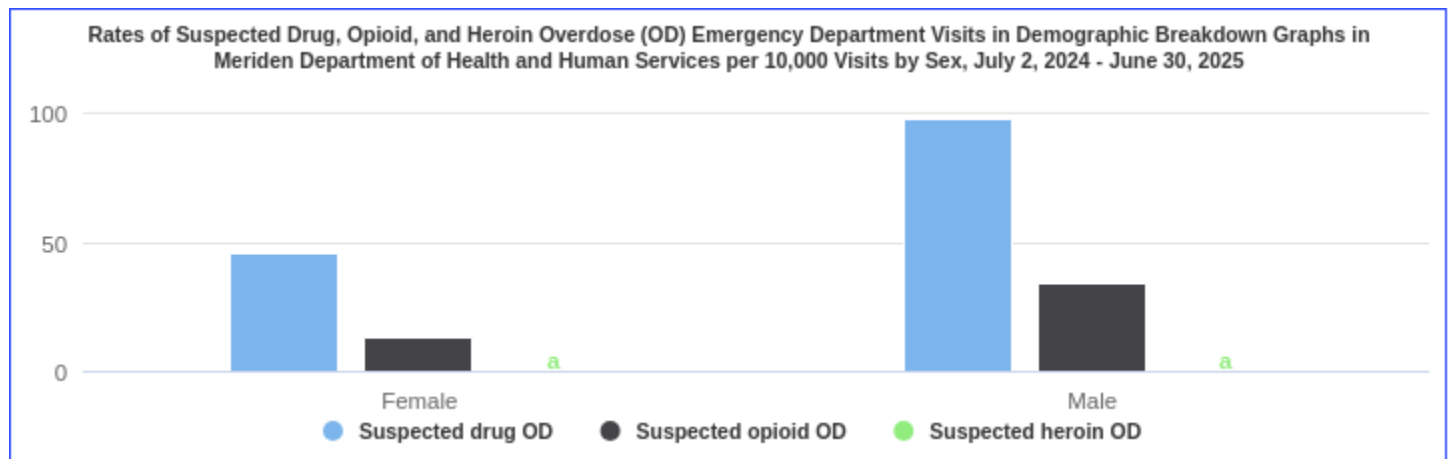

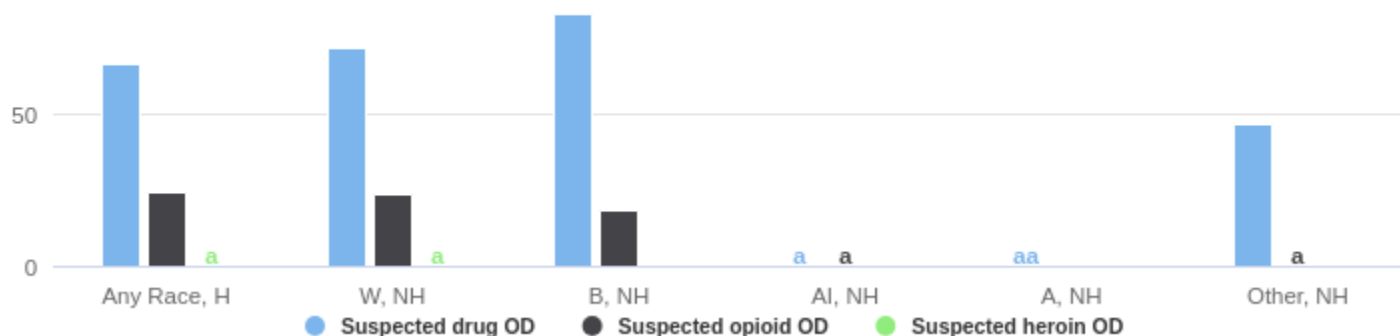

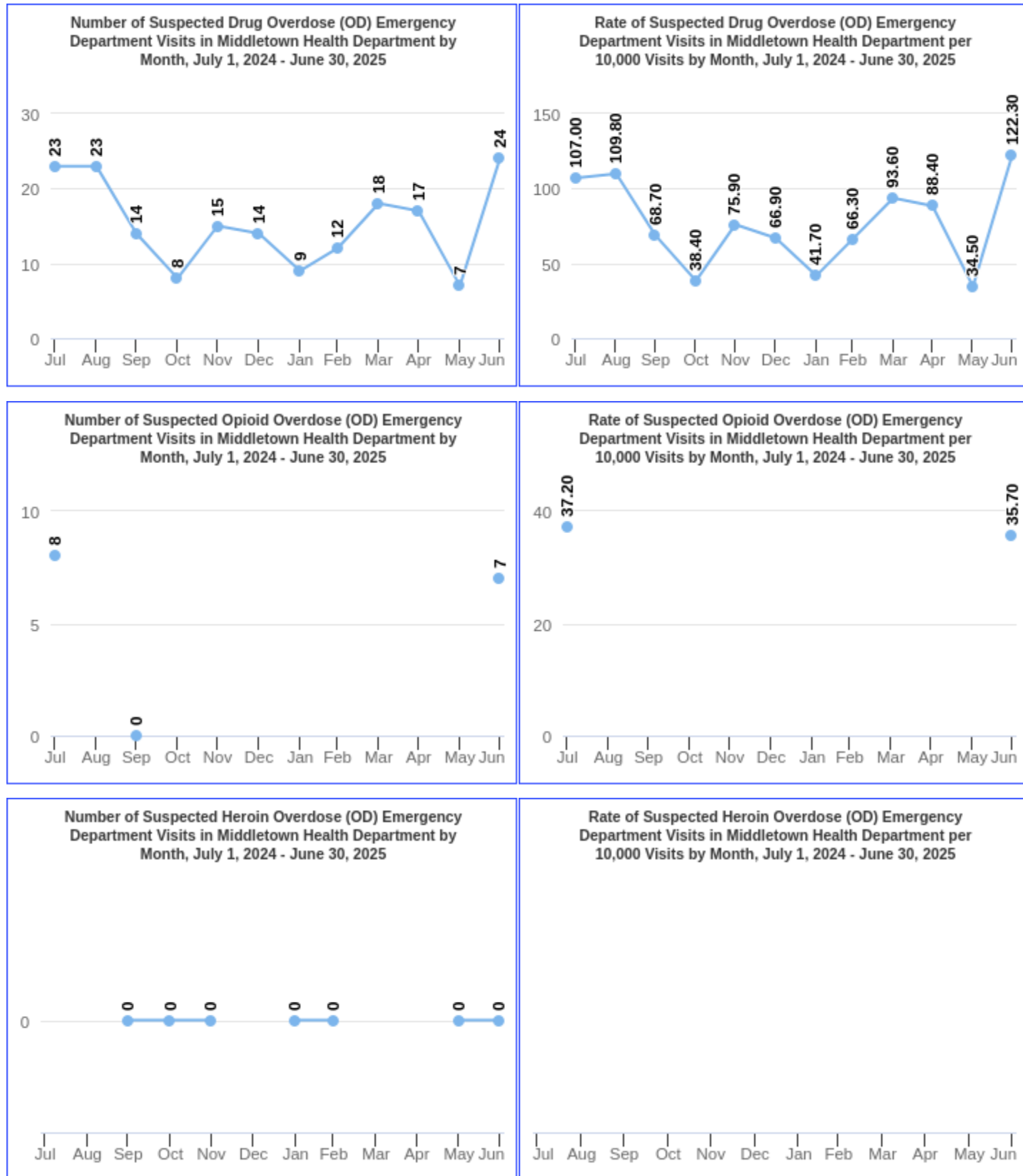

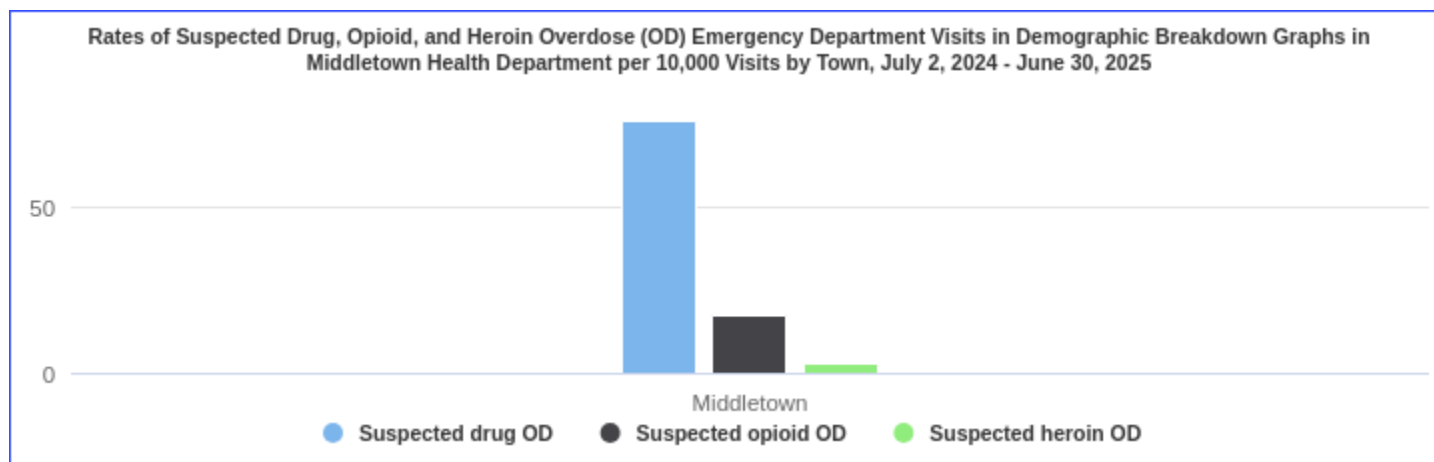

Suspected Drug Overdose in Middletown Health Department



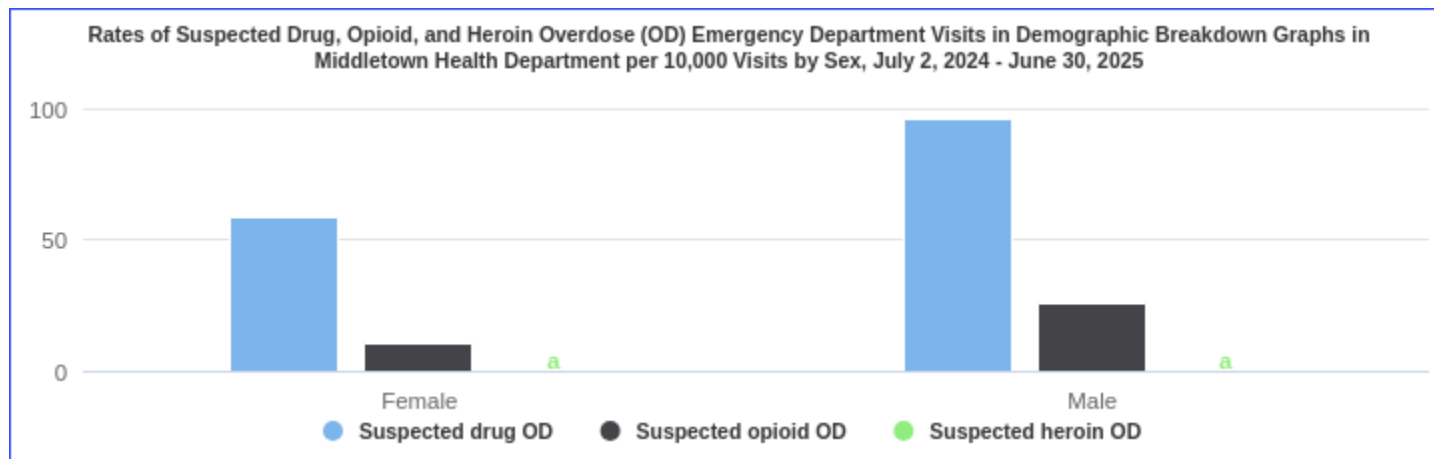

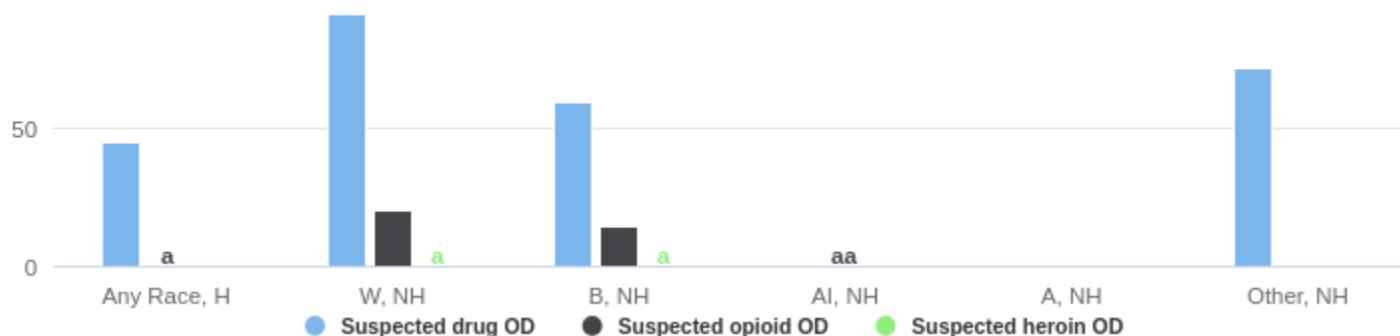

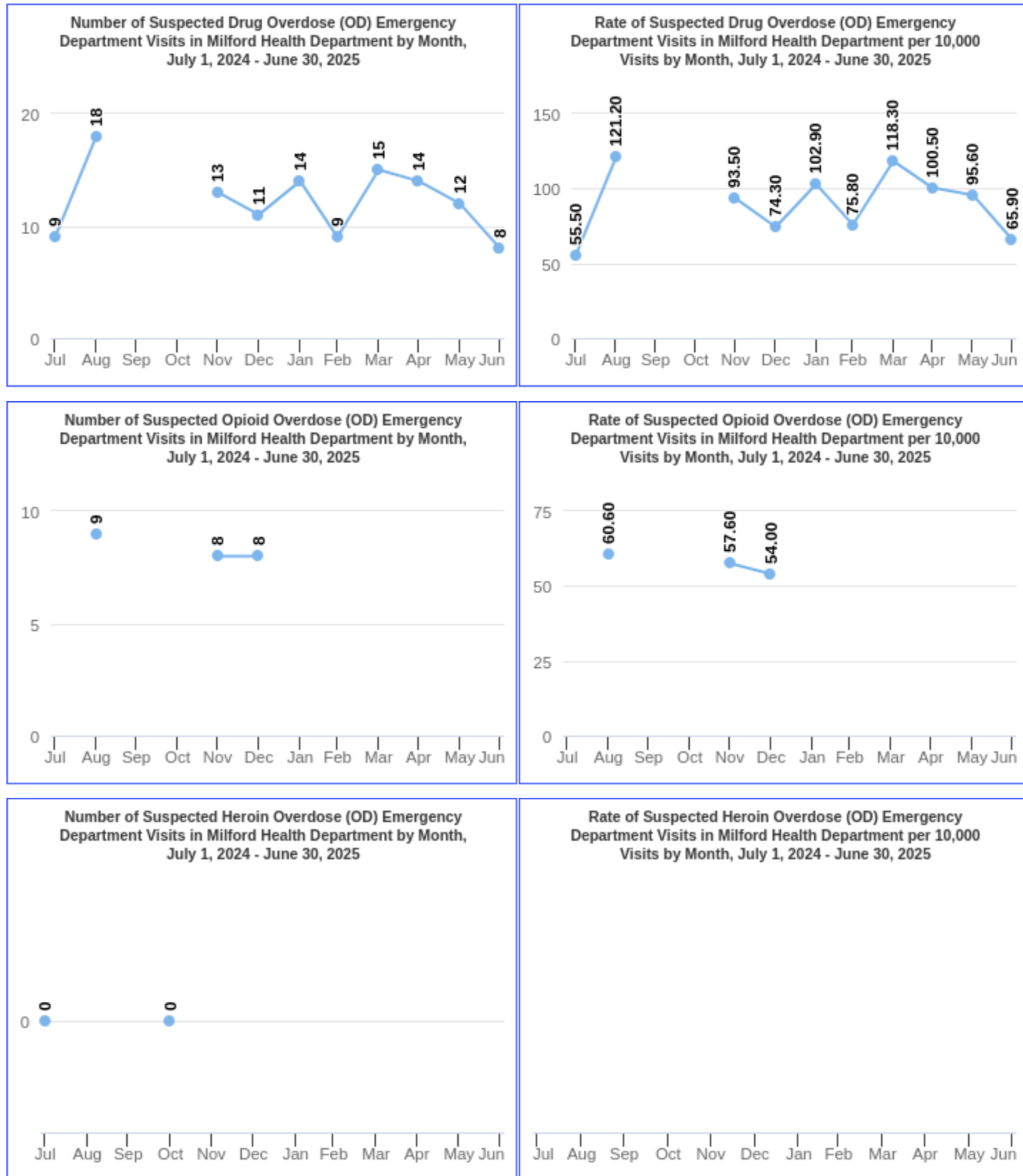

Suspected Drug Overdose in Milford Health Department



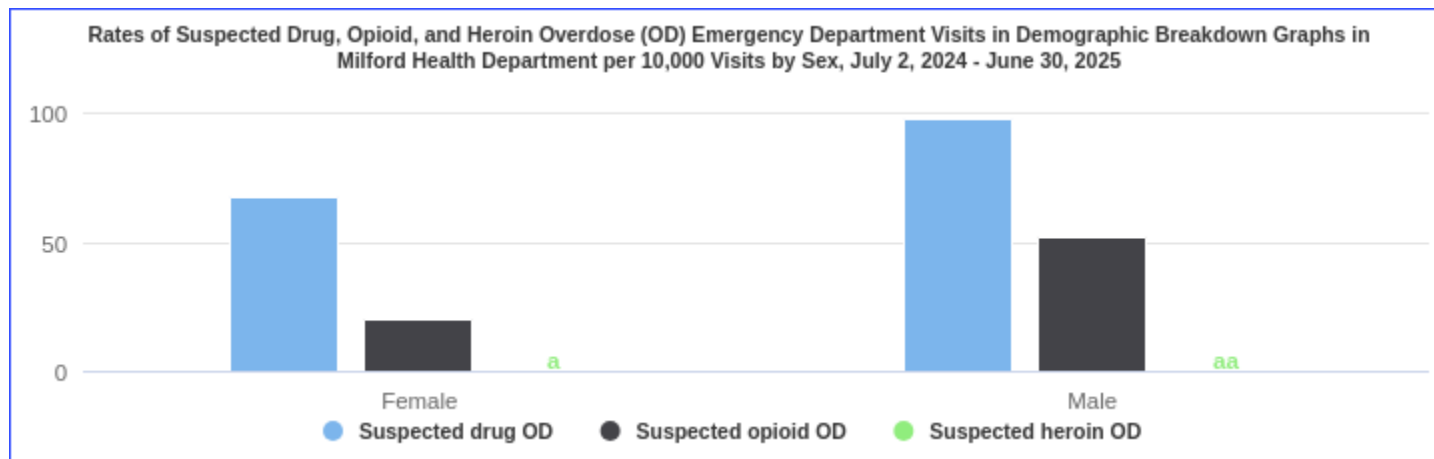

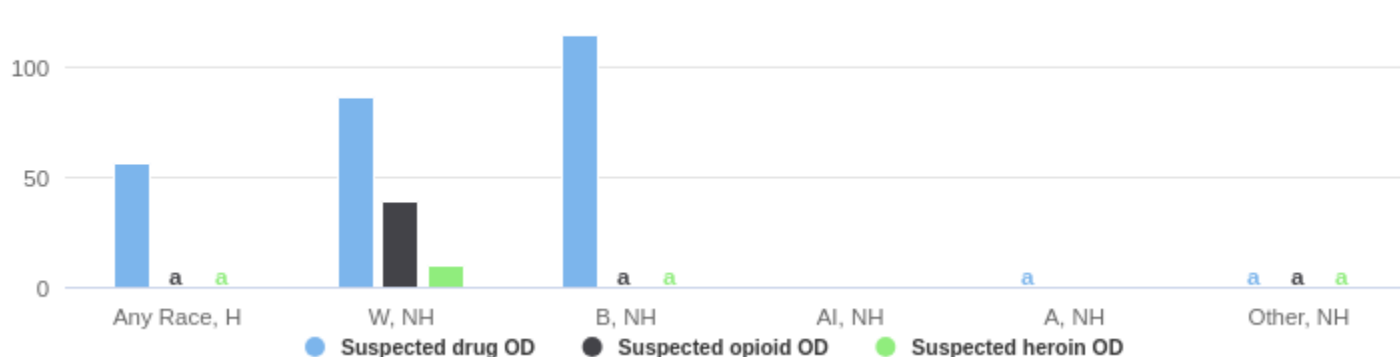

Suspected Drug Overdose in Monroe Health Department



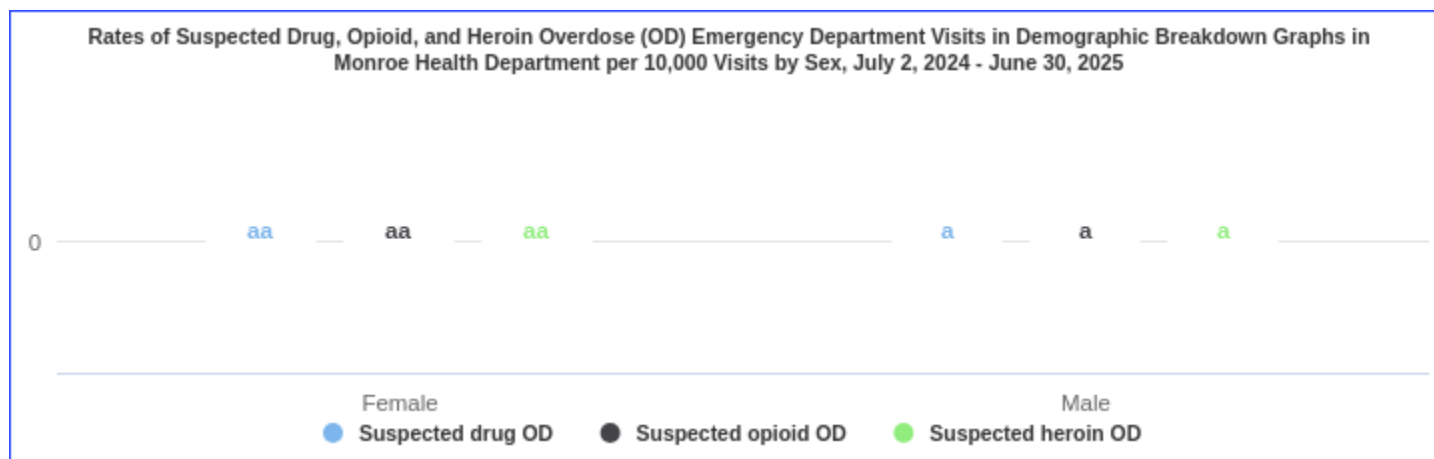

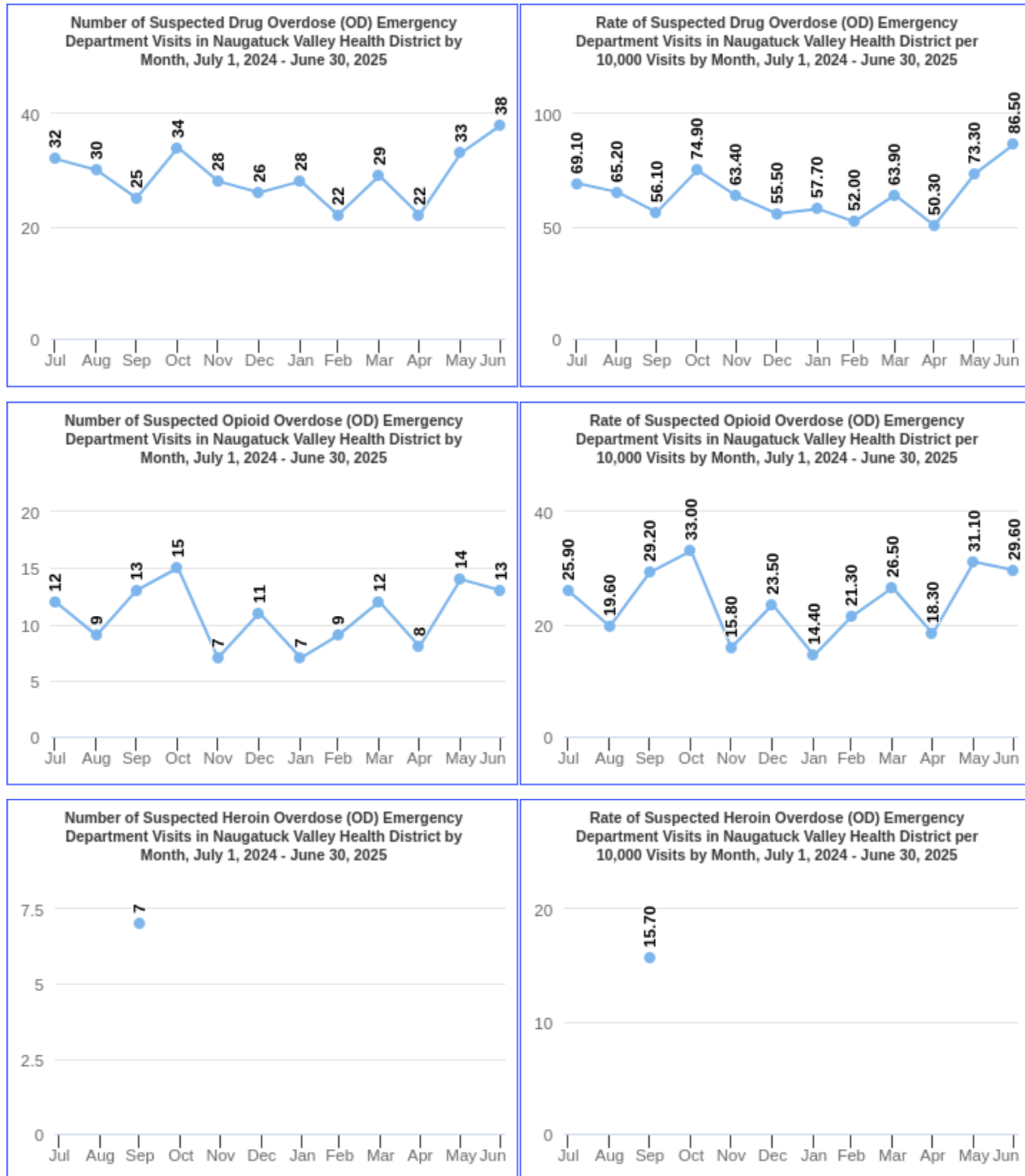

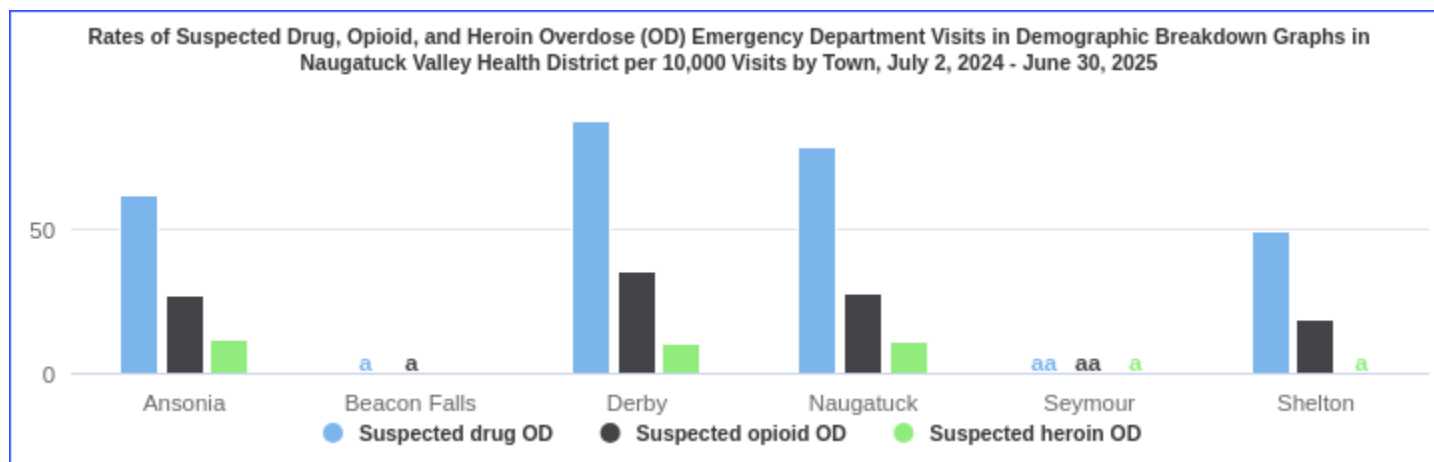

Suspected Drug Overdose in Naugatuck Valley Health District



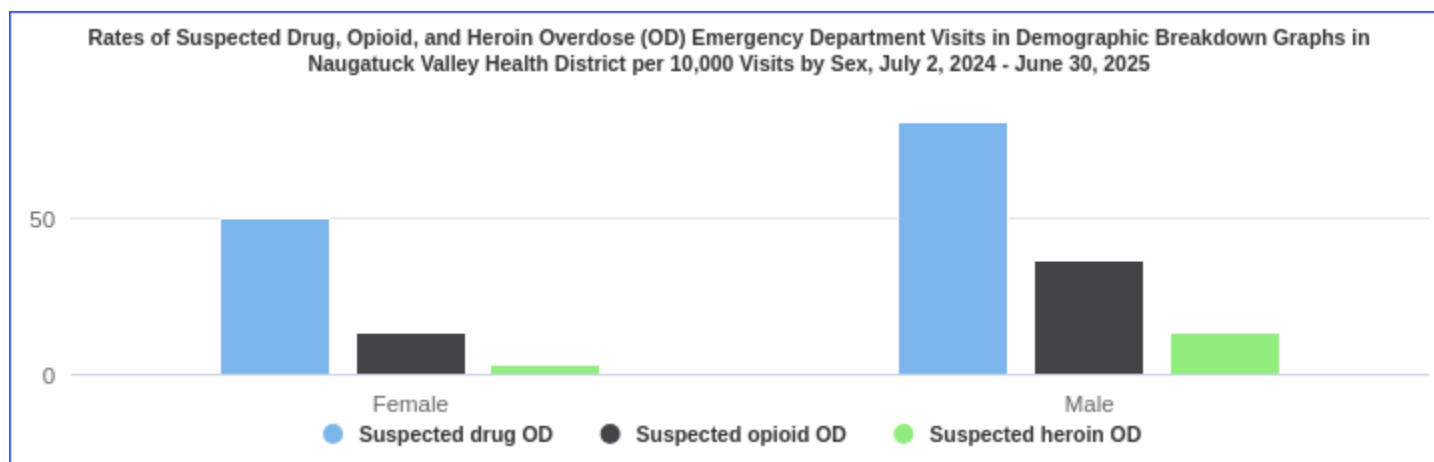

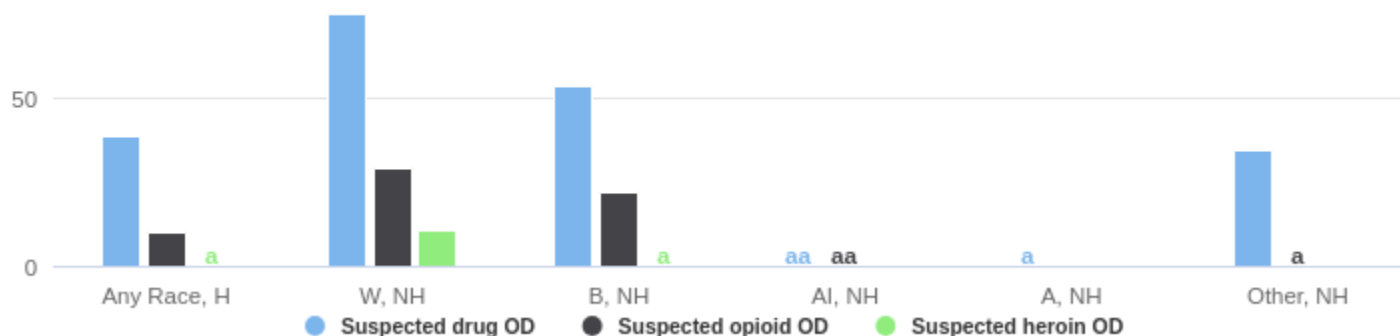

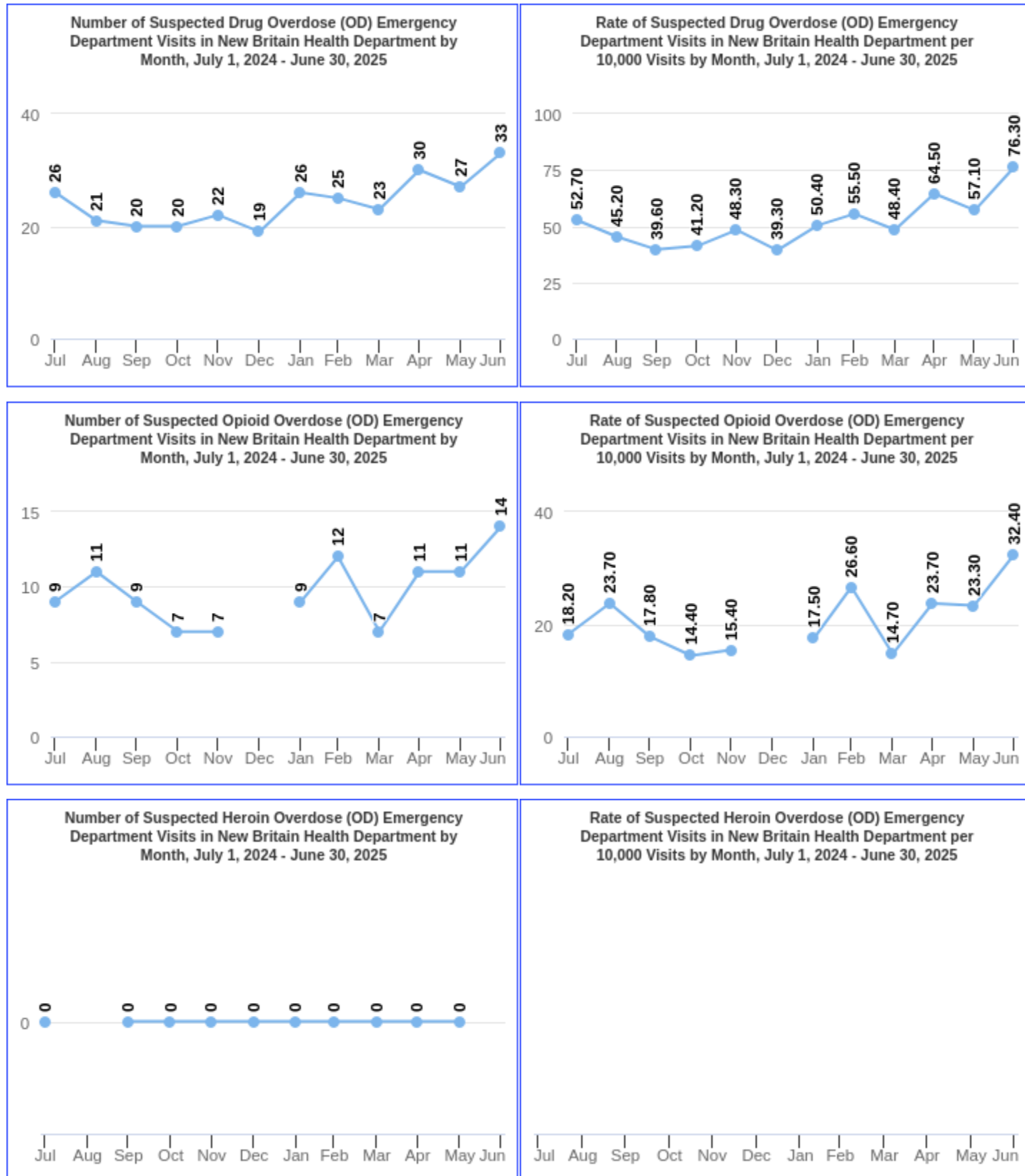

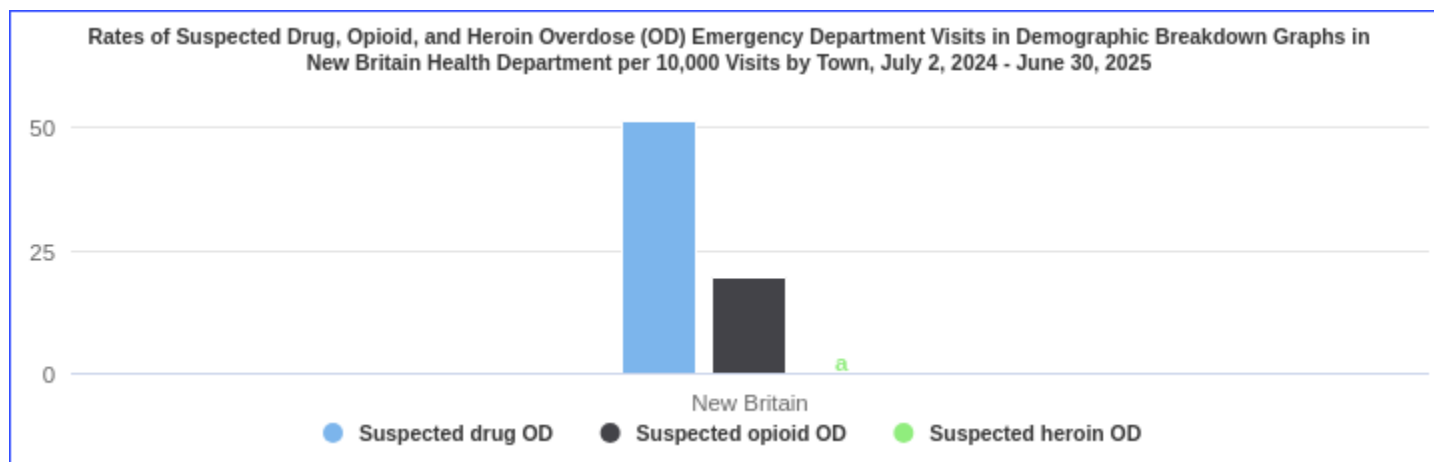

Suspected Drug Overdose in New Britain Health Department



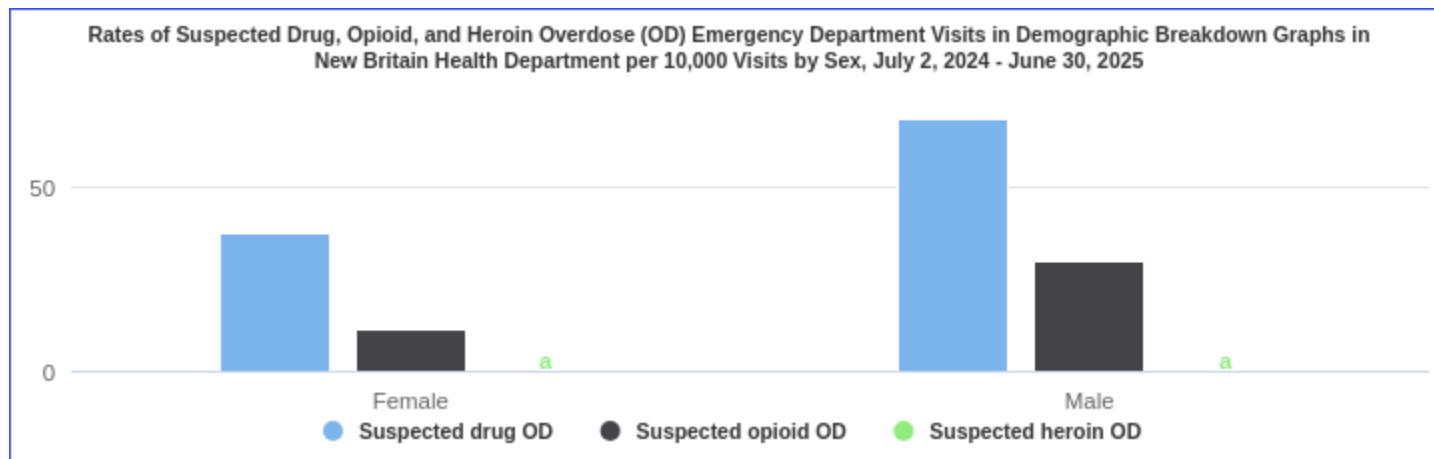

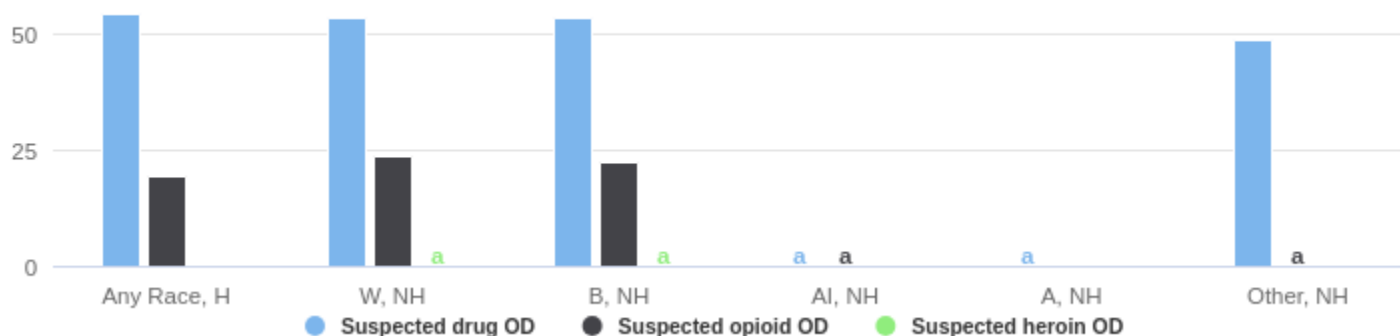

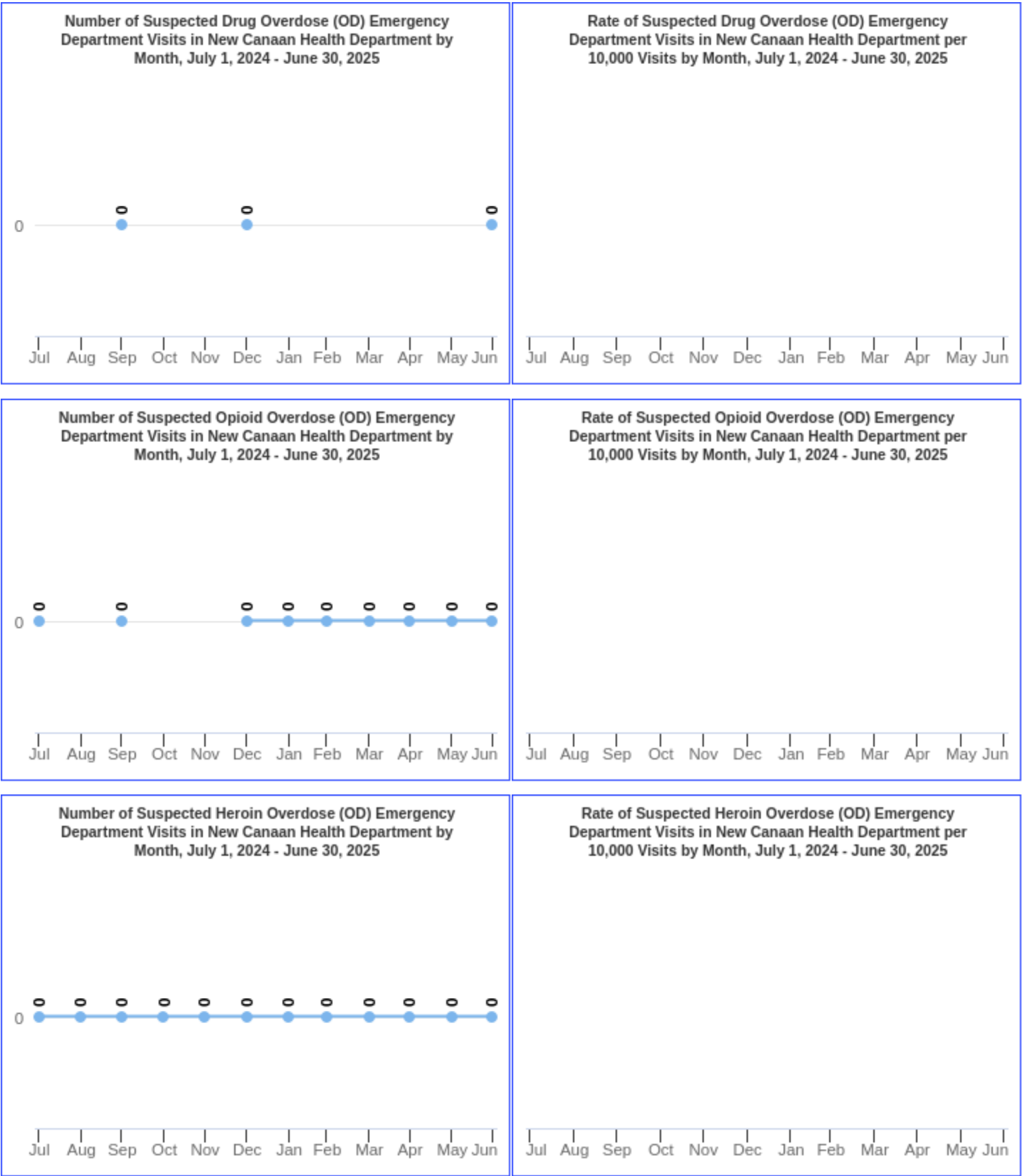

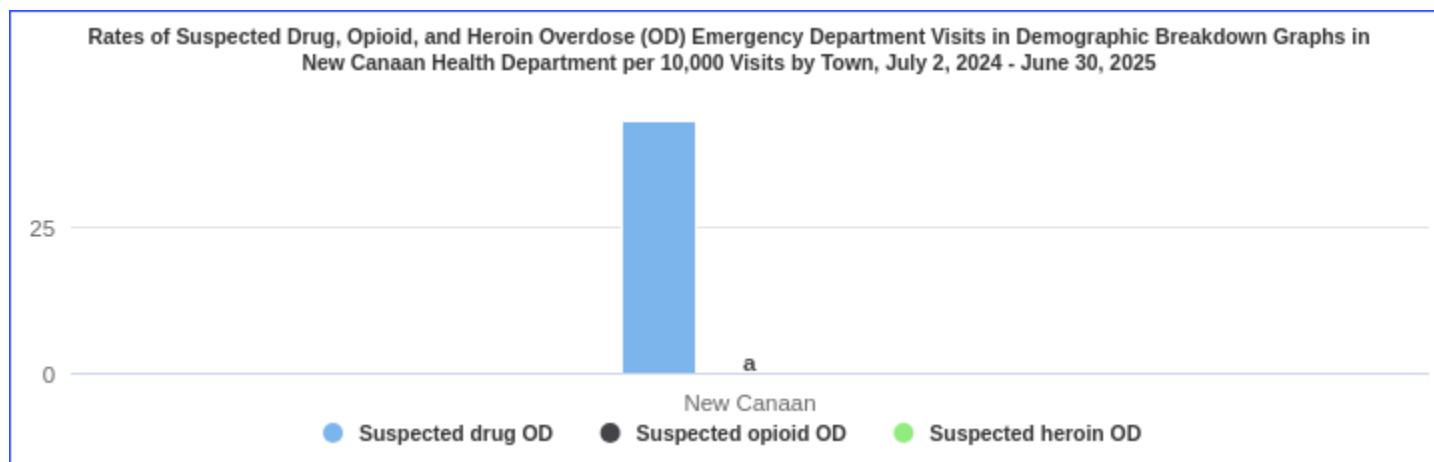

Suspected Drug Overdose in New Canaan Health Department



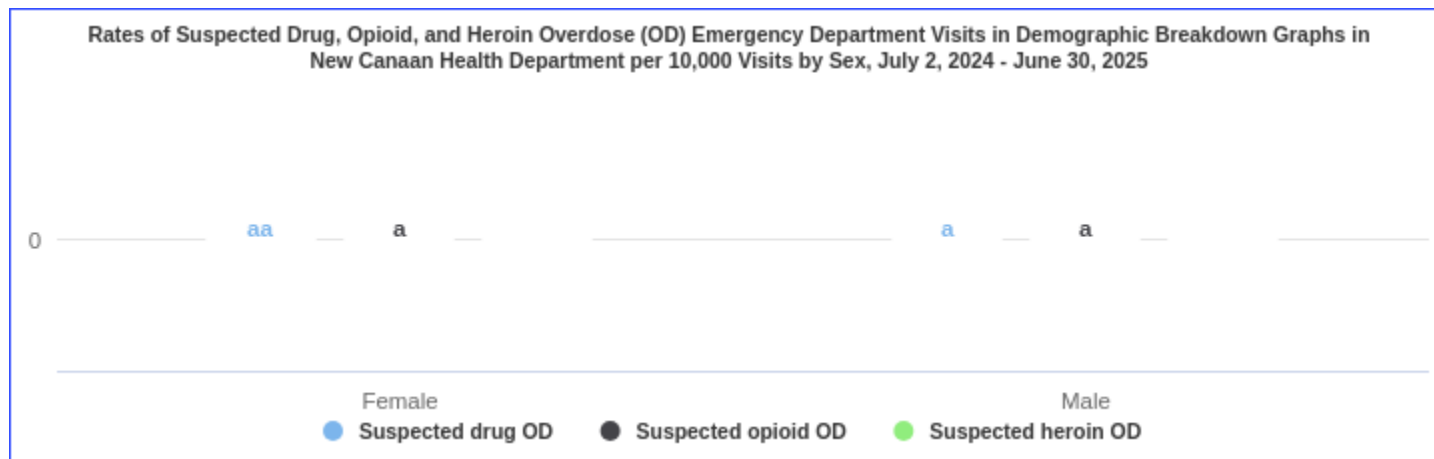

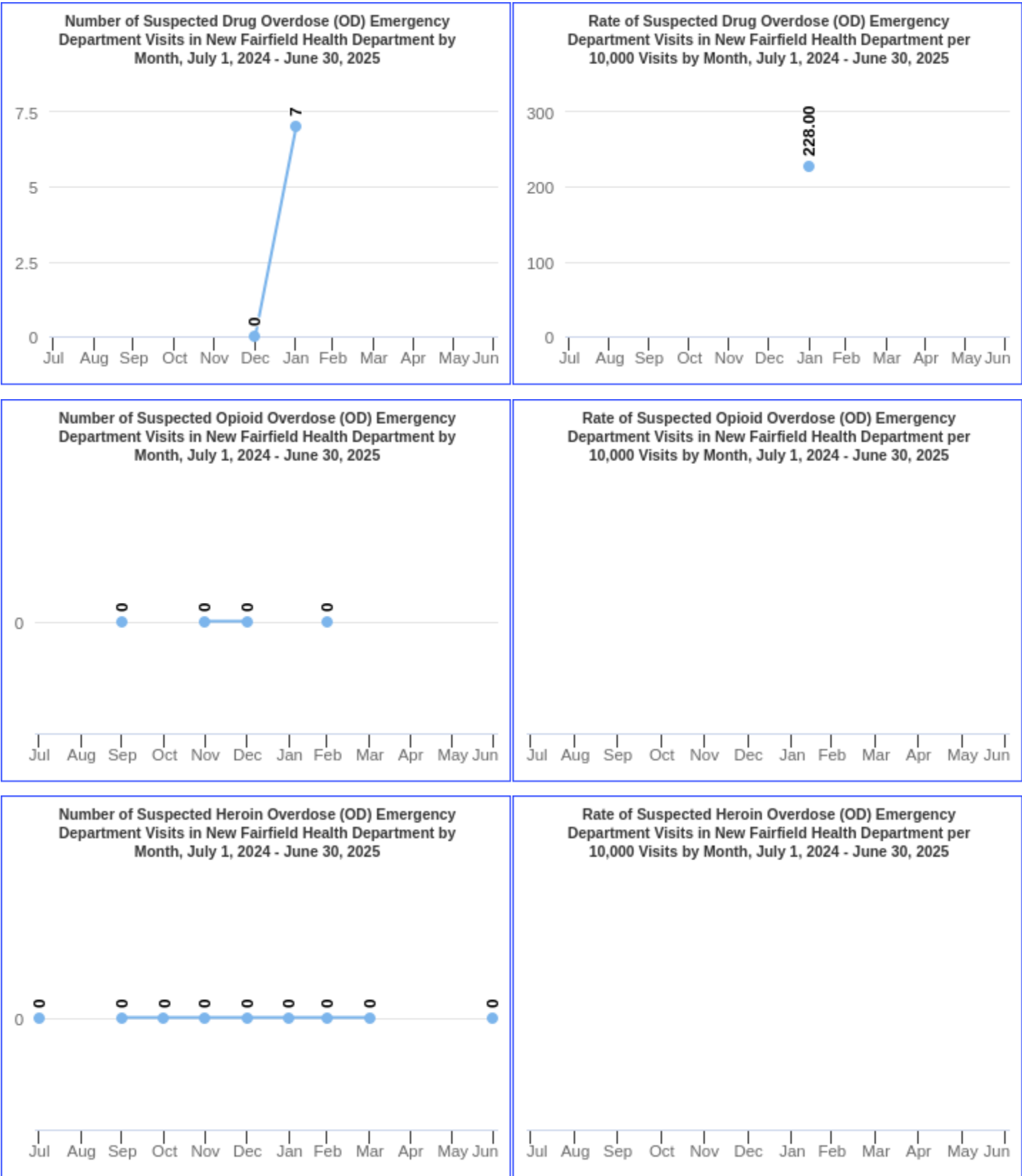

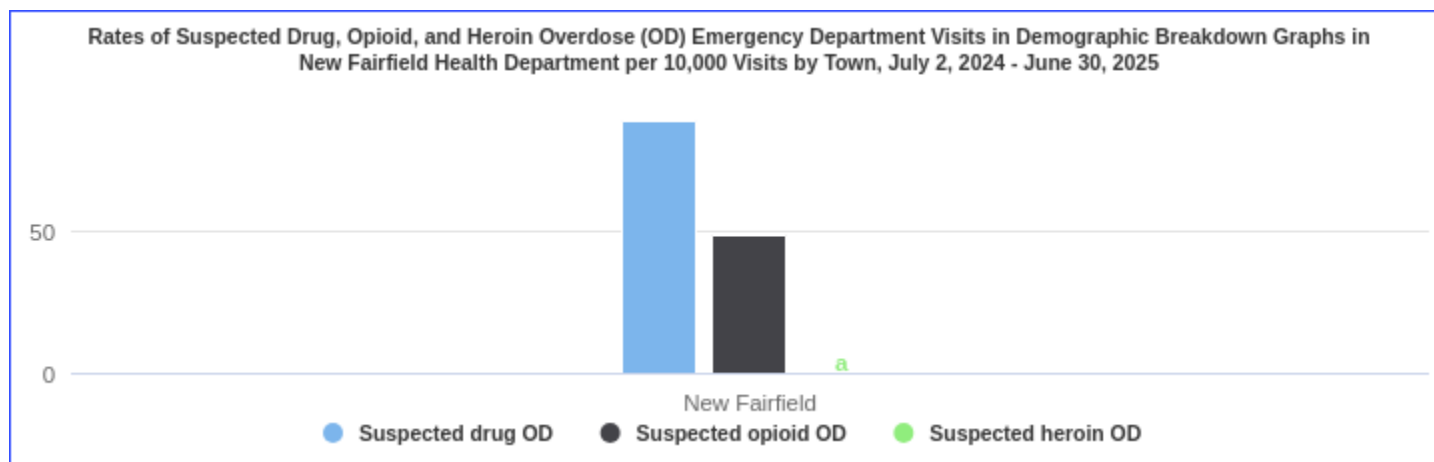

Suspected Drug Overdose in New Fairfield Health Department



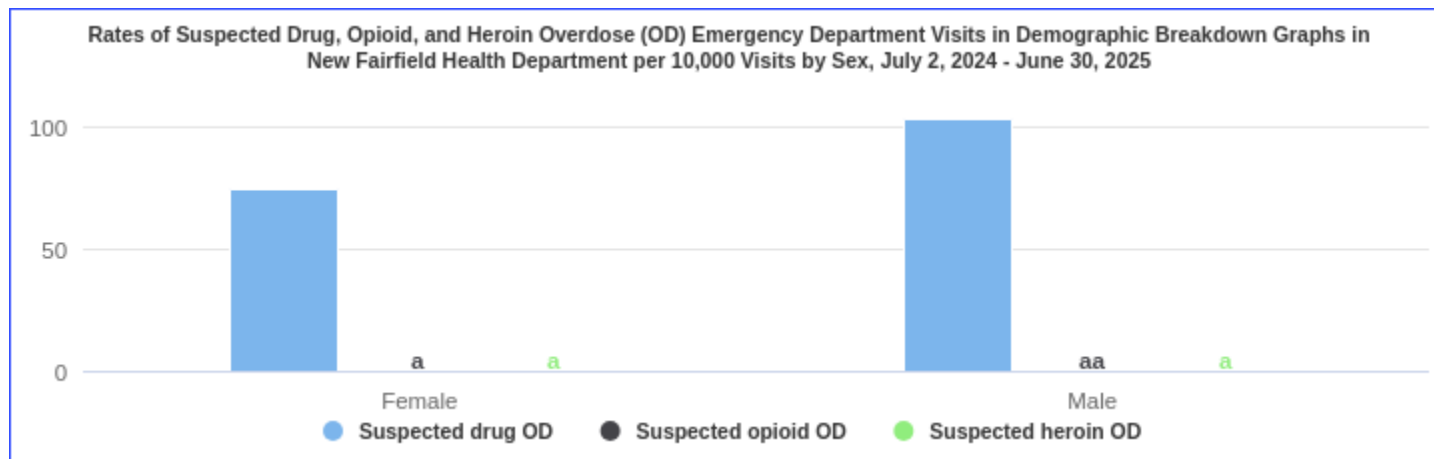

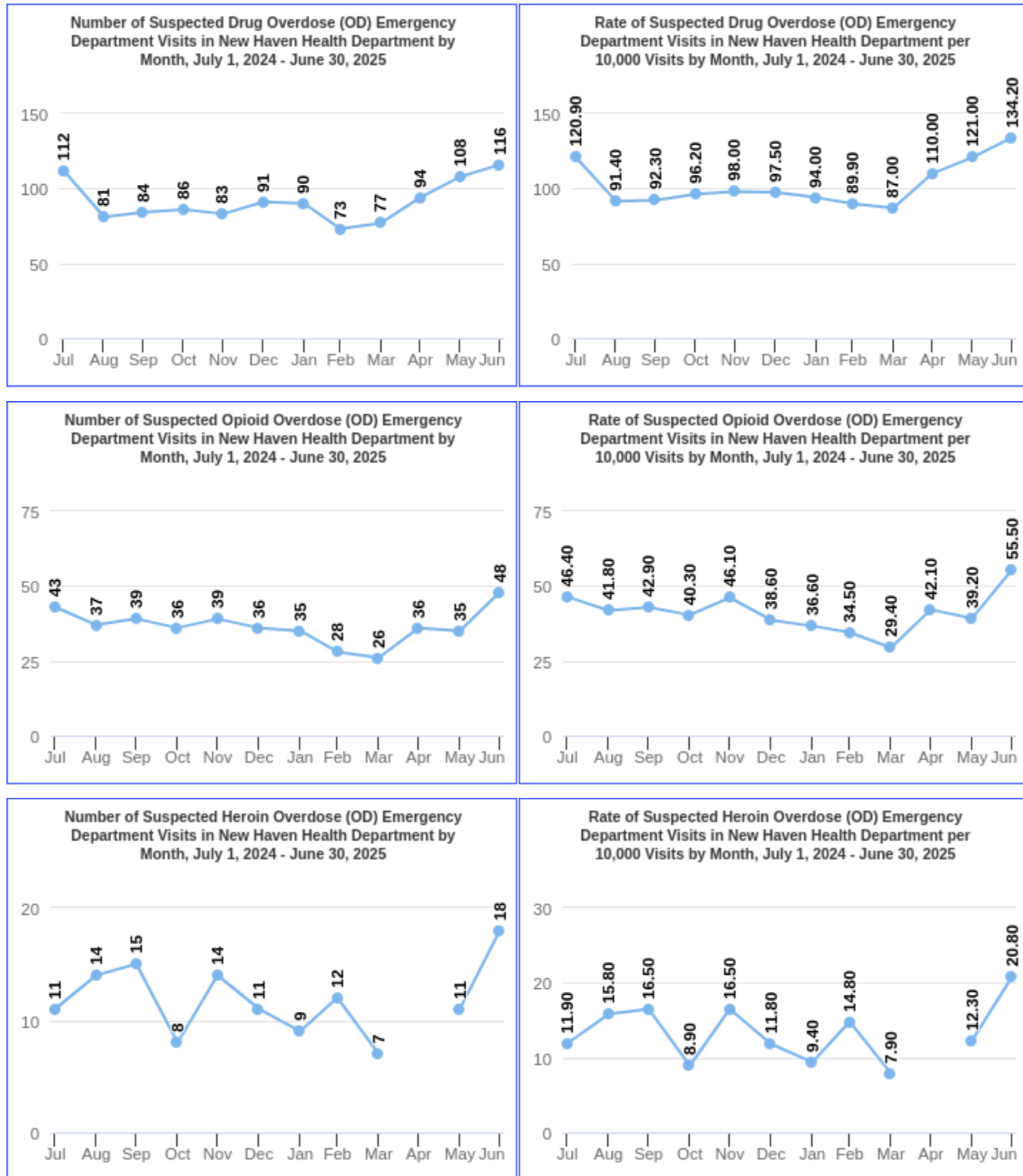

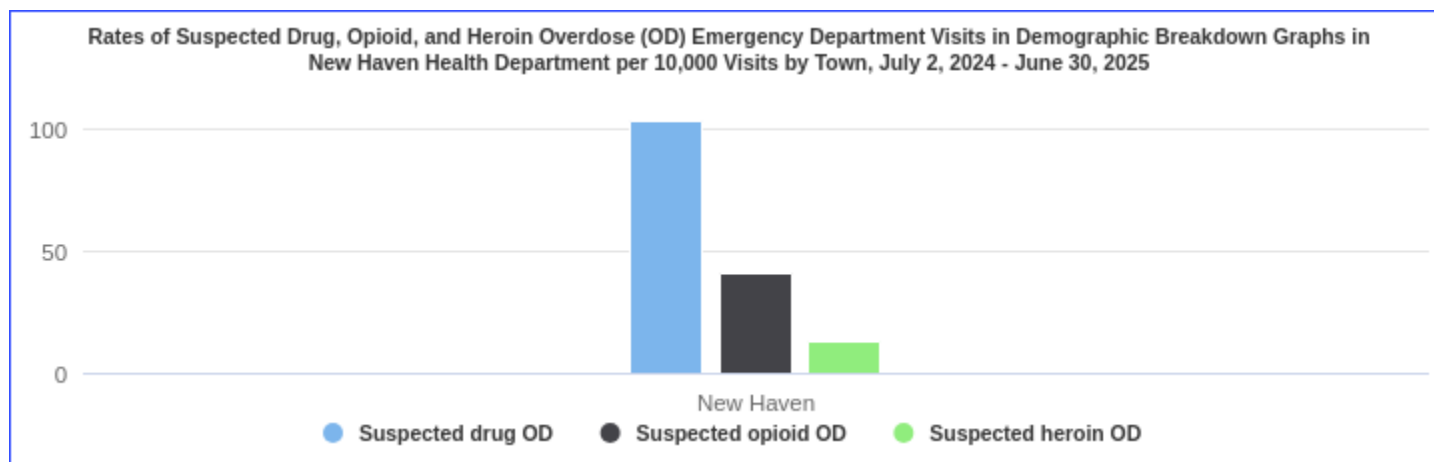

Suspected Drug Overdose in New Haven Health Department



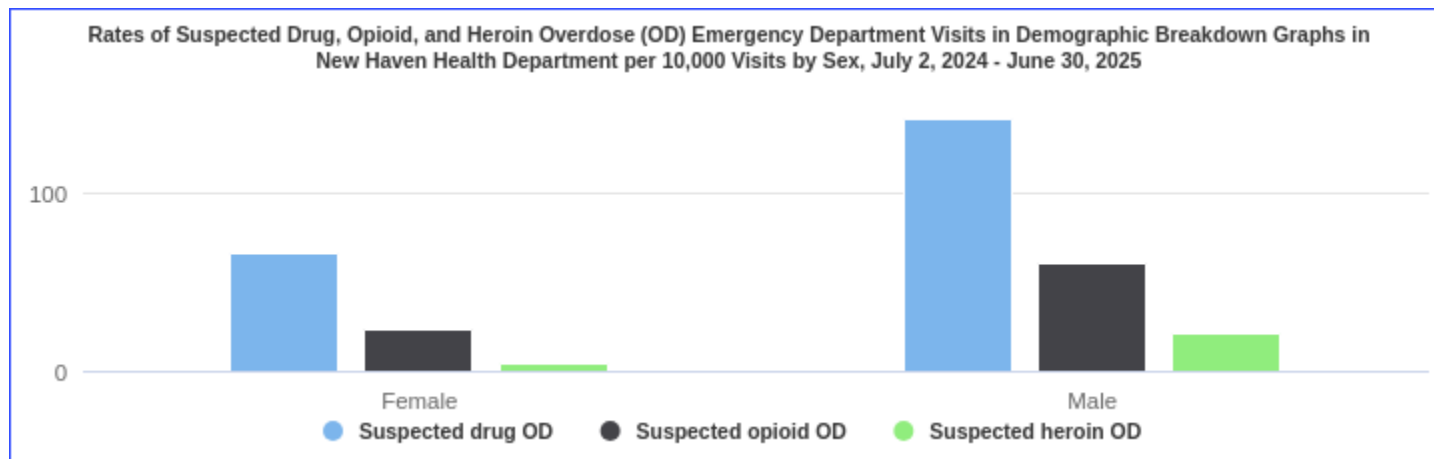

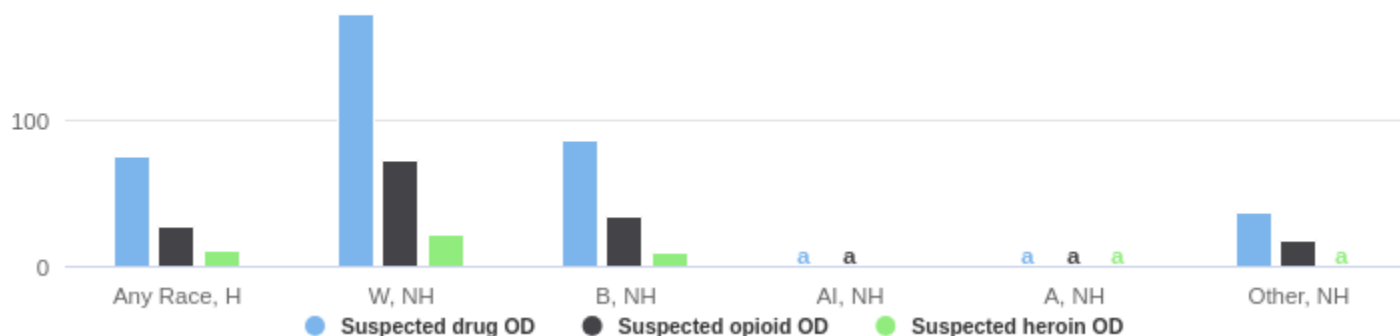

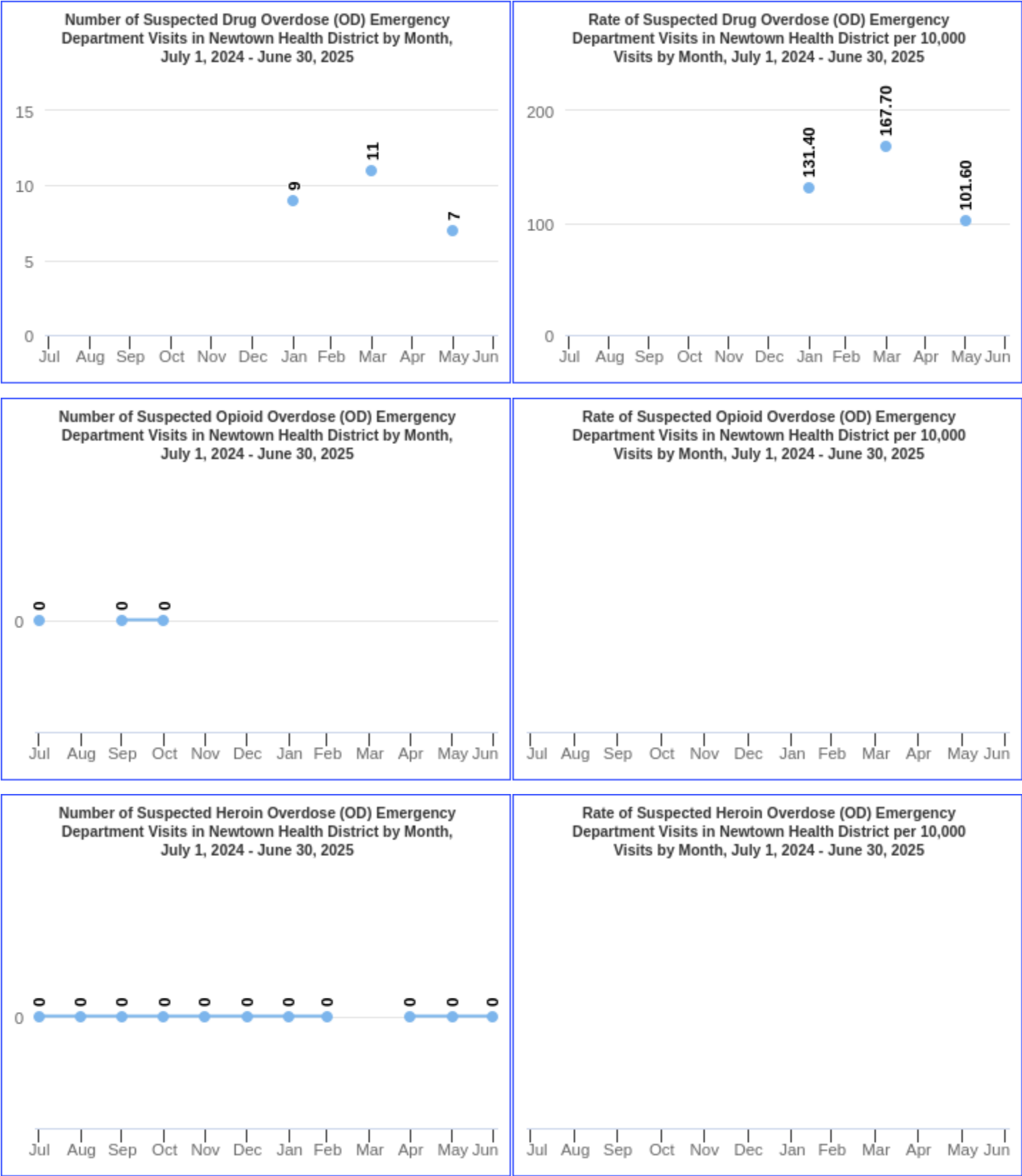

Suspected Drug Overdose in Newtown Health District



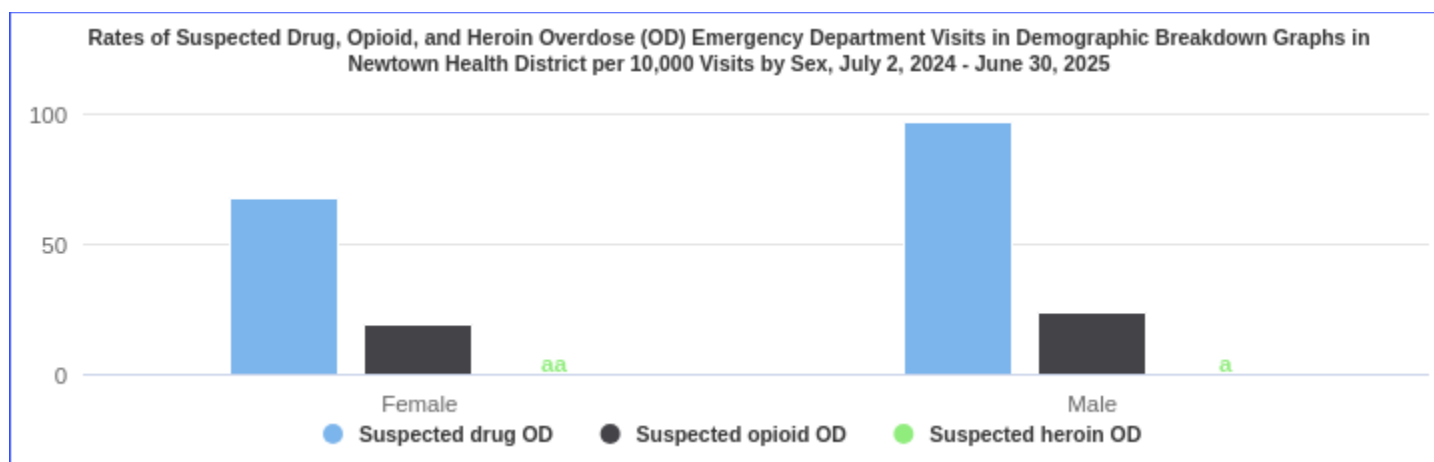

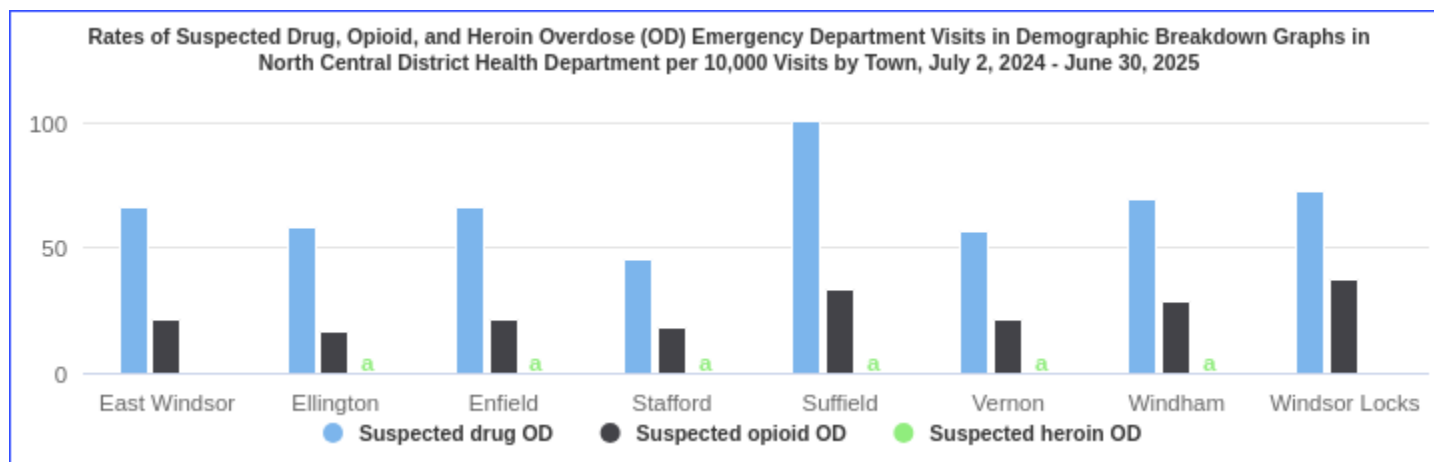

Suspected Drug Overdose in North Central District Health Department



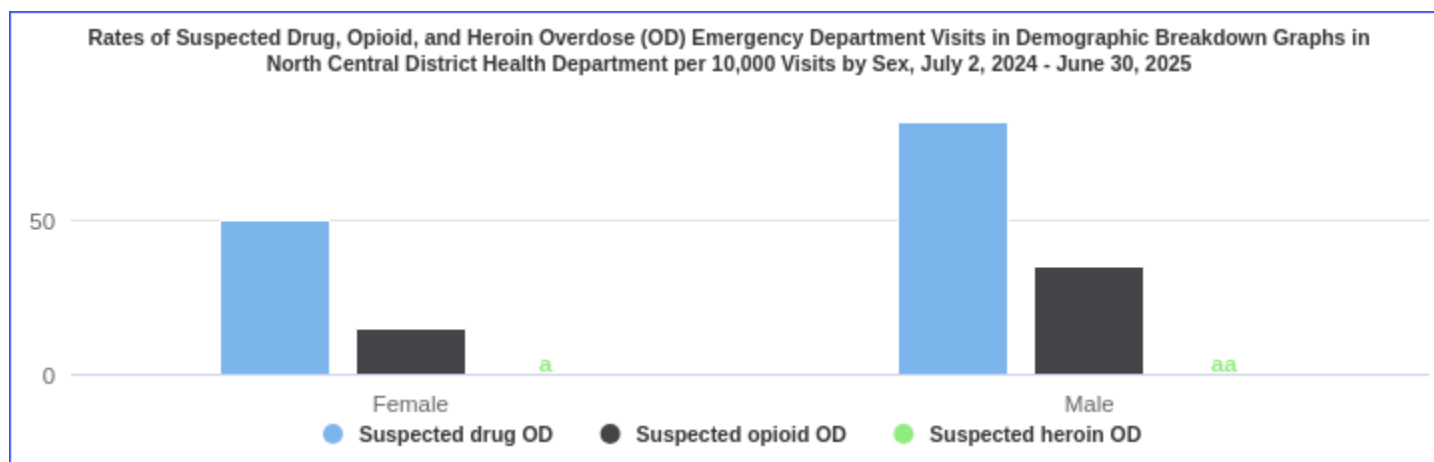

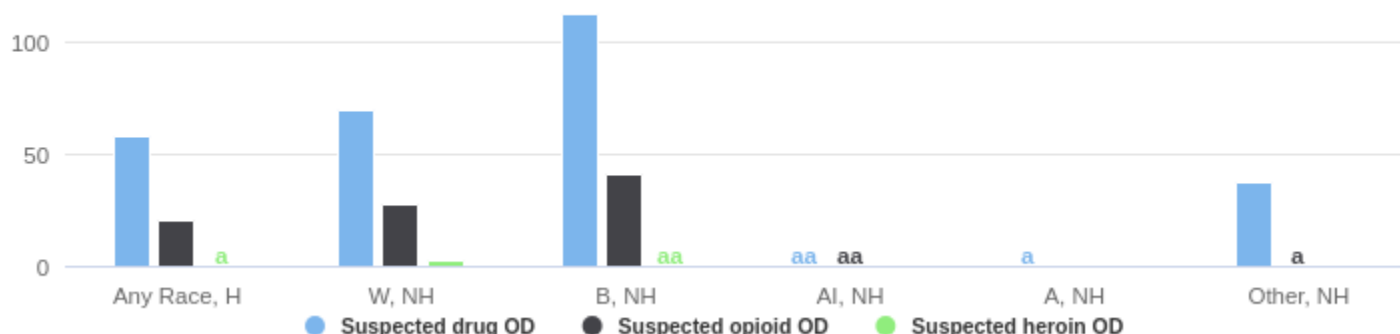

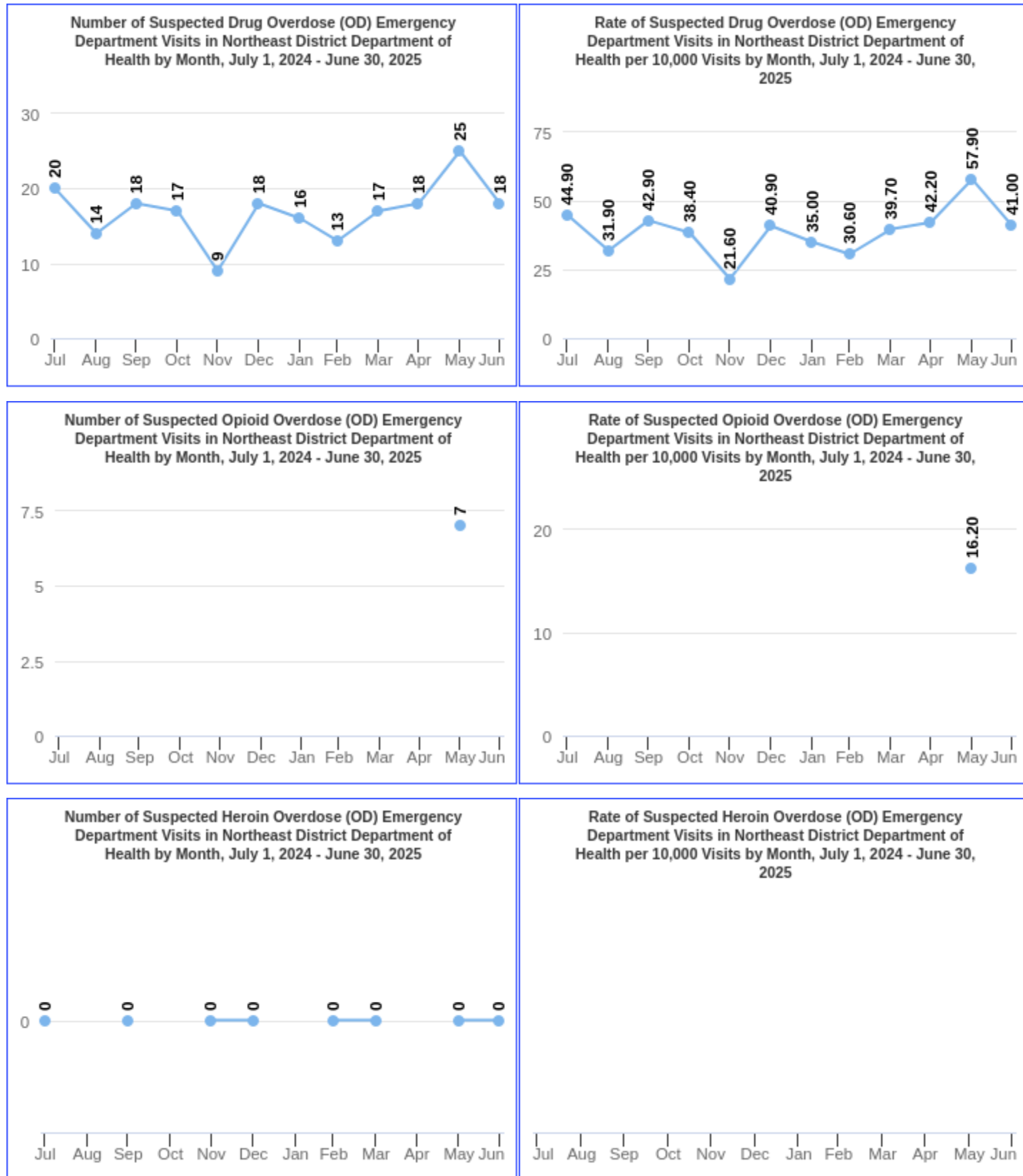

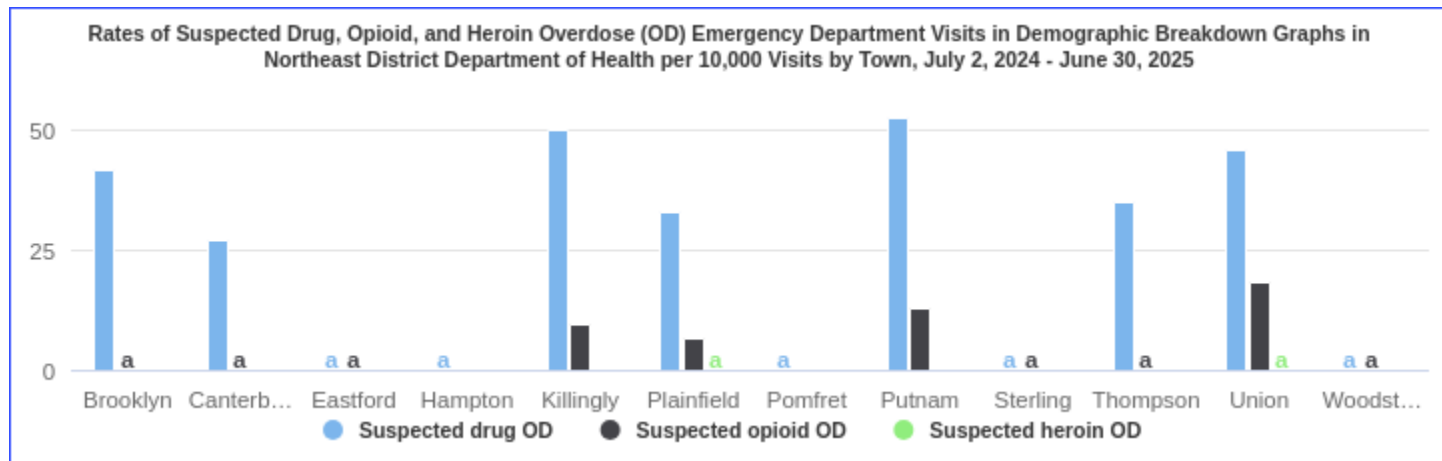

Suspected Drug Overdose in Northeast District Department of Health



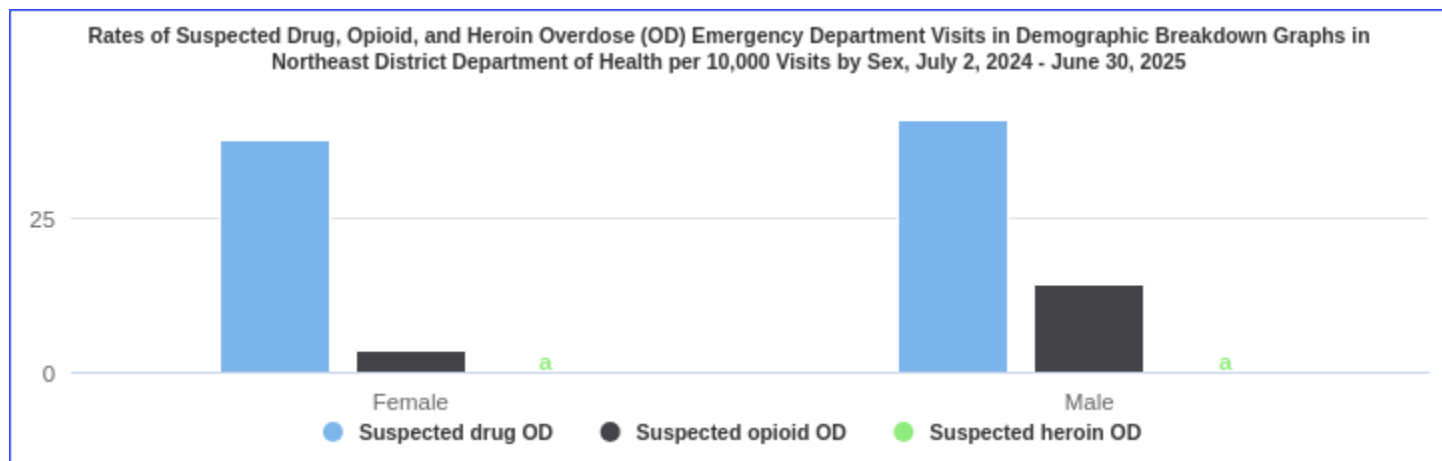

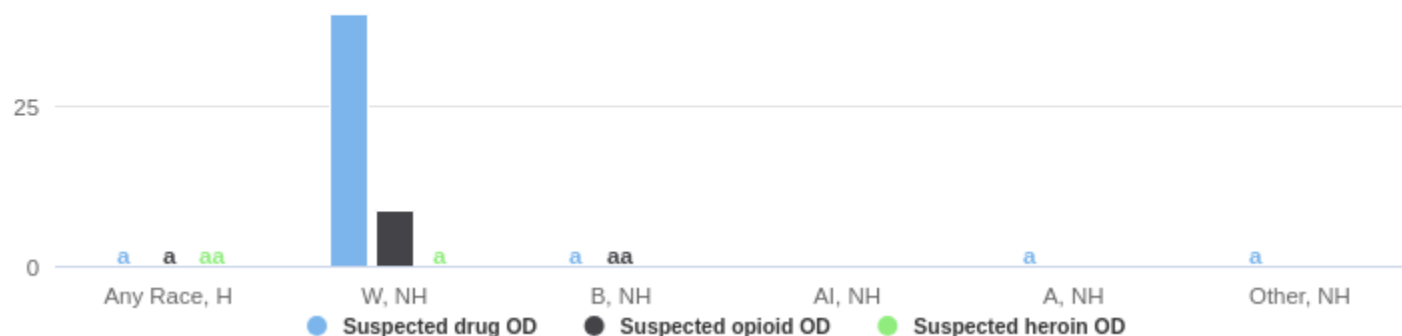

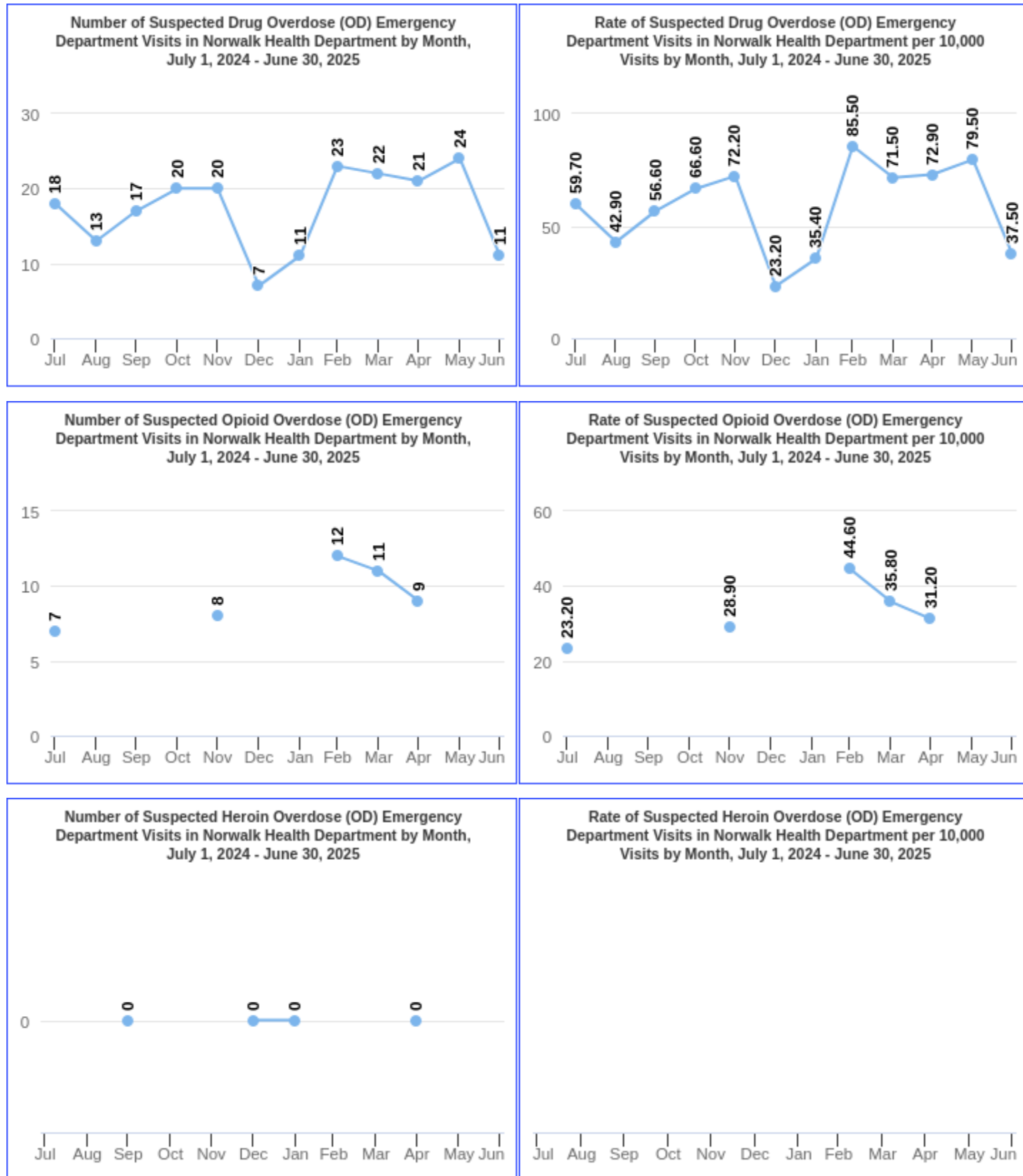

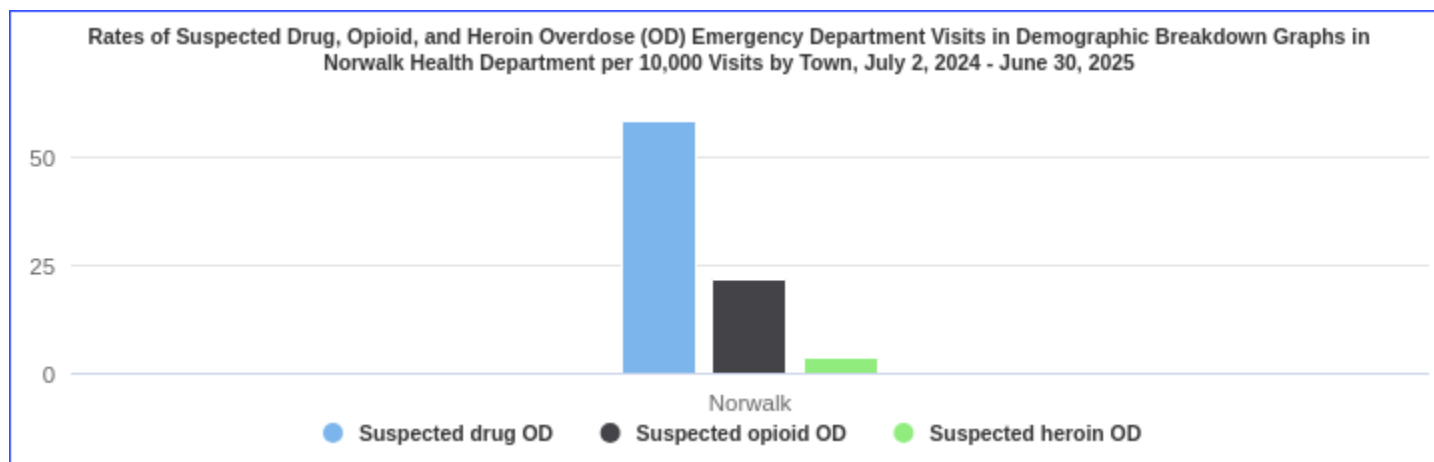

Suspected Drug Overdose in Norwalk Health Department



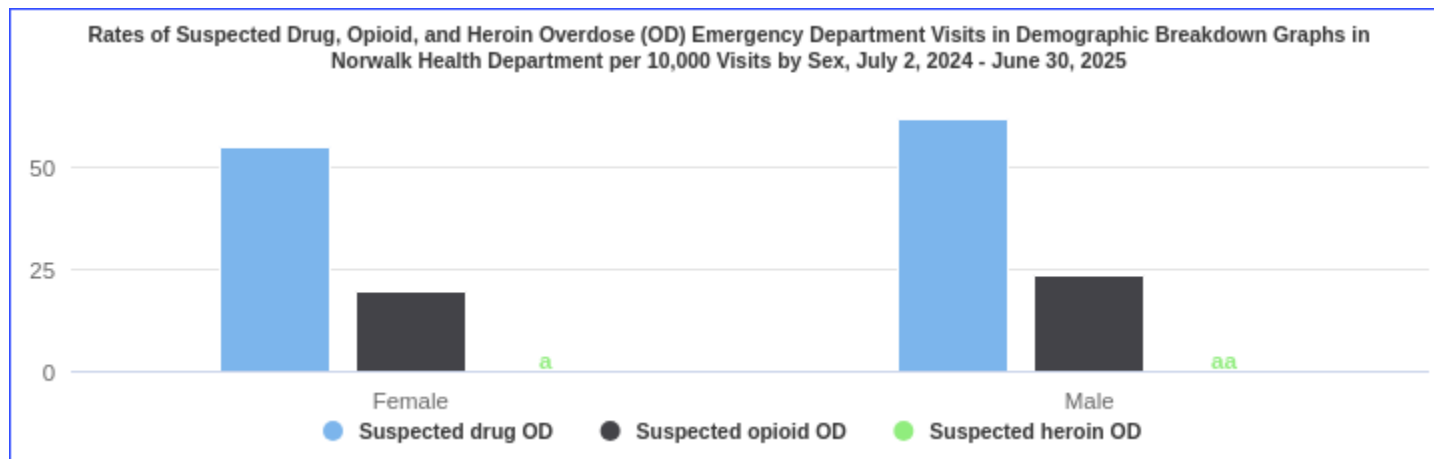

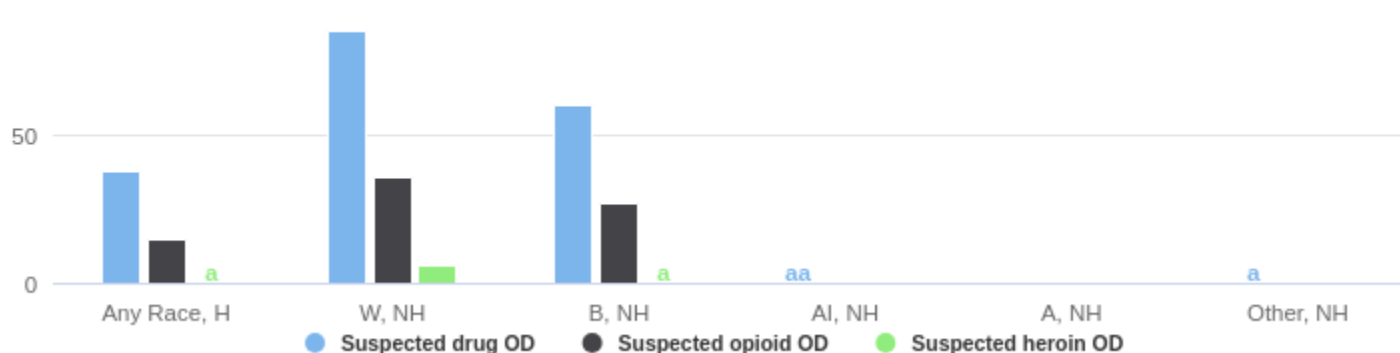

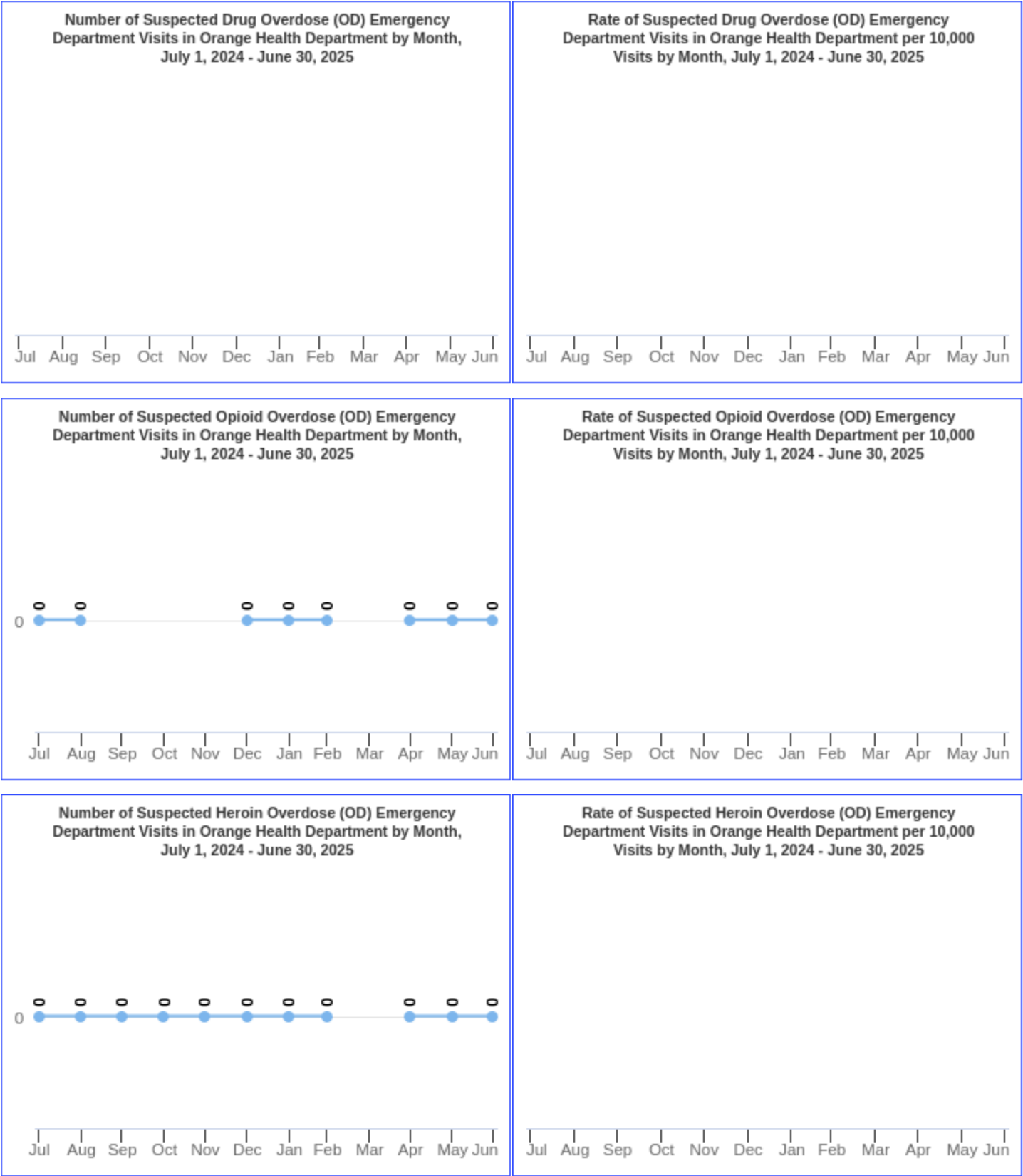

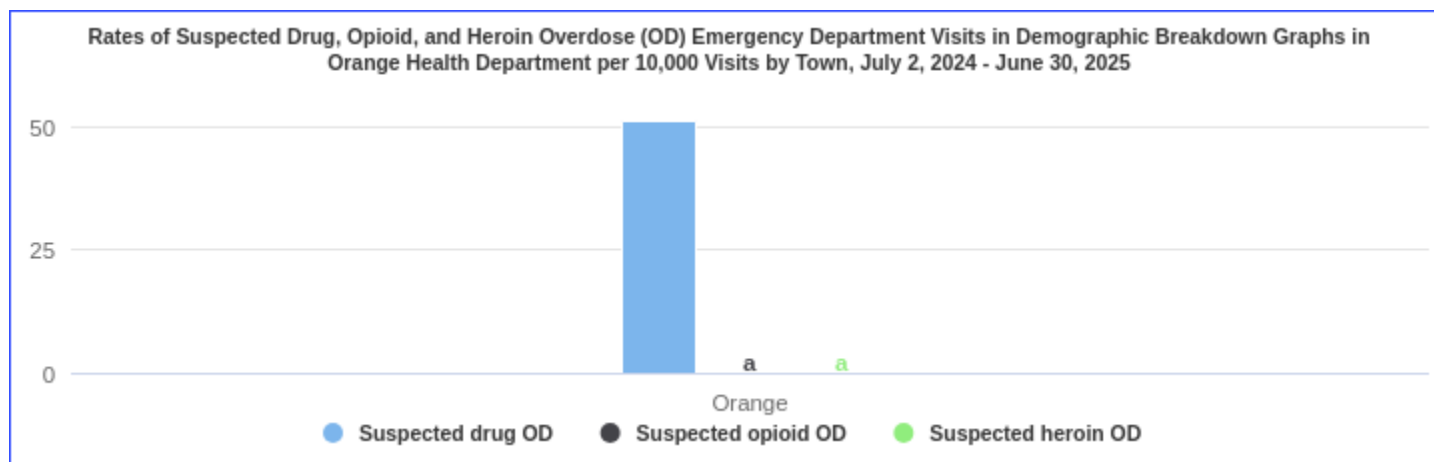

Suspected Drug Overdose in Orange Health Department



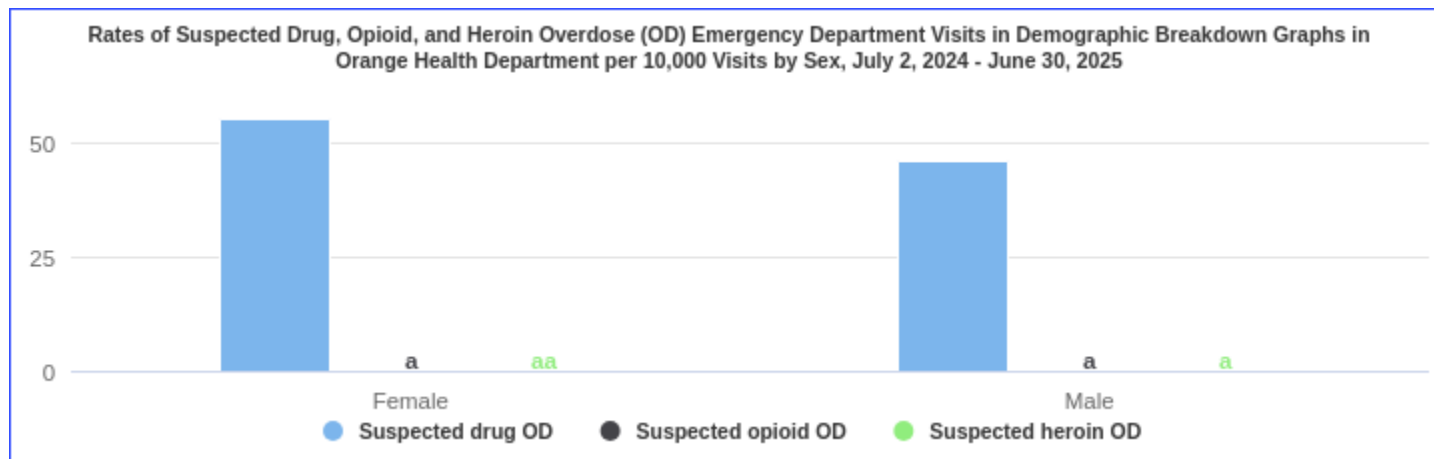

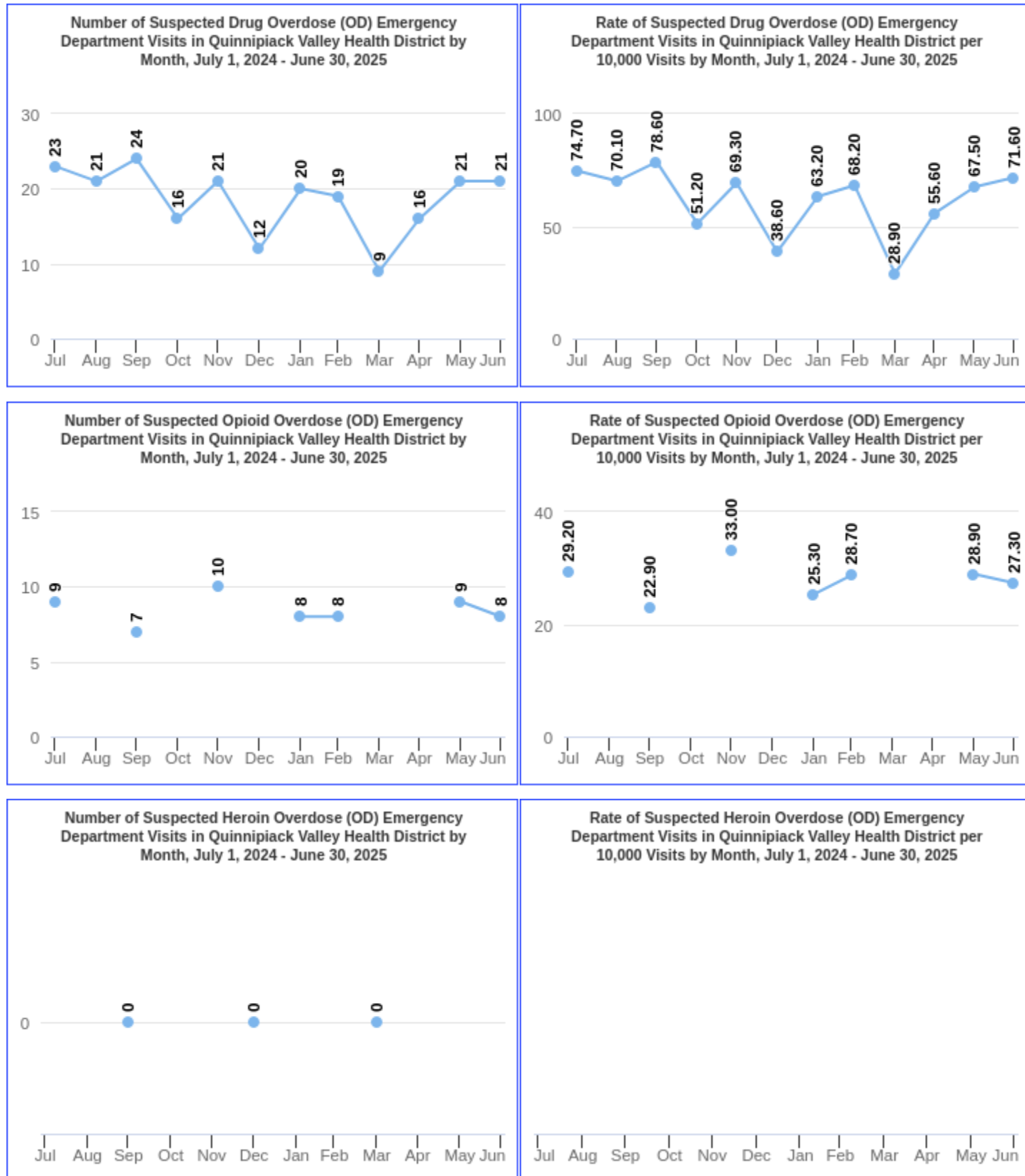

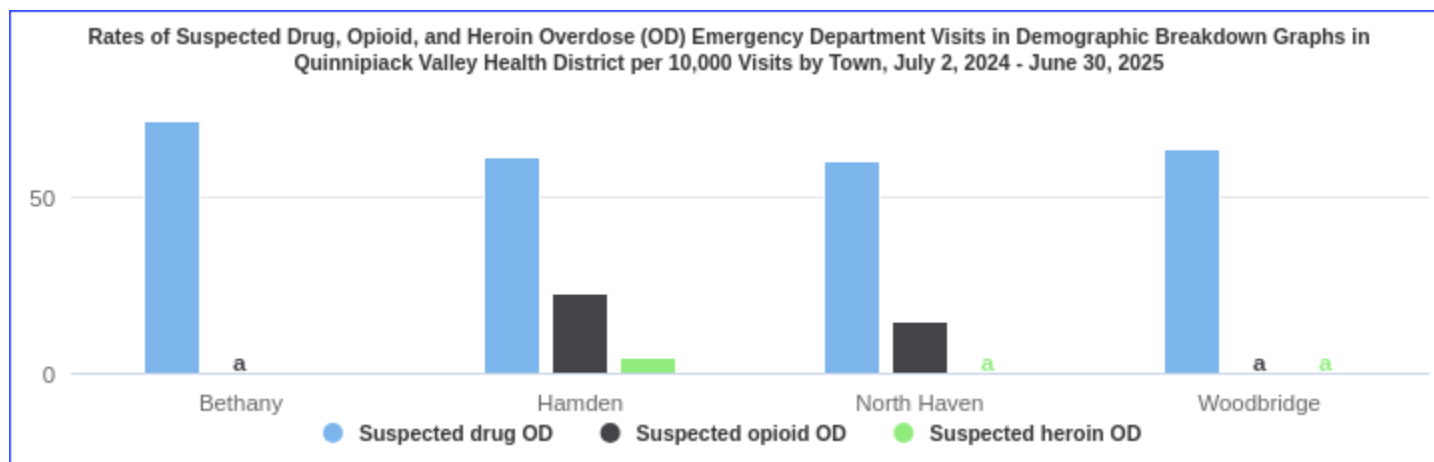

Suspected Drug Overdose in Quinnipiack Valley Health District



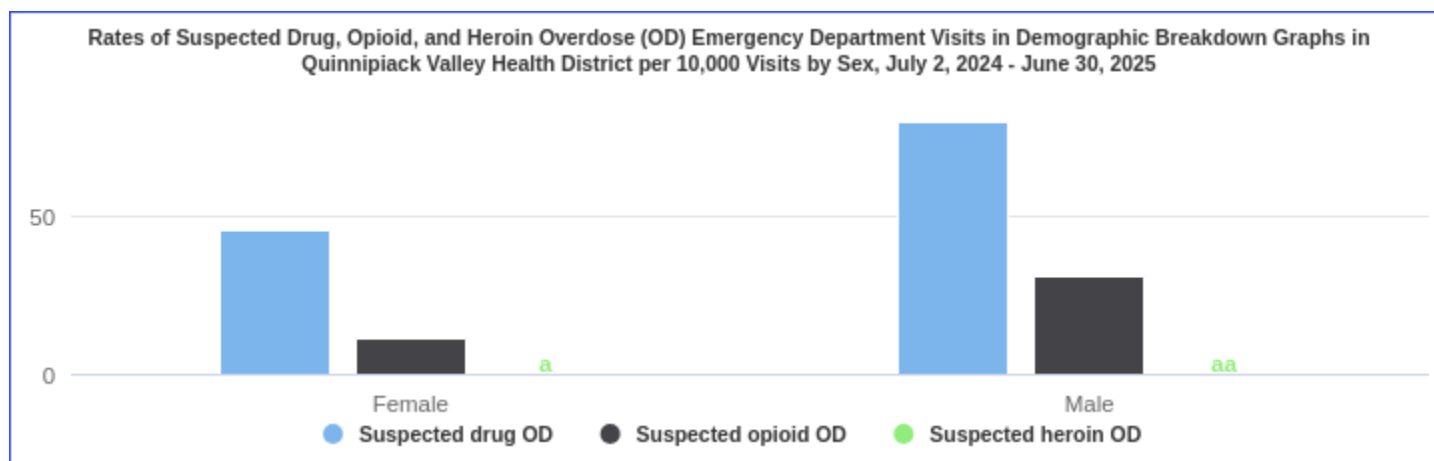

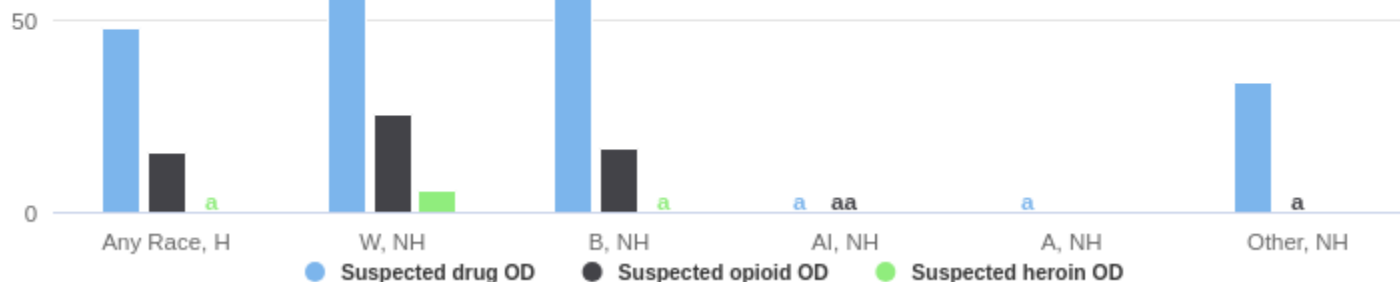

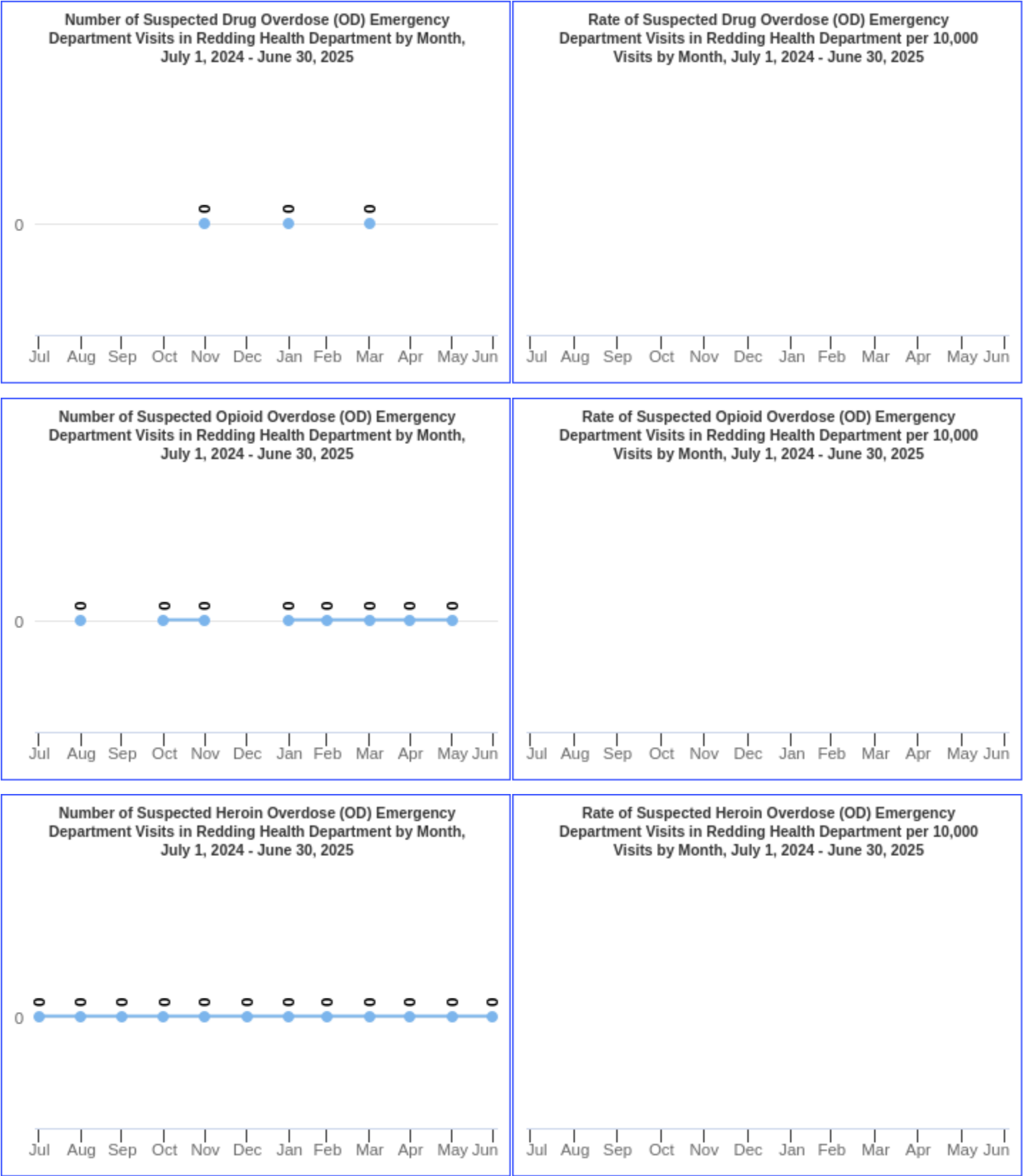

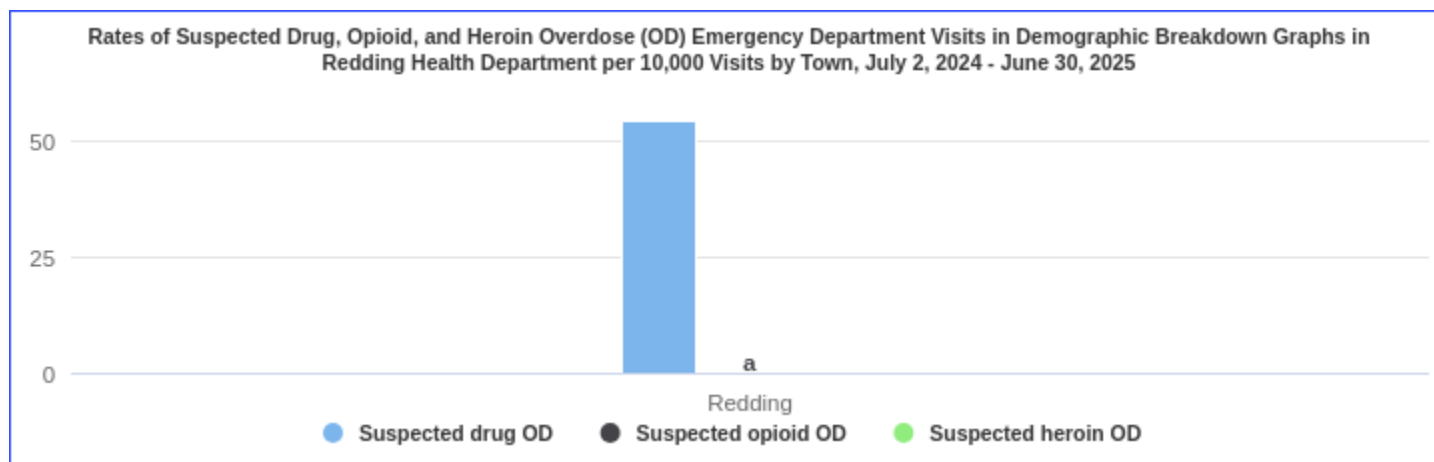

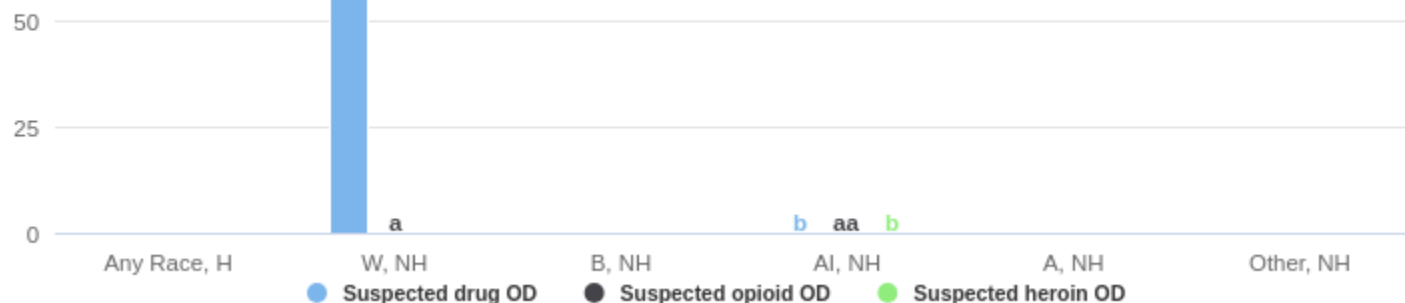

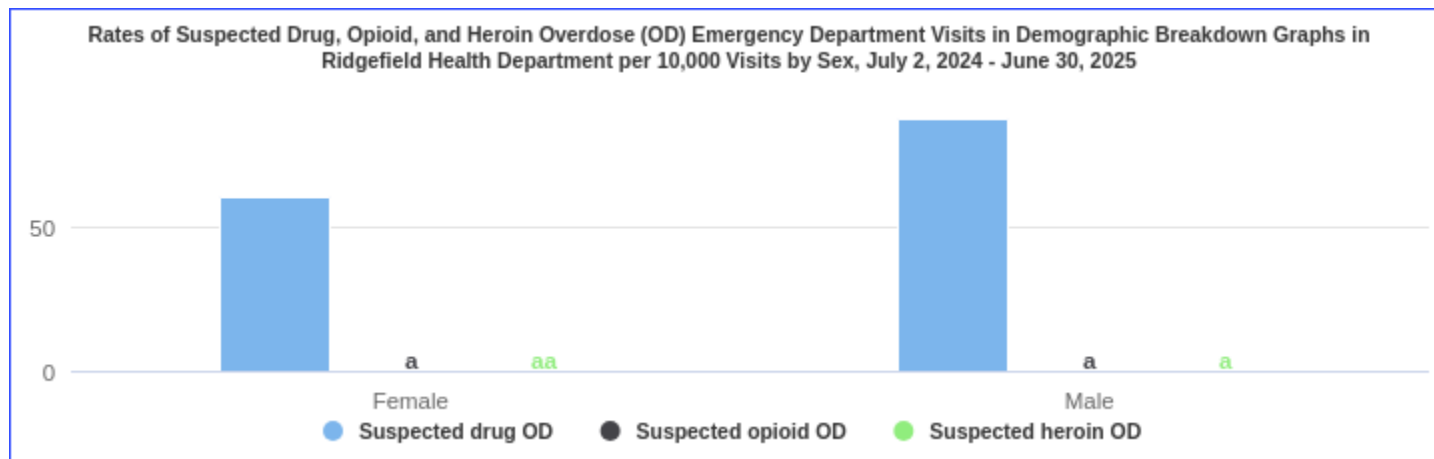

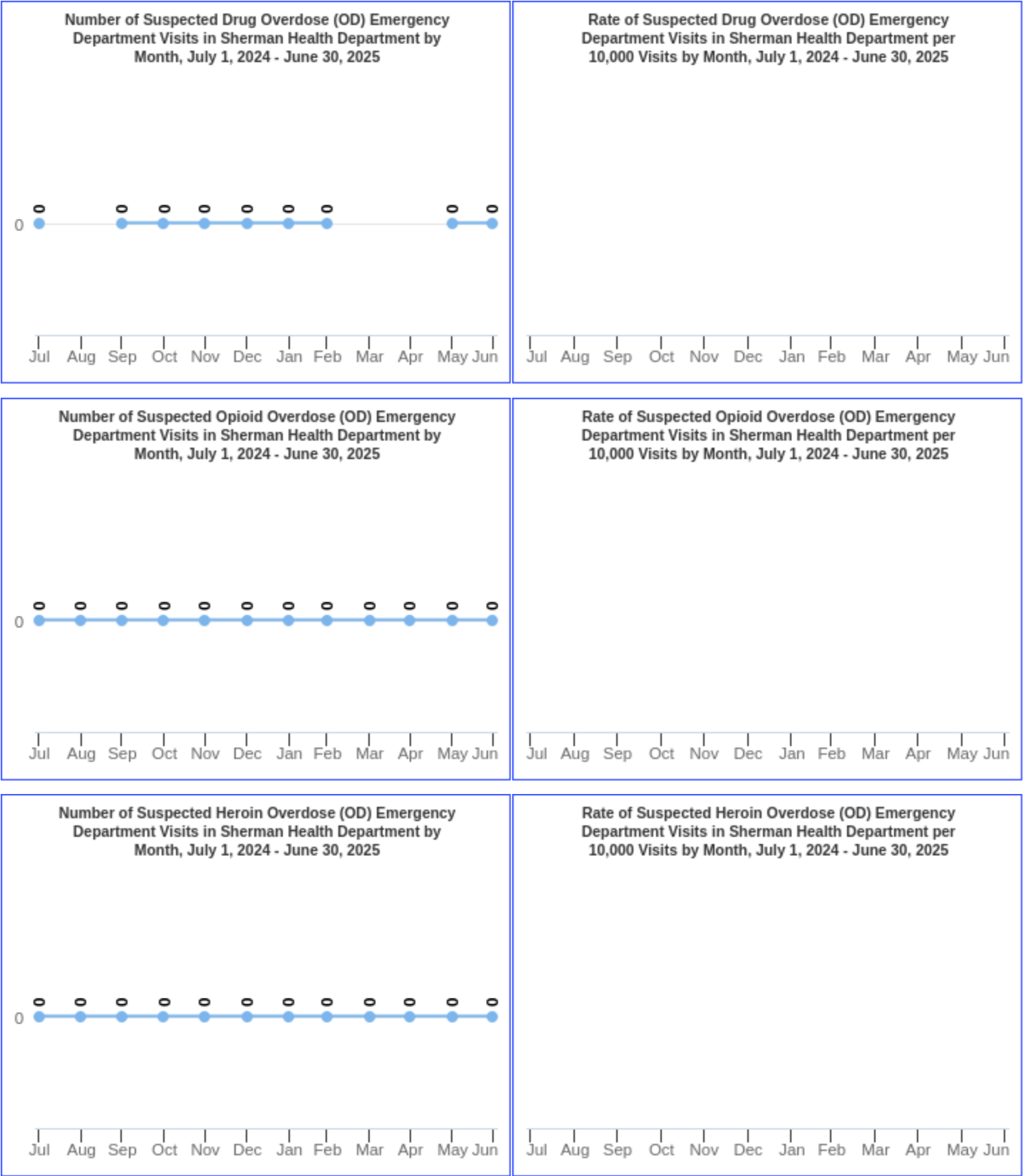

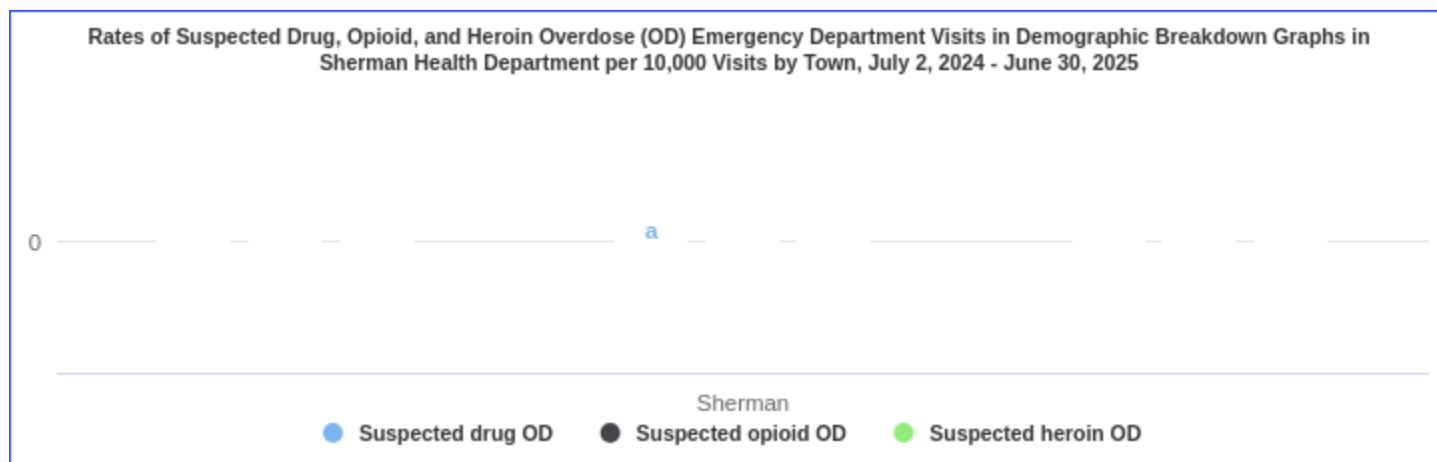

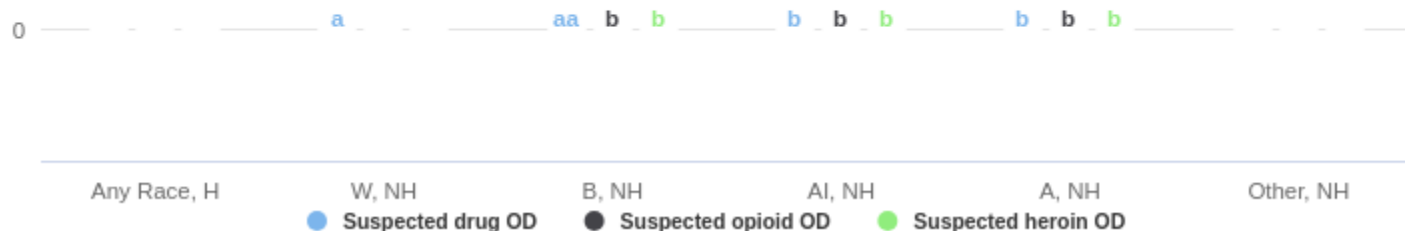

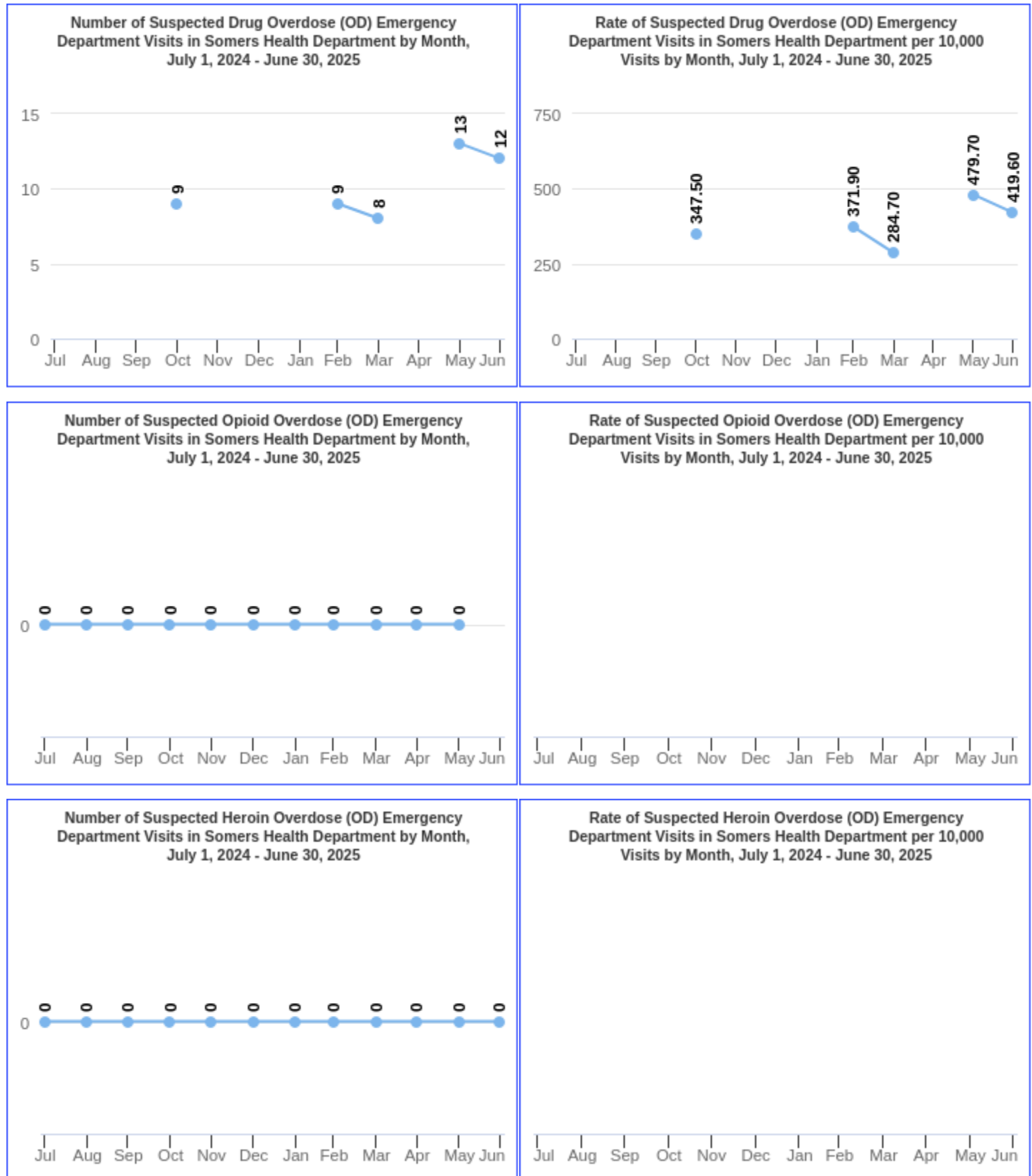

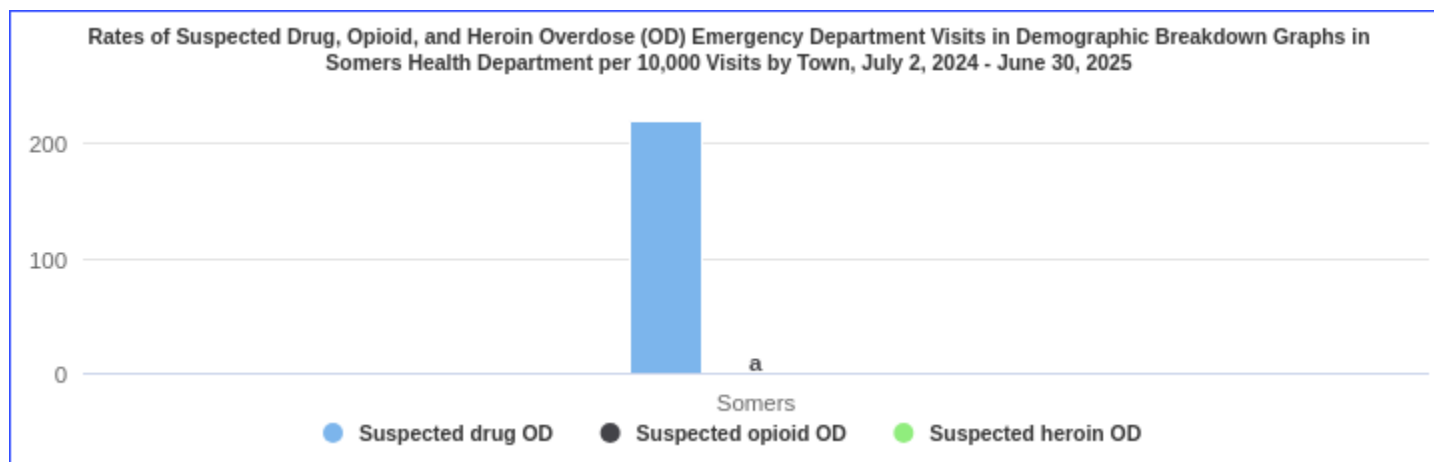

Suspected Drug Overdose in Somers Health Department



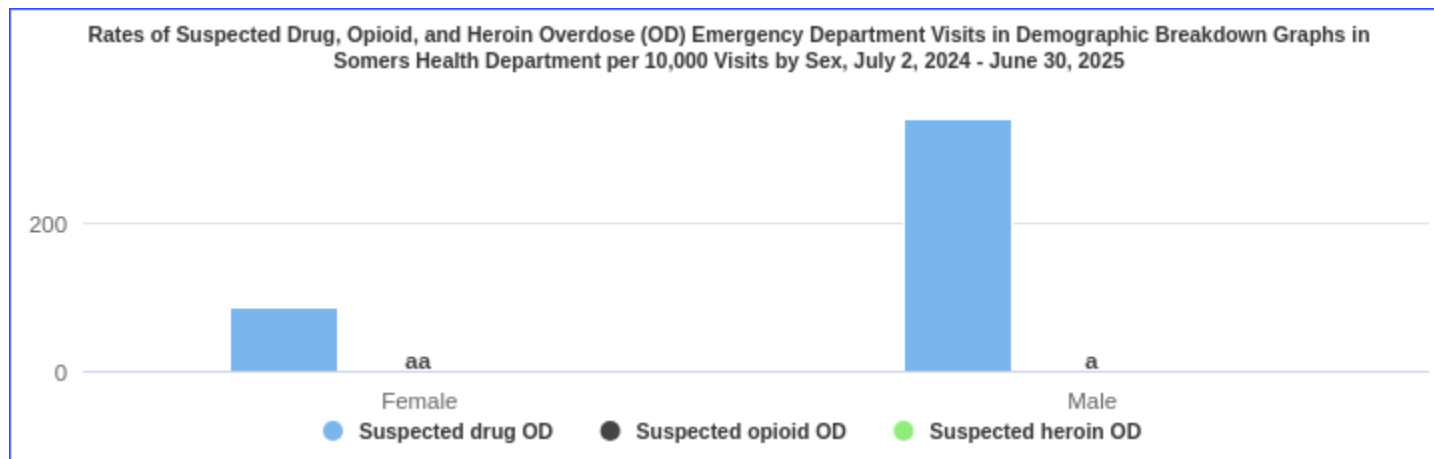

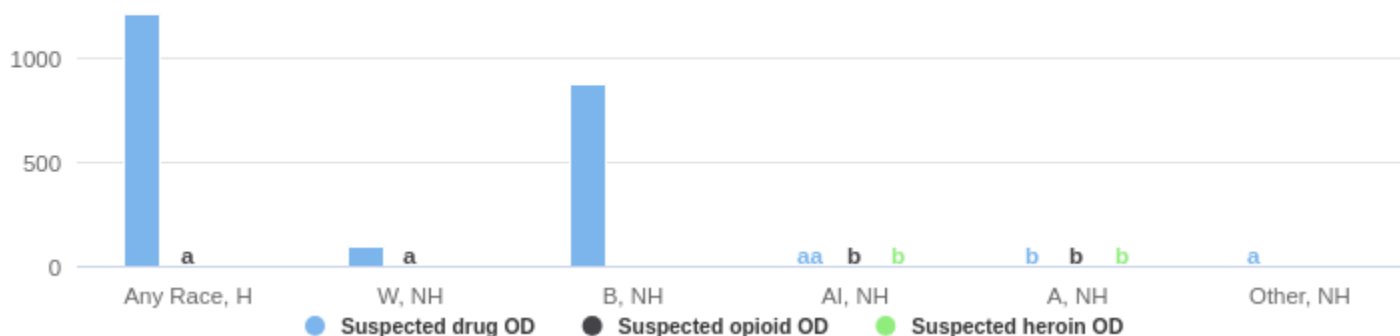

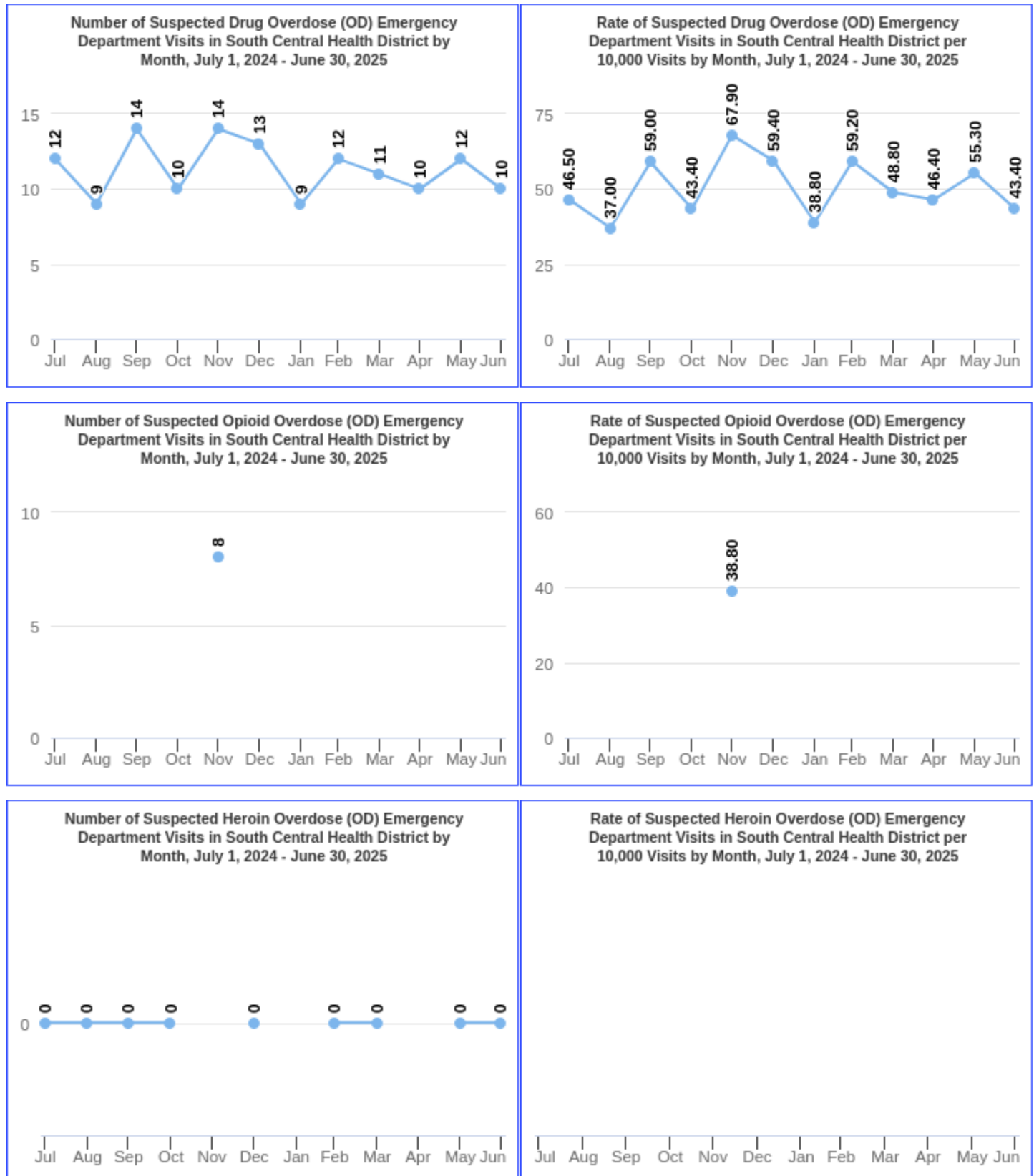

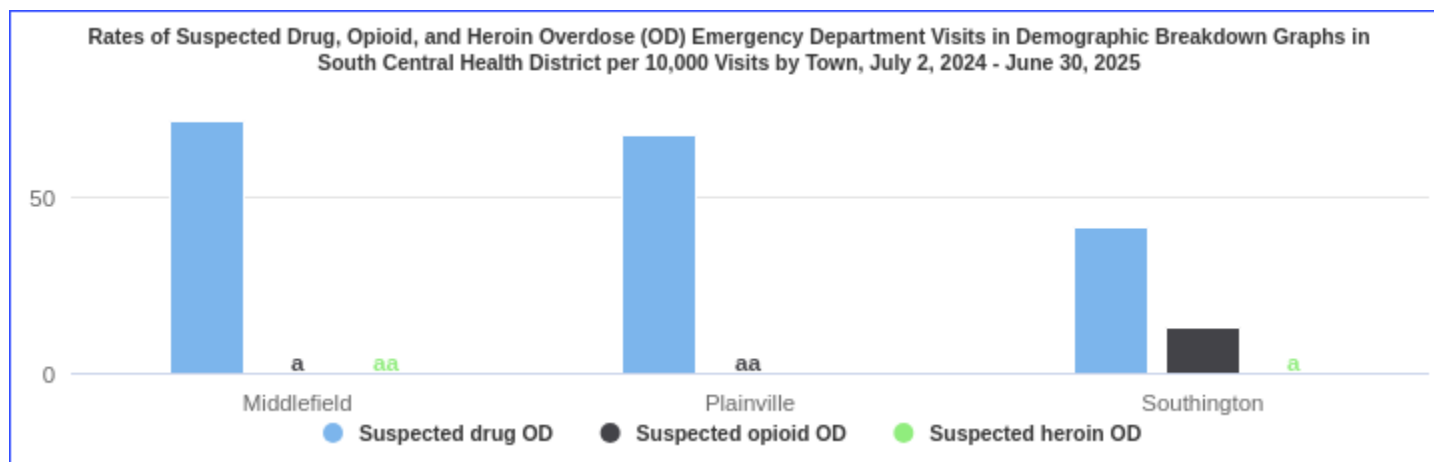

Suspected Drug Overdose in South Central Health District



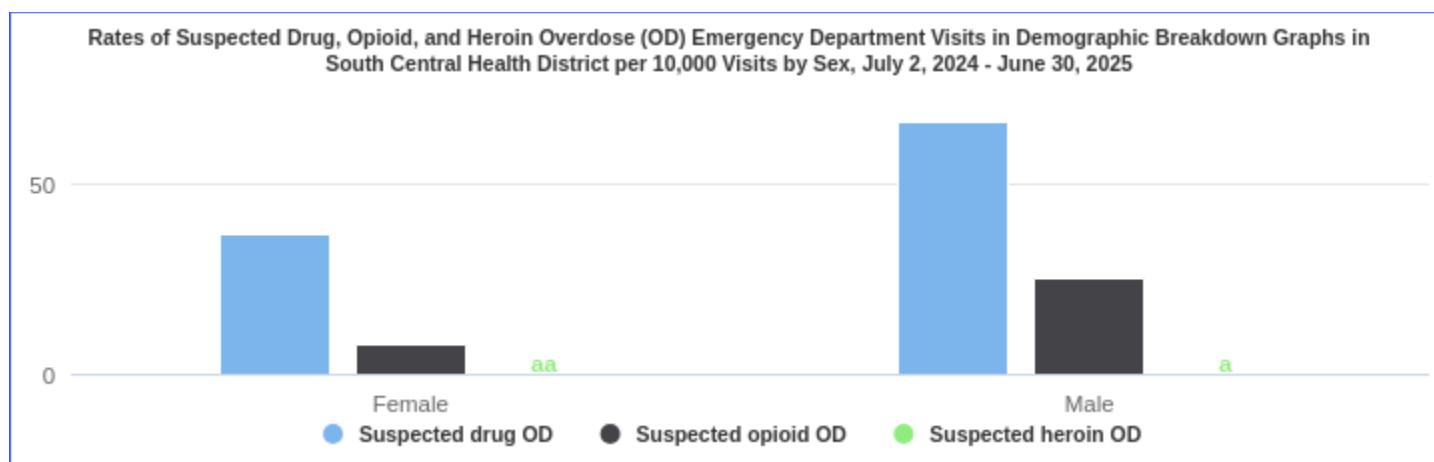

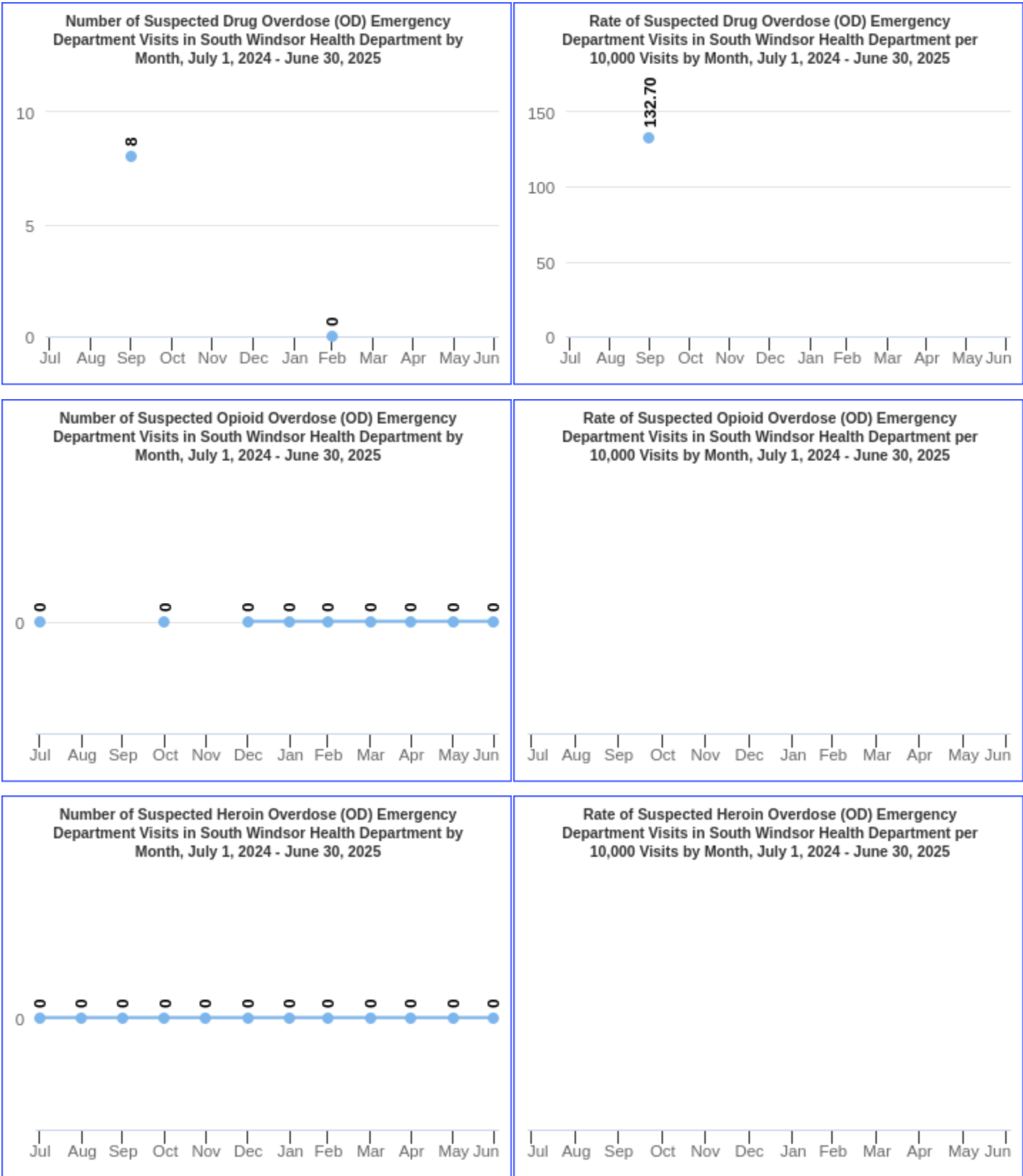

Suspected Drug Overdose in South Windsor Health Department



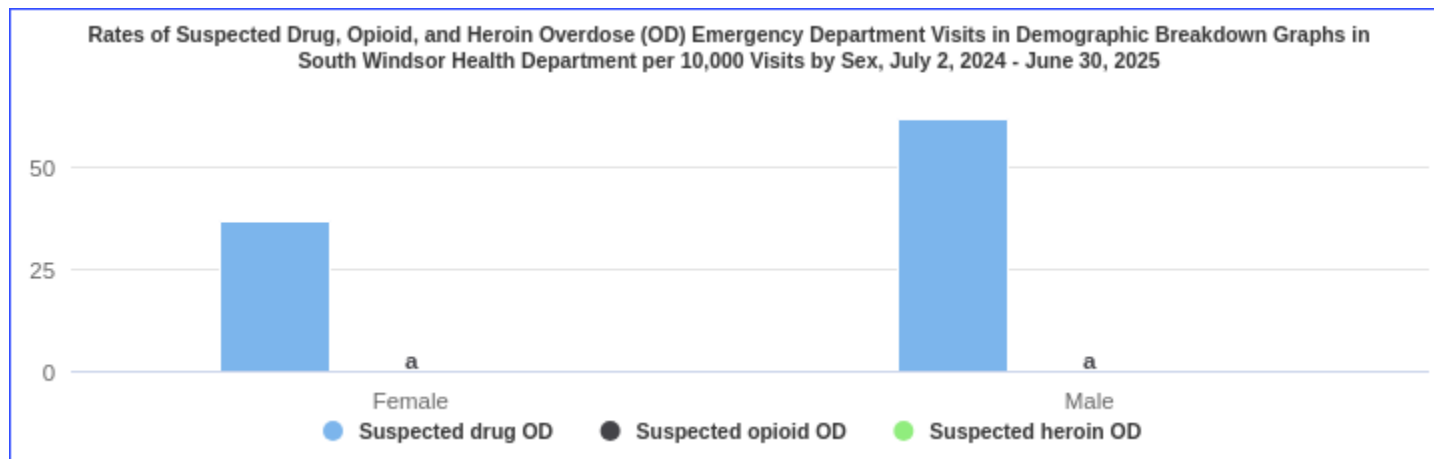

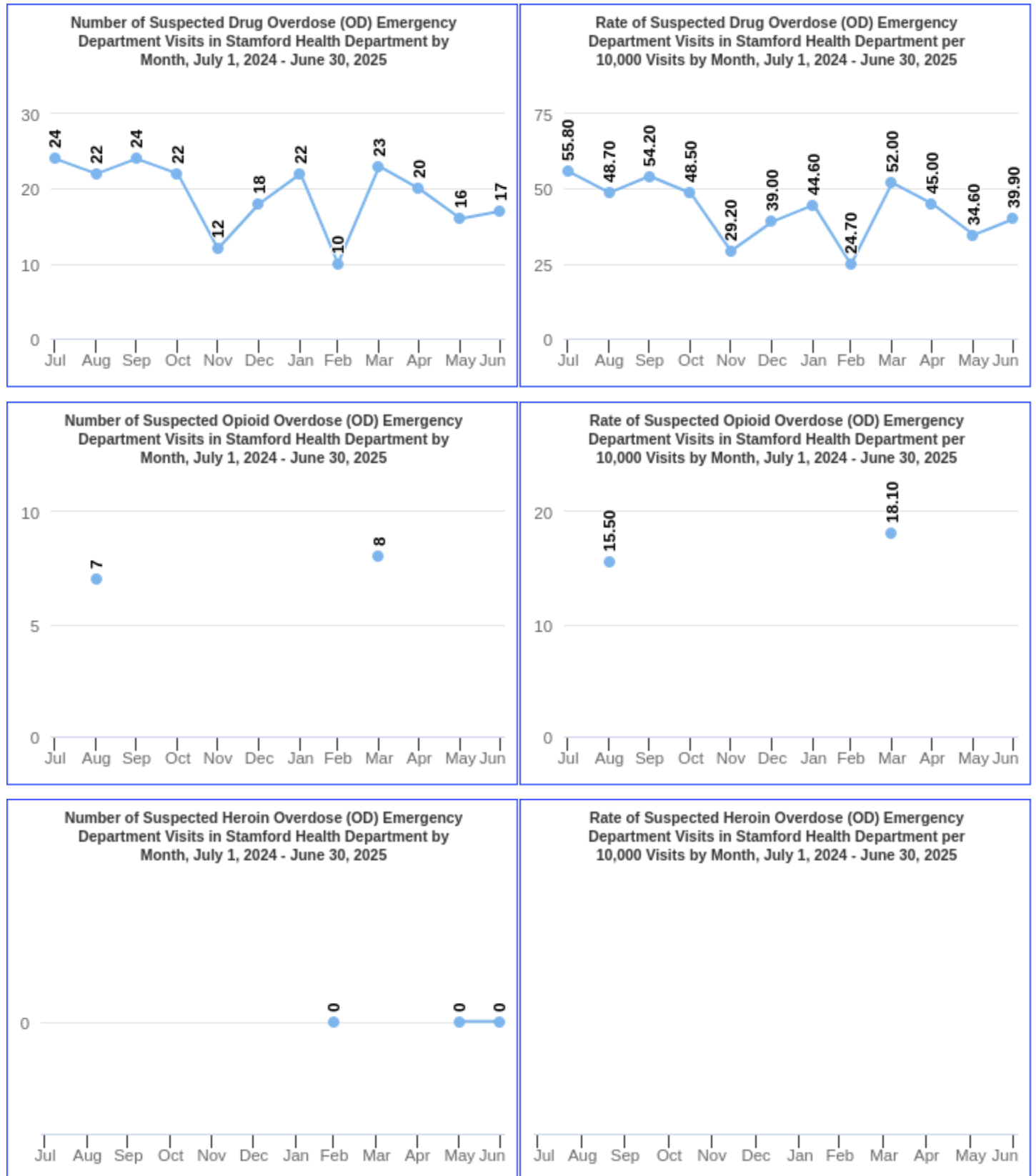

Suspected Drug Overdose in Stamford Health Department



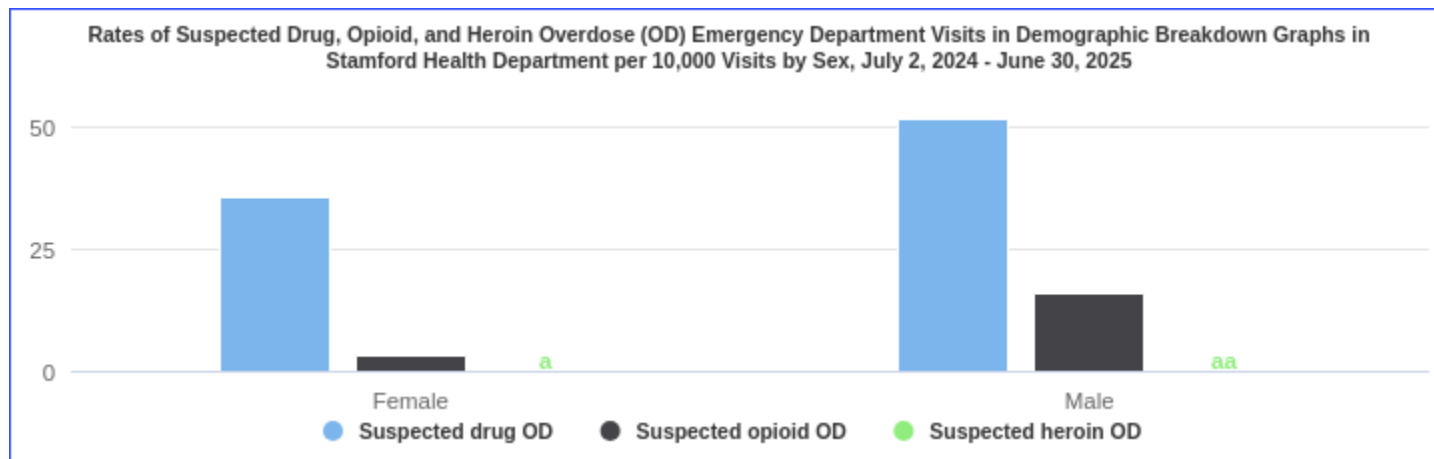

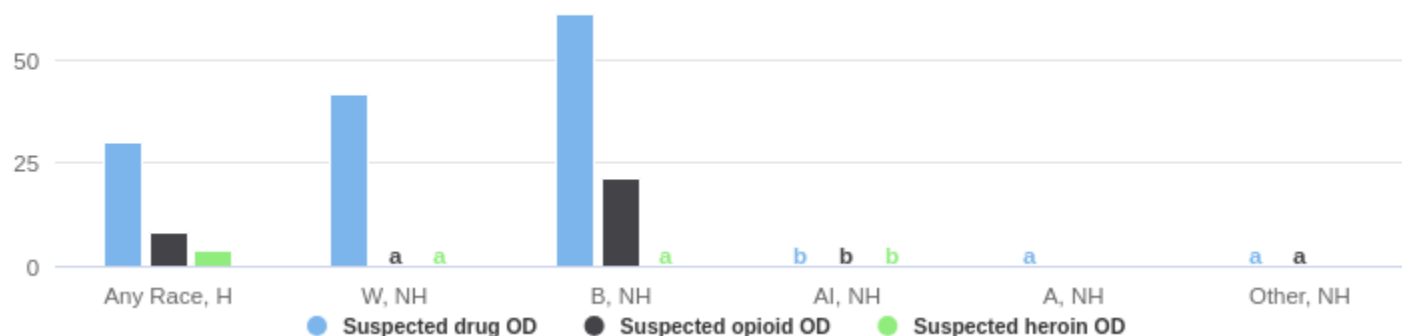

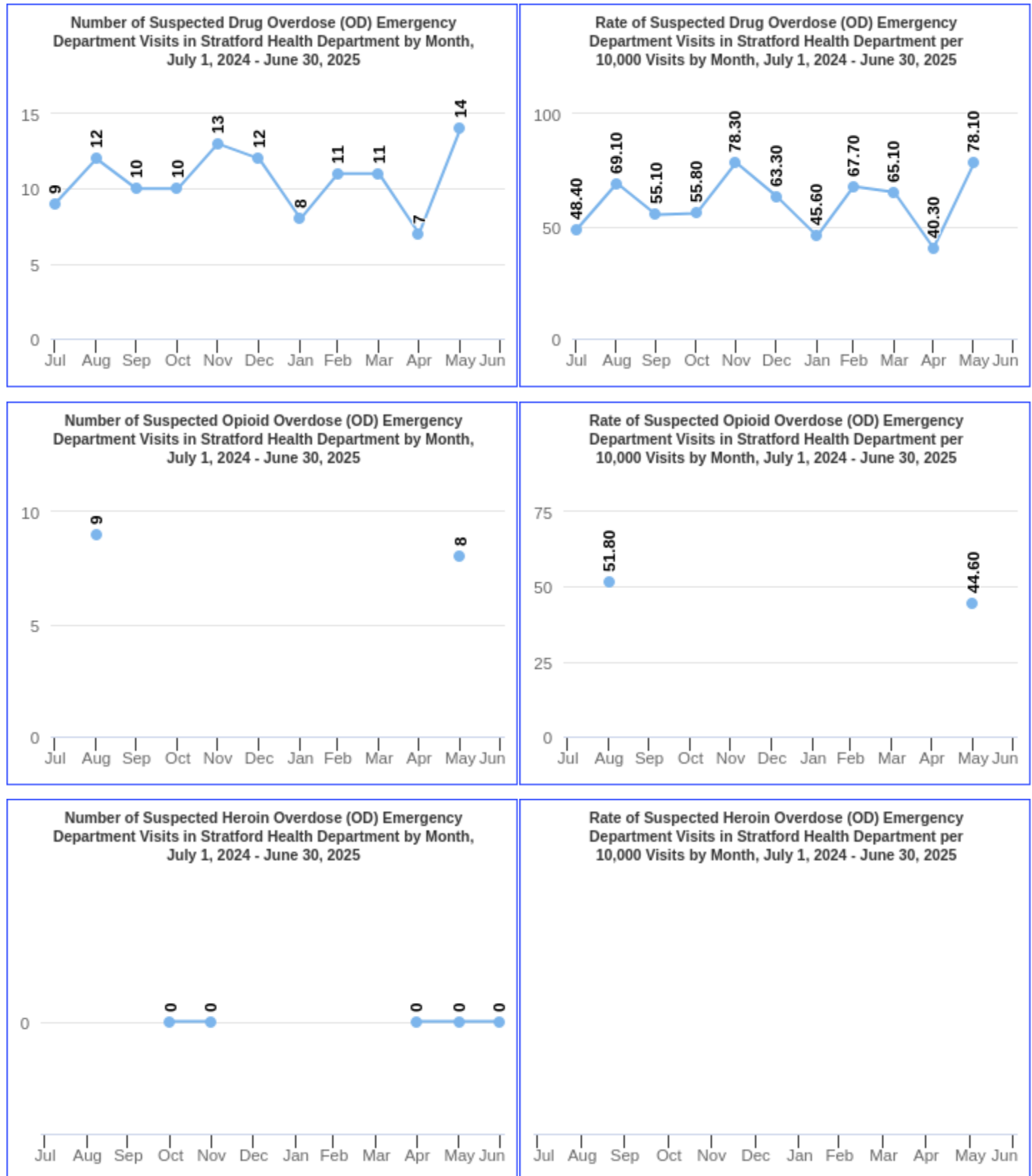

Suspected Drug Overdose in Stratford Health Department



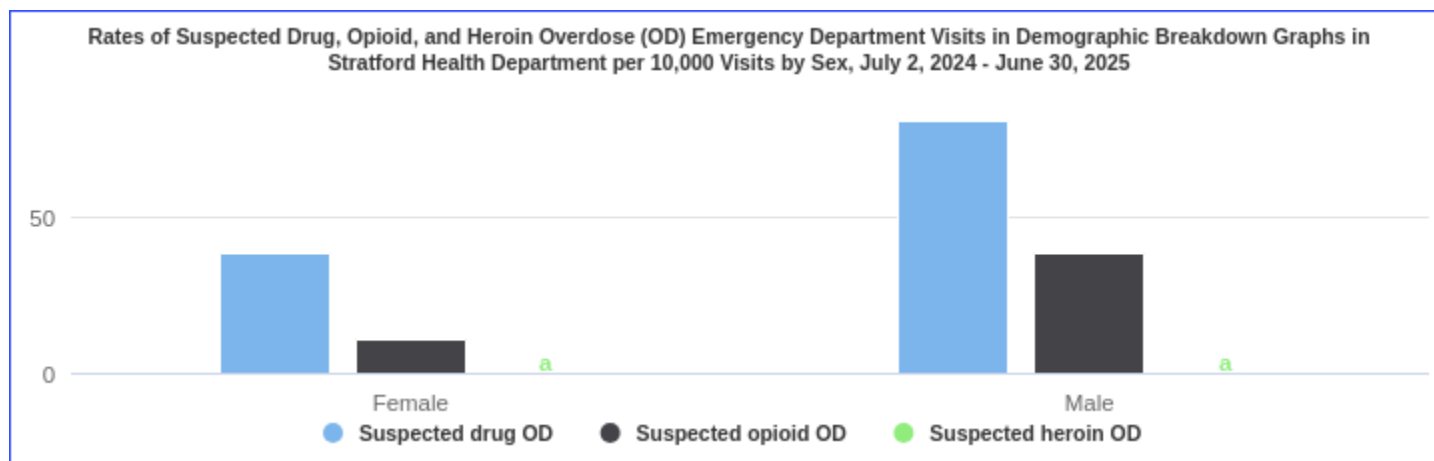

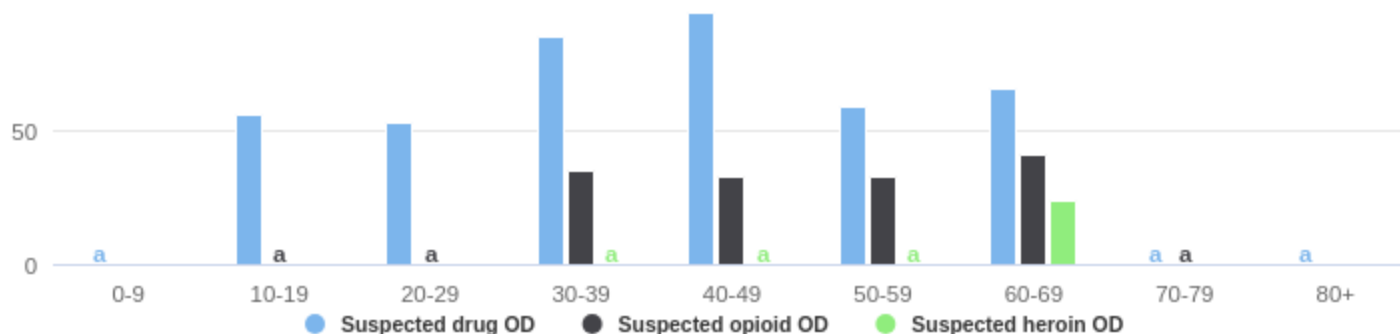

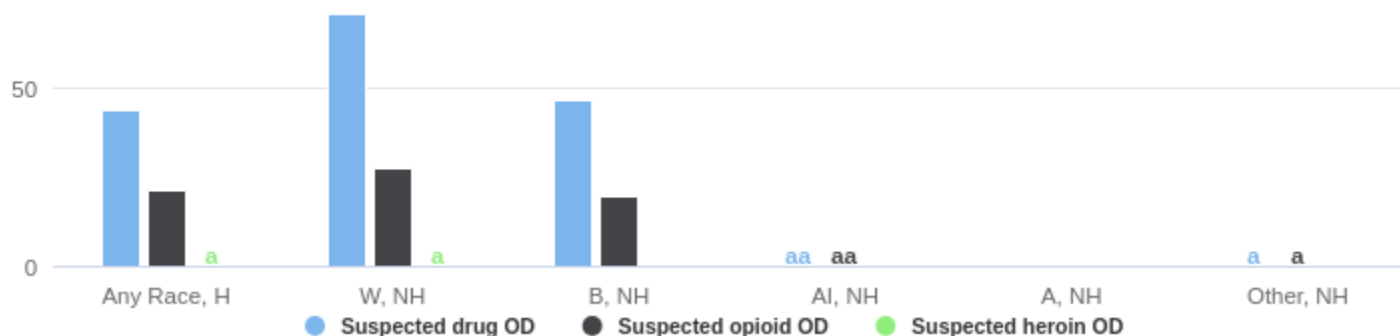

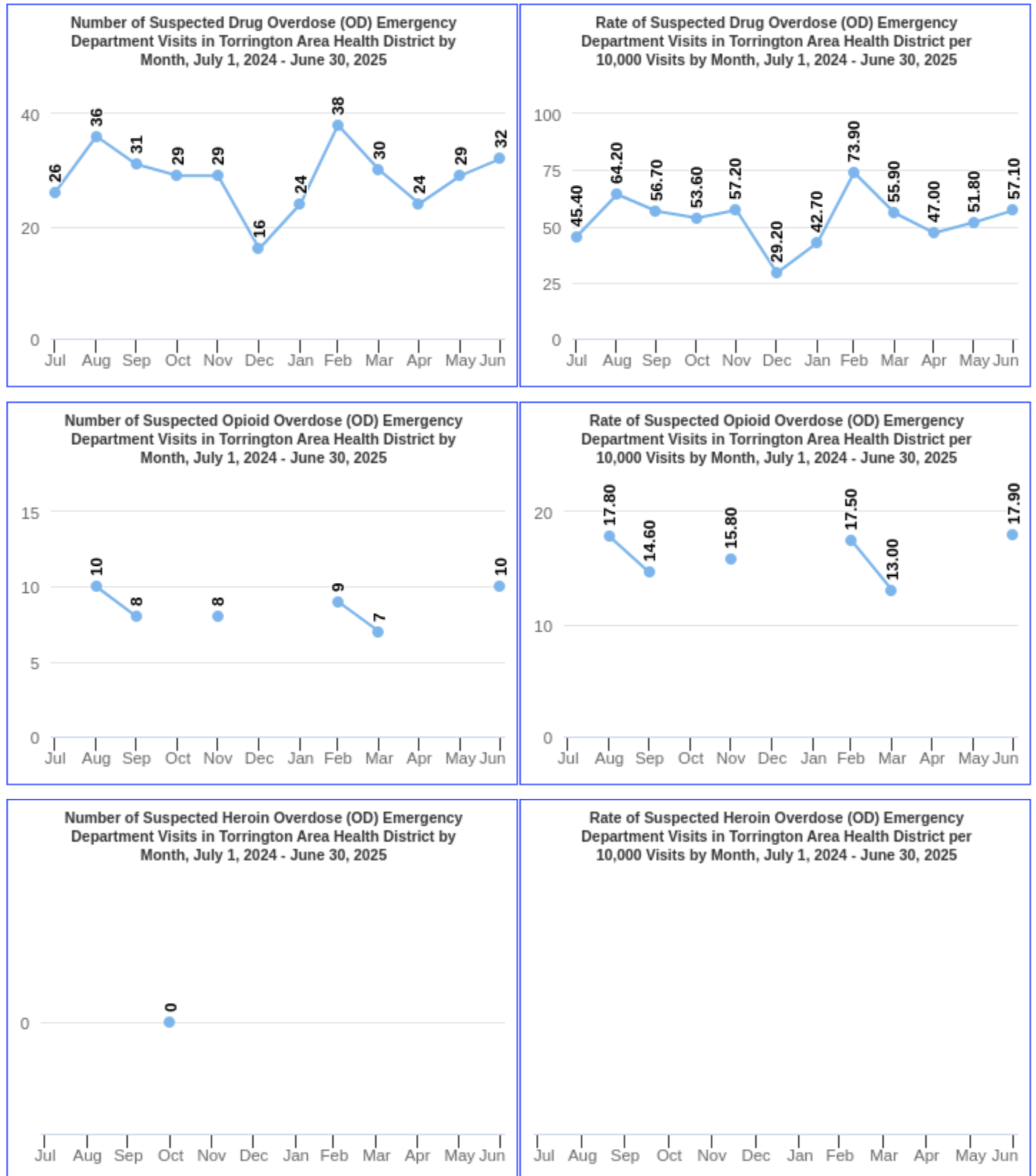

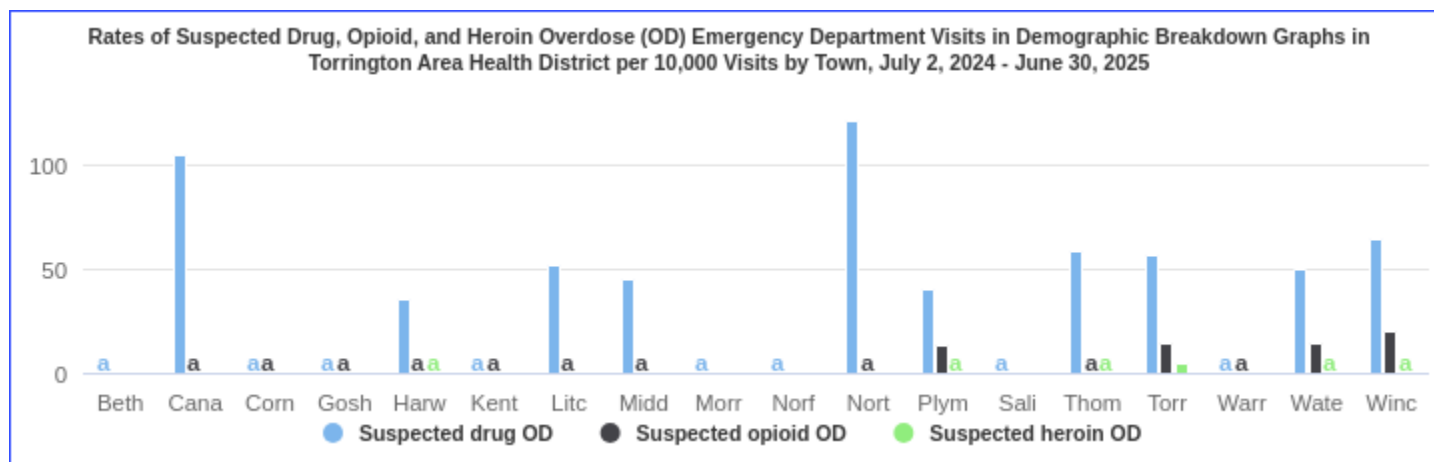

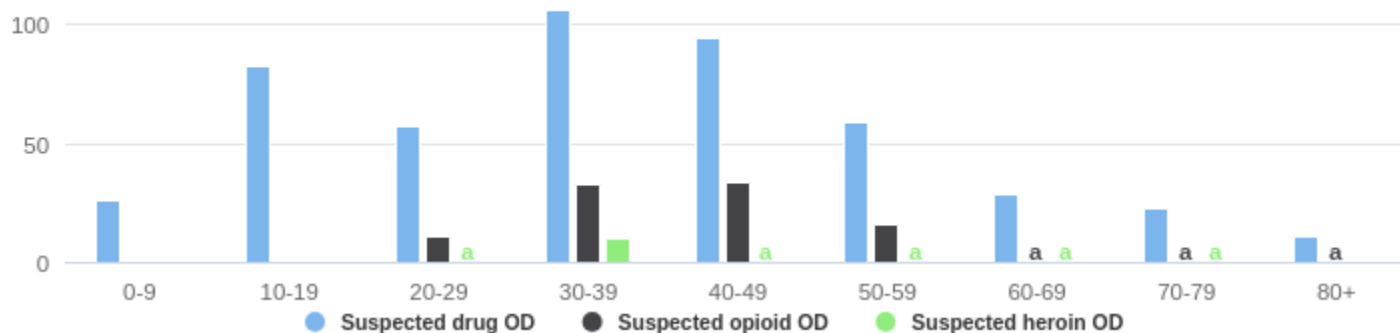

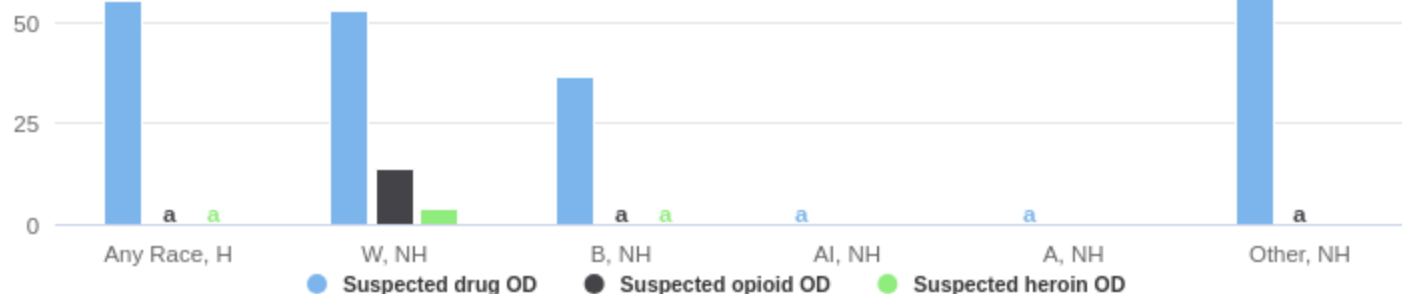

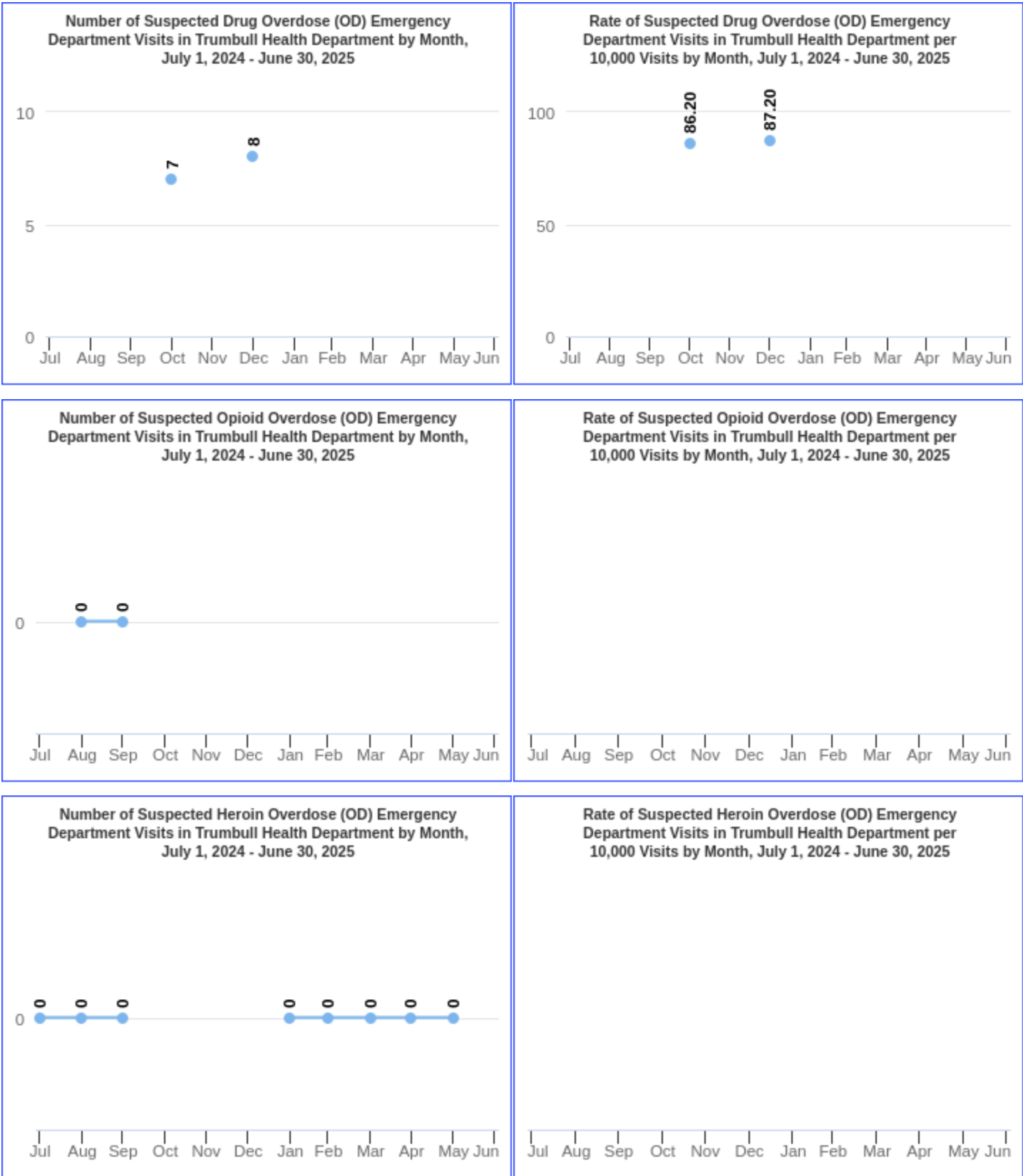

Suspected Drug Overdose in Trumbull Health Department

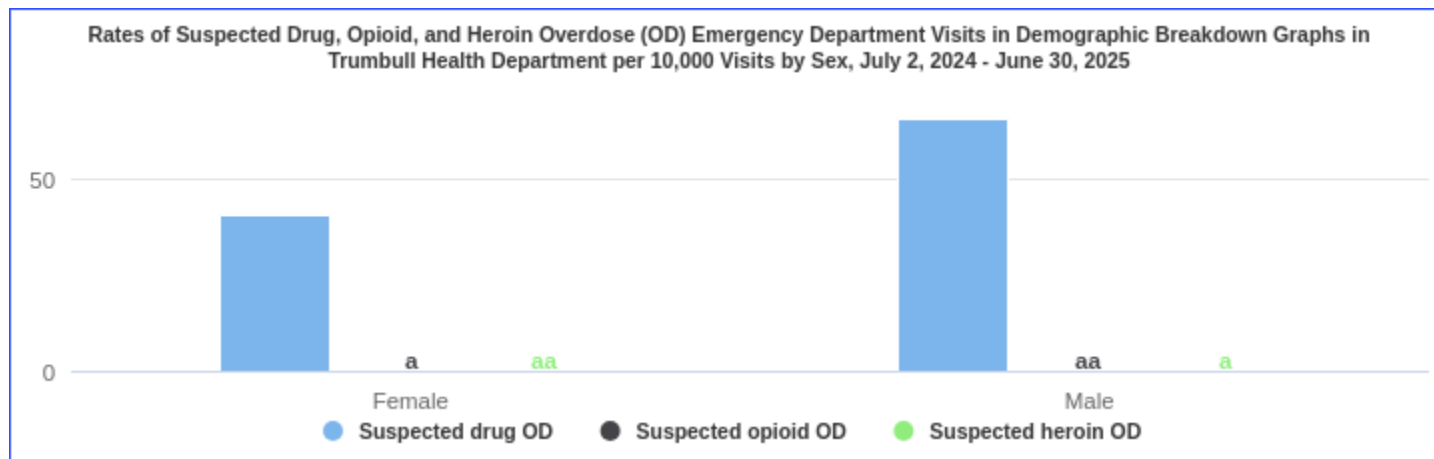

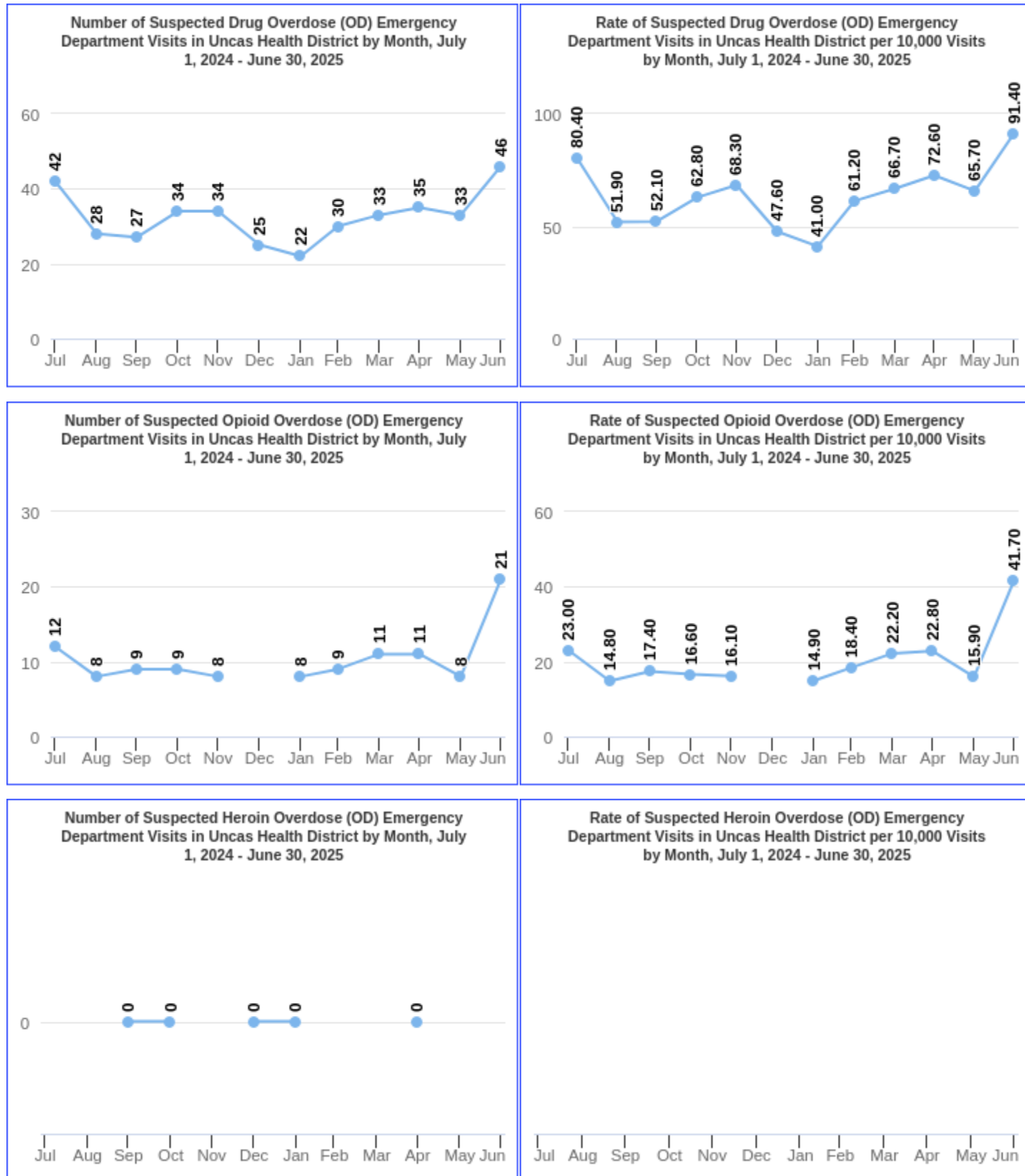

Suspected Drug Overdose in Uncas Health District



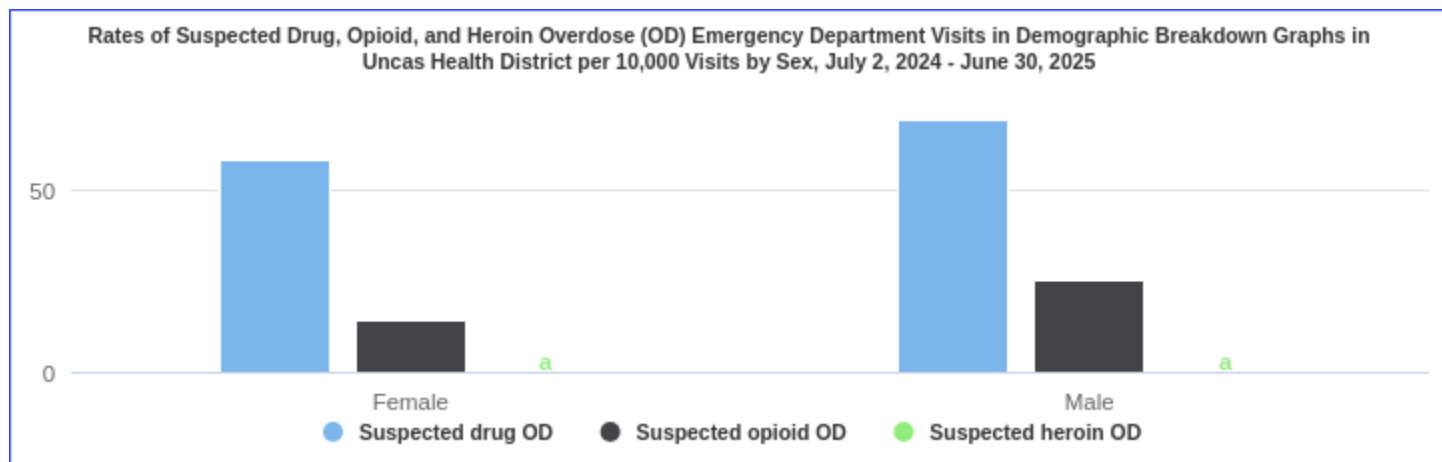

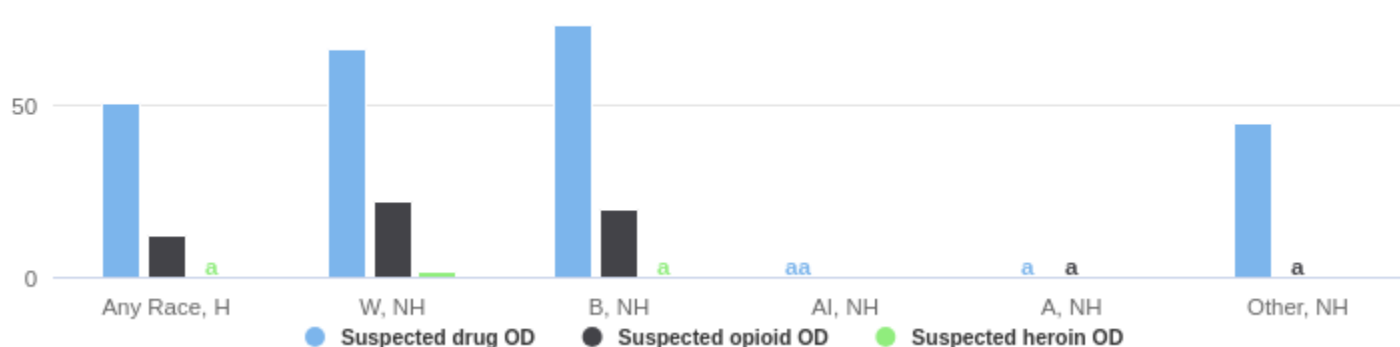

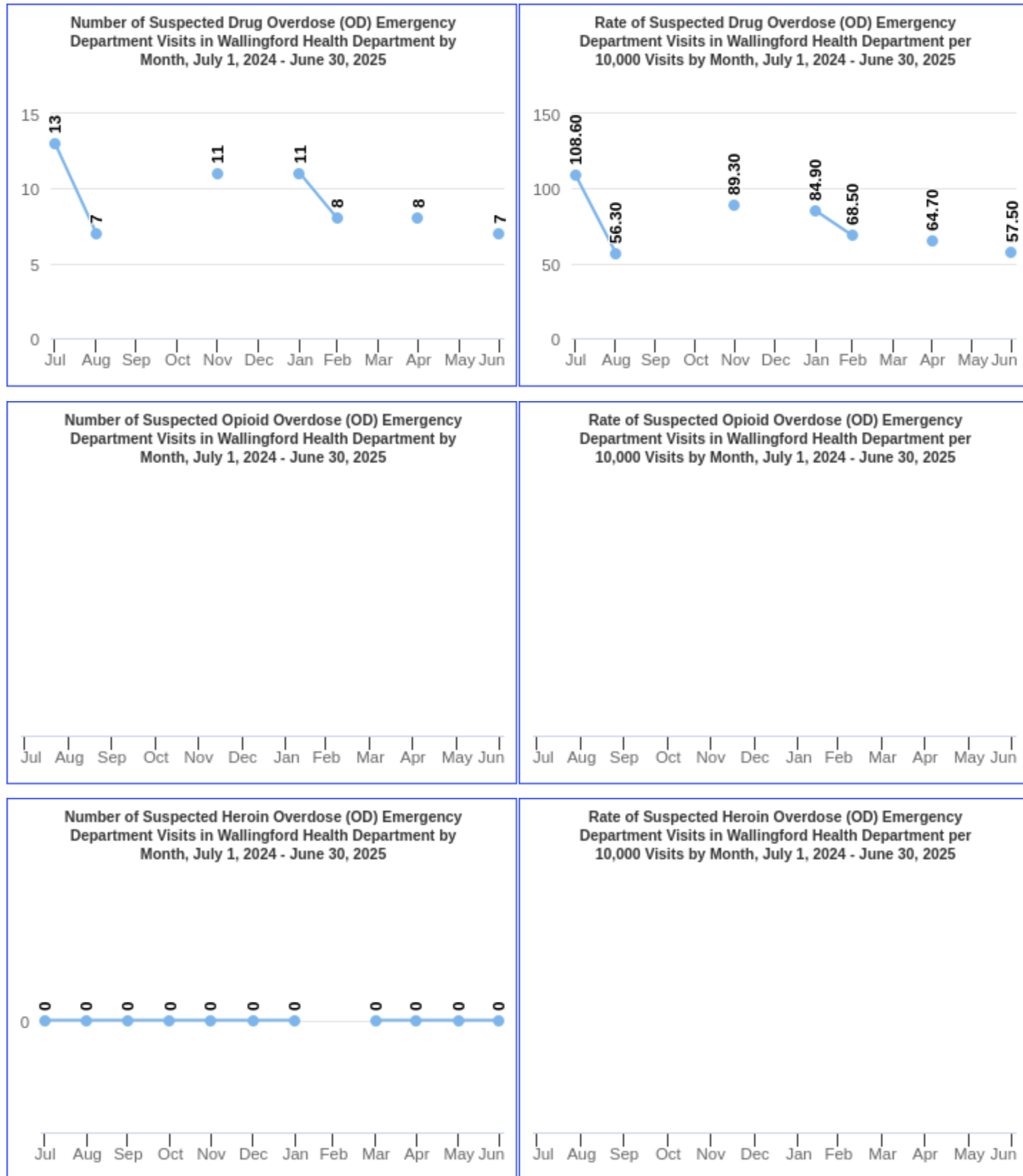

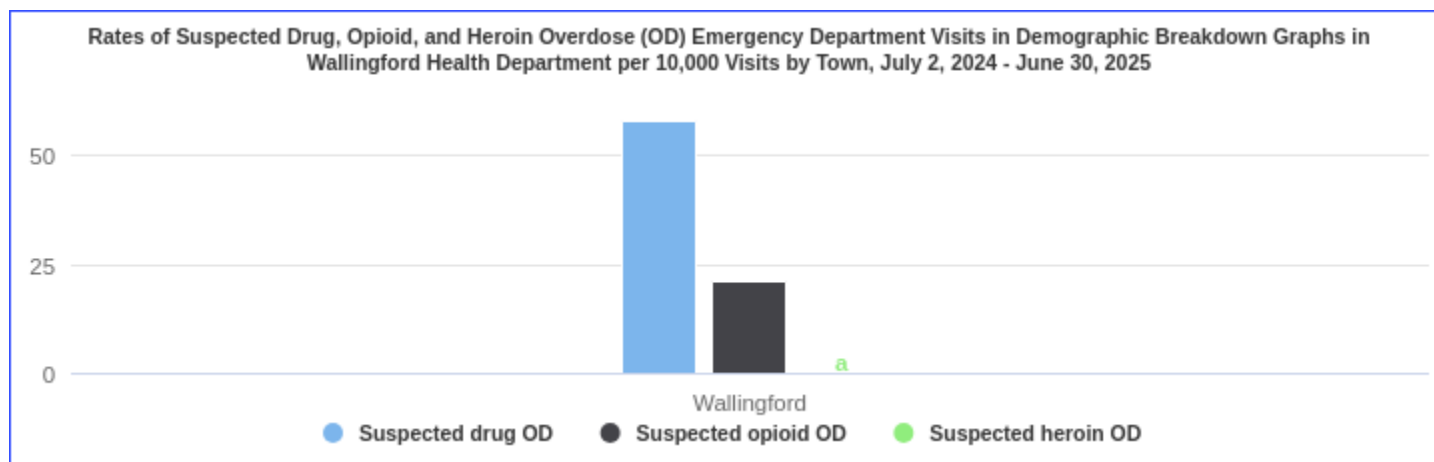

Suspected Drug Overdose in Wallingford Health Department



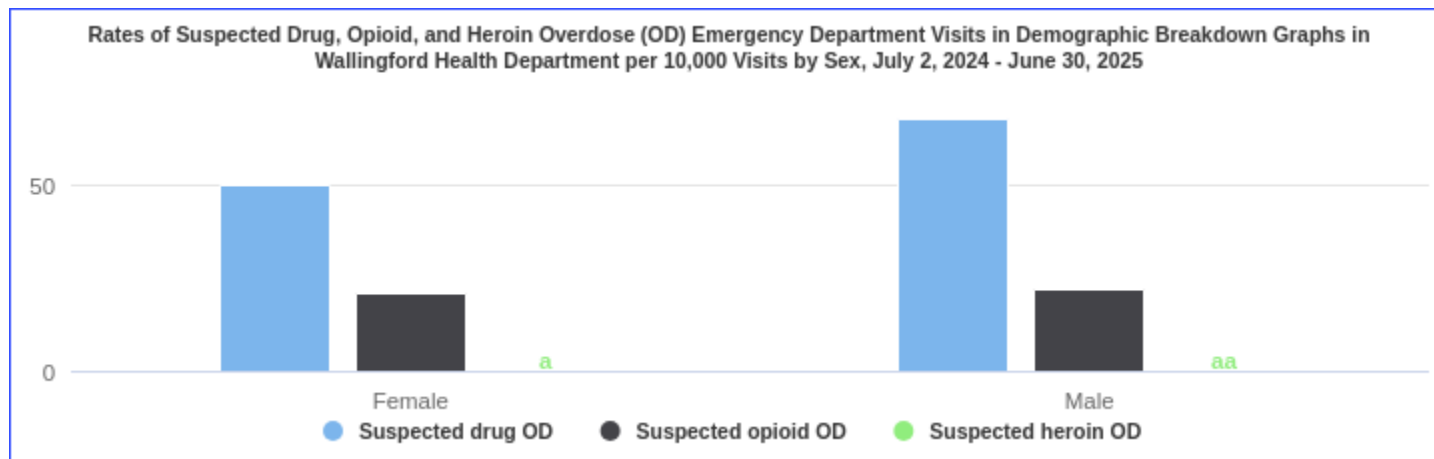

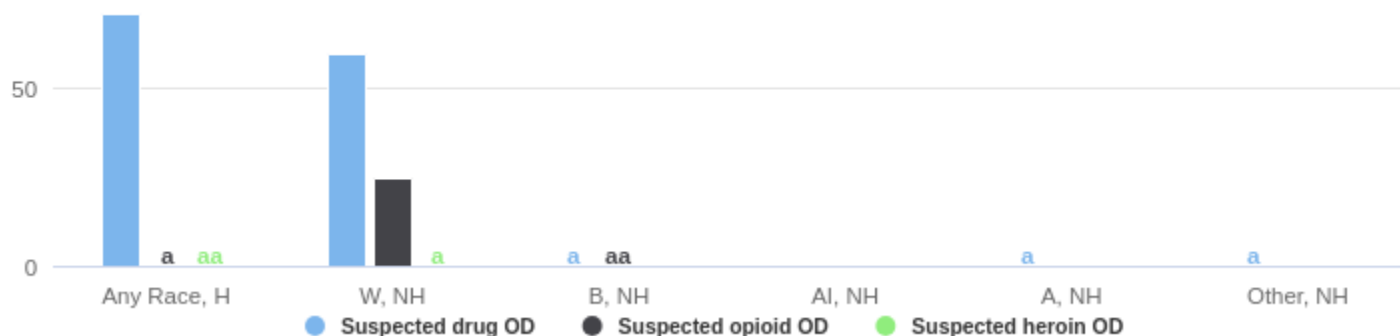

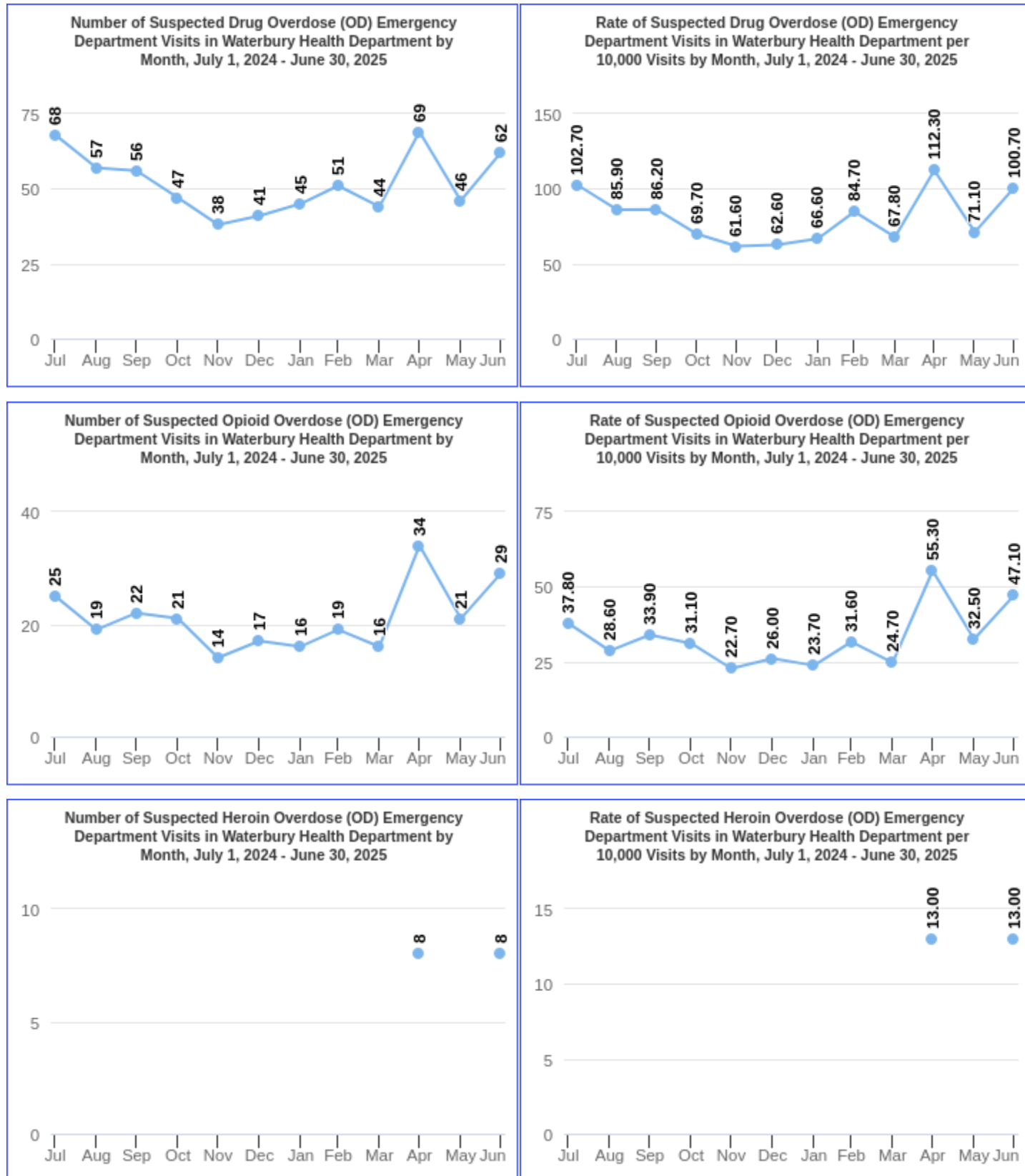

Suspected Drug Overdose in Waterbury Health Department



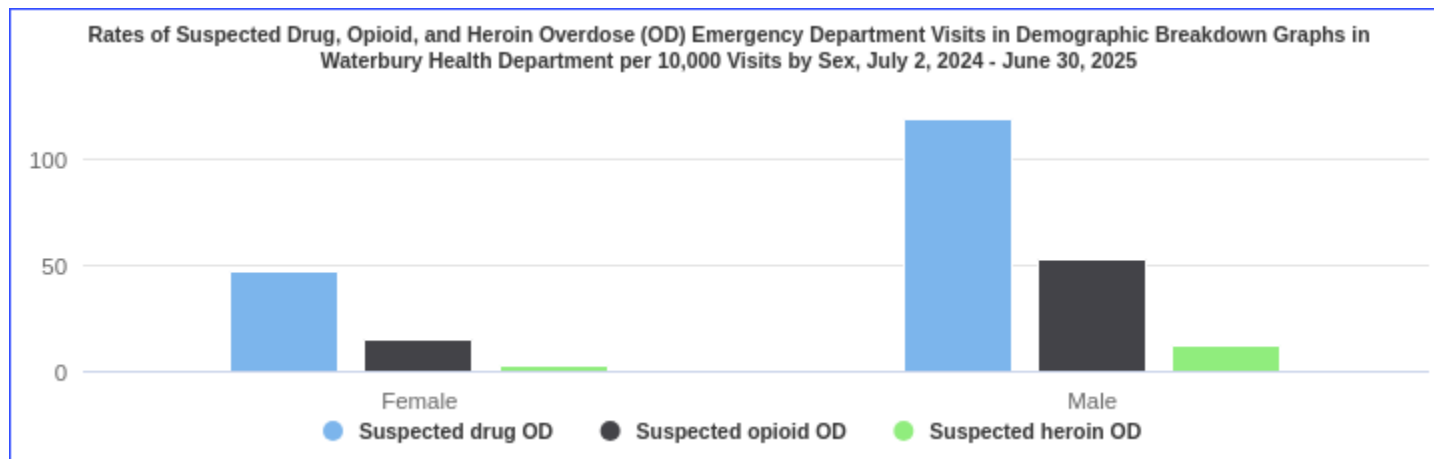

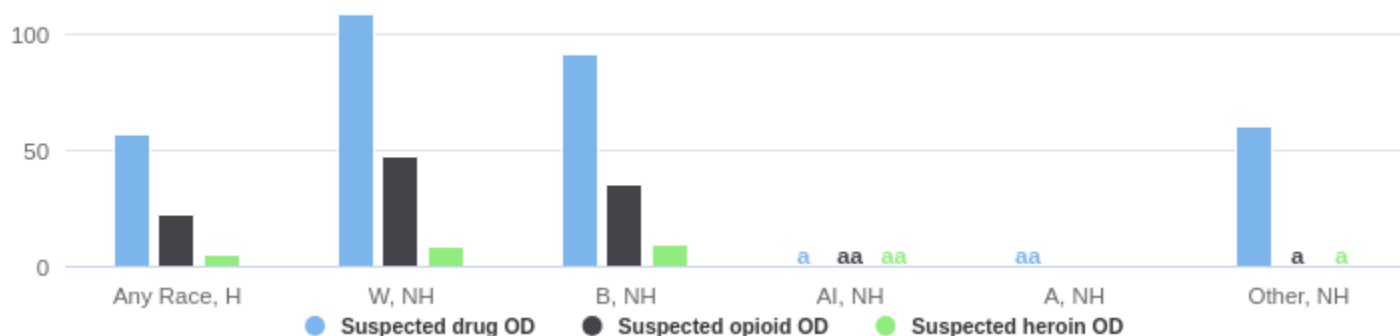

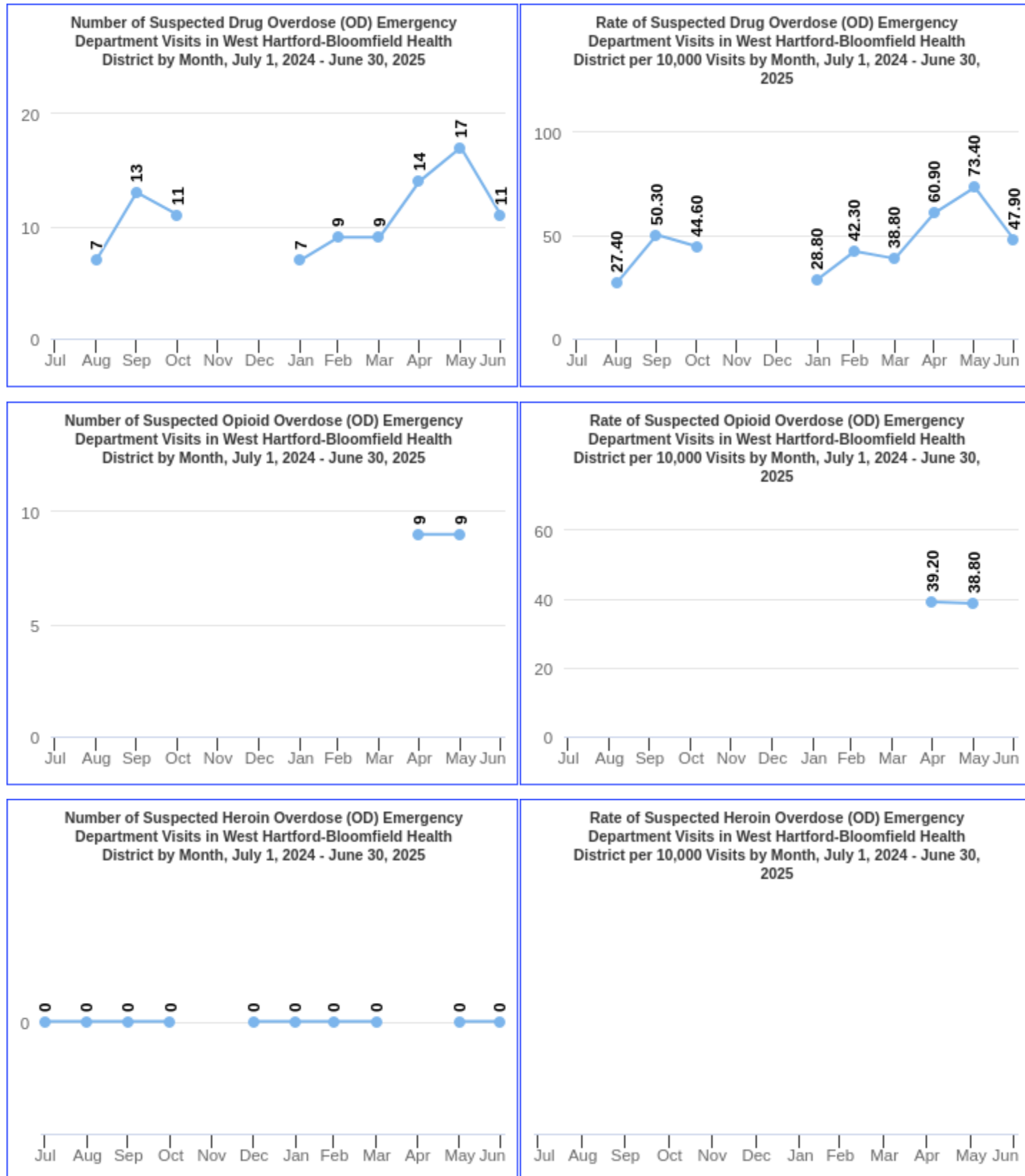

Suspected Drug Overdose in West Hartford-Bloomfield Health District



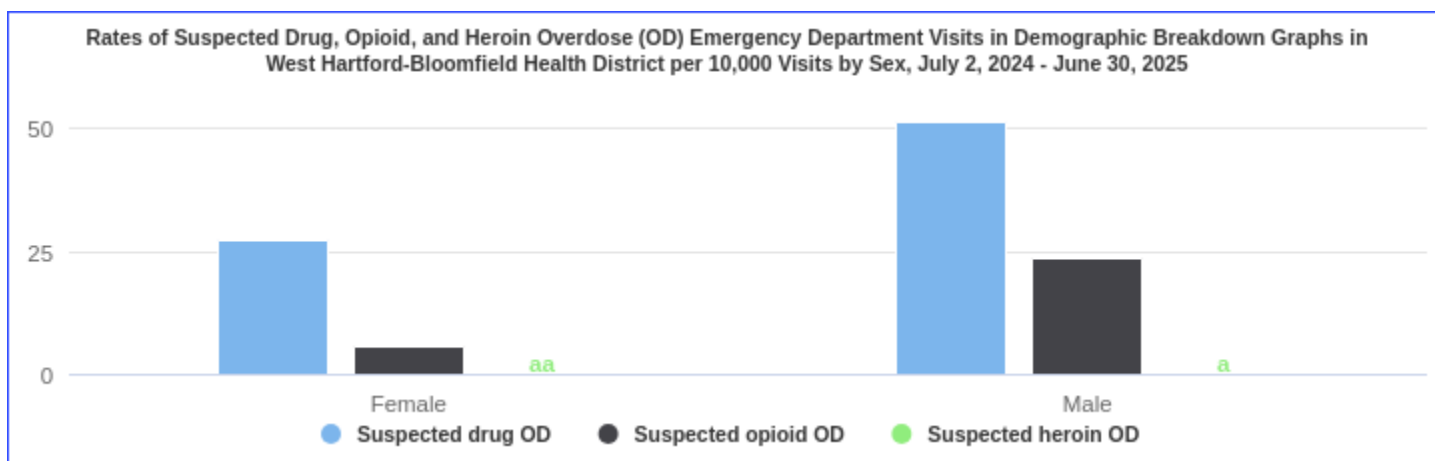

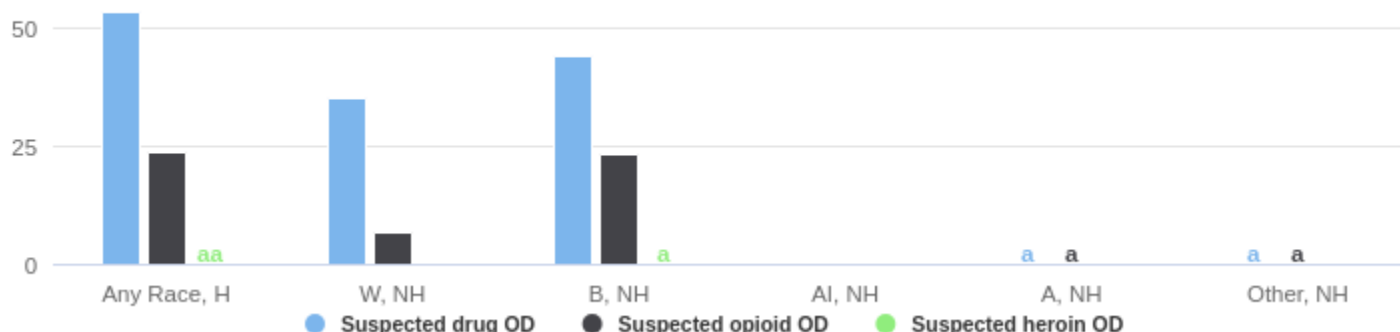

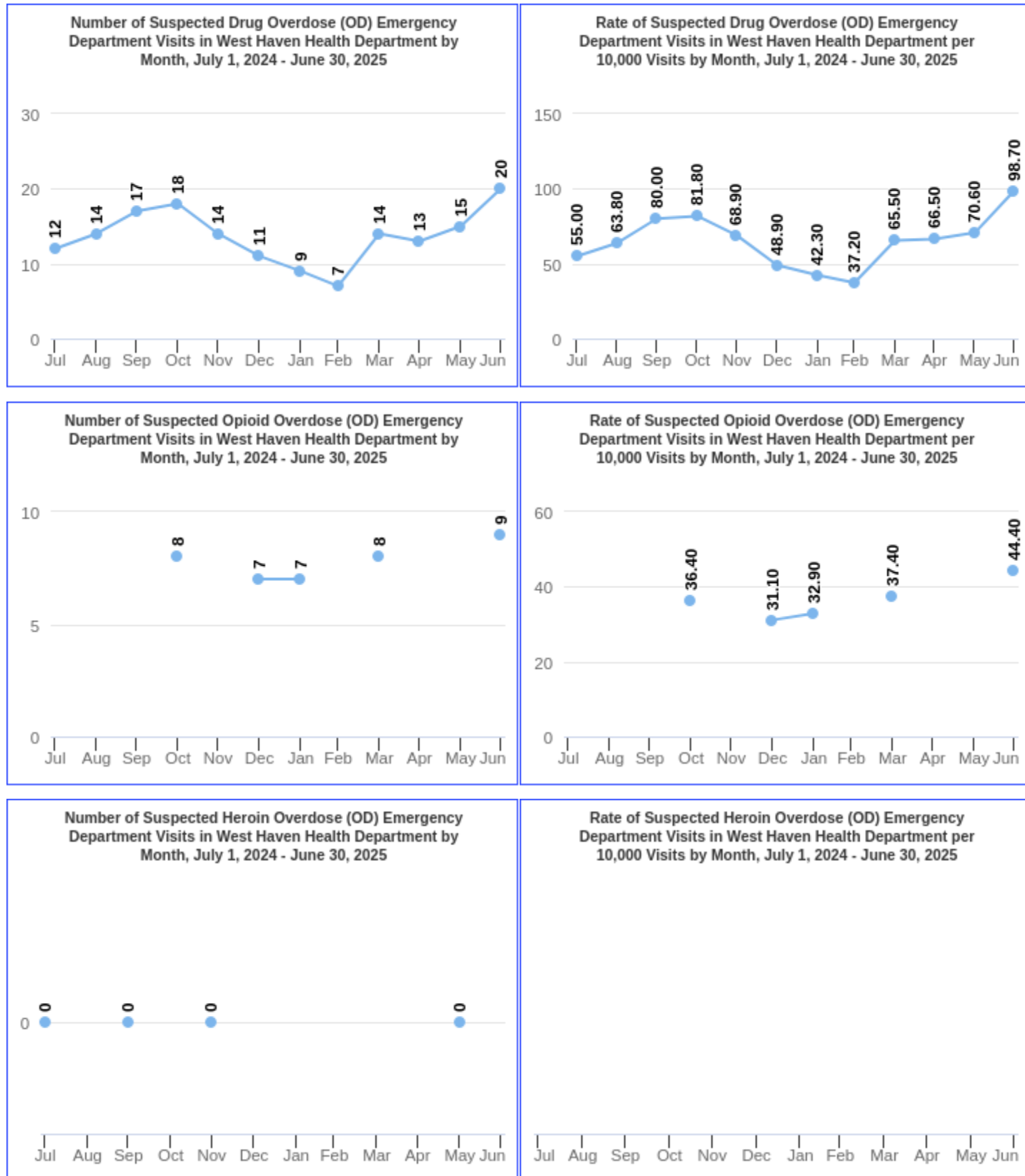

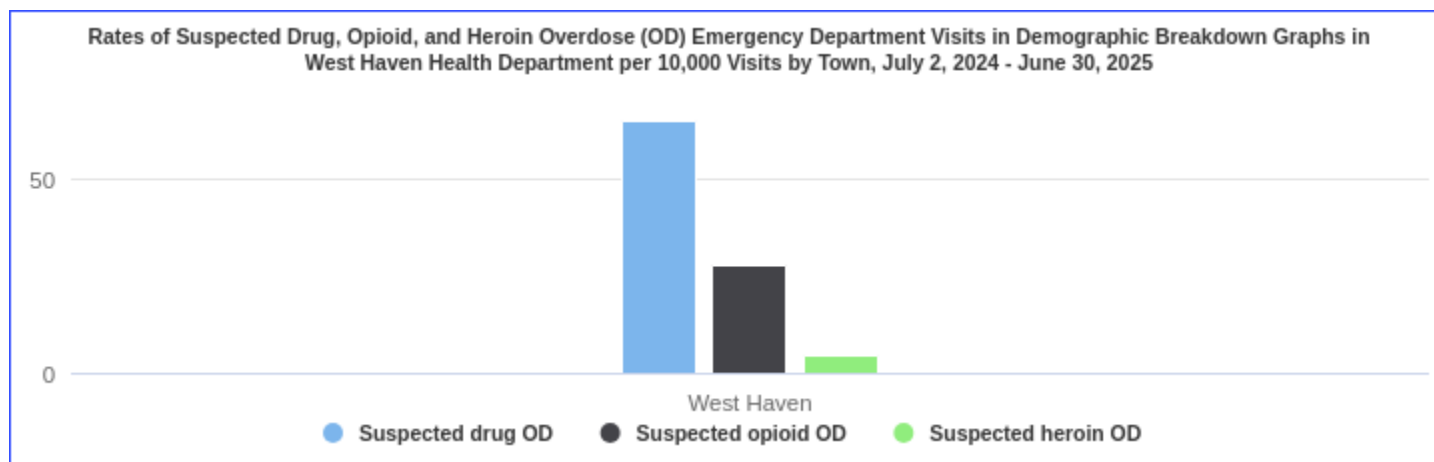

Suspected Drug Overdose in West Haven Health Department



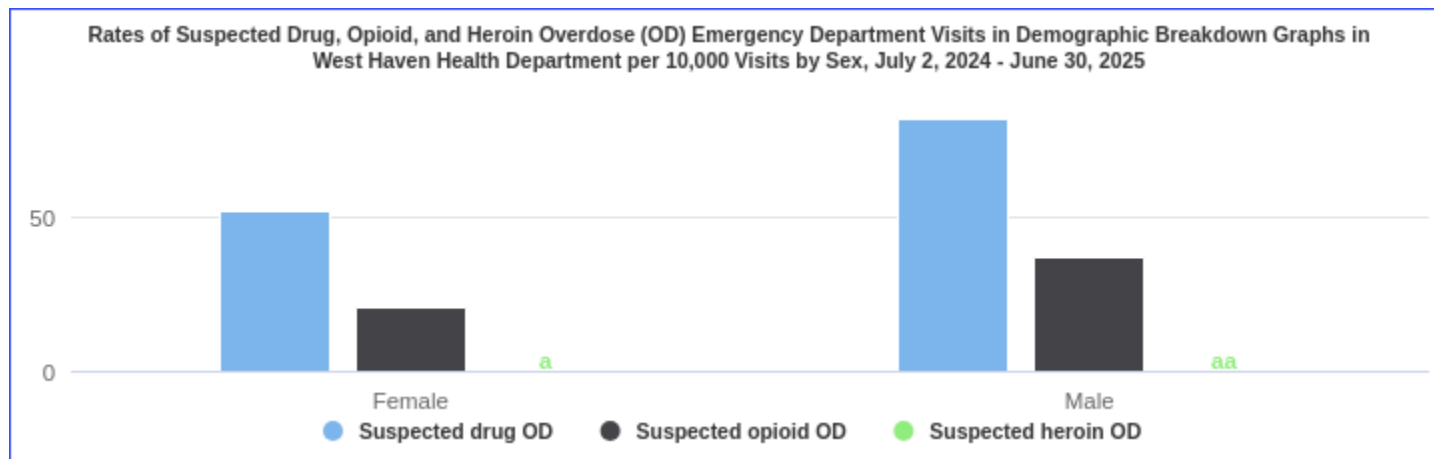

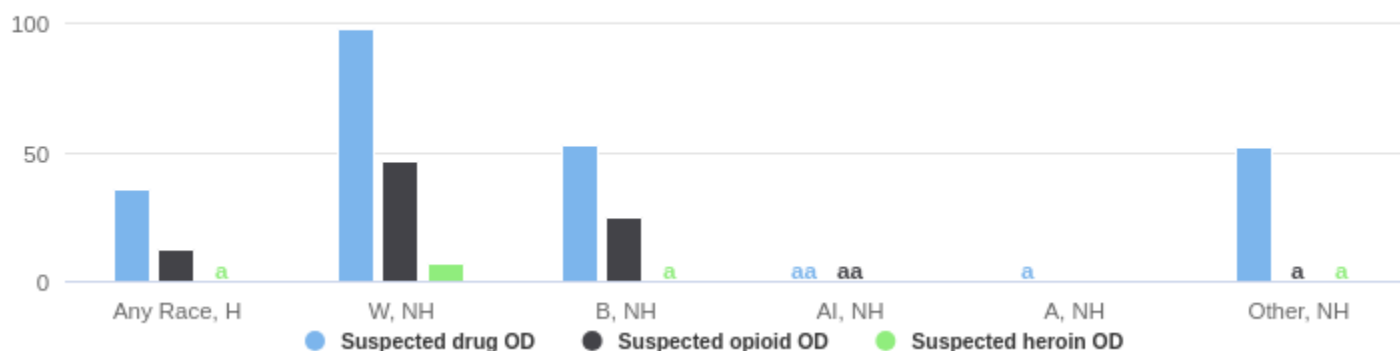

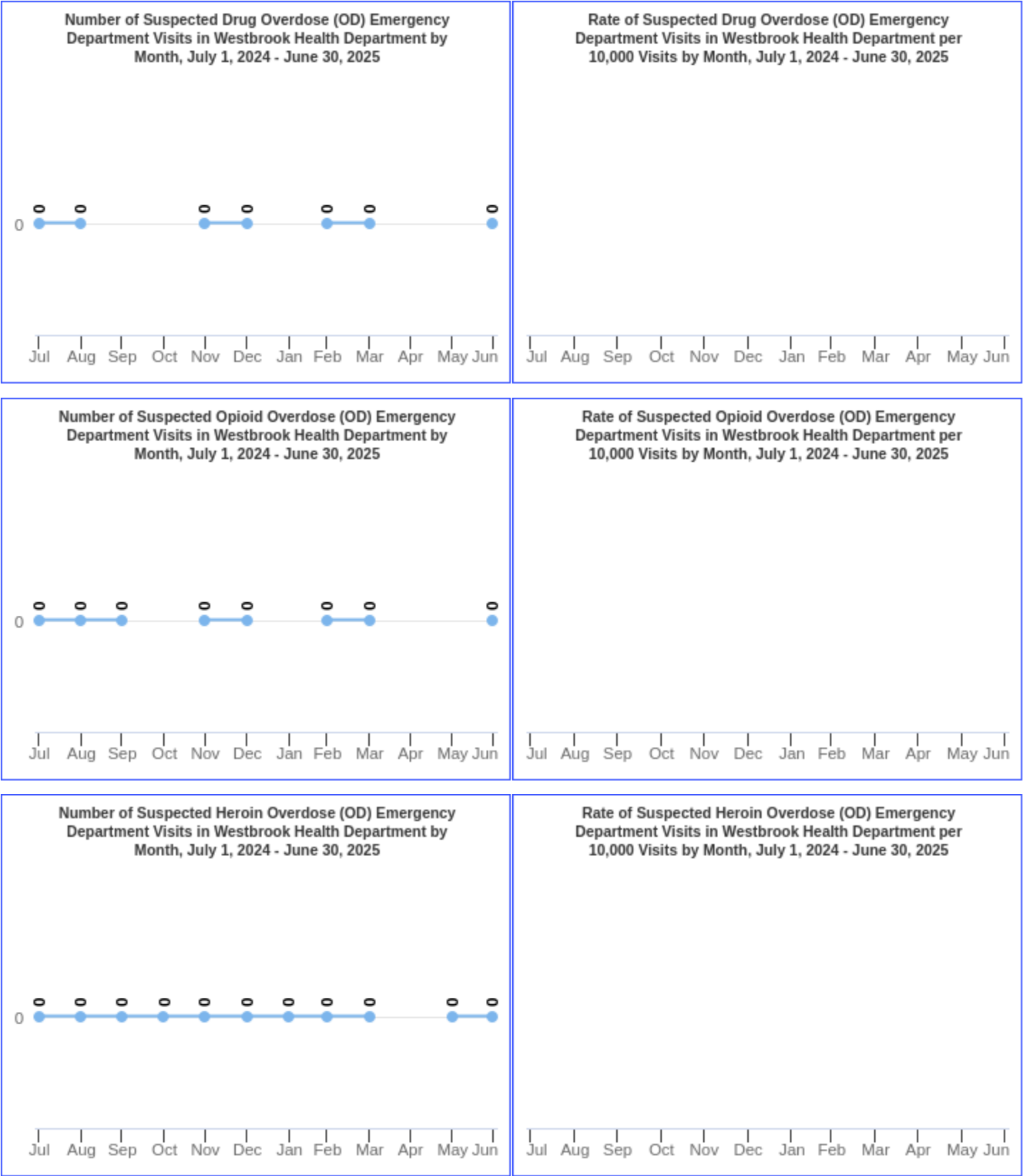

Suspected Drug Overdose in Westbrook Health Department

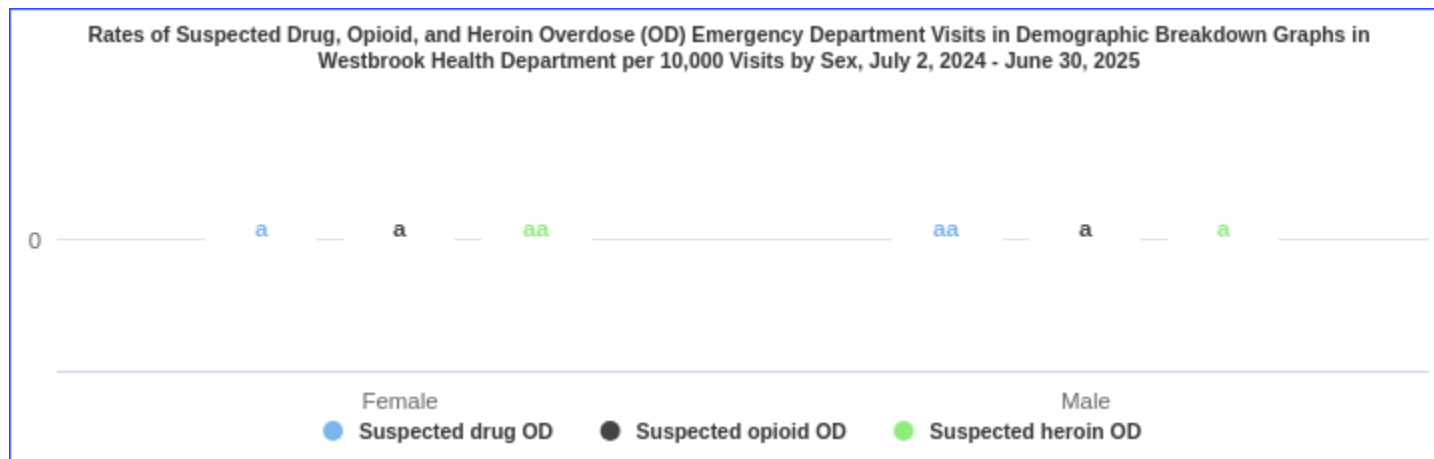

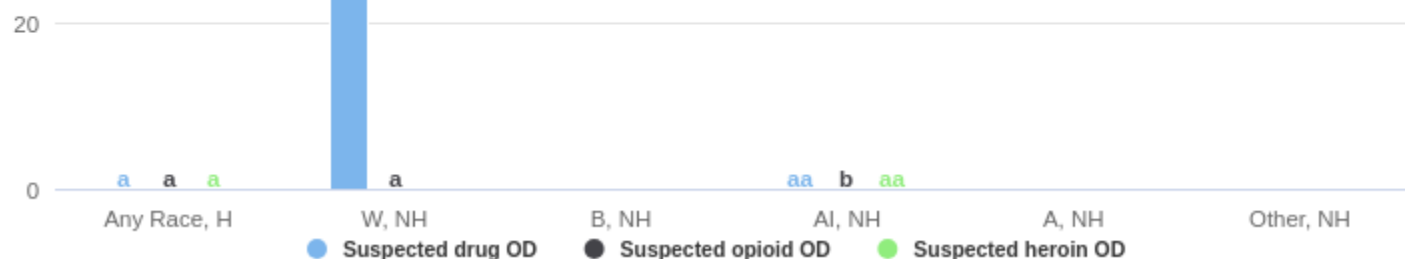

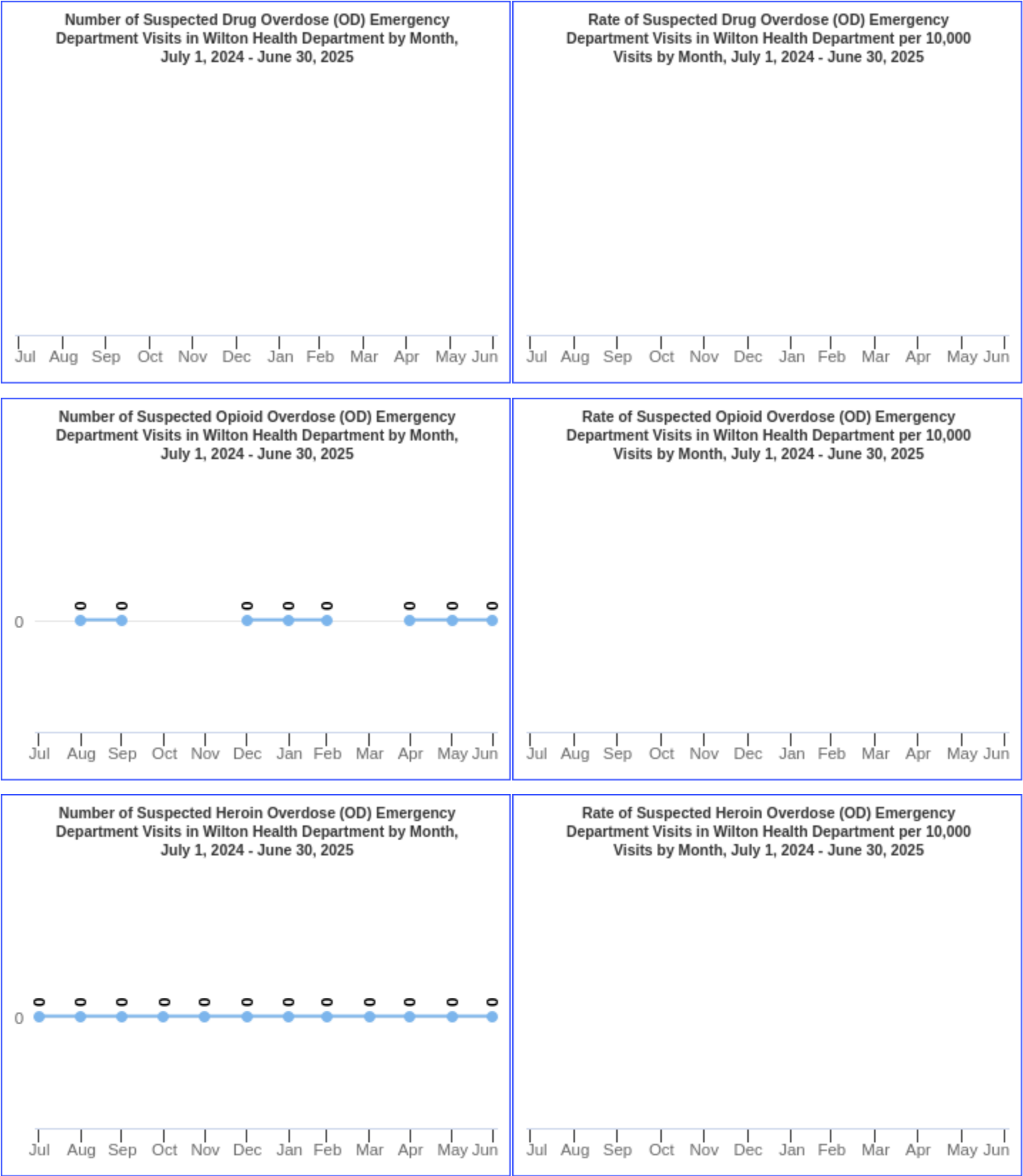

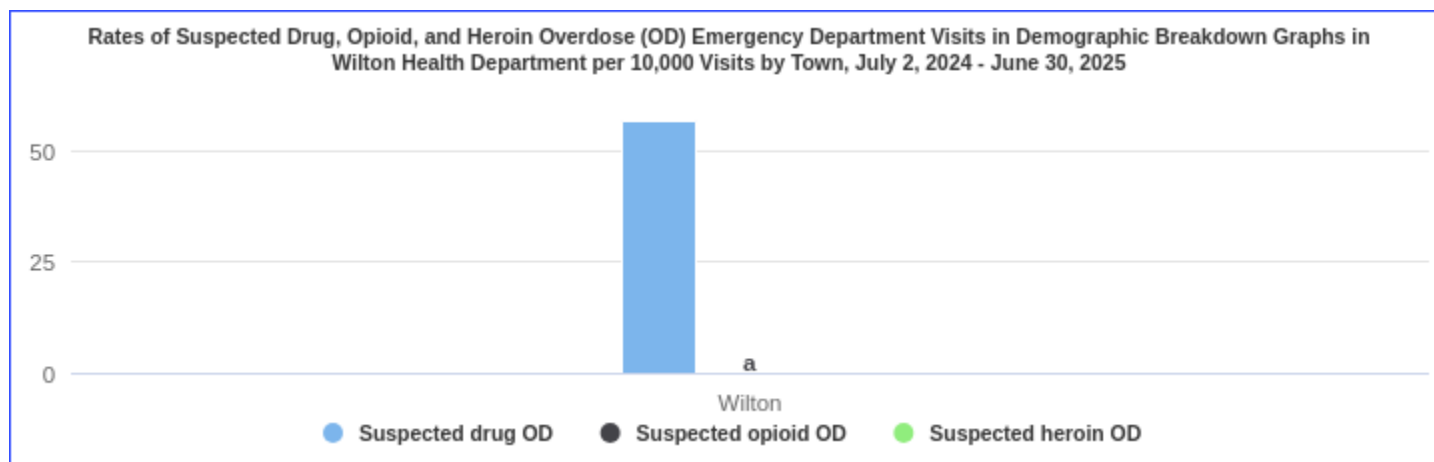

Suspected Drug Overdose in Wilton Health Department



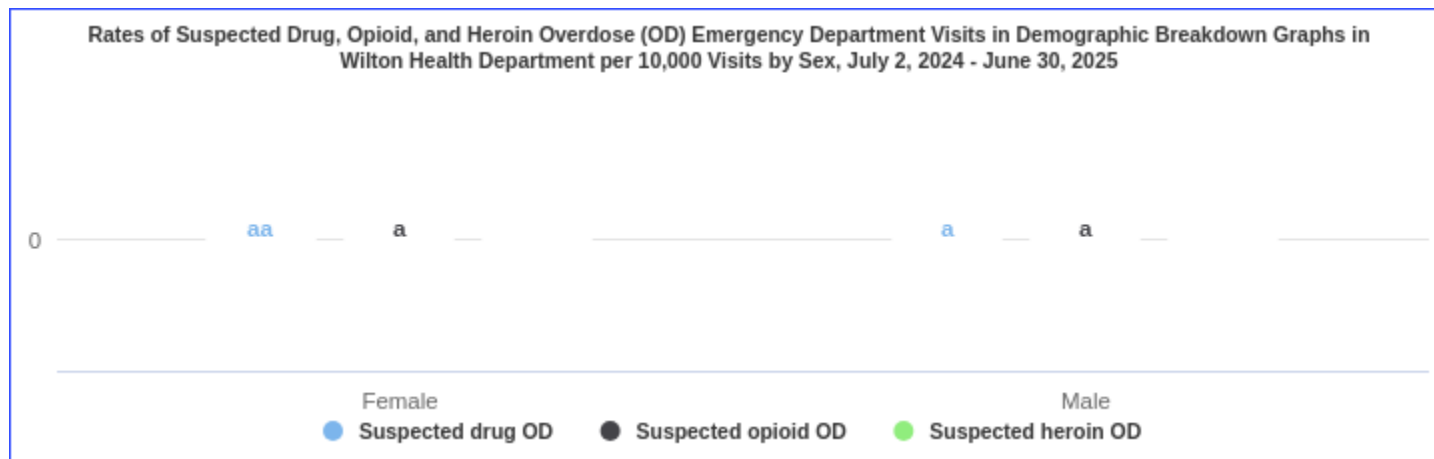

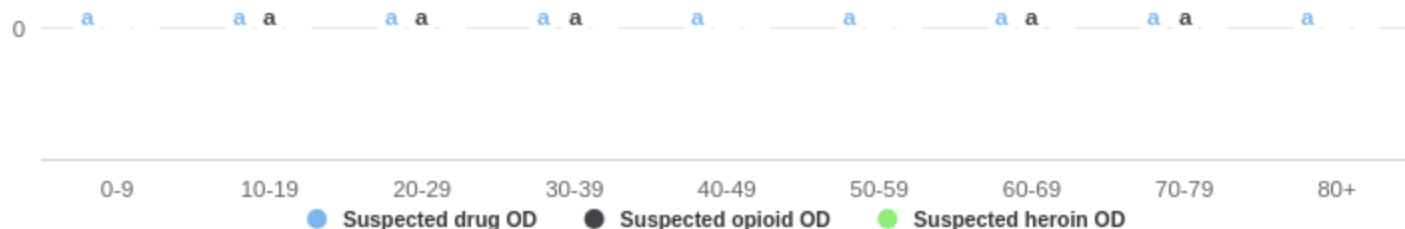

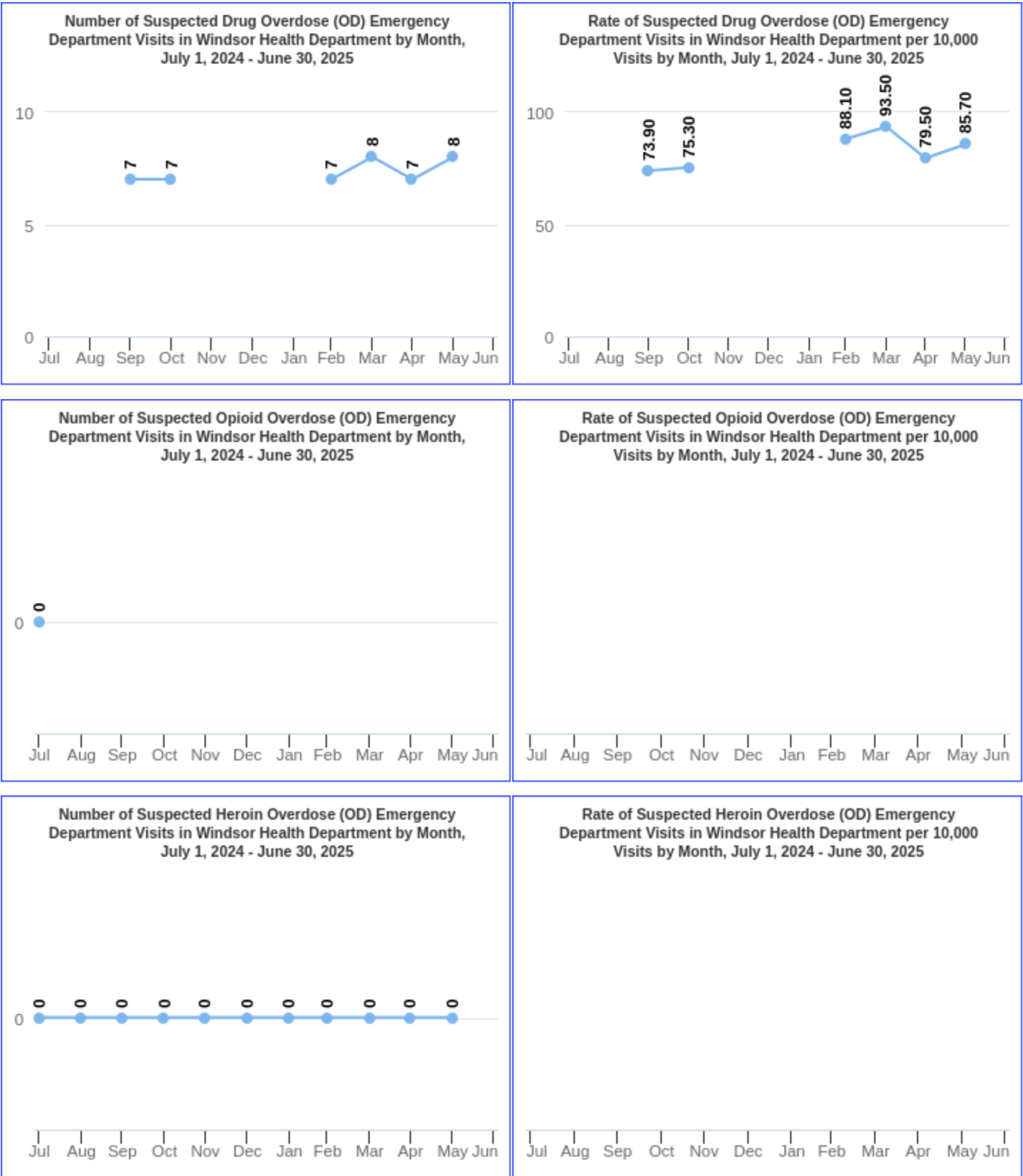

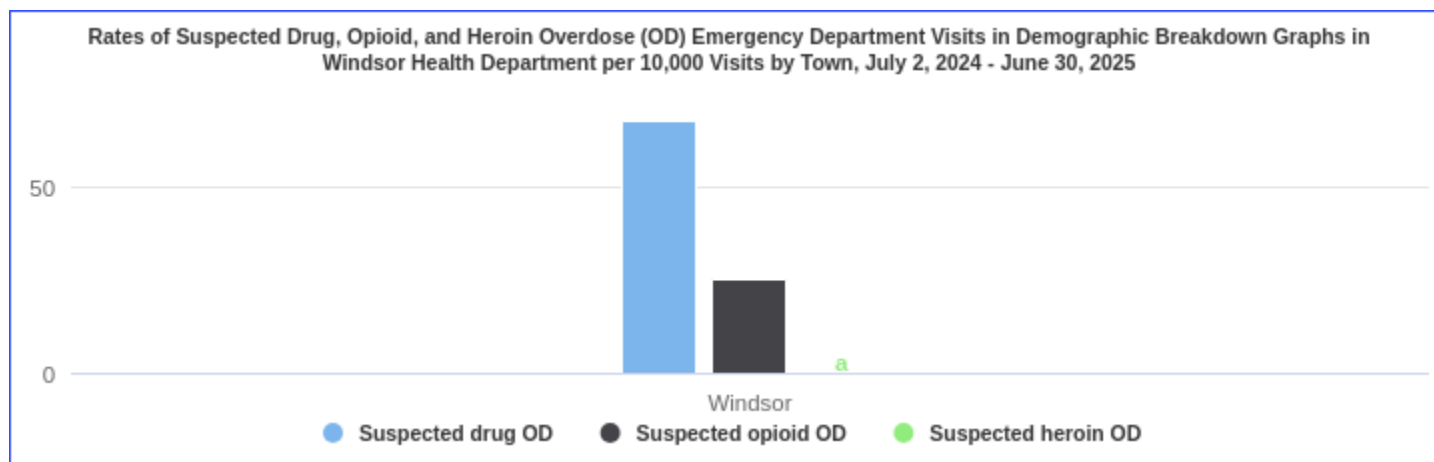

Suspected Drug Overdose in Windsor Health Department



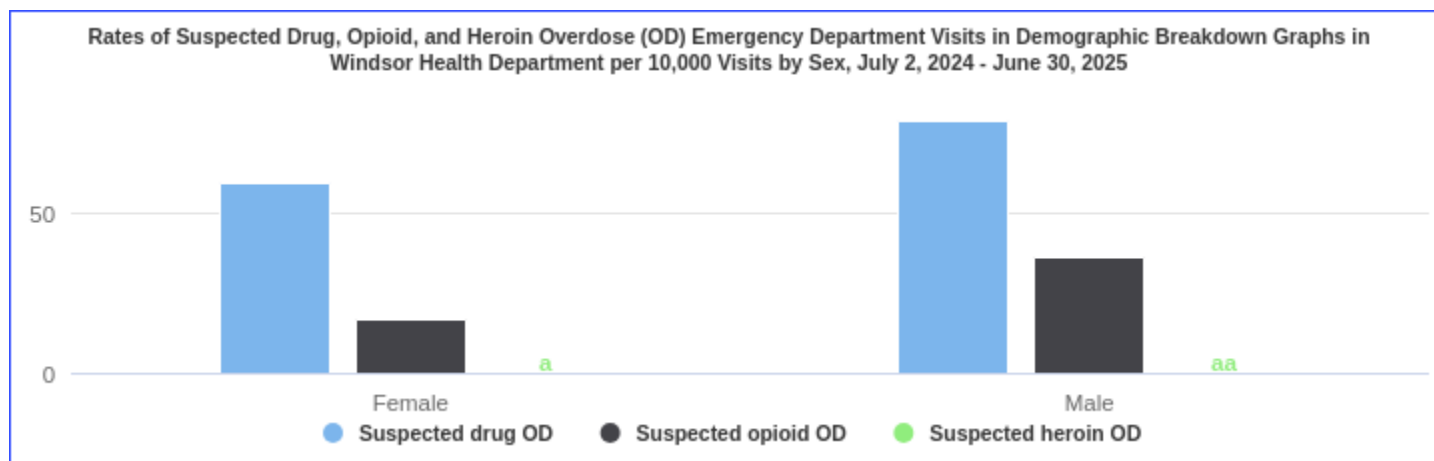

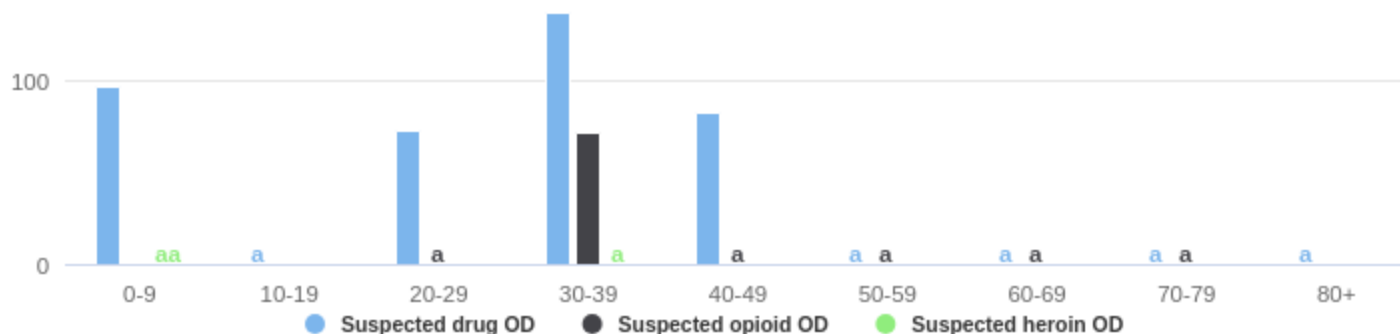

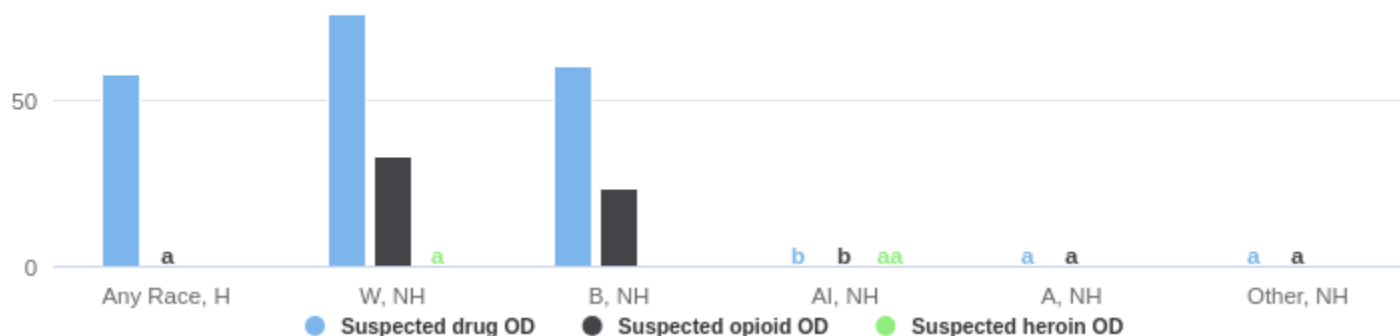
